

# How to make beautiful paper poppy bouquets for October 20

The poppy flower, also known as poppy flower, according to the ancient Chinese conception, this flower represents the faithfulness, the faith of lovers. Therefore, there is nothing more meaningful than making a brilliant bouquet of poppy flowers for someone you love on October 20.

Here are simple steps to make beautiful poppy paper bouquets.

## Material for making paper poppy flowers

1. Paper shrunk white, black, blue
2. A cover or plastic sheet
3. Pull, glue or glue gun
4. Steel wire, paper wrapped with flowers, decorative ribbon



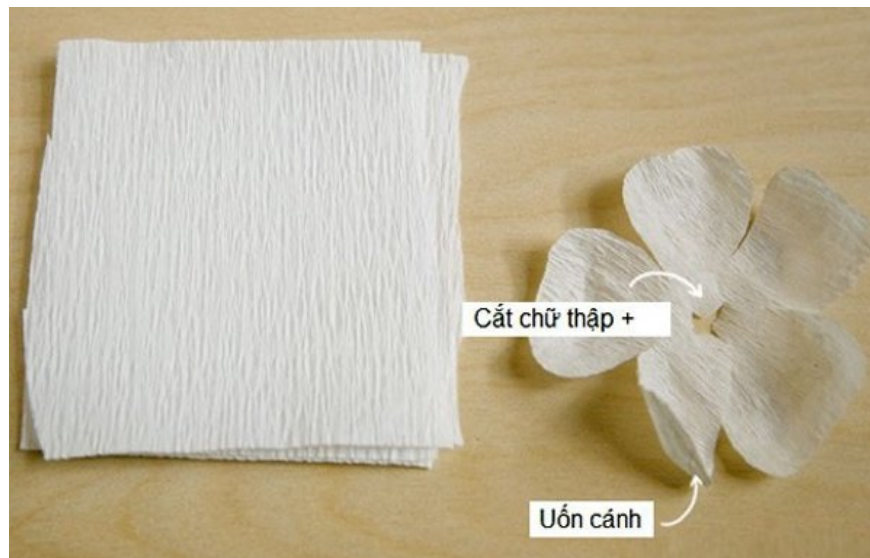
## How to make paper poppy flowers

### Step 1:

Cut the paper to turn white into small squares of paper with sides about 7cm long.

Then you fold the paper the same way you would fold it to cut it into a 5-pointed star shape.

After folding, instead of cutting a diagonal to be starred, you cut an arc to form a 5-pointed flower.



Cut the paper to create the middle part of the flower.

If not, you can draw a flower pattern on the paper and cut it to the drawing.

Stretch the corrugated paper so that the petals have a natural curvature.

## Step 2:

Cut paper to shrug black into strips of about 3cm wide.



Cut the cardboard board so that the cover is 20cm long, 10cm wide.

Roll a few strips of paper around the cardboard board vertically and cut into small pieces of paper to make the pistil inside.



Continue to roll a few black strips of paper around the cardboard horizontally and also cut into equal parts to make stamens.

### **Step 3:**



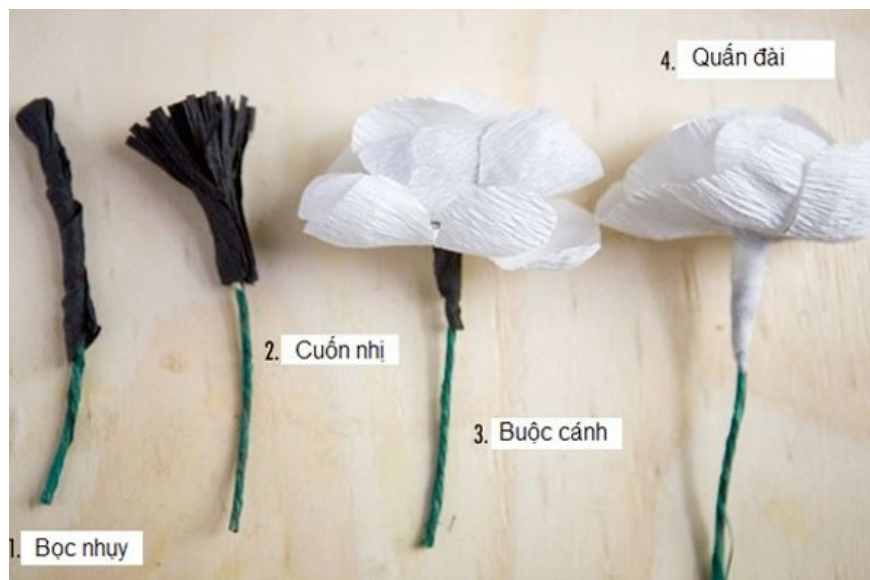
After cutting is finished, estimate the position of about 1/3 of the paper to make the stamen (calculated from one side of the length to the length) and cut it into a rag.

*Note:* This step must be done carefully so as not to break the piece of paper.

### **Step 4:**

Cut pieces of steel wire to make the flower, then take the green scroll paper around the steel wire.

Take the paper to make the pistil roll at the top of the steel wire. You can add a round piece of crumpled paper or a small piece of cotton in the middle to make the pistil look round.



Next, you wrap the paper to make the stamen around the pistil, turning the edge of the cut paper to the top. Use fixed glue to fix milk.

Then, insert a 5-pointed flower cut in the direction from the bottom up, through the small hole of the stamen. Pass 2 or 3 5-pointed flowers staggered to create a poppy flower with soft, gentle petals.

Cut the small pieces of white shrunk paper under the petals and use only a lot of rolls to fix the flower, not let it move down.

### Step 5:



Correct the petals to make the flower look more neat and beautiful.



Do the same to get the other poppy flowers.

### **Step 6:**

Put the flowers together, tie the strings into a bundle. At the flower section, you wrap the ribbon around to decorate the bouquet.



You can use different colored paper to create the colorful poppy flowers that you love.



The bouquet of poppy flowers made of paper looks soft, beautiful, no different from real flowers. You can plug in jars or bring bouquets to give and make the woman you love unexpectedly on **Vietnamese Women's Day 20 - 10** .
