

How to make your computer start up faster, applicable to Windows 7, 8.1, and 10.

There are many ways to speed up your computer's startup that you can apply to your device, either using software or utilizing built-in Windows features. Let's explore some ways to speed up startup on Windows 7, 8.1, or Windows 10 below.

Over time, computers may experience slower startup times and longer Windows loading times compared to when they were new. This can be caused by various factors, such as installing too many software programs or the creation of numerous junk files that take up hard drive space.

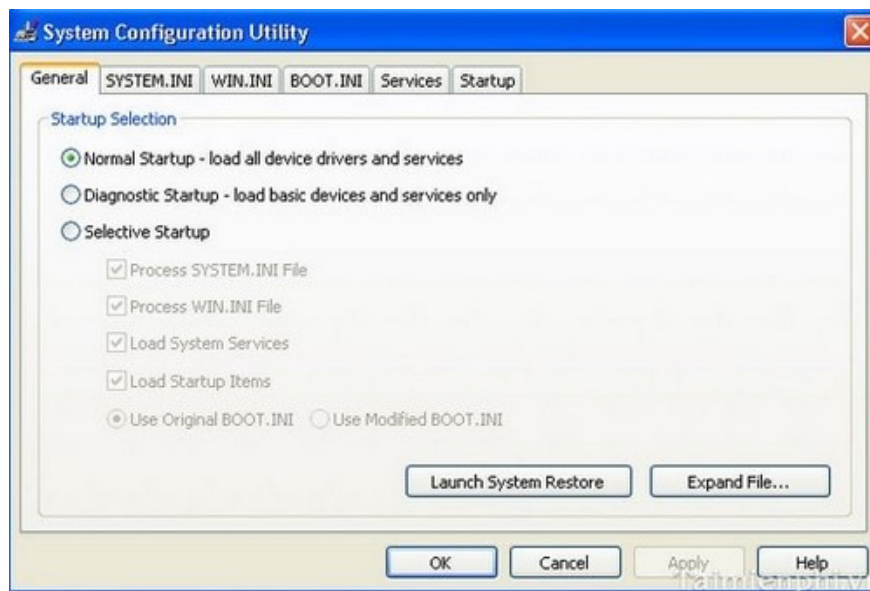

Method 1: Disable the application so it doesn't load at startup.

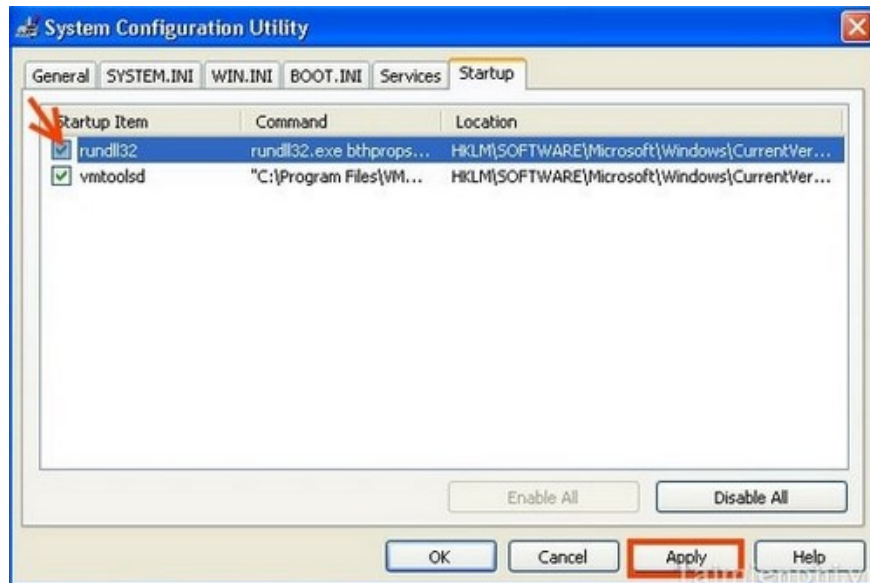
Step 1: Open **Run** by pressing the **Windows key + R** , type '**msconfig**' , and press **Enter** .



Step 2 : **The System Configuration Utility** window will appear.



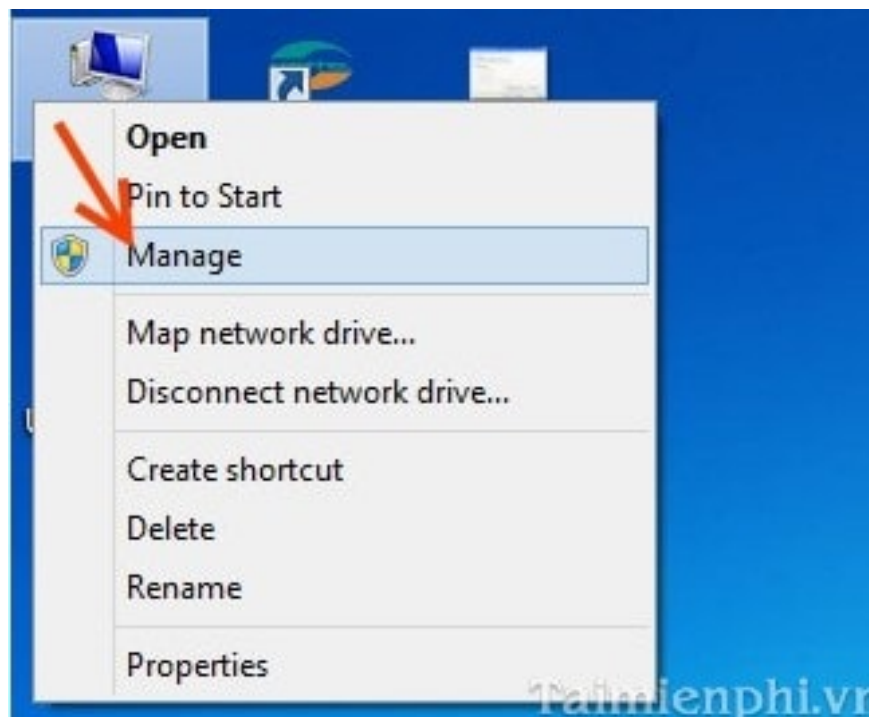
Step 3: In this table, click on the **Startup** tab . This section contains programs that start with your computer. Check the boxes next to unnecessary programs. (Some programs, like antivirus software, should not be checked as they are protective programs.) Then click **Apply** to apply the changes, and click **OK** to close the table.



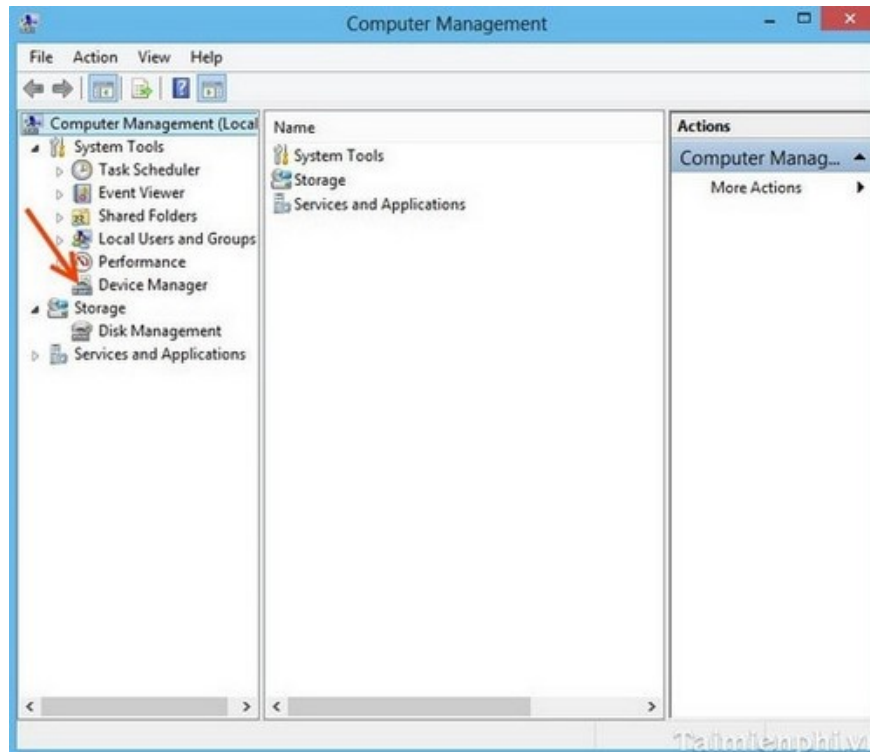
Then, simply restart your computer.

Method 2: Disable hardware programs so they don't load at startup.

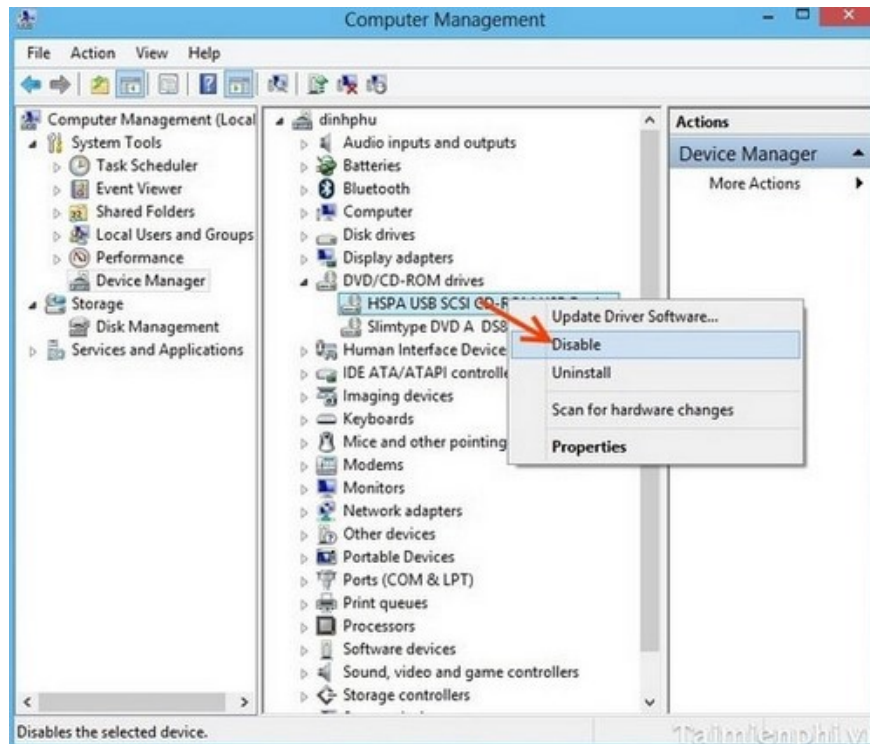
*Step 1: Right-click on **Computer** and select **Manage**.*



*Step 2: A **Computer Management** window will appear; select **Device Manager** to display a list of hardware devices that start up with the computer.*



Step 3: Find and disable unnecessary devices. For example, if you don't have a printer, select " **Print queues** ". If you don't use **USB, SCSI, or CD** drives, right-click and select "**Disable**" to disable them and exit the window.



So now you have a method to help your computer start up faster. This trick will be helpful to you in using your computer.
