

How to mass edit photos on iPhone?

Picky is a free app on iPhone / iPad that allows users to edit images in bulk. Users will not have to waste time editing each image as before.

Surely in your smartphone already owns several applications to capture and edit images. And it is not too difficult for us to find a photo editing application like that, to create attractive and attractive images.

However, you have a lot of images in the collection that you want to edit them quickly, so it is time consuming to edit each image. If so, try using the Picky app for iOS devices, supporting you to edit images in bulk. With just a few simple steps, you will have immediately edited, more time-saving images.

Step 1:

First, download the Picky app under the link below.

1. Download the free Picky iOS app

Step 2:

We start the downloaded application to the device. The application will ask if you want to **receive notifications from Picky** . Click Don't Allow if you don't want to, or Allow if allowed. Click **Get Started** to continue using Picky.

Step 3:

On the next interface, Picky will ask the user **for permission to access the album** on the device, press **OK** . Soon there are **interfaces that introduce the features of Picky** . You just need to click next to continue. Finally click **Continue** to use.

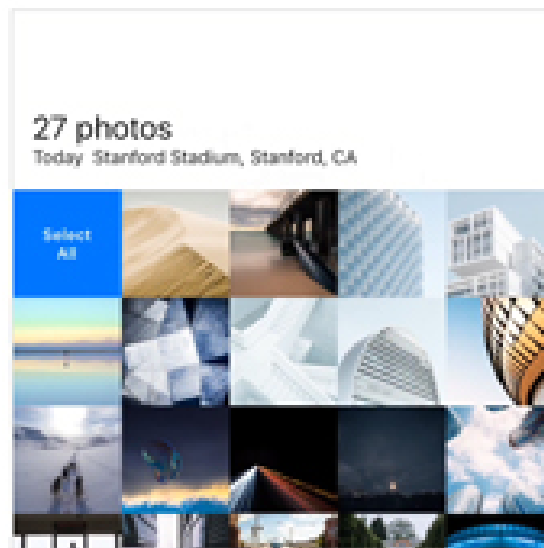

Step 4:

In the first interface, Picky will provide us with **2 options for image editing** . If using the **image available in the album** press **the plus icon** . Use **new photos** to press **the camera icon** to take pictures.

Here you will see the entire album available on the device. To **select some images you** want to edit, **click on the image** . To **select all photos** in that album for editing, click **Select All** . Finally click the **check mark** to the right of the interface.

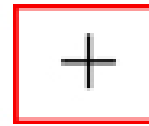

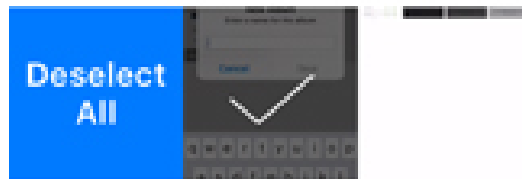

Step 5:

Appeared interface of edited images. Here, you will **click on the image** in that gallery to start editing the image. Next will be the image attached below is **the filter for photos** . When applying certain filters to an image, the remaining images also use that filter. Click on the **traces to save** .

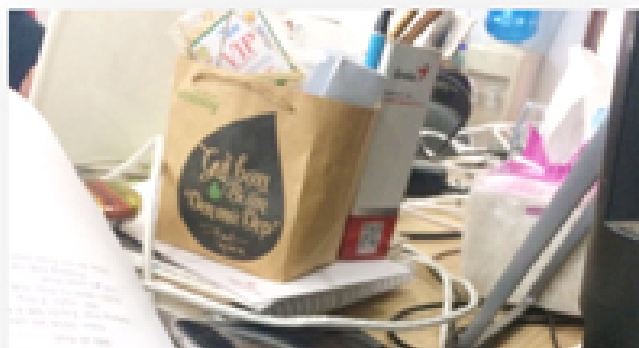

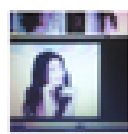

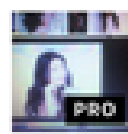

Step 6:

Next, we will click on **the sharing icon** to the right of the interface. **Two types of image saving** appear for users to choose.

1. Single image grid: Save each image separately, then sort by grid.

2. Separate images: Save as individual images.

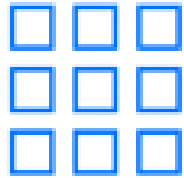
Or we can share photos on Facebook, Wechat, . Once you've selected one of the two types of image saving, we press **Camera Roll** to save the image to the gallery.



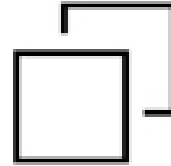
