

How to open and adjust the virtual keyboard on Windows 11

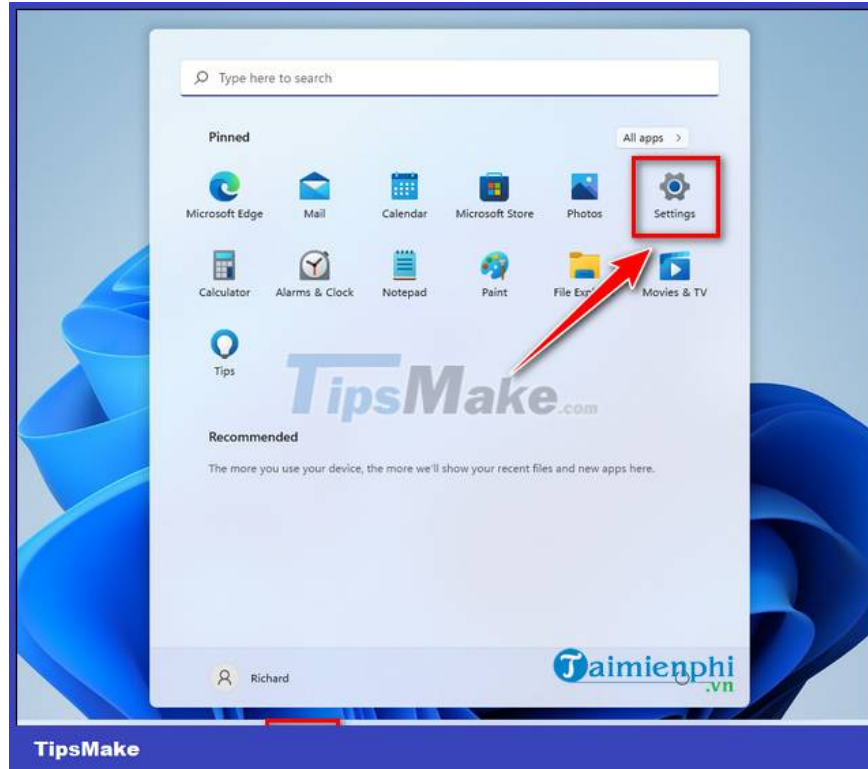

How to open and adjust the virtual keyboard on Windows 11

1. How to open the virtual keyboard on Windows 11

Step 1: You click on **the Windows icon** on the taskbar and select **Settings** or press the keyboard shortcut **Windows + I** to open the Settings application .

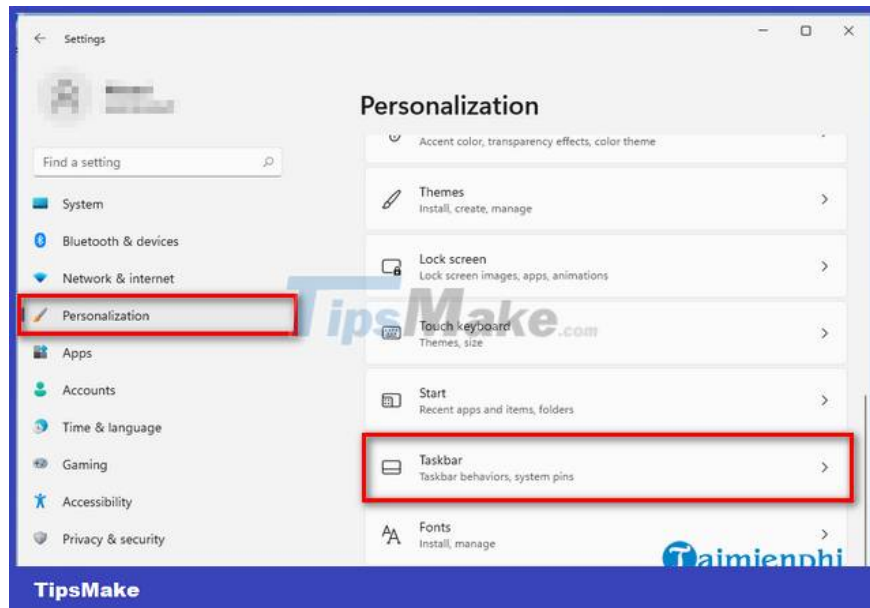

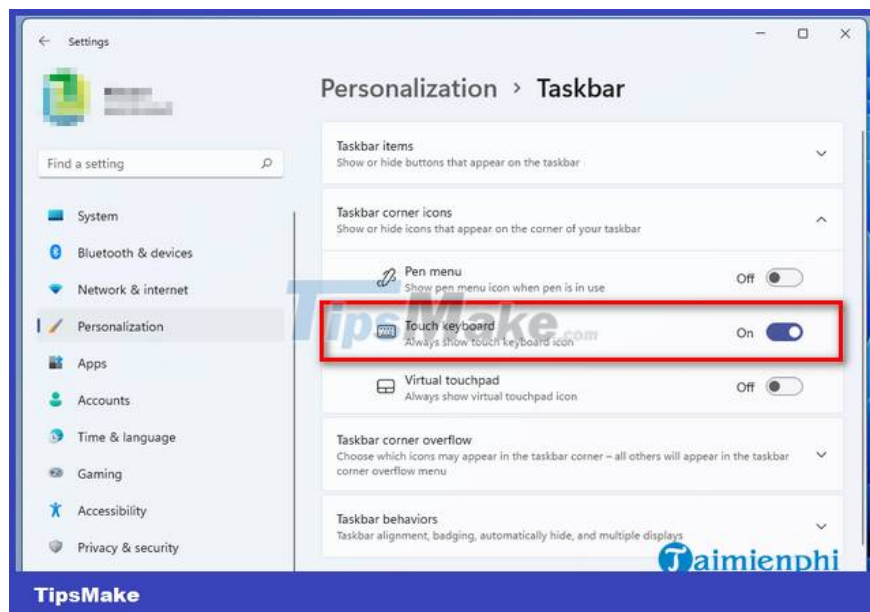
Alternatively, you can also access the **Settings** app by right-clicking **the Task Bar** and selecting **Taskbar settings**.



Step 2: In the Settings window , select **Personalization** in the left panel and click **Taskbar** in the right panel.



Step 4: In the **Taskbar** menu , expand **the Taskbar corner icons** section and turn on **the Touch keyboard** by turning the switch to the **On state**.



You will then see **a keyboard icon** appear on the taskbar on the right side of the screen. Whenever you click or tap this keyboard icon, a virtual keyboard will appear.

2. How to adjust the virtual keyboard on Windows 11

You can change the color, theme and size of the virtual keyboard easily with the following steps:

Step 1: Click **the keyboard icon** on the taskbar to open the virtual keyboard.

Step 2 : Click **the settings icon** in the upper left corner of the virtual keyboard.

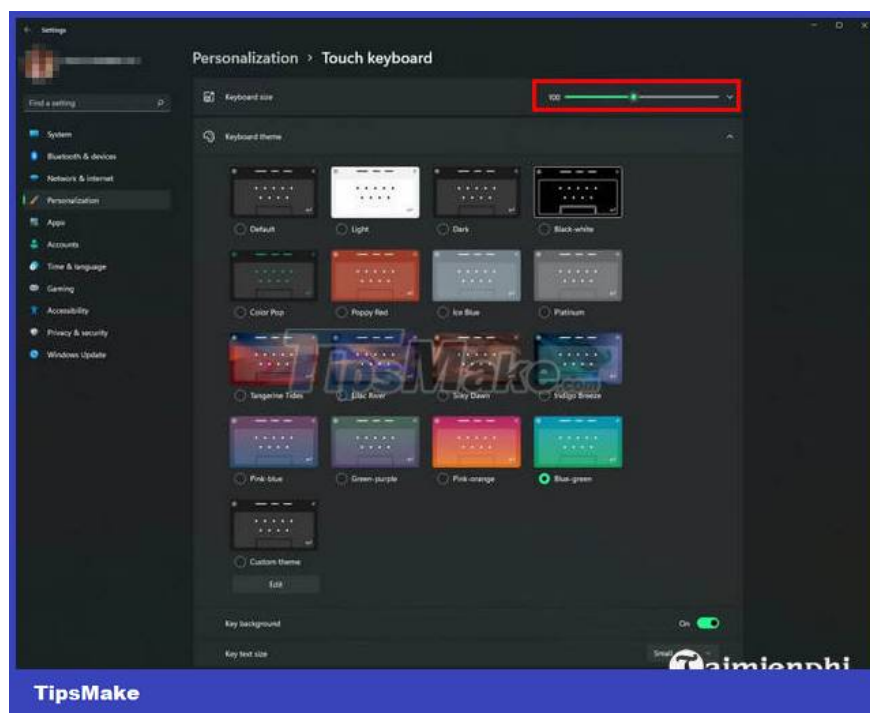


Step 3: Here, you will have some options as follows:

- **Keyboard layout:** Change the keyboard layout.
- **Handwriting :** Enable handwriting on the keyboard (depending on whether your touch screen device supports pen or not).
- **Theme and resize:** Change keyboard theme and size.
- **Give feedback:** Give feedback.
- **More settings:** Typing - Your input options (autocorrect.), Language - Change language, Learn more - Find out more information.



To change the theme and size of the virtual keyboard, select **Theme and resize**. Then, in the **Touch keyboard window**, you can **shrink or increase the size of the virtual keyboard by dragging the Keyboard size slider** left or right, and change the appearance and color of the virtual keyboard from a variety of themes. Themes are available in the **Keyboard theme** section .
