

How to manage access to applications with Face ID on iPhone X

If you don't want third-party applications to use Face ID, you can block access to these apps on your iPhone X phone easily. Follow these steps to manage Face ID access for apps on iPhone X.

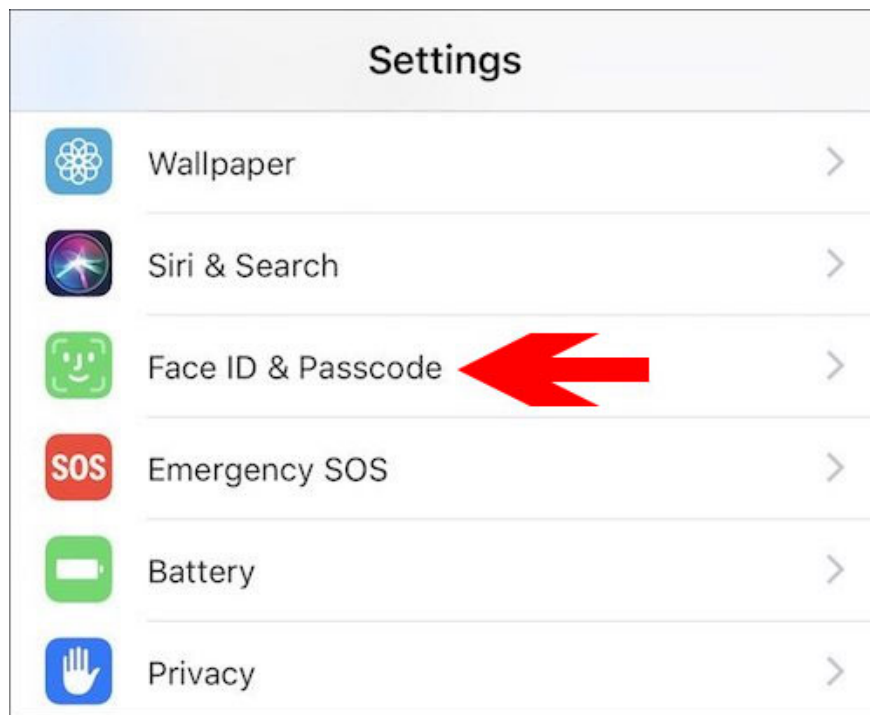
In addition to setting security for your iPhone, this security method also allows users to use for authentication for third-party applications. When using Face ID as an authentication method for an application, logging in to apps such as banking or online shopping will become quicker and easier like Touch ID.

Although it is convenient, in some cases, if you want to remove the application's Face ID access, you can follow Quantrimang's instructions below.

1. How to sign in by face, install Face ID on Windows 10
2. Check IMEI and check the origin of Android and iPhone phones
3. How to transfer data from old iPhone to new iPhone (iPhone X, iPhone 8, iPhone 7)
4. Instructions on how to recover deleted messages on iPhone

Instructions to turn off Face ID access of applications on iPhone & iPad

Step 1: On the iPhone screen, please select the **Settings** application (**Settings**) , scroll down and select **Face ID & Password (Face ID & Passcode)** .



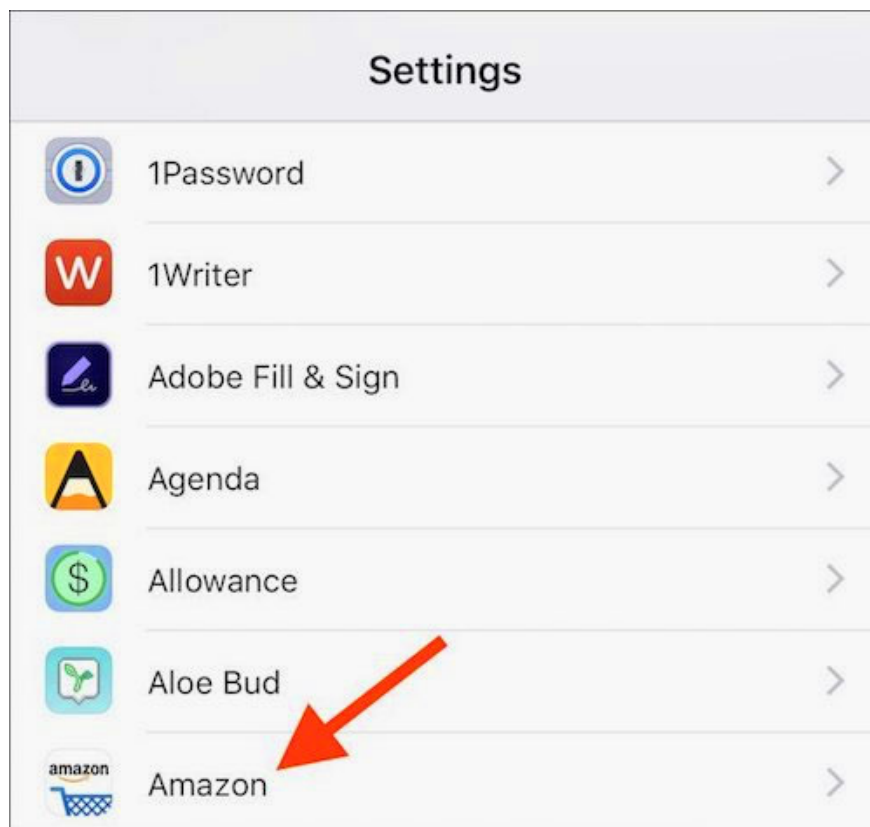
Next in the Face ID & Passcode menu, select **Other Applications (Other App)** .



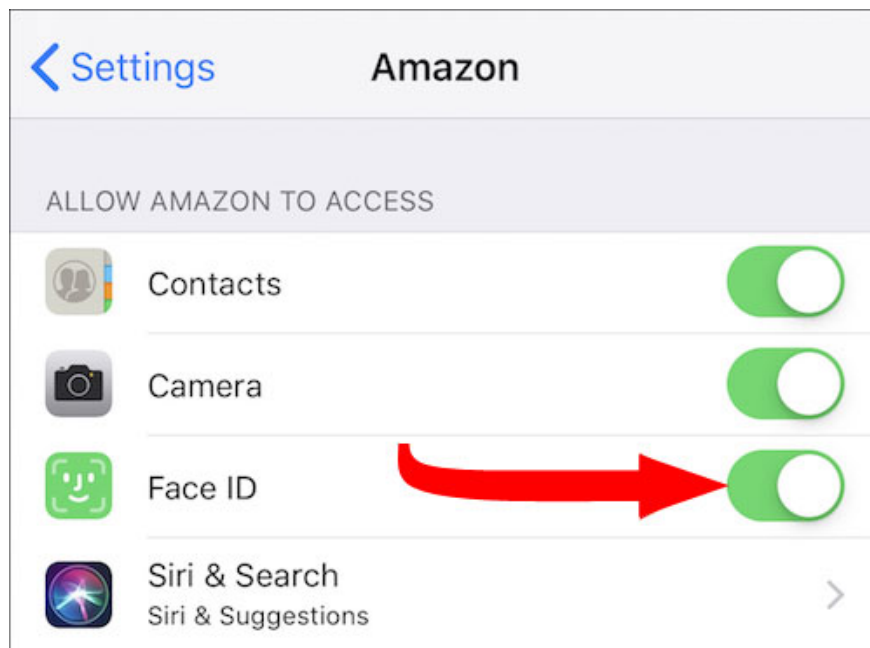
Step 2: In the **Other Applications** section, you can see the list of applications that you have granted the right to use Face ID. Besides, the status of these applications, if you see the right shortcut button is turned on, please turn them off to remove the right to use Face ID of that application.



If you do not want to delve into Face ID Settings, there is another way: scroll down under the Settings application until you find the name of the application you want to revoke Face ID, then click it. .



Then in setting up the application, please turn off the Face ID and the application will be disabled for Face ID access.



Through the above article, you can remove the right to use Face ID on your iPhone application, which will cause you to log in again with that application account whenever you access the application.
