

How to make intro videos on RenderForest

Instructions for using RenderForest to create intro videos

Step 1:

Users visit the link below to access the intro video making section on RenderForest.

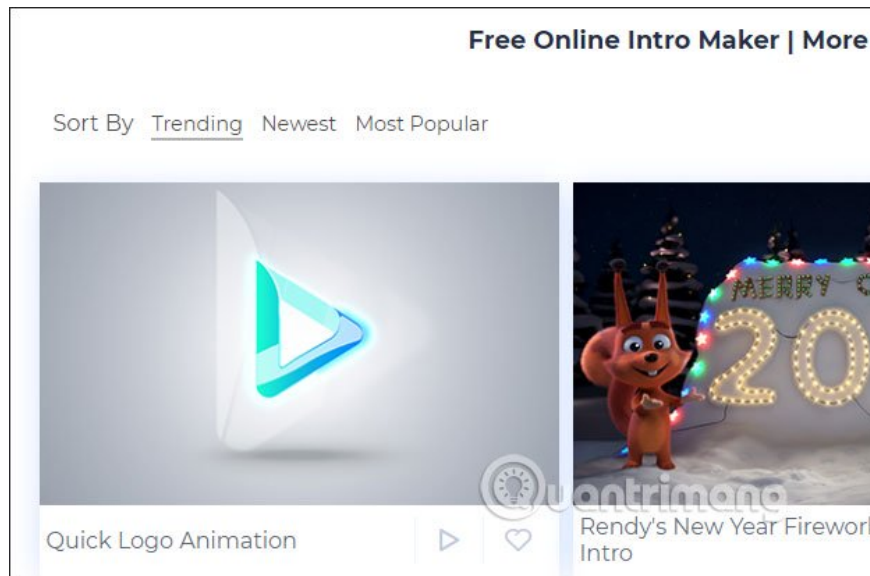

At the interface of RenderForest we click on **Create Video** to start creating videos.



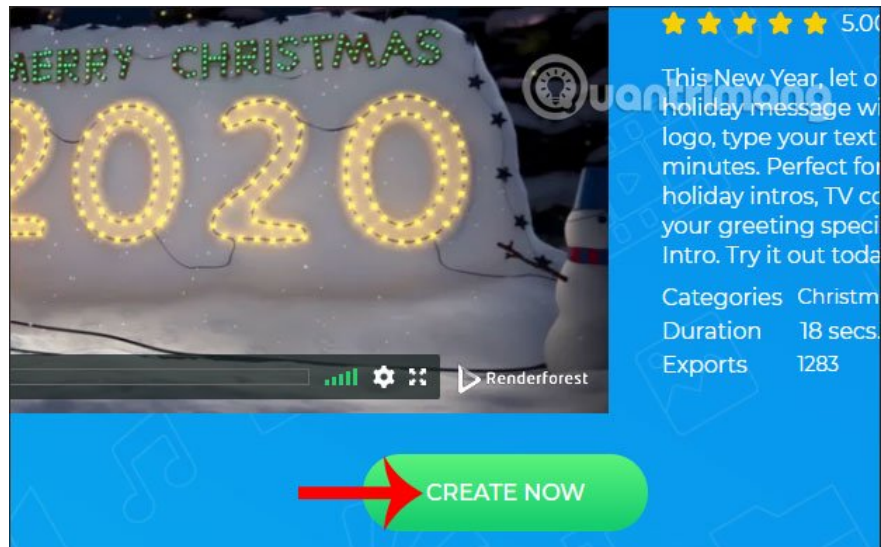
Step 2:

Switch to the new interface, the user will see a lot of different video topics. We can choose from each category: Trending, Newest and Most Popular to find the video we like.



Step 3:

When clicking on a video the user will see information about the video subject to, video intro time. Click the **Create Now** button to proceed to edit intro videos.

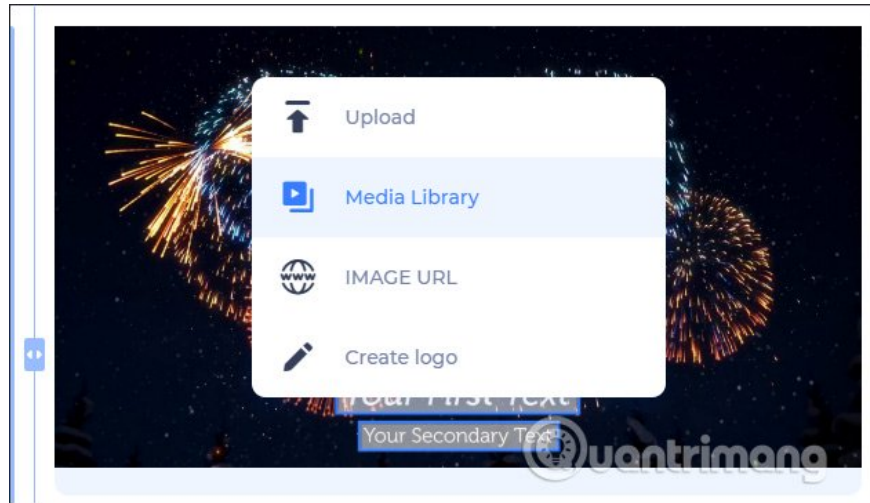


Step 4:

Switch to the intro video content setup interface on RenderForest. First in the video frame, click on the **Your logo here box** to insert your website logo.



Now display options for uploading logos to intro videos. If the logo is available on your computer, click Upload, use the online image, paste the image URL in the image URL frame, the Media library will get the image from RenderForest and Create logo to switch to the logo builder on RenderForest.



If you download the logo from your computer, we need to create an account using RenderForest, click **Sign up** to proceed.

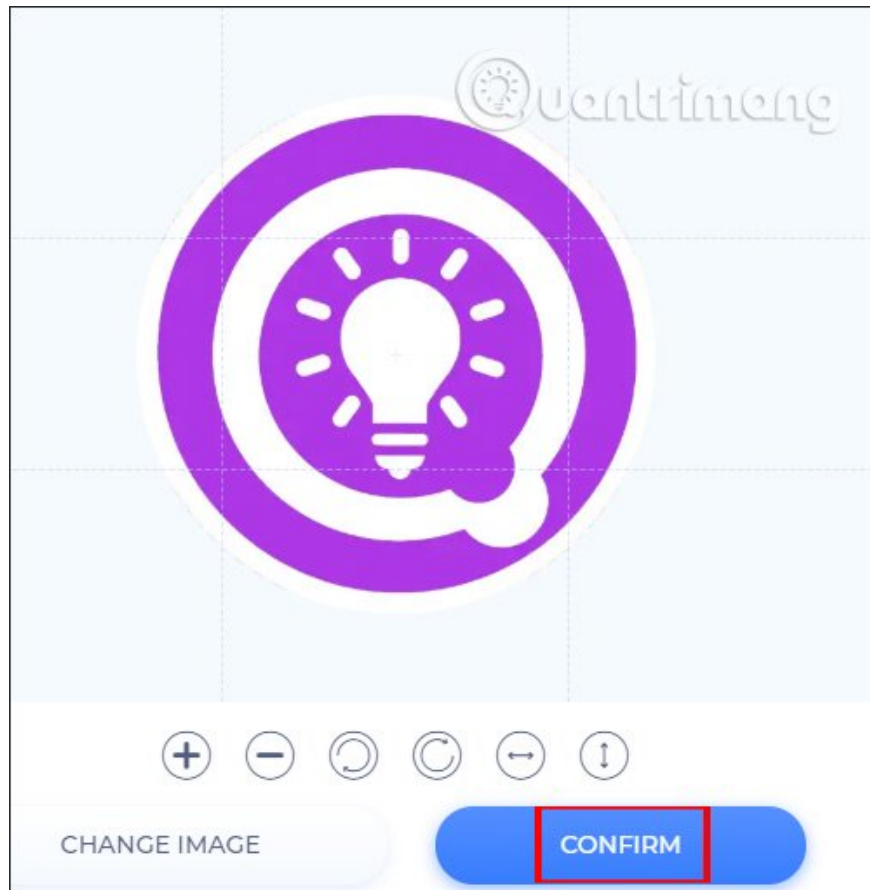

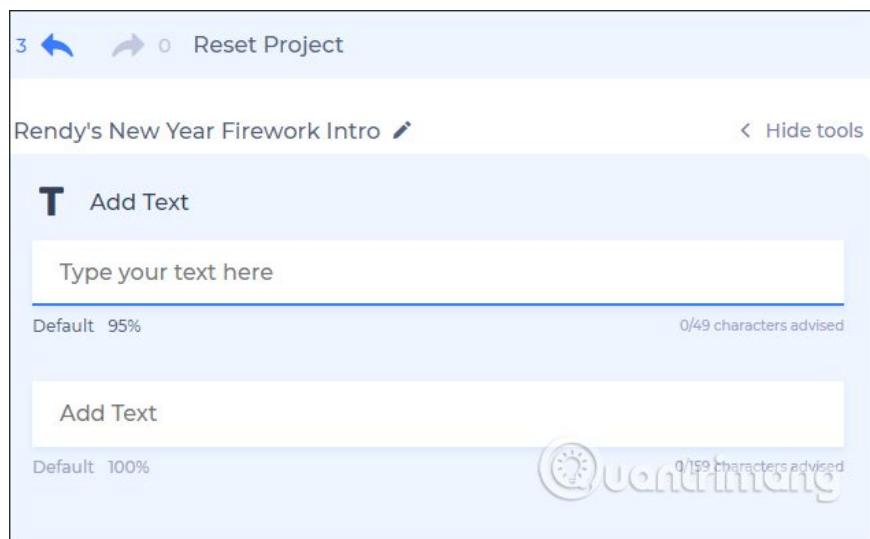
Step 6:

Once you have an account, use the logo download video again. Then the logo is transferred to the editing interface. We proceed **to adjust the logo** accordingly and click on **Confirm** to confirm.



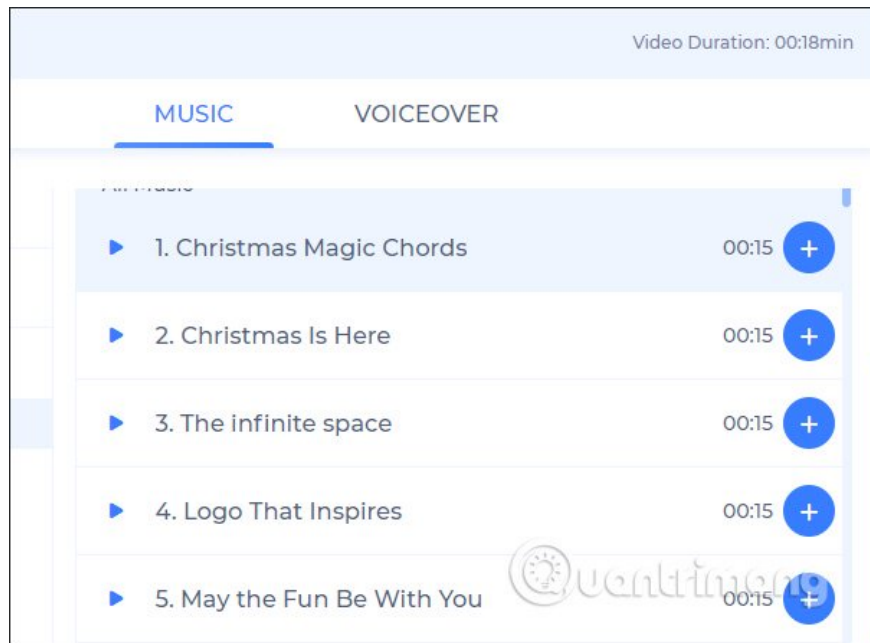
Step 7:

Next we will write the content that we would recommend to everyone. Looking to the left, you will see **the entry** and edit. We have 2 lines to enter the content. You enter the information to be provided to the user in the intro video.

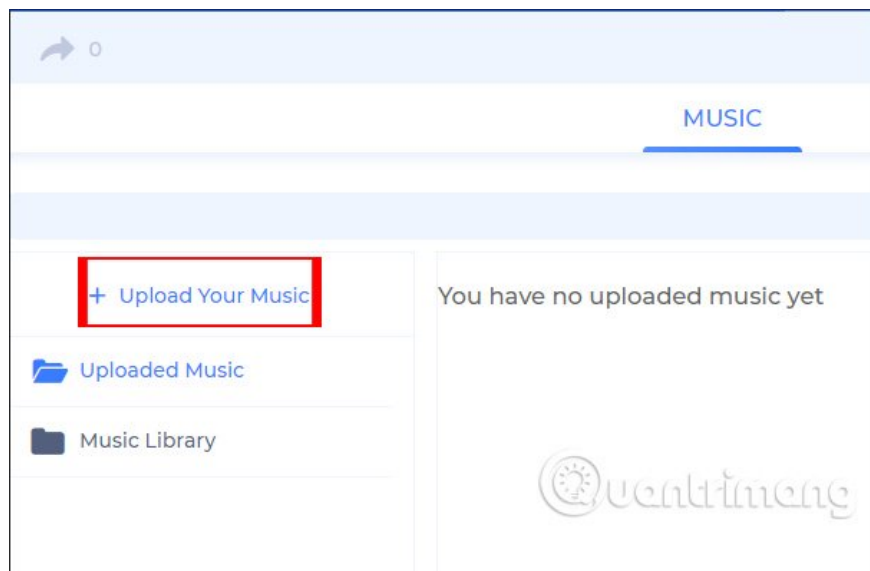


Step 8:

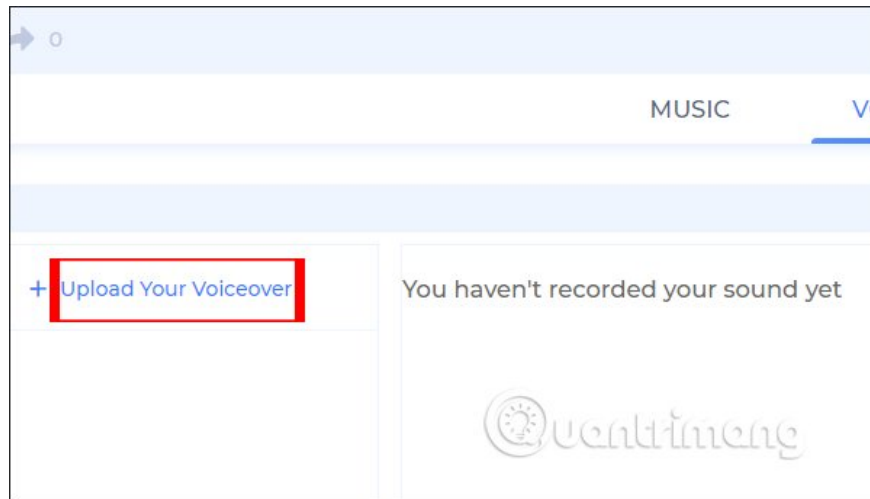
Then we click on **the Music section** to change the background music for Intro. Switching to the new interface we will see many of **the music that RenderForest provides** for you. Click the play icon to try it out. You need to find a piece of music that has the same time as the intro video, if shorter, it should only be a few seconds short. Click **the plus icon** to agree to use.



If users want to **download music from the computer**, then click **Uploaded Music** to select music.

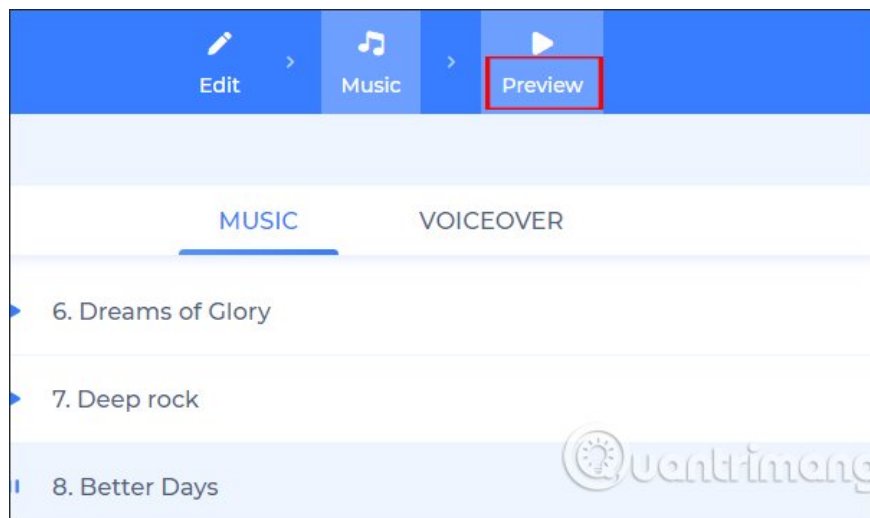


The site also allows you to download audio files you have recorded at Voiceover. Also click Upload your Voiceover to upload files.

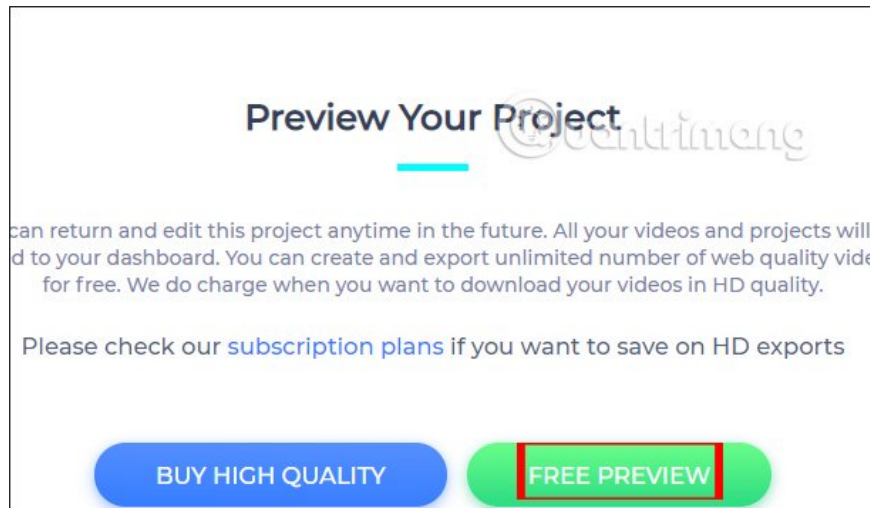


Step 9:

Once you've selected the music, click **Preview** to preview your intro video.

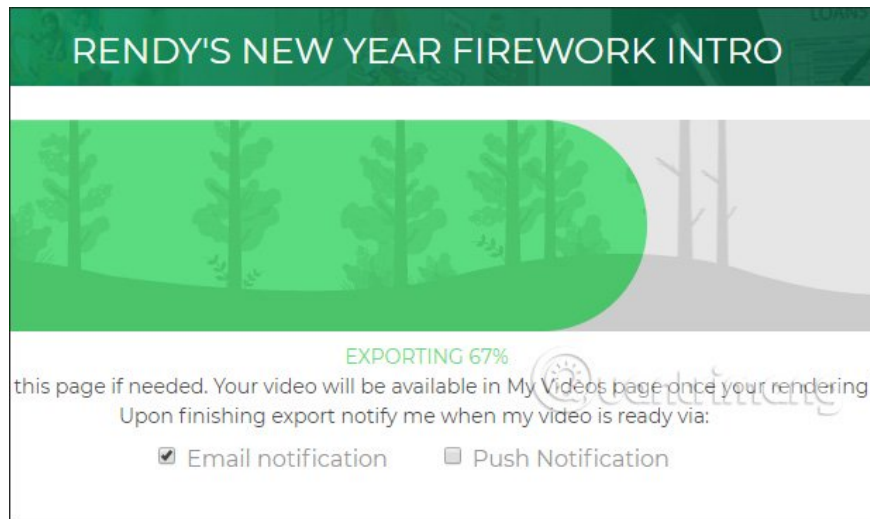


Now we need to click on **Free Preview** to preview the video for free.



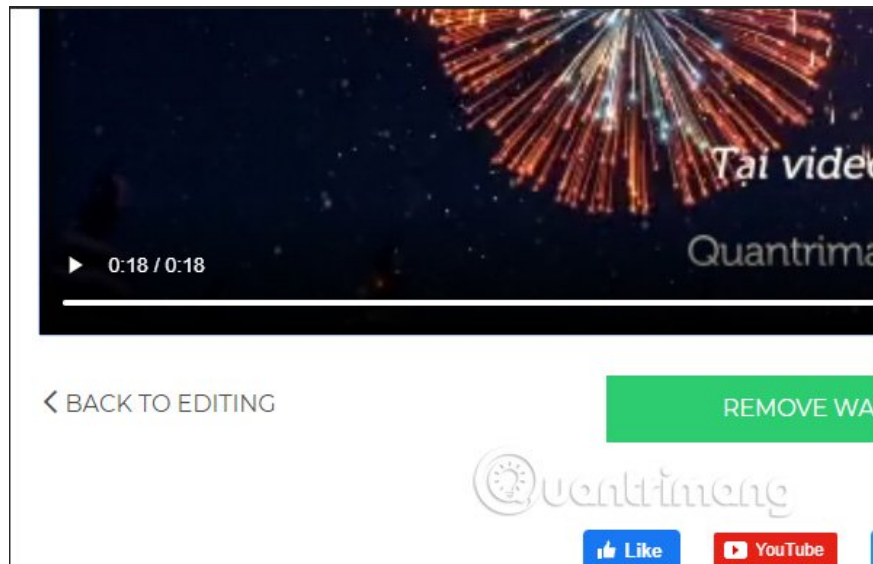
Step 10:

Now RenderForest proceeds to create intro videos with the content that we have created.



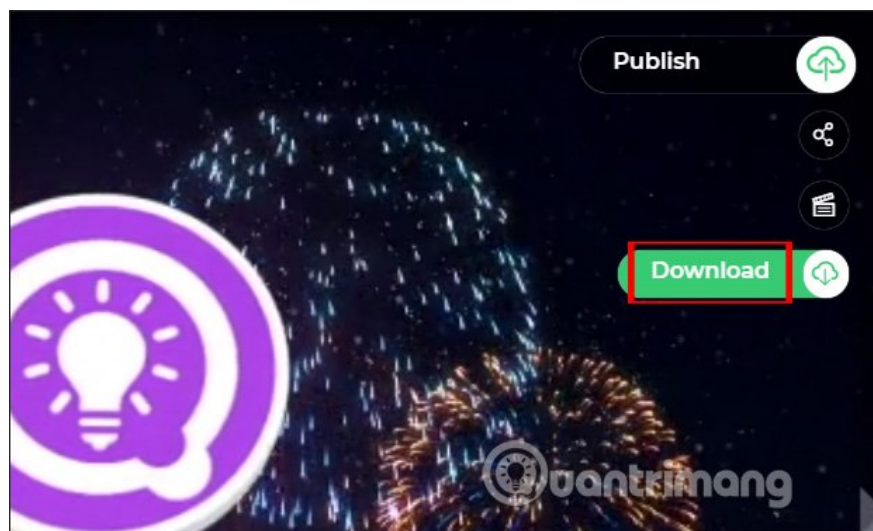
Step 11:

Watch your intro video after it's done. If you want to edit it, click Back to editing. Note the free created video will have RenderForest logo attached.



Step 12:

To download the video, at the video interface click **the Publish button** . Now users have the option to share videos on social networking sites, save videos to My video on RenderForest because you already have an account and **click Download** to download videos to your computer.



Due to the free account, the intro video created with RenderForest is of average quality, so users should pay attention.



RenderForest brings an intro video maker with a lot of different topics, updating the latest trends for you to make videos such as making videos for Christmas for the year. However, users should also note that because it is a free version, there will be many video restrictions.
