

# How to open a screenshot folder on Opera Neon

Opera Neon is Opera Software's new browser with completely different interfaces and features than browsers like Google Chrome, or Firefox.

The introduction of the Opera Neon browser has given users a whole new perspective on the old Opera browser. With a beautiful transparent interface, the options to use and interact with the website appear right on the screen interface to make it easier for users to manipulate. Besides, Opera Neon also provides users with some tools such as screen capture, video or mp3 shutdown or stop right on the browser interface, .

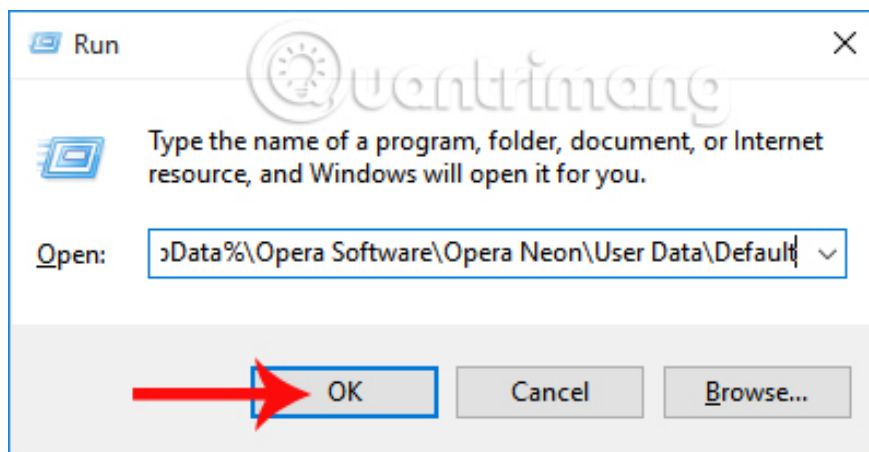
However, after taking some screen shots on Opera Neon, how can I open those images? In the article below, Network Administrator will guide you how to open the folder to store screenshots on Opera Neon.

1. How to use the new Opera Neon web browser

## Step 1:

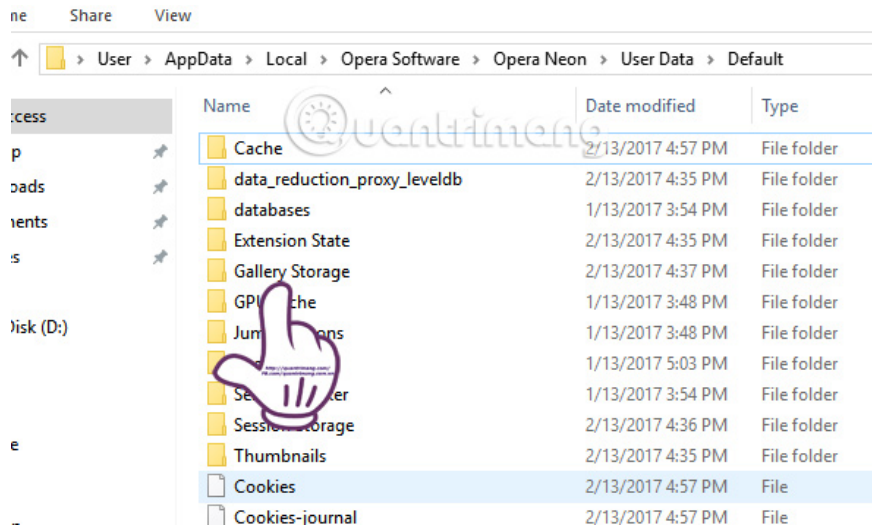
First of all, **open the Run window** with the Windows + R key combination. In the dialog box we will enter the following directory path and **click OK** to access the computer.

% LocalAppData% Opera SoftwareOpera NeonUser DataDefault



## Step 2:

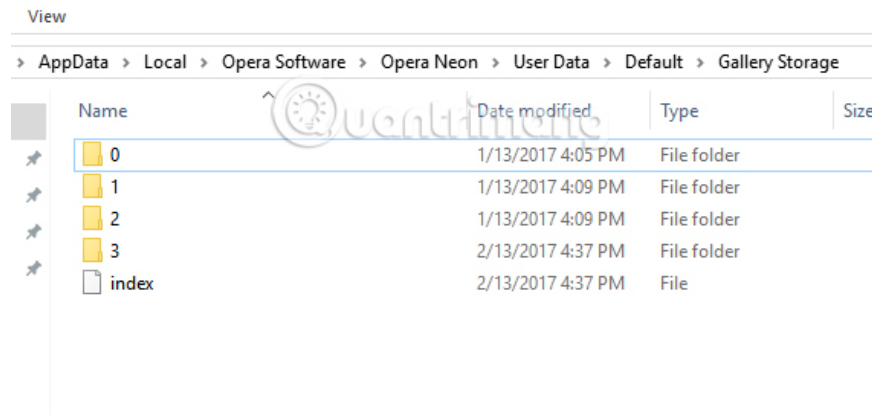
In the Default folder, we go to **the Gallery Storage folder** and double-click the left mouse button to open the folder.



### Step 3:

This is **the folder that stores all the screen images captured on the Opera Neon browser**. The photos will be sorted by folders, with order of photos taken on the browser. Accompanied by each photo will have a specific time that we took screenshots on the Opera Neon browser.

We can rely on this information to find the right screenshot of the browser, in case there are multiple images in the folder.

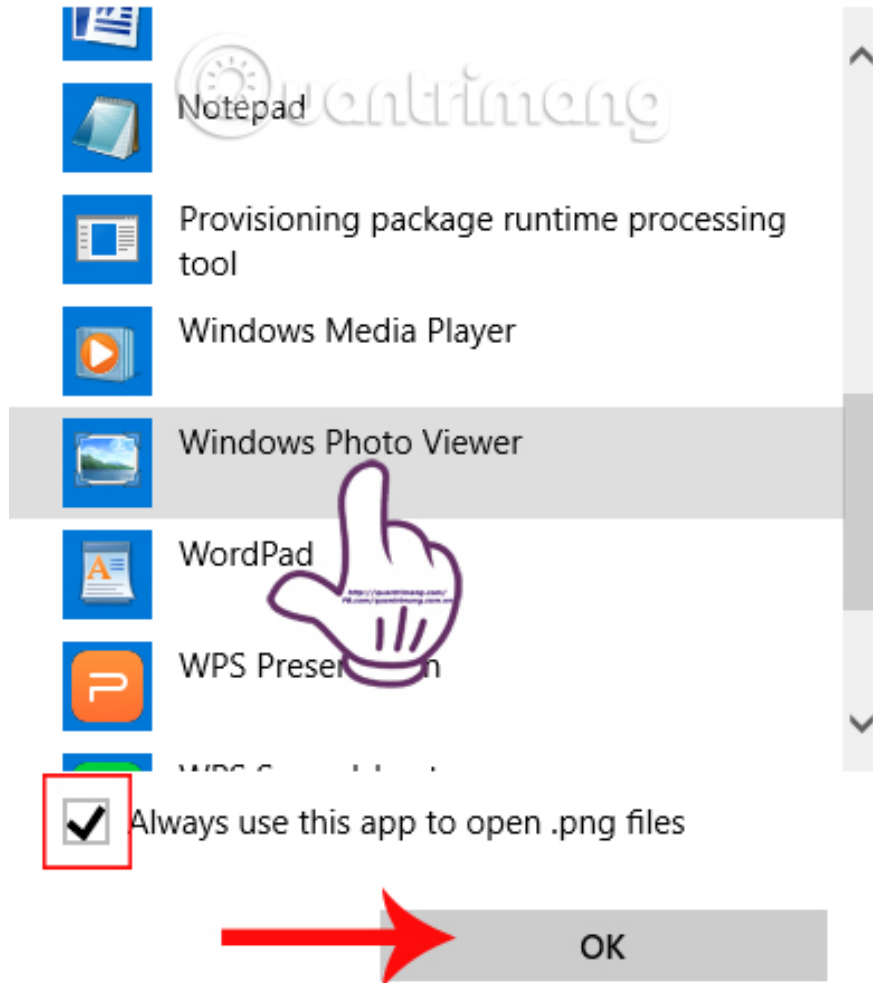


### Step 4:

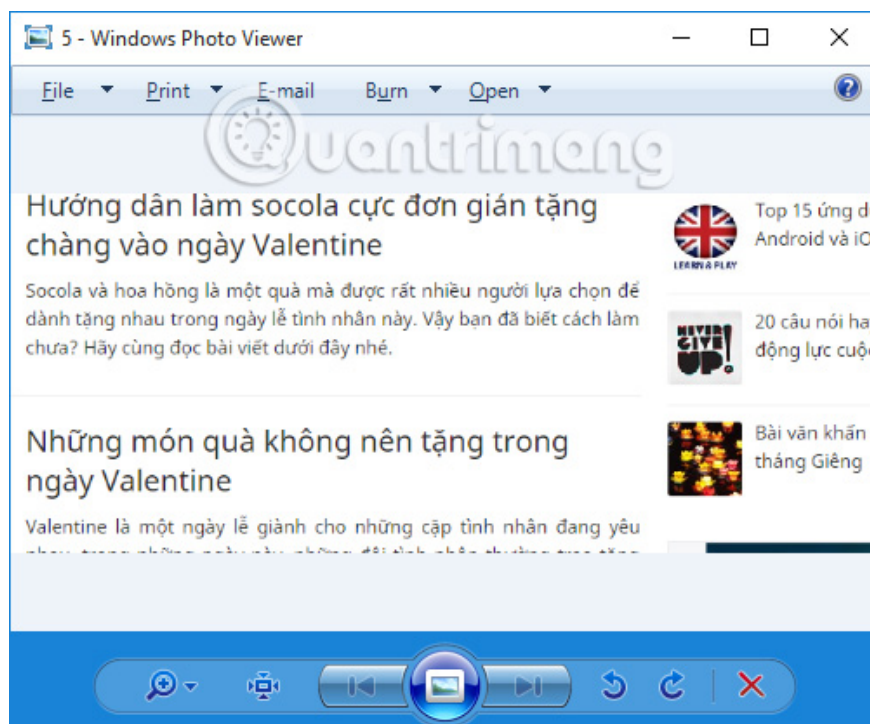
Since the **photo will be saved in .png format**, when you double click on the image you want to open, we will be asked to open the image with any tool, select **Windows Photo Viewer** to open the image.

Also, select the option **Always to use this app to open .png files** to be able to open screenshots on Opera Neon without going through this step anymore. Finally **click OK** to save and open the image.

So you have opened the screen shot on Opera Neon browser already. Now you can copy, edit photos or send to friends on Facebook, email, . if you want.
