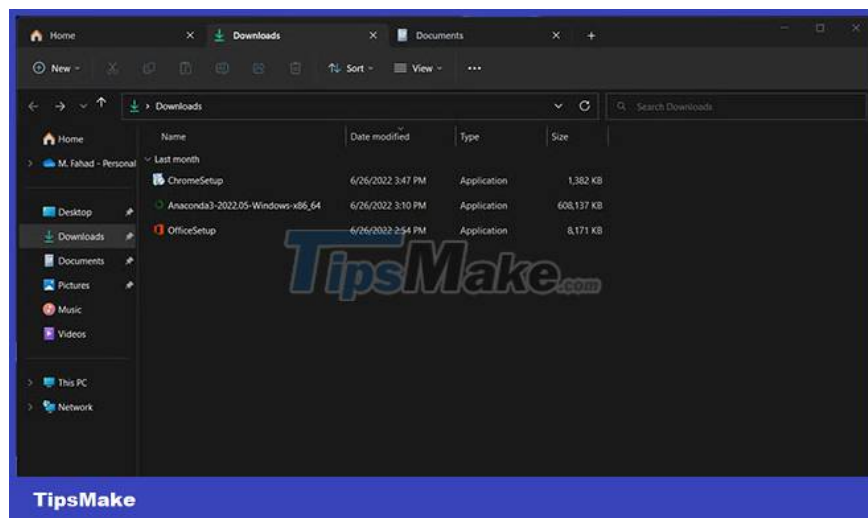

One of the most significant improvements in the Windows 11 22H2 update is the addition of File Explorer tabs.

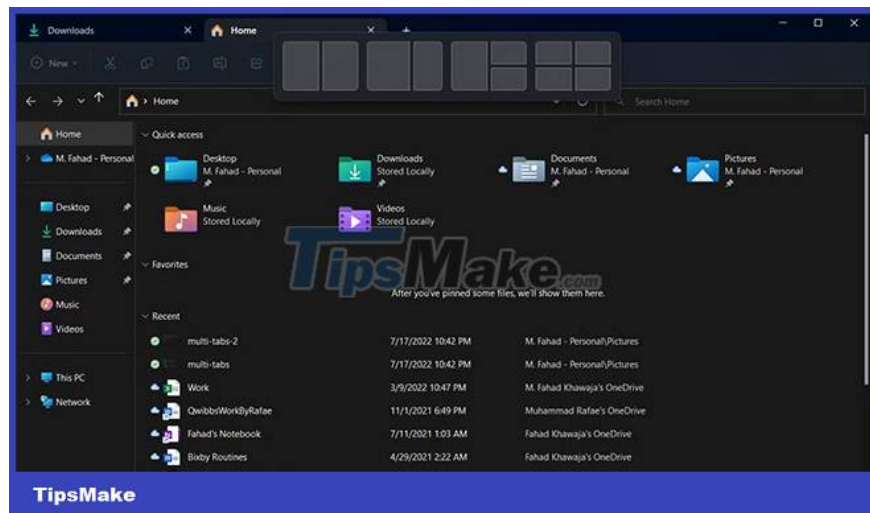
