

# How to live stream and broadcast videos on Facebook using XSplit

## 1. XSplit Installation Guide

**Step 1:** Download the XSplit software .

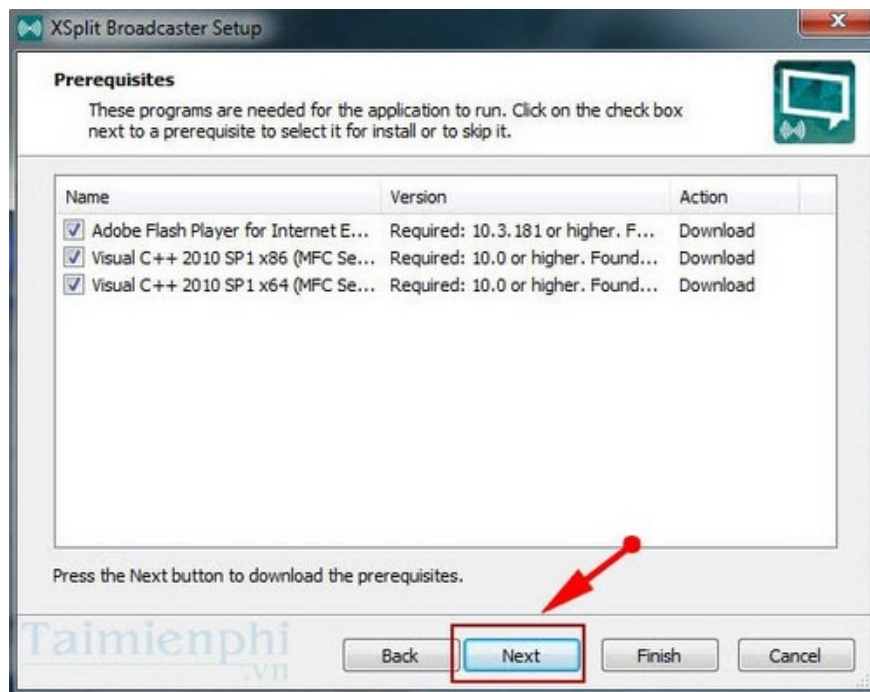
**Step 2:** After downloading the software, double-click the downloaded .exe file to begin the installation. Click OK in the language selection window.



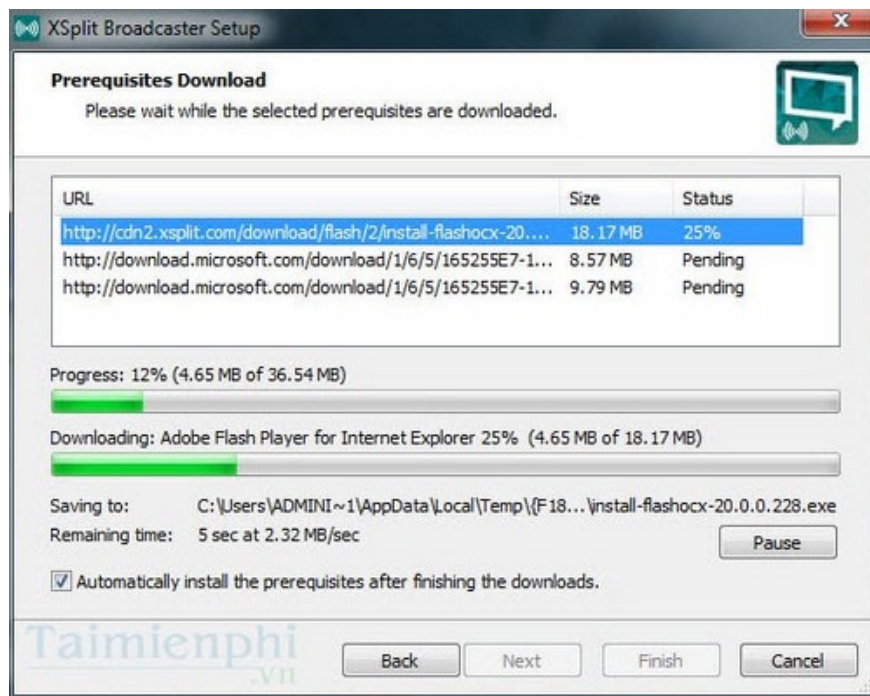
Press **Next**



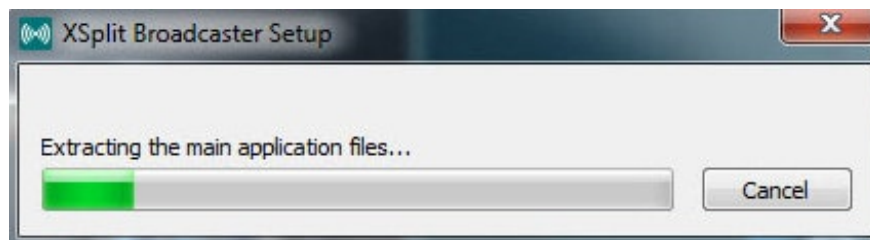
Press **Next**



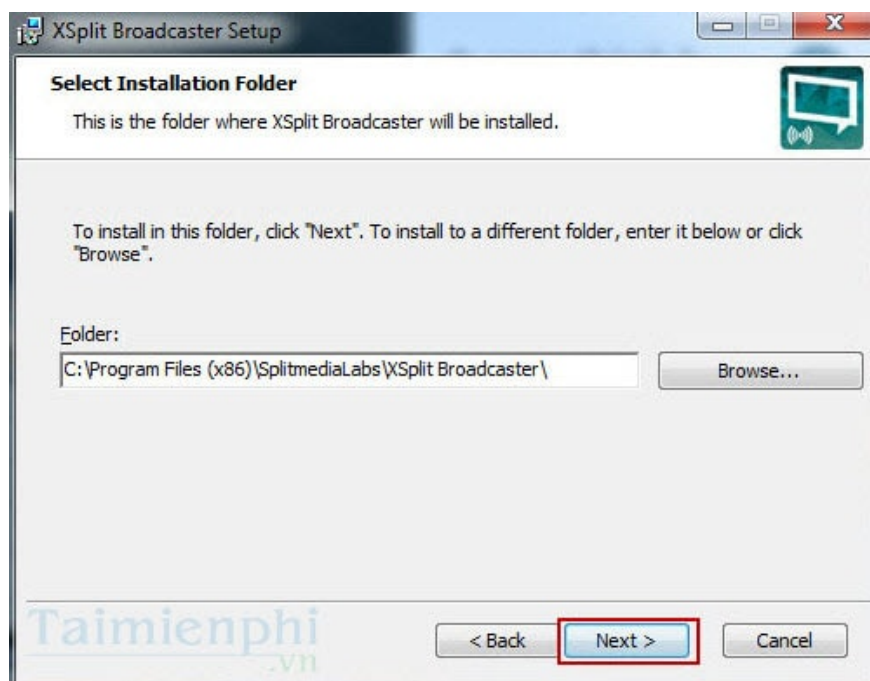
**Step 3:** The software installation process will automatically detect any missing supporting components and download them automatically. Click **Next** in the window notifying you of the required supporting components to download and install them on your computer.



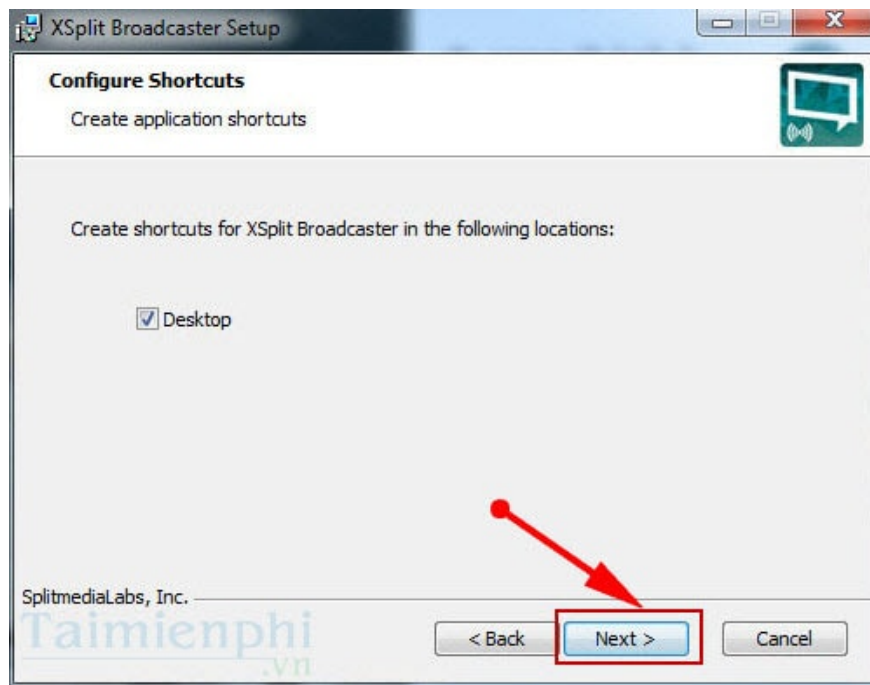
Please wait a moment for the software to download and proceed with extracting and installing the supporting components.



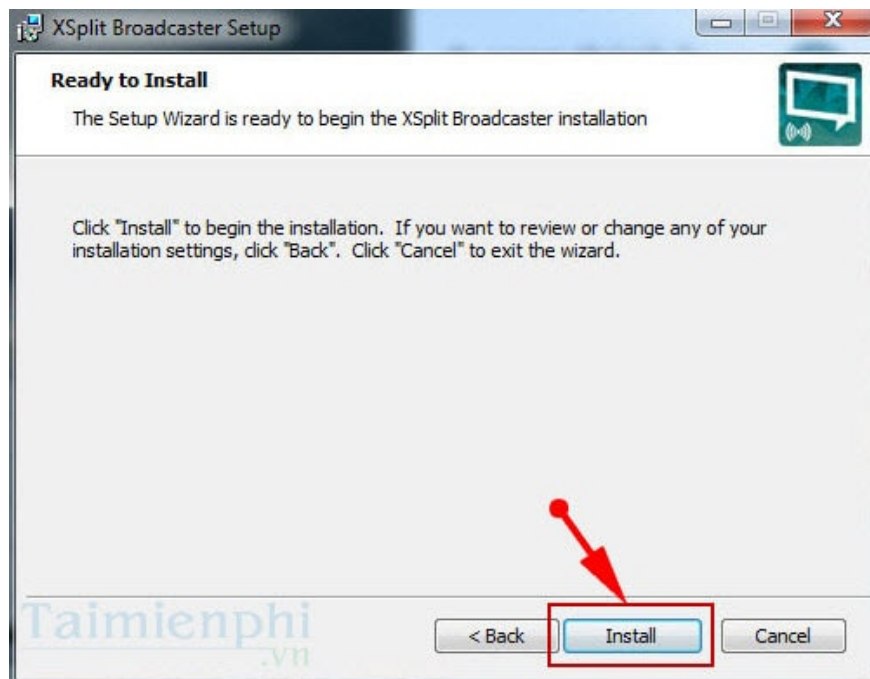
**Step 4:** After installing all the add-in components, click **Next** on the XSplit installation screen.

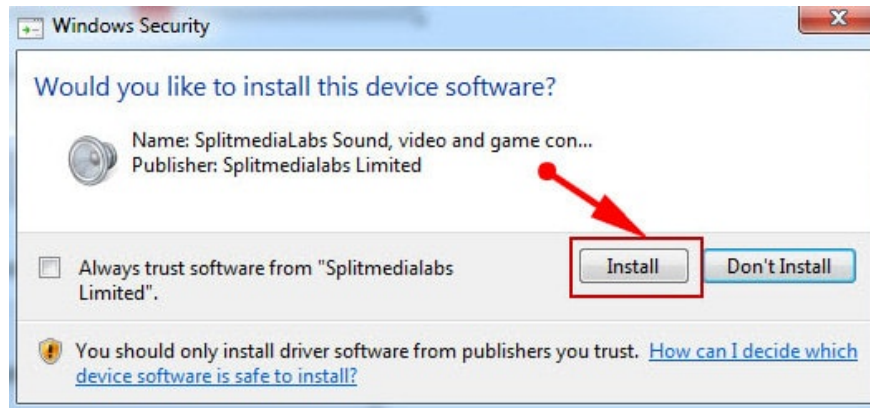


Click **Next** in the window to choose where to save the settings, or you can click **Browse ...** to select a different save location.

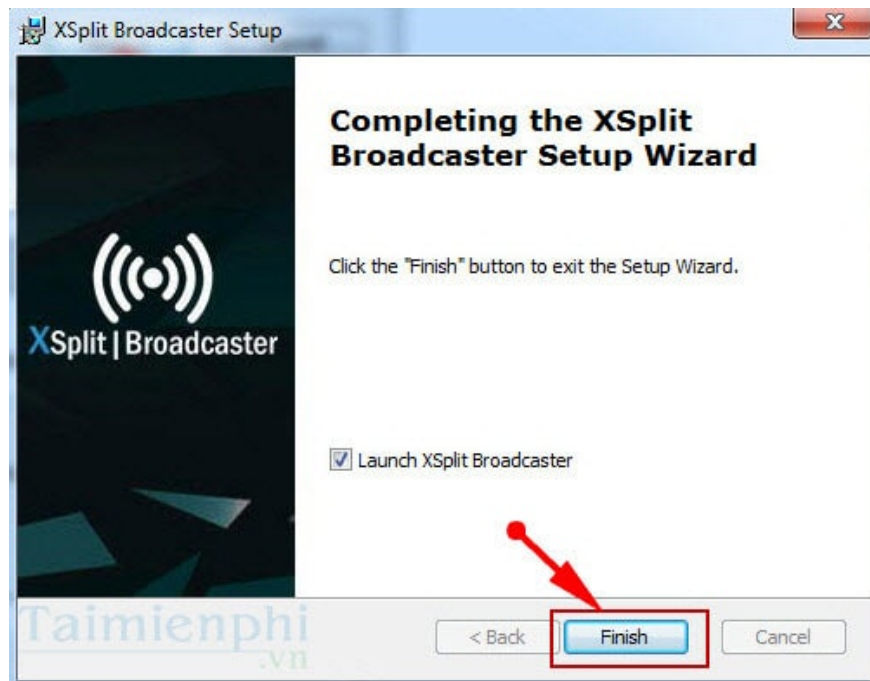


**Step 5:** In the subsequent windows that appear, simply click Next and Install to complete the installation process.



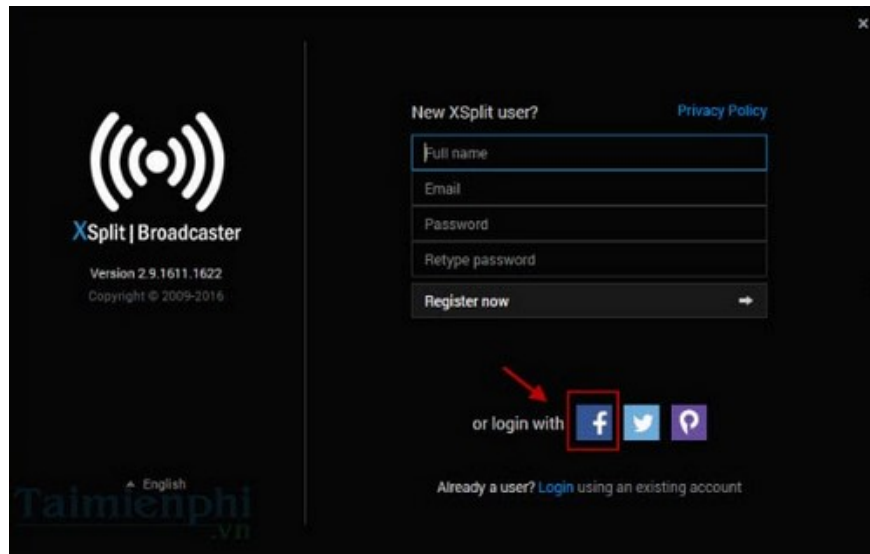


**Step 6:** After successful installation, press **Finish** to complete and open the application interface.

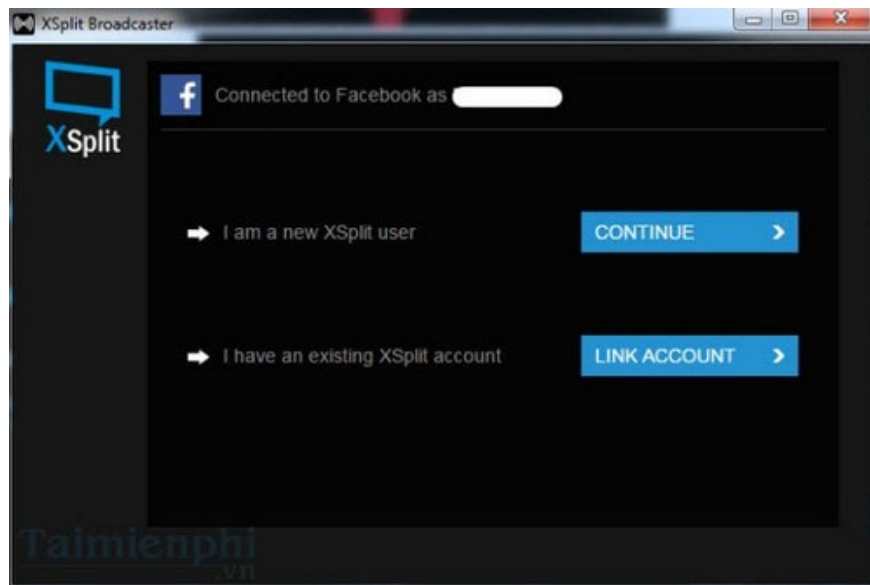


## *2. How to stream live video on Facebook using XSplite*

**Step 1:** On first use, you need to log in to the application. If you already have an account, you can press login to log in, or you can log in using your Facebook or Twitter account. Here, TipsMake chooses to log in with a Facebook account.



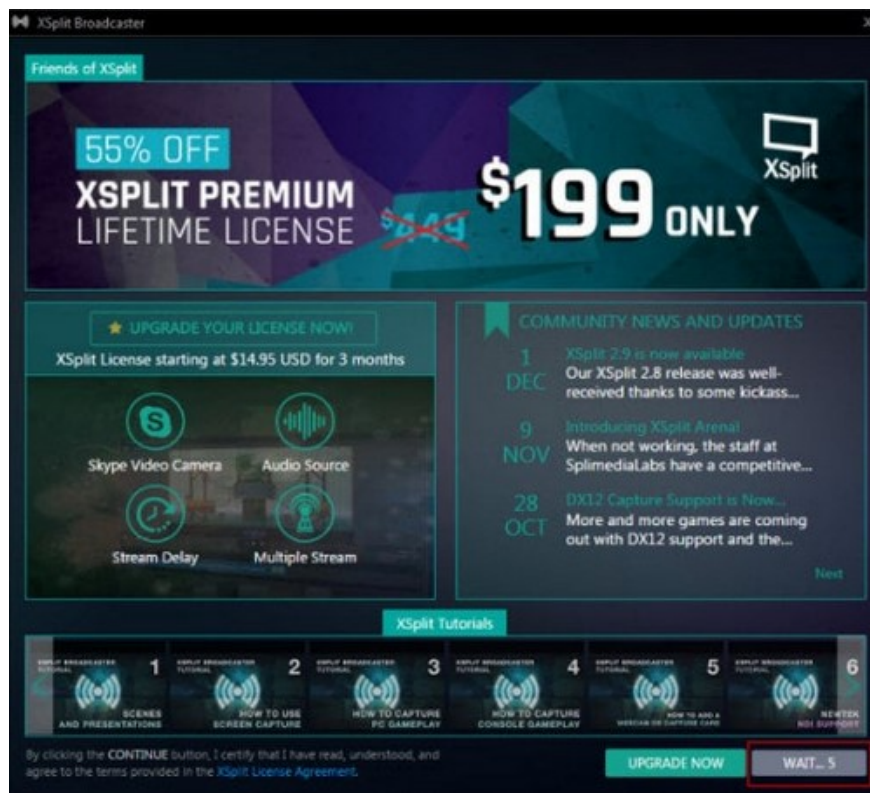
**Step 2:** Select **Continue** if you are a new user, then you will need to set up some personal information. If you have previously logged in with Facebook, you can click **Link Account** to log in again.



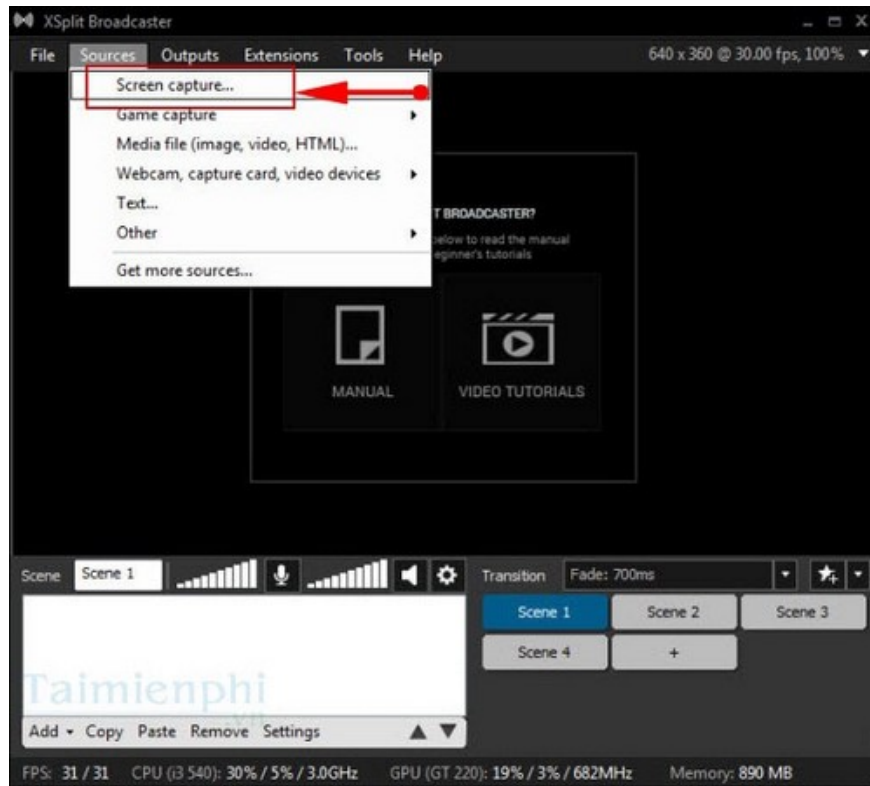
Please wait a moment while we log into the software.



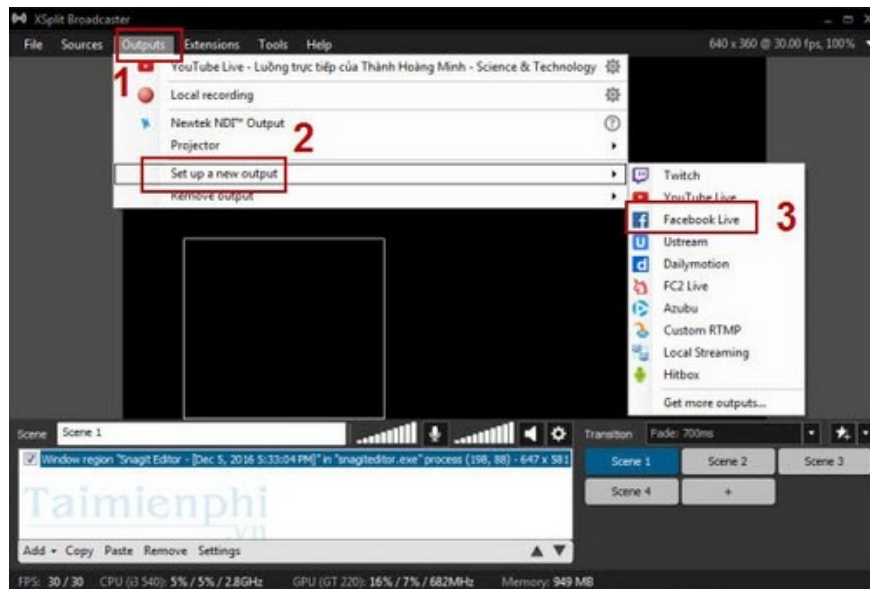
**Step 3:** After successfully logging in, wait for the **10-second countdown** , then click Continue to access the main Live Stream setup interface.



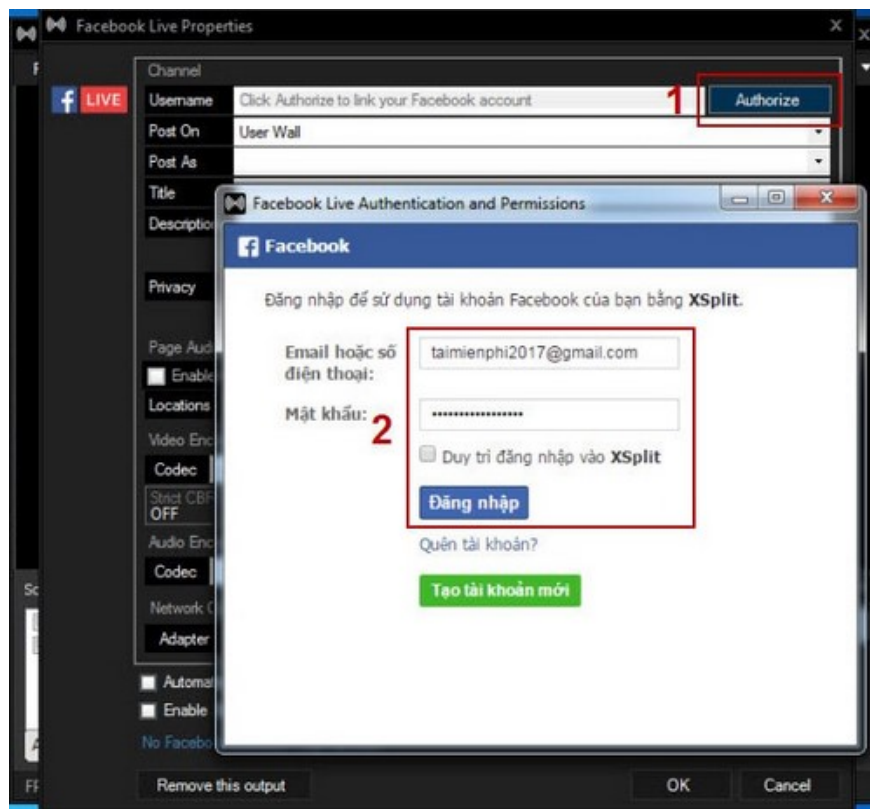
**Step 4:** On the main XSplit interface, select **Sources** , then choose the corresponding feature. Here, TipsMake chooses screen live streaming, so they select the **Screen Capture** feature : Record your computer screen using custom frames.



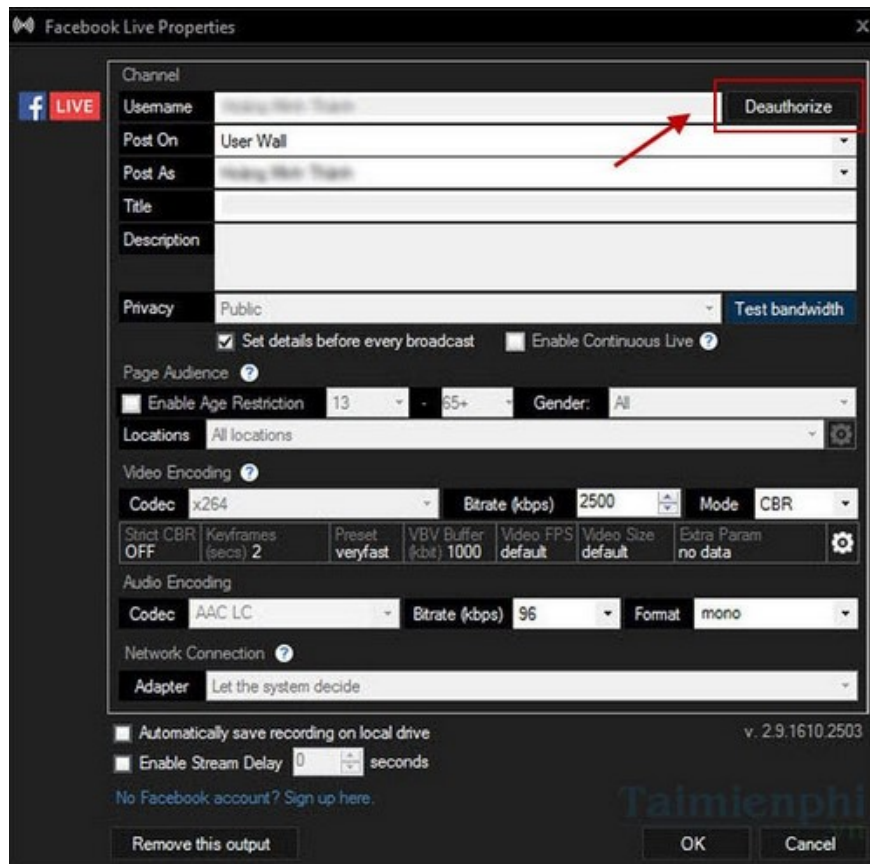
**Step 5:** Next, select **Outputs** -> **Set up a new output** -> **Facebook Live** to live stream on Facebook.



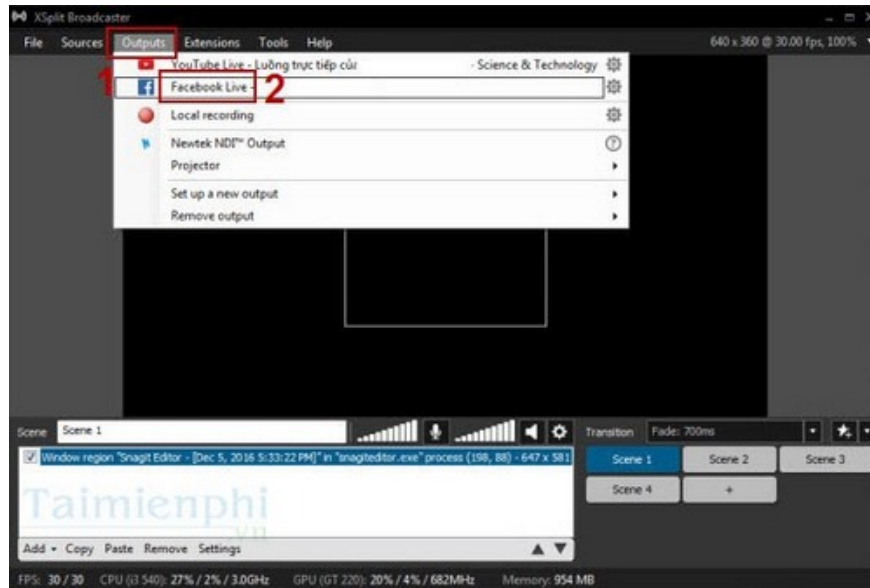
**Step 6:** Click **Authorize** to log in using the Facebook account you want to use for **live streaming**.



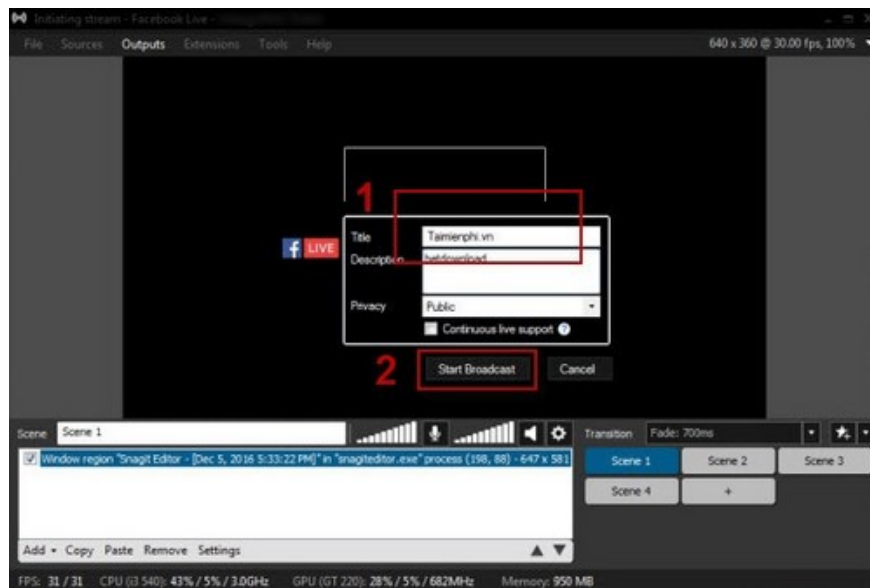
Alternatively, you can press **Deauthorize** to log out of your previously logged-in account and log in with a new Facebook account you want to live stream with.



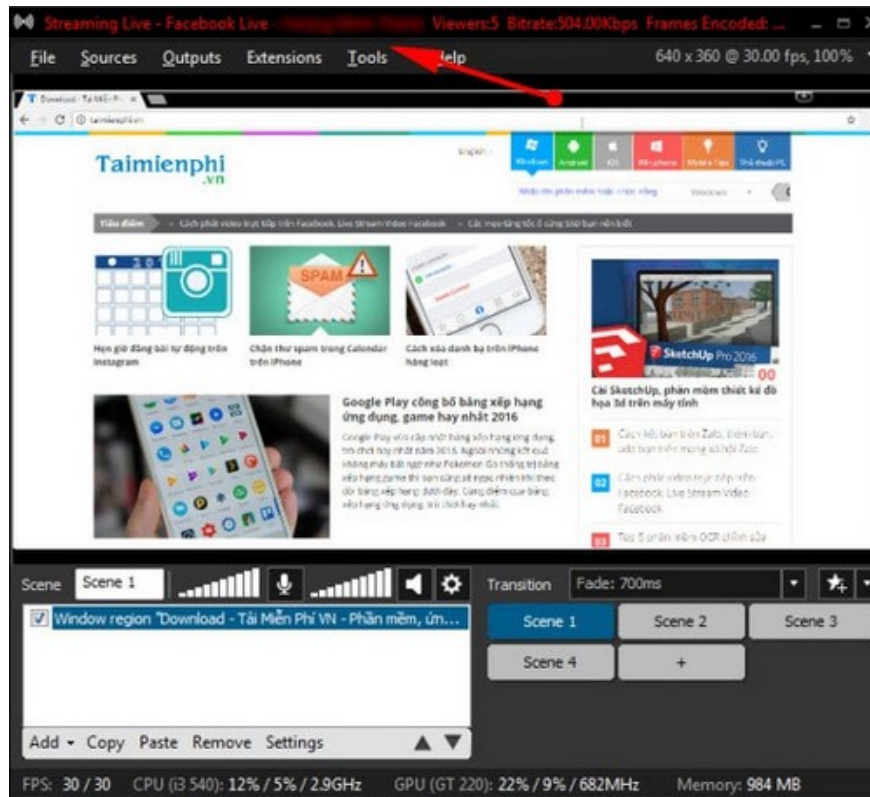
**Step 7:** Next, select **Outputs -> Facebook Live**



**Step 8:** A small window will appear. Here you will enter **the Title** (the title of the Live Stream Video) and the Description (a description for the video). Then click **Start Broadcast**, and your screen will be live streamed on Facebook.



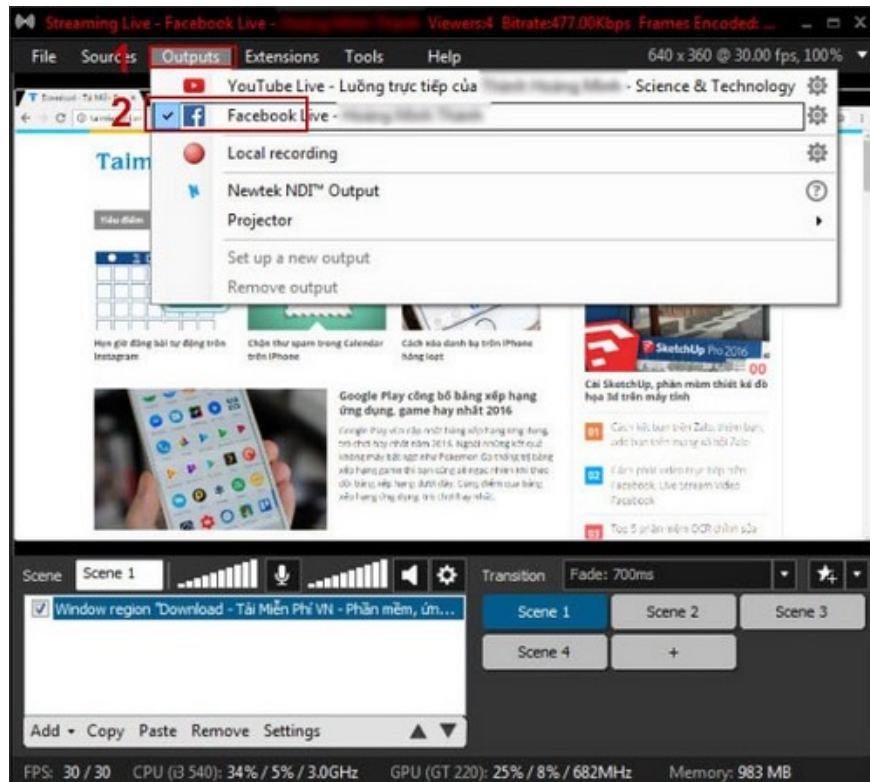
Live Stream interface on XSplit -> When you see the red line: **Streaming live - Facebook Live** . you've successfully streamed!

To stop live streaming, select **Outputs** and uncheck the box next to the Facebook account that is currently live streaming.

For those who frequently download and use Zalo, the **live video streaming** feature in groups is now also available, allowing you to live stream your screen to your friends in a vivid and engaging way.
