'ASCII' art is a way of making pictures using different keyboard symbols. To make adorable ASCII bunnies, try one of the following methods. === Sad Bunny ===

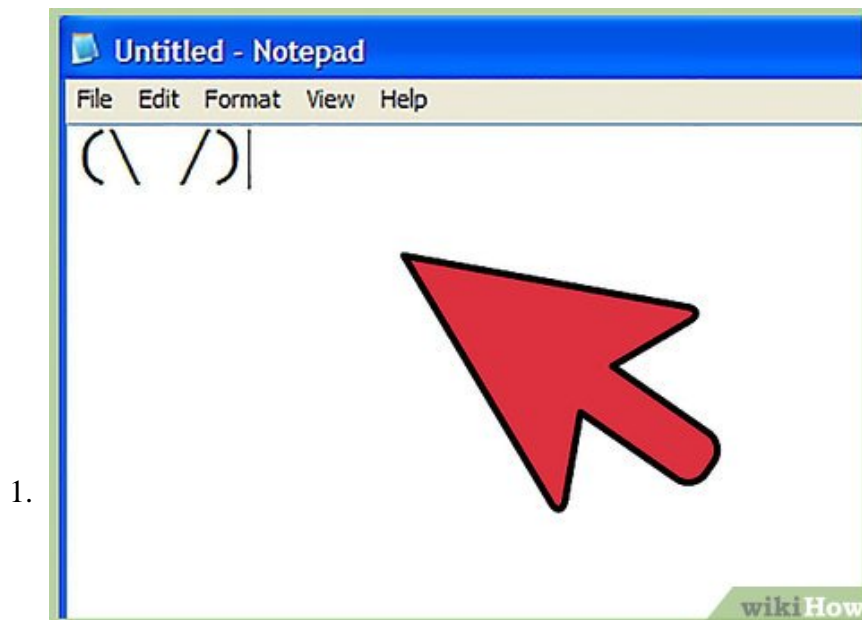
