Instructions on how to stream live video on Facebook (Facebook video streaming feature)

When using Facebook, the Live Stream feature allows us to broadcast a live video while reporting on events, meetings, birthday parties, etc., which is quite interesting and innovative.

During Facebook Live Streaming, users can interact with each other. It allows you to add descriptions to your videos, send them to other users, like, comment, and share them. If you are using a mobile phone, you can download the latest version of Facebook to use Live Streaming.

A. What is your purpose for live streaming on Facebook?

Note: You should only read this section after you know how to use Facebook live streaming. If you haven't already, please see our instructions below. Here, TipsMake only explains the common features available on OBS that we can use for Facebook live streaming.

So, we've completed the Facebook live streaming connection; now comes the more important step: what you'll use Facebook live streaming for. OBS Studio supports many different Facebook live streaming purposes, such as live streaming for sales, live streaming for gaming, live streaming for video broadcasting, and many more. In today's guide, TipsMake will help you live stream on Facebook using the most popular methods currently available.

1. Use Facebook Live Webcam for conversations and talk shows.

Live stream on Facebook to express your views, to create a talk show for your Facebook premiere. The feature we use in **OBS Studio** is called **Video Capture Device** .

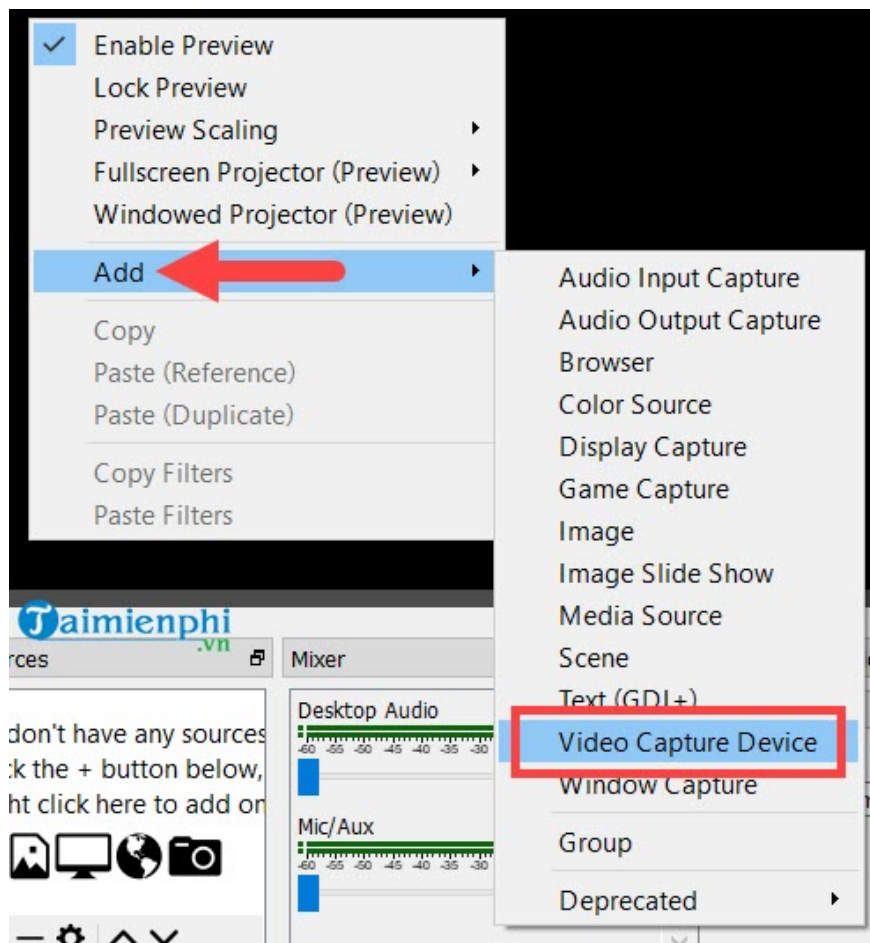
First, you need to download OBS Studio using the link below:

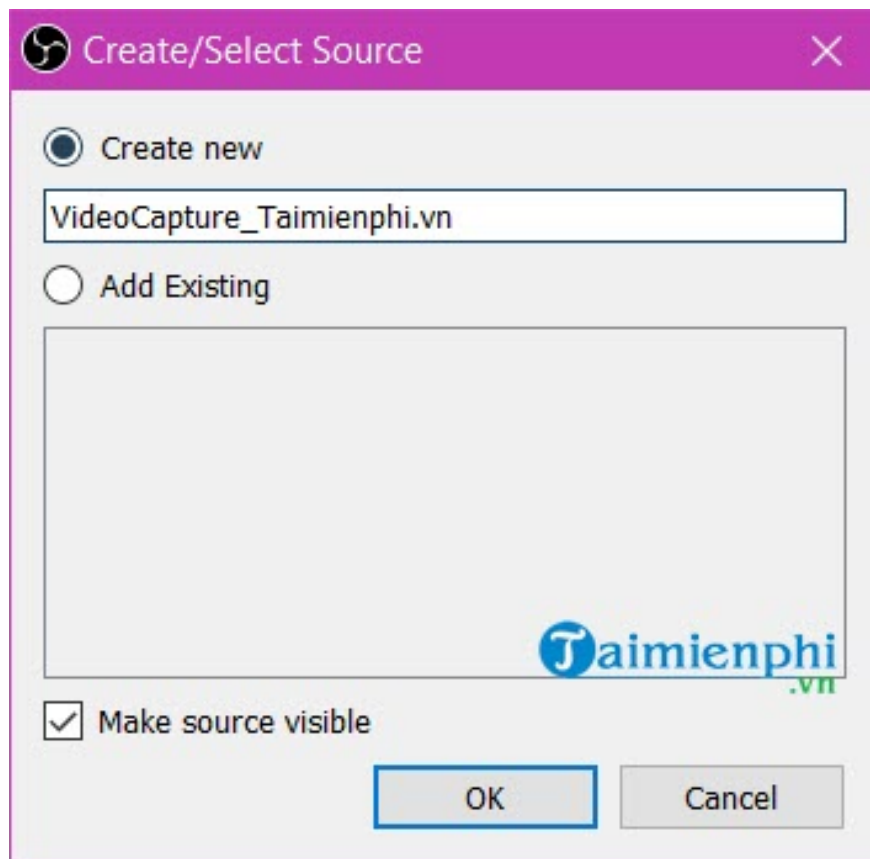

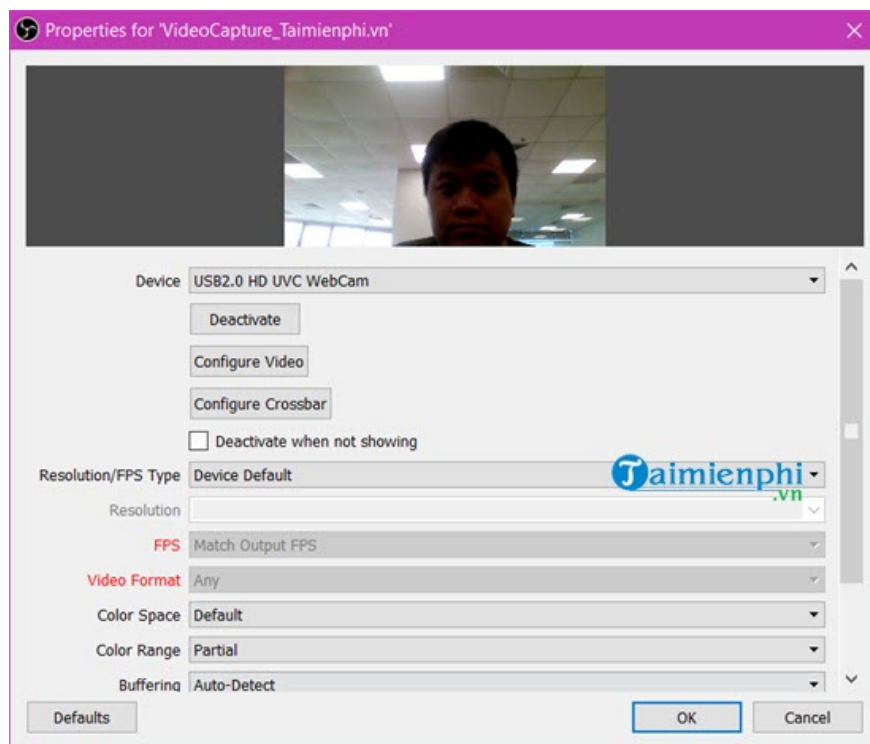
Step 1: To live stream on Facebook using your laptop's webcam, right-click on the screen and select **Add > Video Capture Device** .



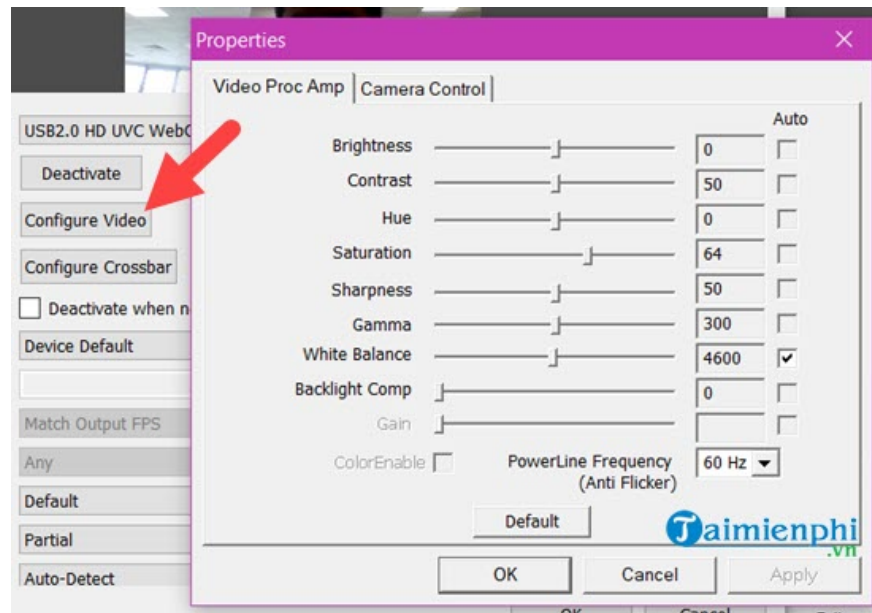
Step 2: Next, name this stream. Choose a name that's easy to remember to help you distinguish it if you want to stream different things.



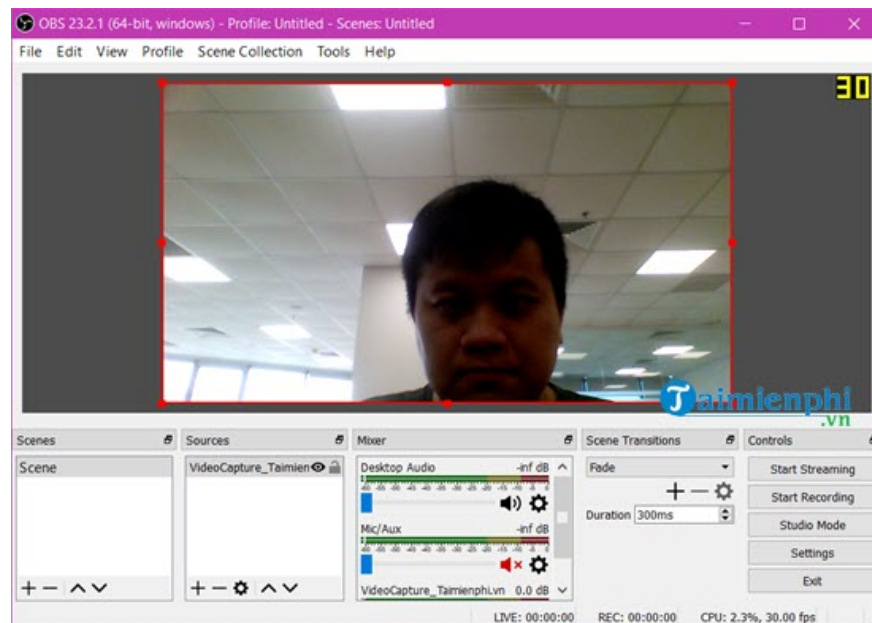
Step 3: Of course, here you select **your own USB webcam as the device** . OBS has already selected it for you if the webcam is already enabled on your computer/PC.



Step 4: Additionally, OBS also supports Configure Video to adjust the color and brightness parameters slightly for your webcam.



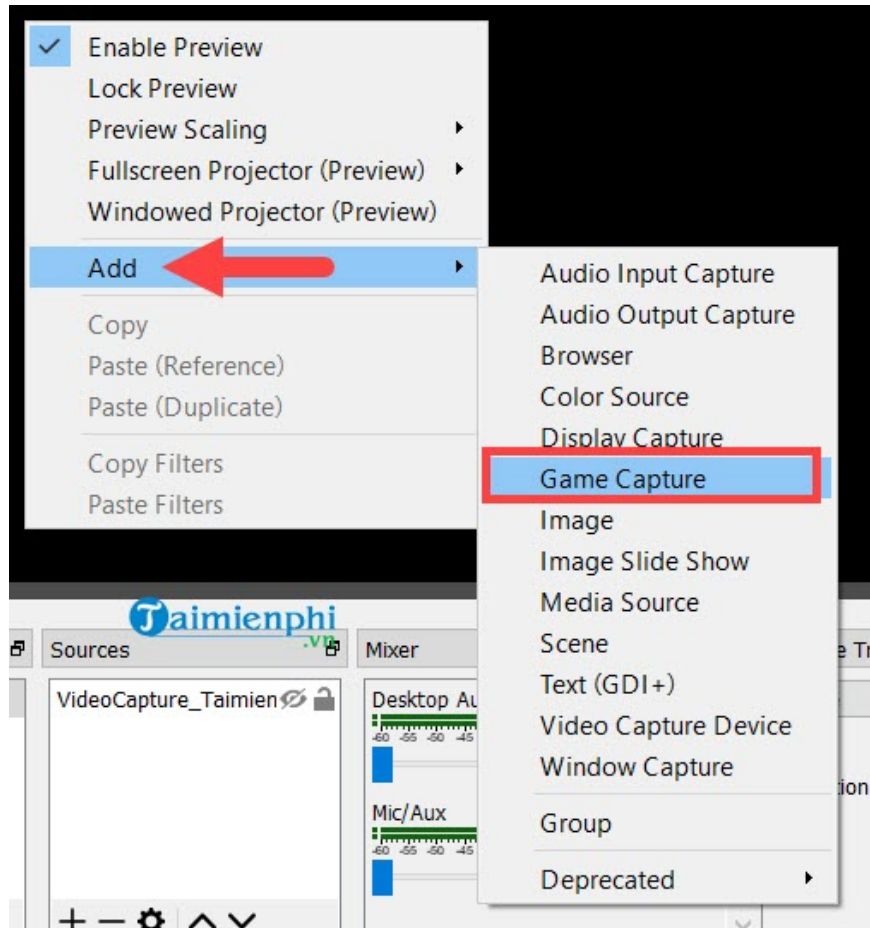
Step 5: Finally, double-check before live streaming on Facebook to ensure the display position and quality are all **satisfactory**.



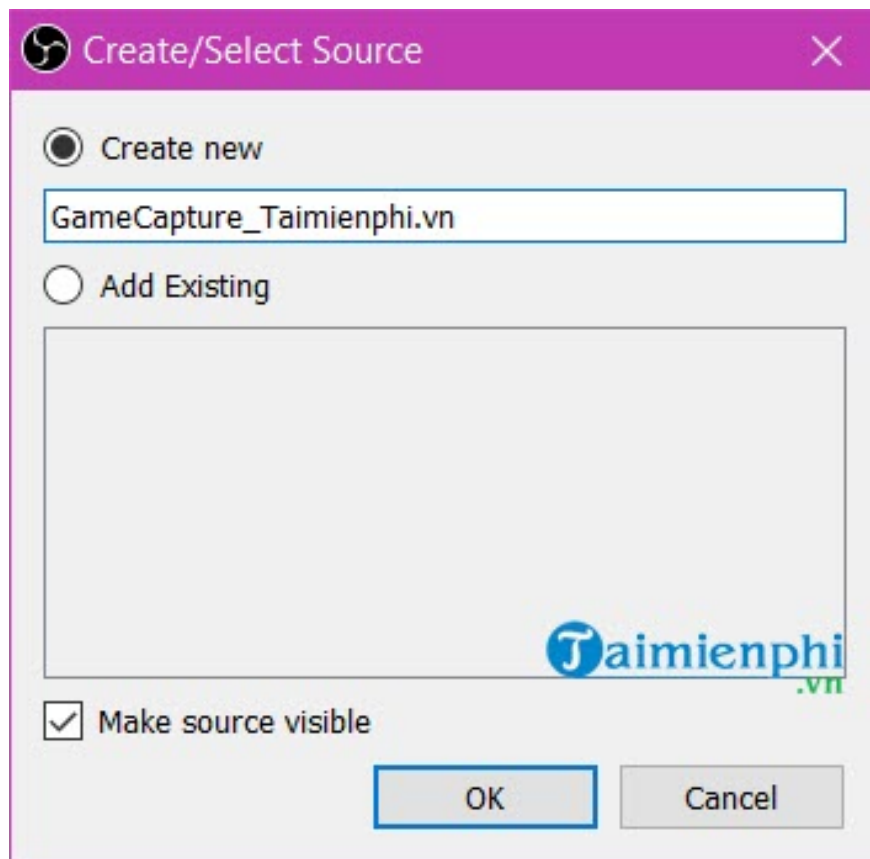
2. Use Facebook Live to stream games live.

Streaming video games live is clearly a never-ending trend in Vietnam, with the number of game streams constantly increasing. Sharing gameplay strategies along with witty commentary always attracts a large number of users.

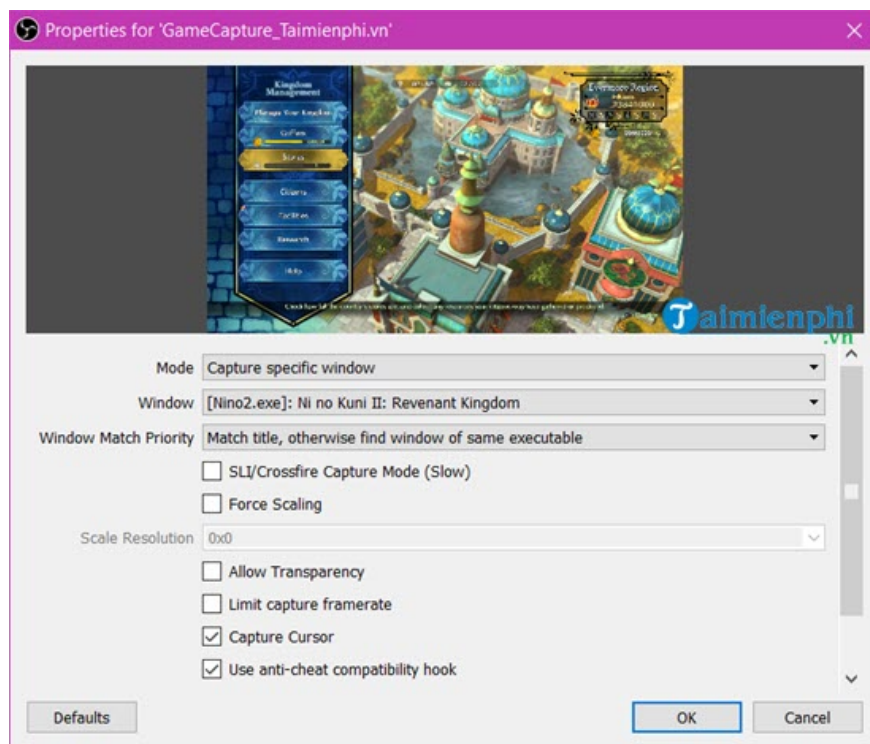
Step 1: To live stream a game on Facebook, we create a stream line by clicking **ADD** => **selecting Game Capture**.



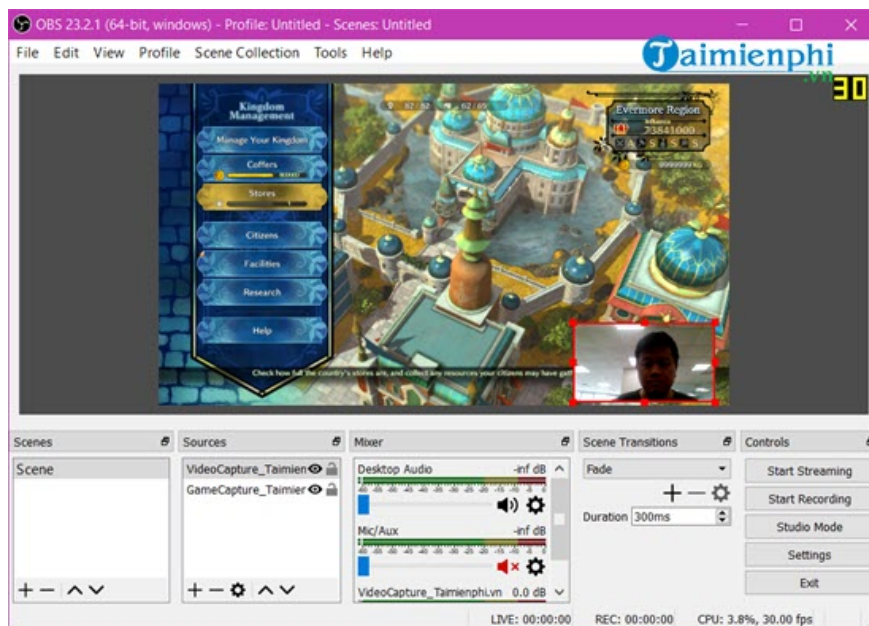
Step 2: Similarly, we must name this stream to avoid confusion, as users can create multiple different streams.



Step 3: Inside the interface, select **Mode** (choose full screen, choose window), under Windows select the game you currently have open, and then click **OK**.



Step 4: Then check to see if the Facebook live stream is complete. You can also combine different streams, such as live streaming with your webcam and playing your game at the same time.



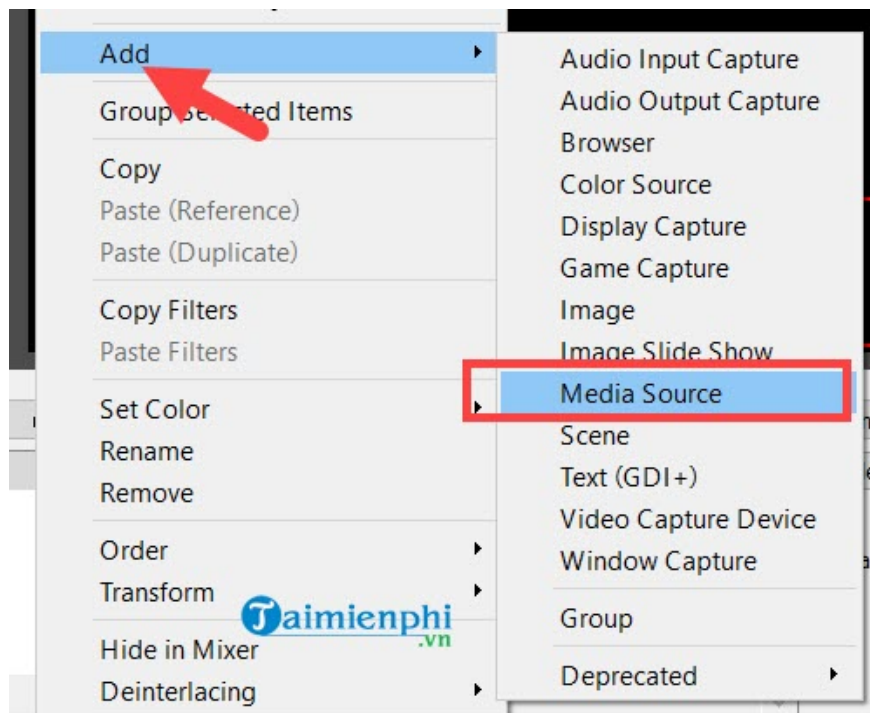
3. Live stream on Facebook to play videos, images, and music.

Another basic feature that Facebook live stream users can do is broadcast videos for everyone to watch, play music for everyone to listen to, or show photos.

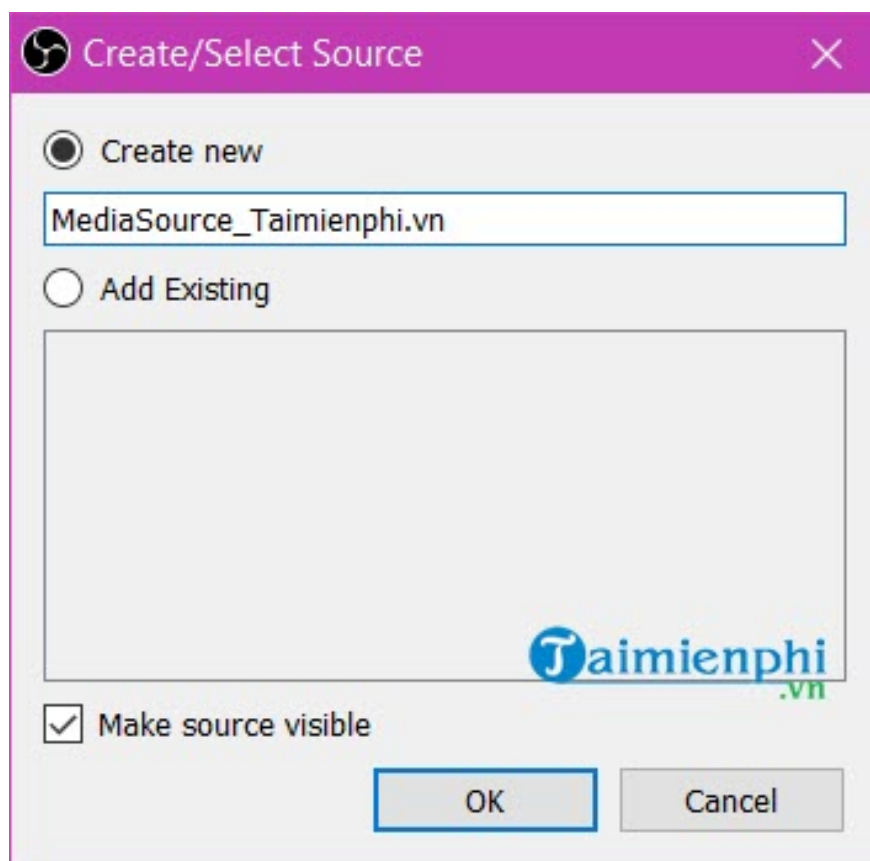
Step 1: To do this, right-click on **ADD** > select **Media Source** .

Note:

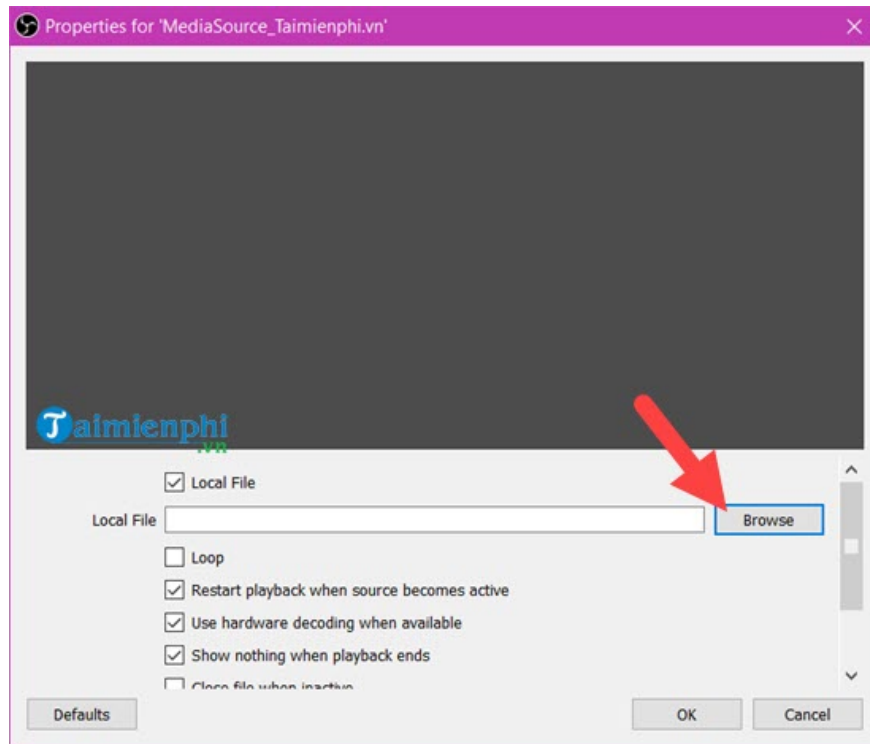
- * **Media Source** : Used to play videos and music.
- * **Image** : Used to display images.
- * **Image Slideshow** : Displays a series of images.



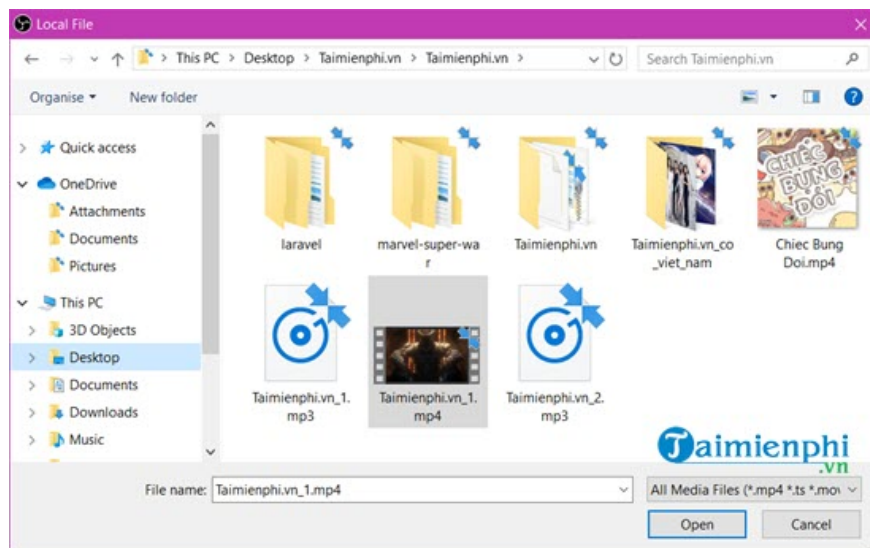
Step 2: Similarly, name this stream to make it easier to manage your **OBS Studio** .



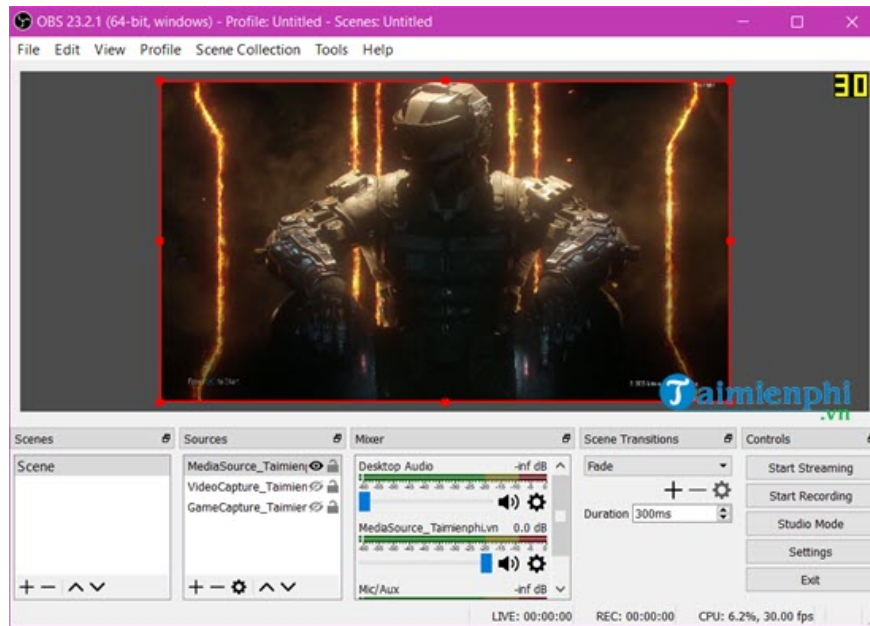
Step 3: In the **Media Source** interface, click **Browse** to find the file to open.



Step 4: Select the video you want to live stream on Facebook and then click **Open** .



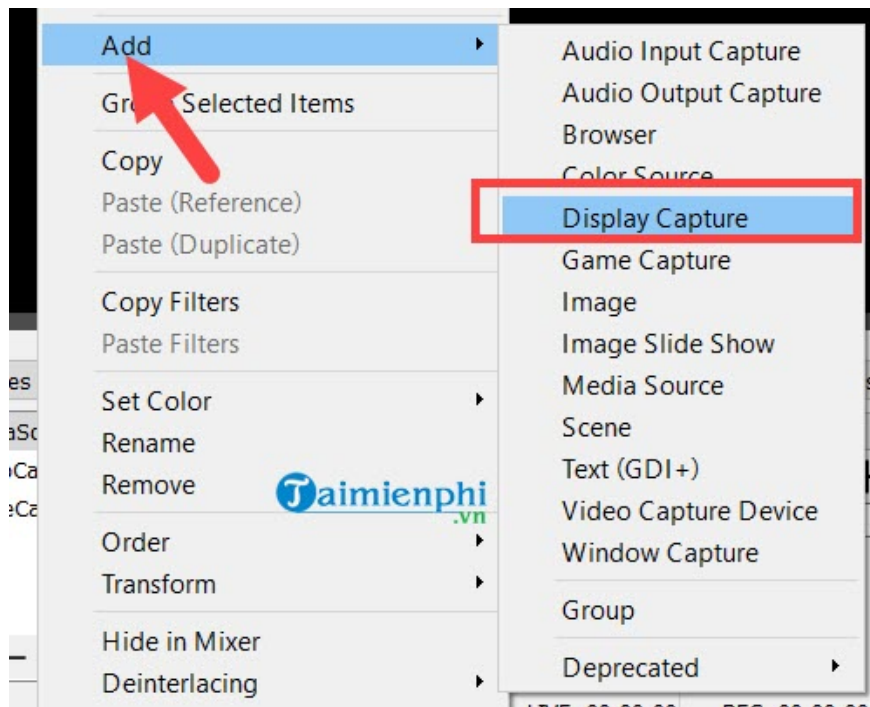
Step 5: Finally, make some adjustments before proceeding to live stream on Facebook with your video and music.



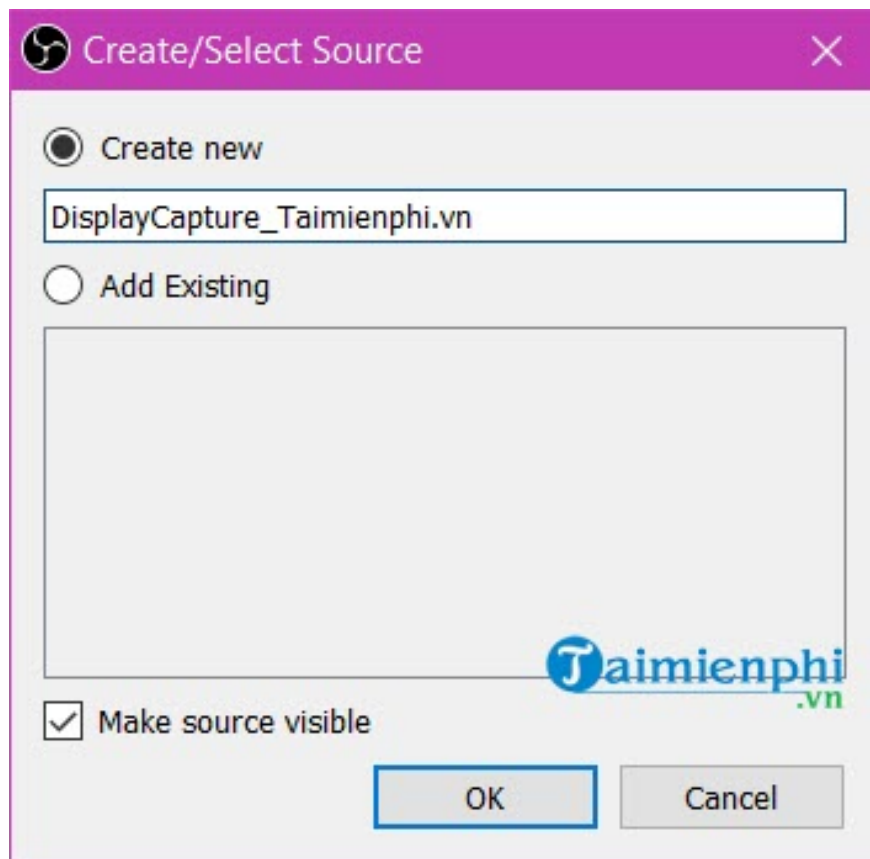
4. Live stream on Facebook with everything displayed.

Display Capture is a mode that allows Facebook live streamers to display everything currently on their screen. This is the most flexible mode as you can multitask, from playing games and watching movies to displaying any content you want.

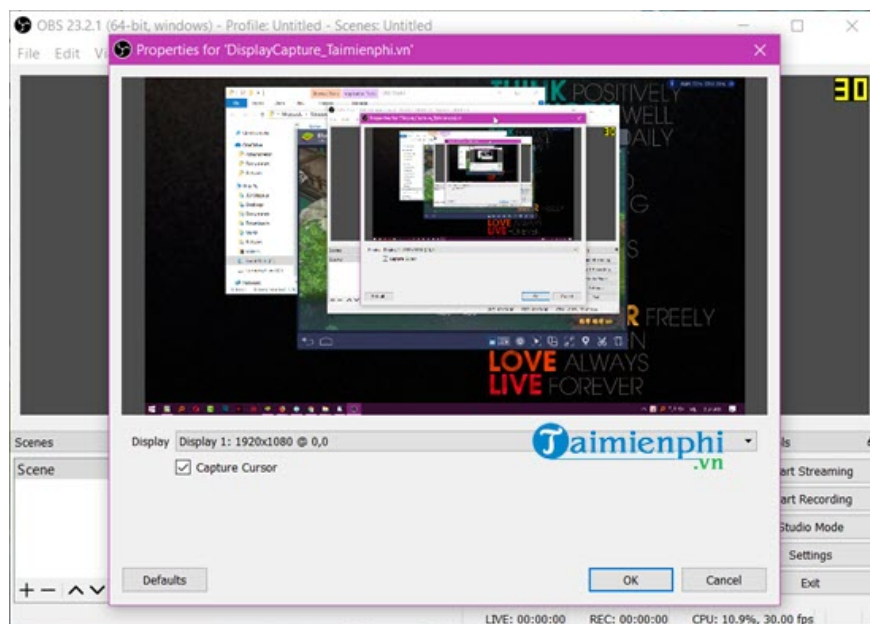
Step 1: To use Display Capture mode, right-click on the OBS screen, select **Add** > then select **Display Capture**



Step 2: Create a name for this Display Capture profile and then click **OK** .



Step 3: Here, all the information currently on your screen will be displayed. If you have two or more screens, you can select **Display 1** and **Display 2**.



Then press **OK** and complete the steps in the Facebook live stream guide below, and you'll be able to live stream everything on your screen to Facebook.

B. Stream live video on Facebook using a computer with a webcam.

To be able to stream live video on Facebook, you need the following tools:

- The software allows you to stream live video on Facebook using OBS Studio. You can download the software via the link above.
- You need a Facebook account; any account will work for logging in. If you don't have an account, please register for Facebook here.

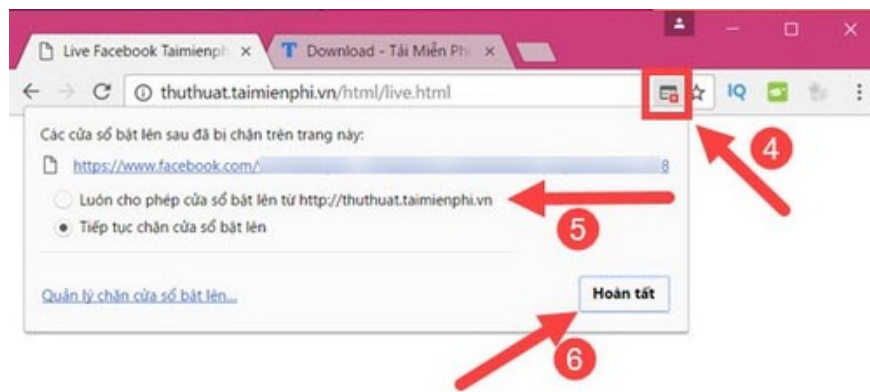
Step 1: After the OBS software has finished downloading and installing according to the instructions above, we can start live streaming on Facebook. Click on **CREATE LIVE VIDEO ON FACEBOOK** below to begin live streaming on Facebook.

Step 2: A Facebook confirmation notification will then appear. You can choose to share the video to friends or a group, as long as they allow you to post it on their wall. If you manage a fan page, you can also share it to the fan page. After making your selection, click **Next**.

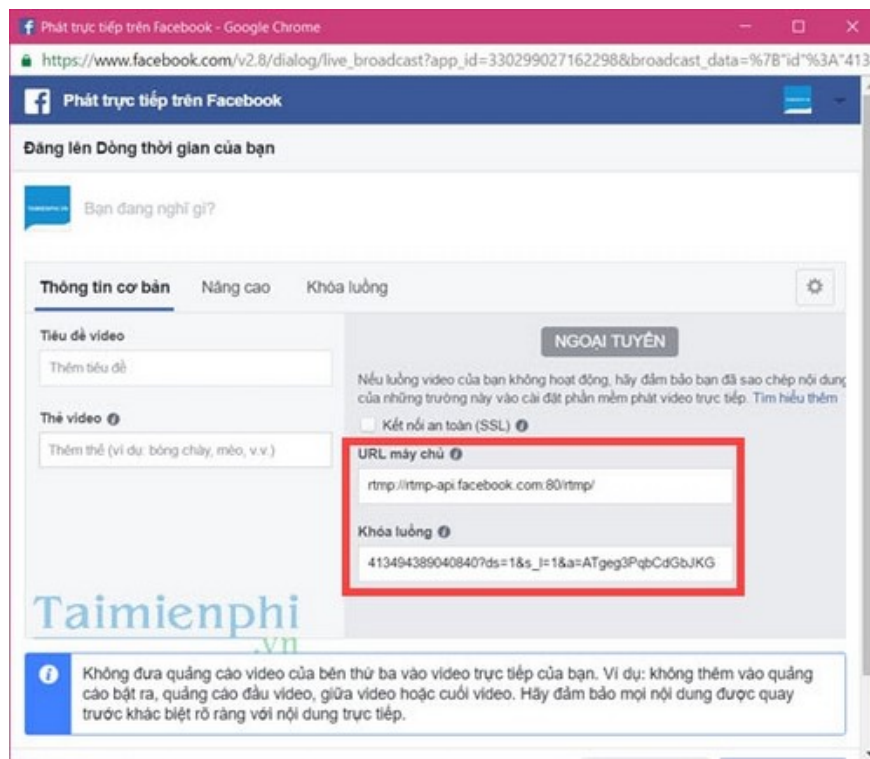


Step 3: If no notification appears, check the icon in your browser's address bar, as notifications may be blocked. Click the icon in the upper right corner of the browser bar, select "**Always allow pop-ups,**" and click "**Done.**"

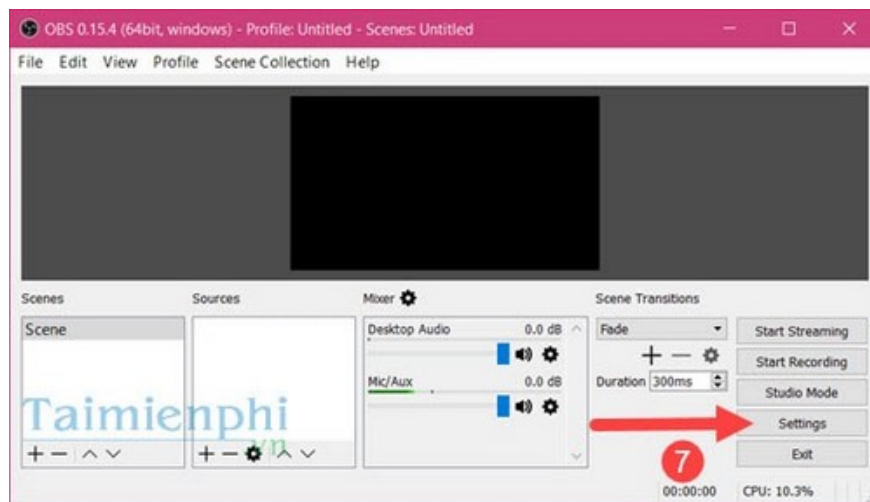
Note: After enabling the window to always remain open, repeat *Step 1*.



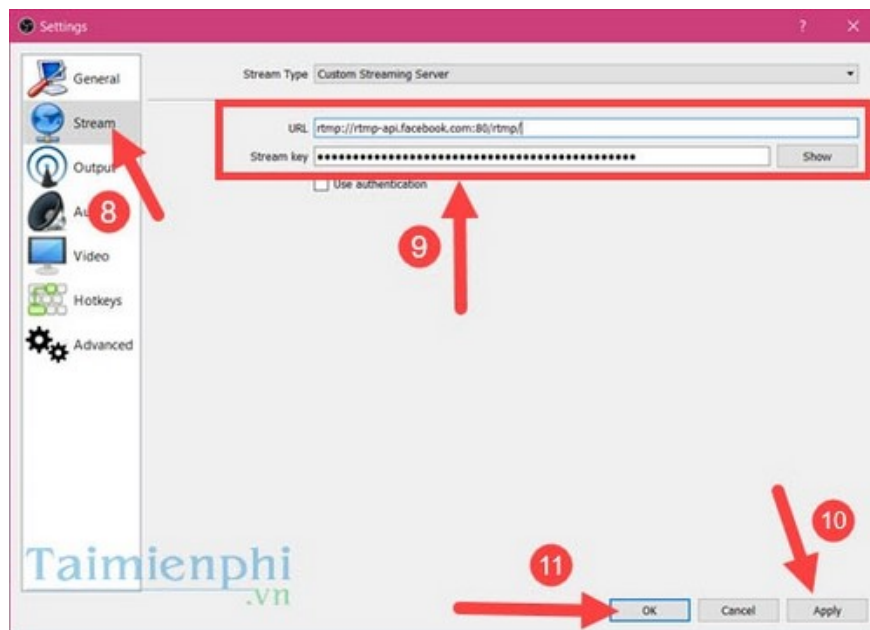
Step 4: At this point, the server URL and stream key will appear. Remember these two parameters, keep the window open, and now we can start using the **OBS Studio** software we installed earlier.



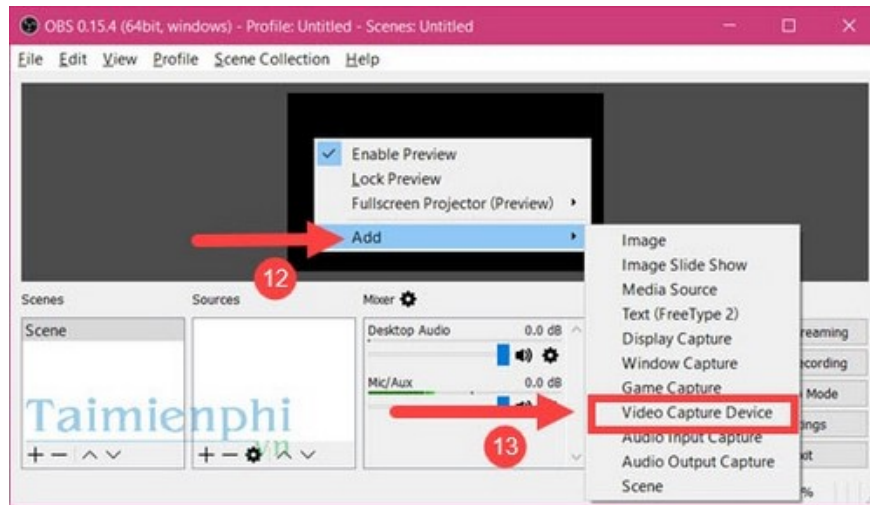
Step 5: Open **OBS Studio** , select **Settings** to configure the system.



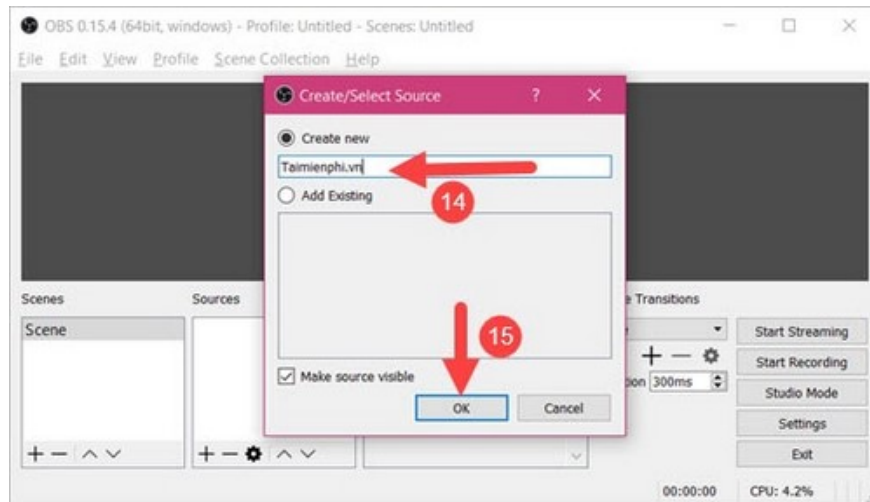
Step 6: Go to **Stream** , select **Custom Streaming Server** , then enter **the URL** and **stream key** .



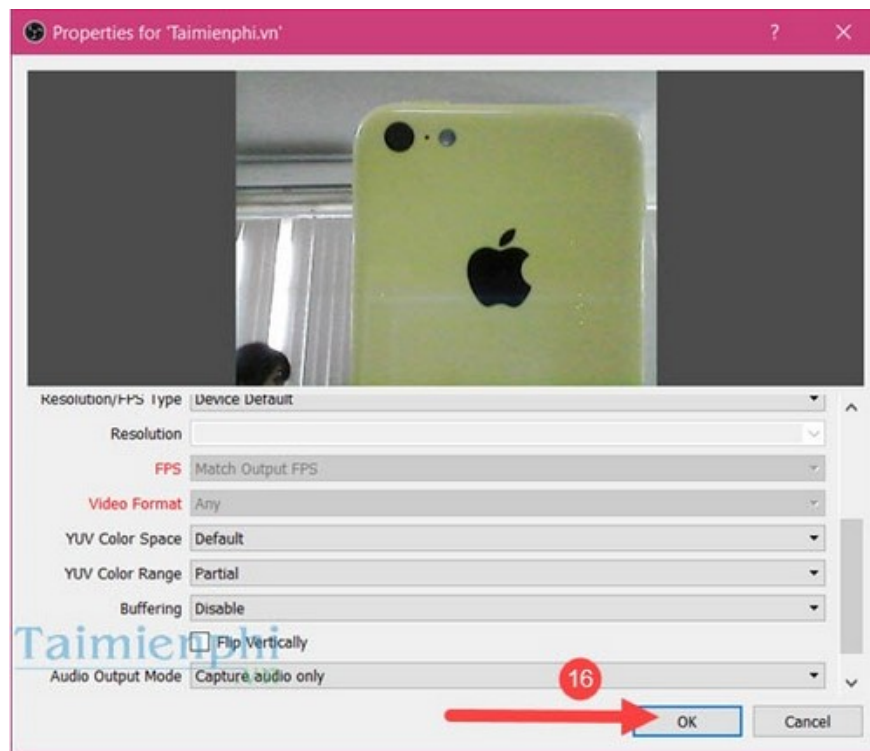
Step 7: Right-click anywhere on the black background of the software, select **Add** > **Video Capture Device** .



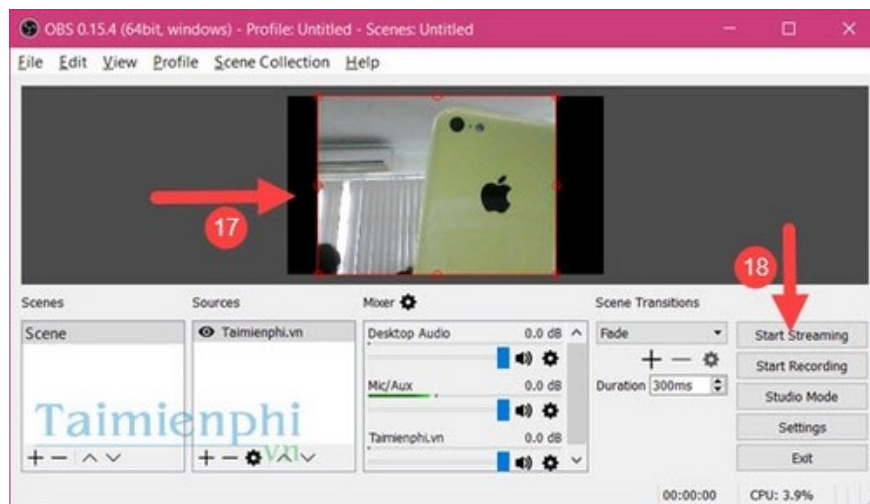
Step 8: Create a new source and name it as you wish.



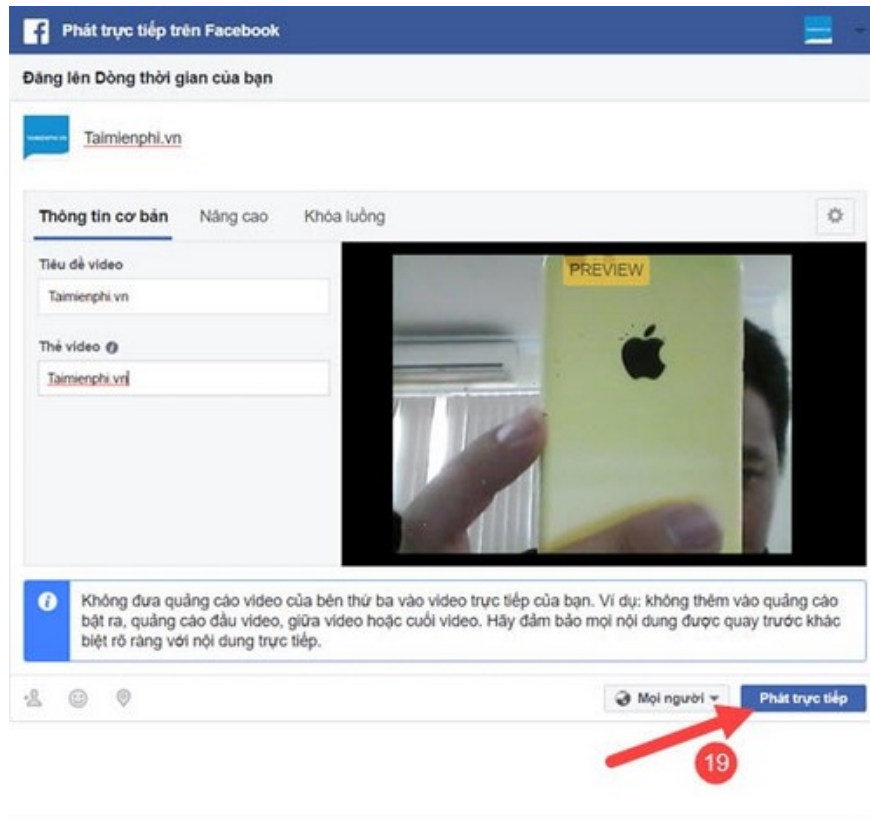
Step 9: Set up your webcam with various options; however, TipsMake recommends leaving it in default mode for optimal performance.



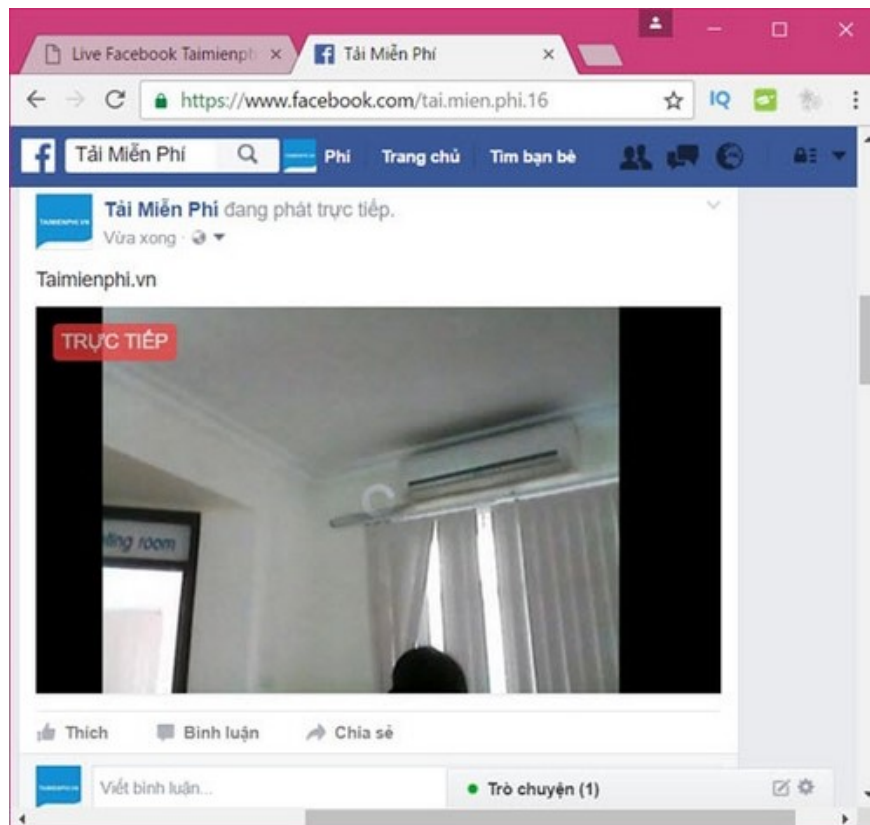
Step 10: Next, customize the display on the screen by dragging the red circled area on the screen. Finally, start streaming by clicking **Start Streaming** .



Step 11: Remember the window from *Step 4* ? Go back to it and you'll see the **Preview** interface appear. Fill in the title, set up the broadcast feature for yourself or your friends, and then click on "**Go Live**".



Step 12: Go back to your Facebook now, and you'll see you're streaming the video live on Facebook.



How to stream League of Legends and Dota live on Facebook

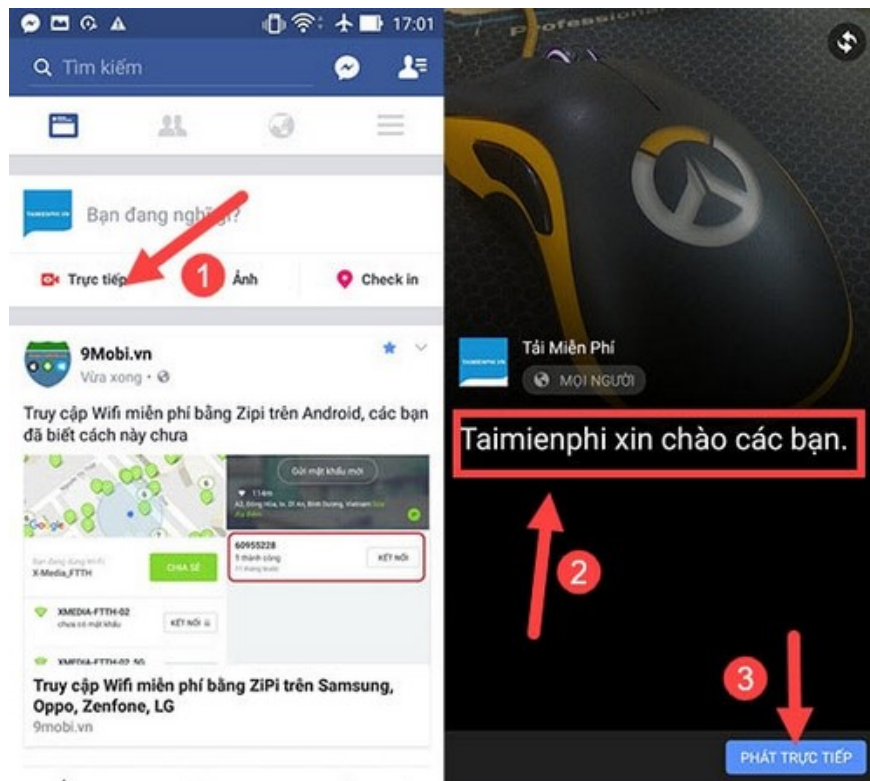
One of the trends in live video streaming on Facebook is streaming League of Legends (LoL), or Dota (Live Stream Facebook LOL). Those who want to stream these games can use various software programs to live stream League of Legends on Facebook.

C. Live Stream on Facebook using Android or iPhone

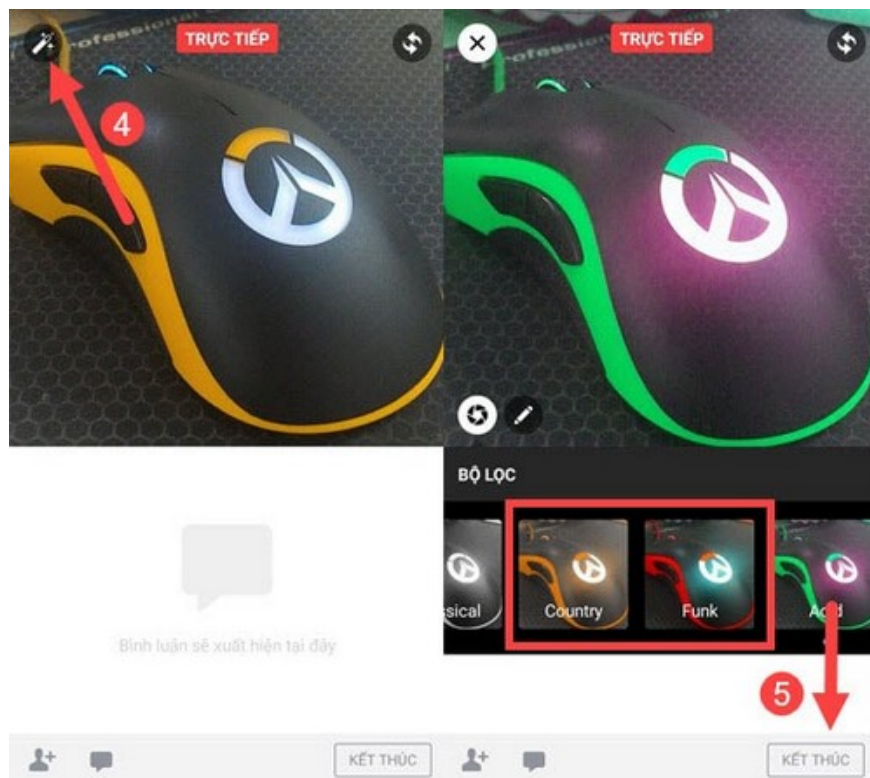
=> Download link for Facebook for Android

1. Live Stream on Facebook using an Android phone.

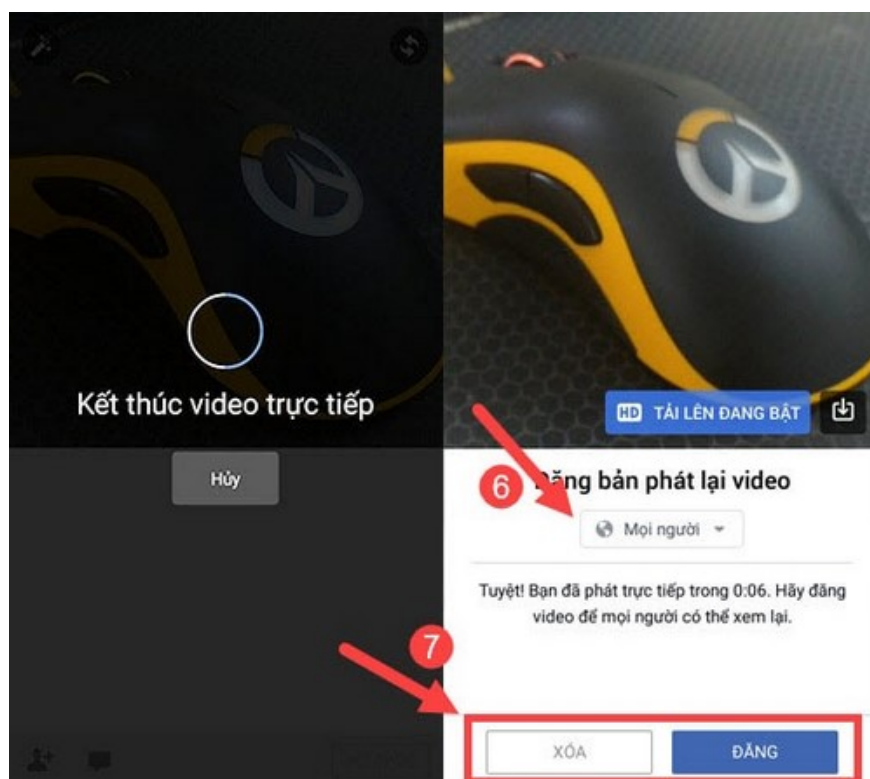
Step 1: Go to Facebook on your phone. If you own a fan page, you can go to it and tap "Post" to see the live streaming feature right below the interface. Otherwise, tap the "**Live**" icon that appears below your status, then add a title and tap "**Go Live**".



Step 2: When the live stream icon appears, you have successfully started. You can choose a suitable color filter using **the icon in the left corner**, and if you no longer want to live stream on Facebook, click **End** in the right corner.



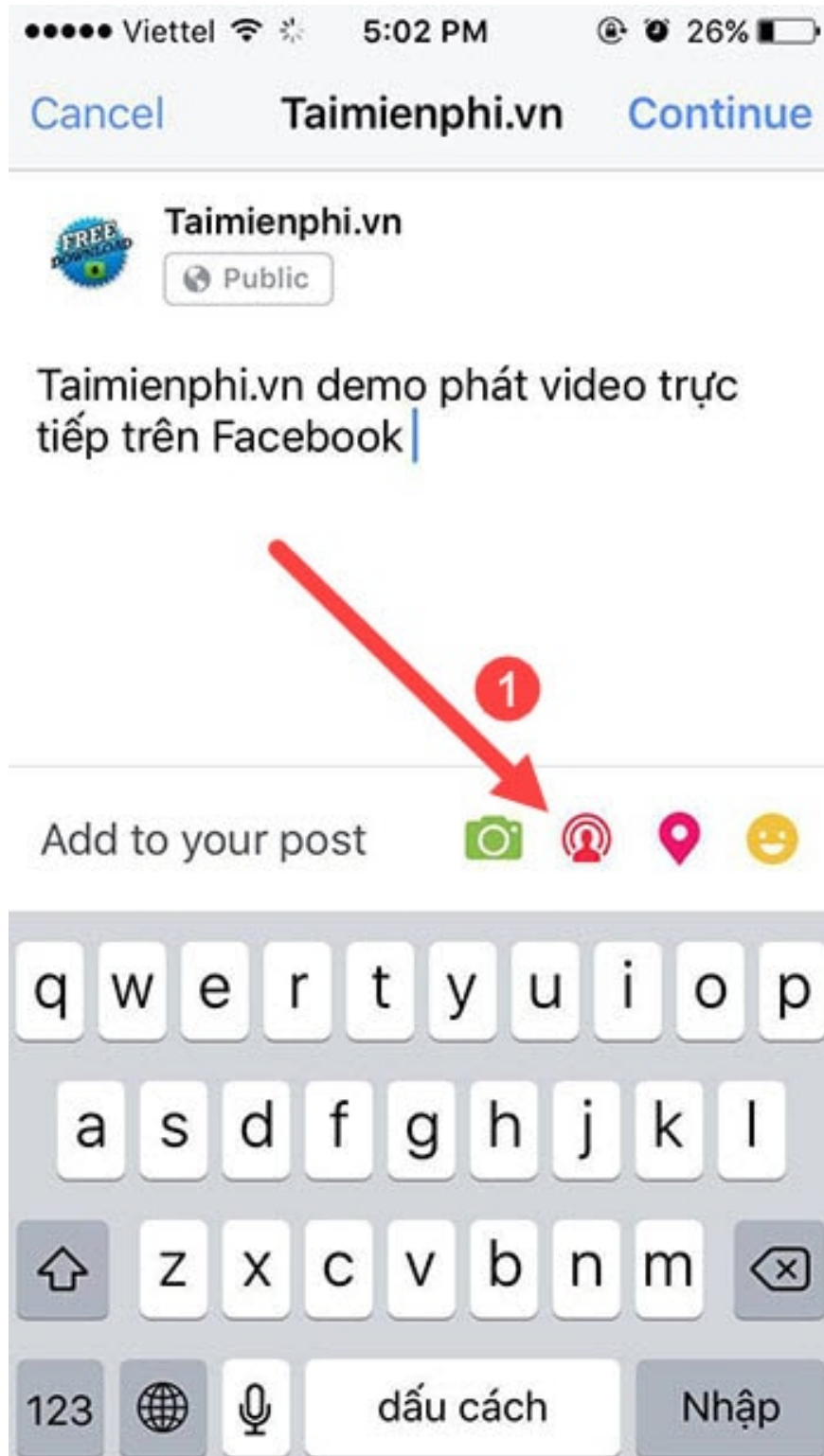
Step 3: Wait a moment for the Facebook live stream to finish. Once complete, the system will ask if you want to save the video or upload it to Facebook, with the option to set it to public (everyone, friends, or private).



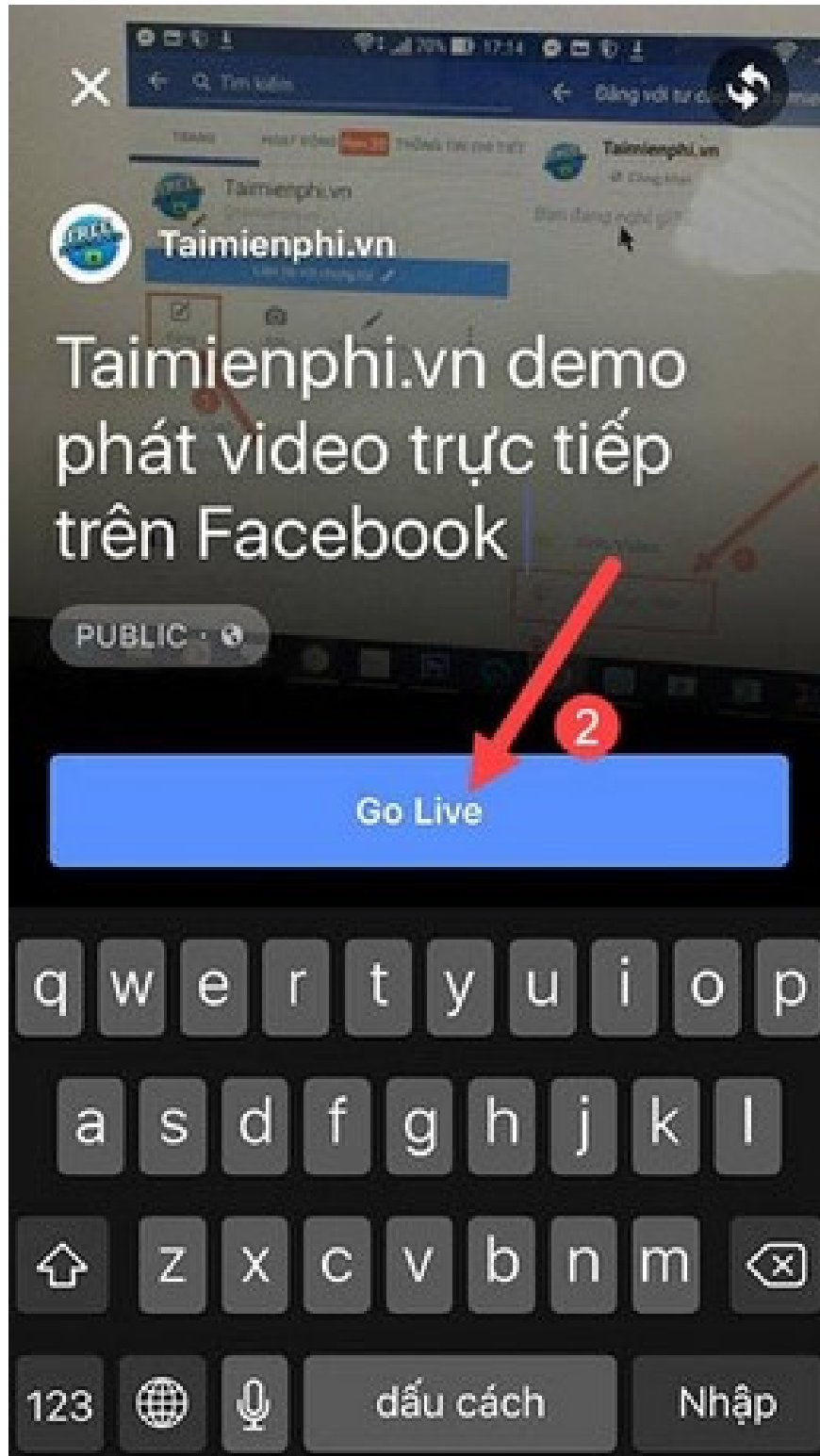
2. Live Stream on Facebook using your iPhone

Download the Facebook app for iOS devices (iPhone, iPad):

Step 1: Log in to Facebook on your iPhone, iPad -> Go to Status and press **Live video (1)** which is the red icon as shown below .



Step 2: Press **Go Live (2)** to stream live video on Facebook .



Step 3: Interaction and Conclusion

During the live video stream you have control over the number of viewers, comments and reply to those comments. When finished press Finish (3) and you will have the option to repost it on your timeline, which is yes by default.



One of the Facebook tricks that TipsMake has mentioned is how to recover a deleted Facebook fan page – this is also one of the pretty cool features that Facebook added previously. Recovering a fan page helps you get it back

if you accidentally delete it. So how do we use Live Video? Let's explore with TipsMake how to stream live video on Facebook for both mobile and desktop computers/laptops.

D. Reasons why some phones can stream live video and others cannot.

According to some information, YouTube is also about to launch a live streaming feature for high-end mobile phones. Therefore, users will soon have two options: live streaming on YouTube or live streaming on Facebook to broadcast videos live for their family and friends to enjoy.

If you're having trouble streaming live video on Facebook with your browser, you can try enabling Hardware Acceleration to speed up your browser and improve the quality and speed of your Facebook live video stream. Additionally, Facebook video streaming errors can occur because your browser blocks pop-ups; the next window in the setup process doesn't appear, preventing you from live streaming. Fixing this pop-up blocking issue is quite simple; with a few steps, you can proceed with the final setup steps and successfully live stream your video **on Facebook** .

To avoid being disturbed while logging into Facebook, you can completely turn off Facebook chat by **hiding your Facebook profile** from your friends or hiding it from certain strangers when browsing Facebook.
