

How to mute when taking pictures for iPhone fast, simple

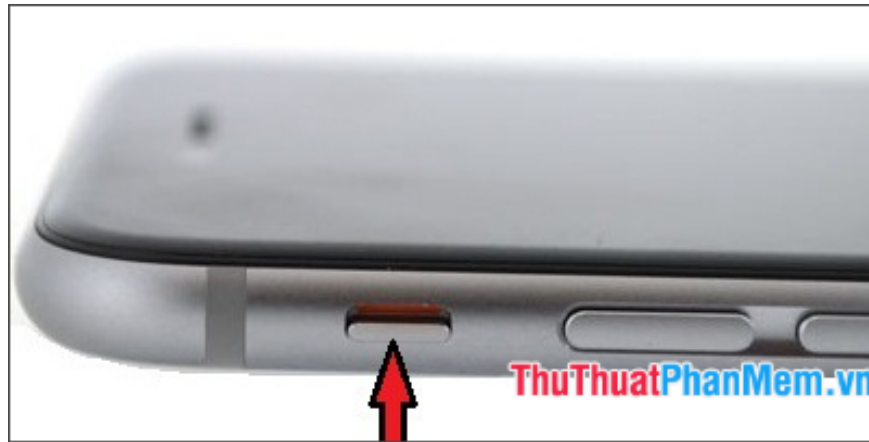

You love to take pictures on your iPhone, but the "click" sound when taking pictures makes you feel uncomfortable. However, we can turn off the annoying sound when taking photos on iPhone using the tips in the following article.



1. Turn off iPhone volume with physical mute key

With international iPhone models or iPhone lock (except Japanese or Korean) we can mute when taking photos by returning iPhone to **Silent** mode . The way to do this: you turn the Silent button on the left side of the iPhone and the **Silent** switch with the status as shown below is successful.



2. Mute when taking photos for iPhone with accessibility shortcut

In addition to muting photos with physical hardware keys, we can also mute images by accessibility. You must first enable accessibility by going to **Settings** => **General settings** => **Accessibility** => **AssistiveTouch** => turn the **AssistiveTouch** switch to **On** .

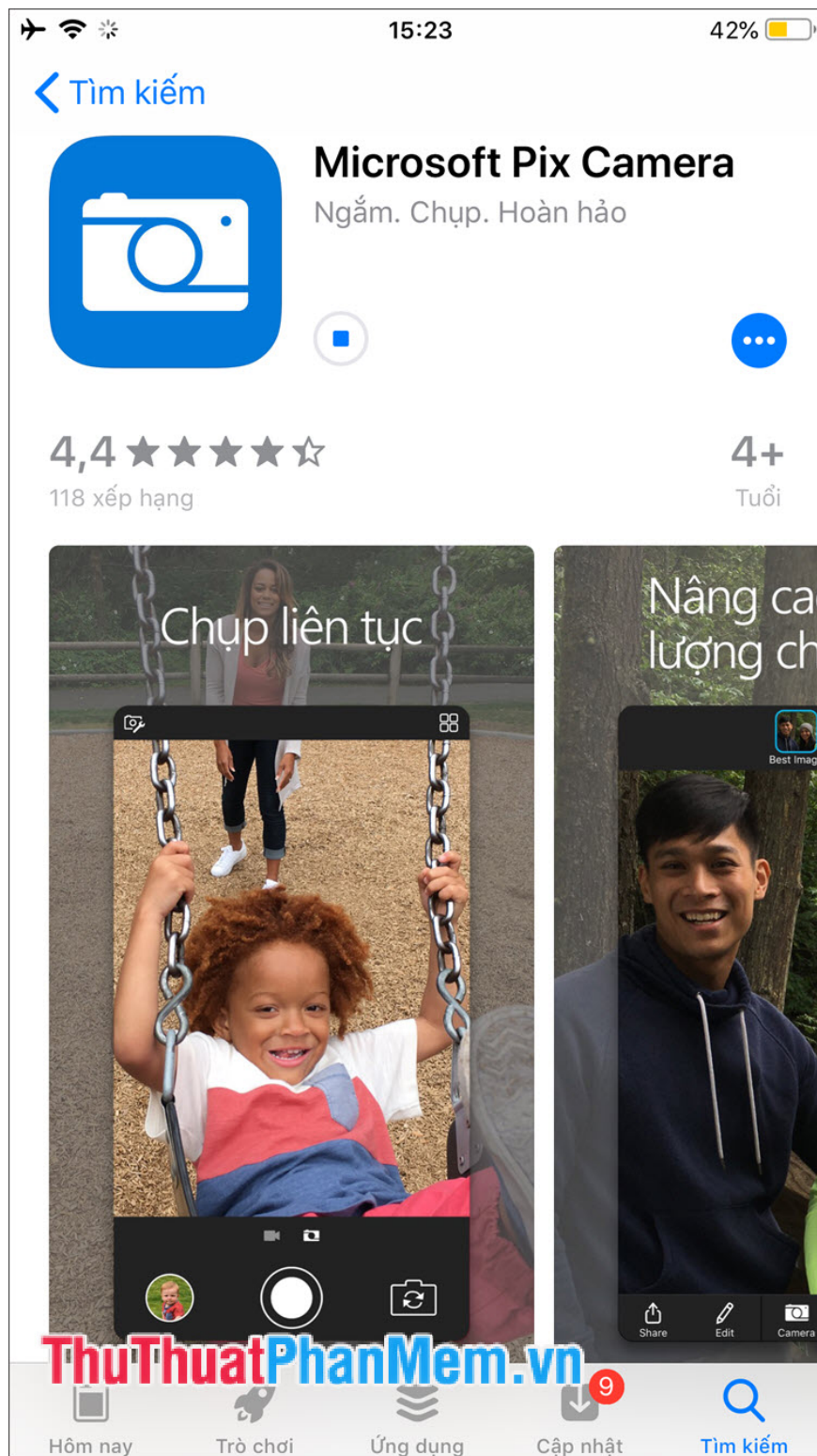
After enabling AssistiveTouch, you can do the following to mute:

- Touch the AssistiveTouch icon on the main screen (1) => **Device** (2) => **Mute** (3) .

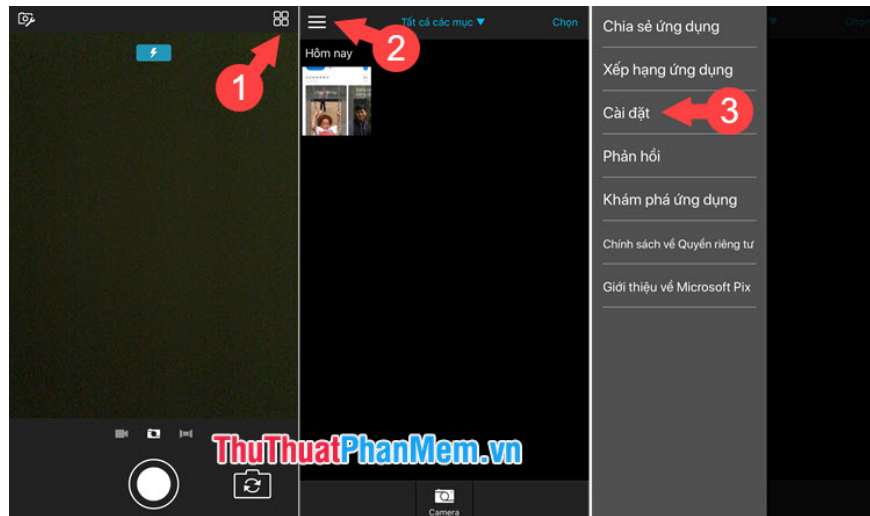


3. Turn off the volume when taking photos for iPhone using Microsoft Pix software

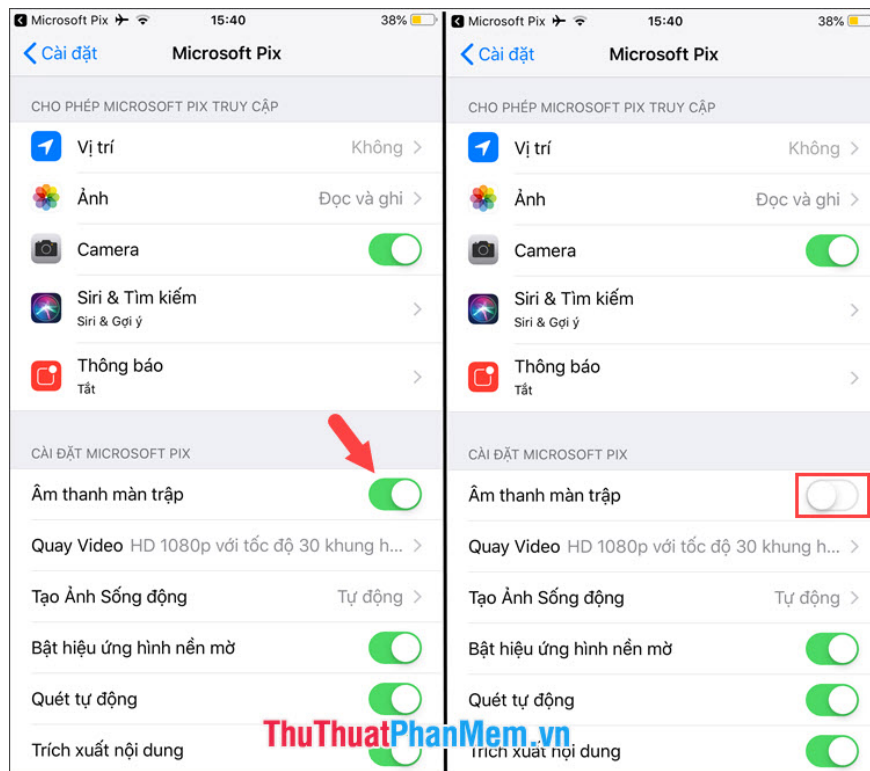
With some iPhone models Lock international or for the Korean market, Japan, we can not mute the camera as the above two methods that must jailbreak the device or use an external photography application. However, jailbreaking involves potential security risks and we'll use the Microsoft Pix app. Link to download the application here: <https://apps.apple.com/vn/app/microsoft-pix-camera/id1127910488?l=en>



Step 1: After downloading, open the application and grant access to the camera and photo for the application. Then you touch the square icon in the top right corner (1) => touch the 3 dashes in the left corner (2) => Settings (3) .



Step 2: You switch the switch **Shutter sound** is off. Then you go back to the app and take photos and videos without sound.



With the instructions in the article, you can carefree taking photos with iPhone without the sound emitted during shooting to annoy people around. Good luck!
