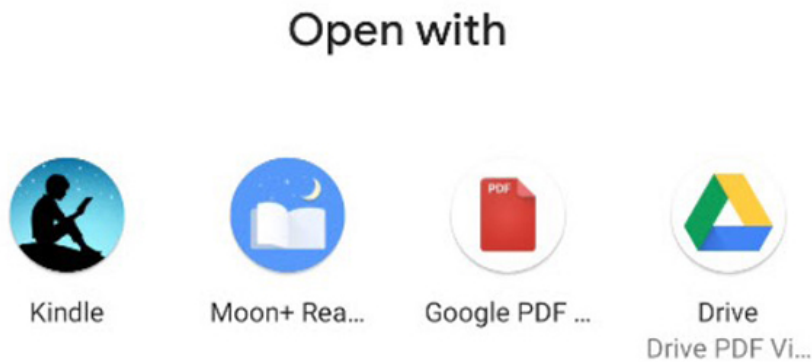


How to open and read PDF files on Android

Working with a PDF file on your phone can be tricky sometimes. However, to open the file is very simple. Your Android phone probably already does, if not, there are a few options for you.

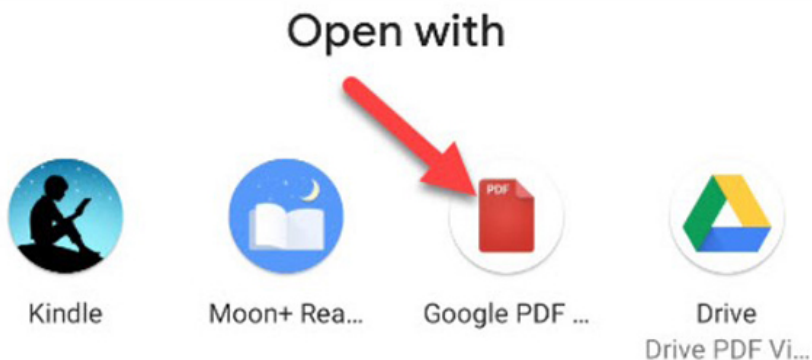
In the article below, TipsMake will guide you on how to open PDF files on Android devices. First, you probably already have an app on your Android device that can open PDF files. Google Drive or ebook reader apps like Kindle can also be opened.



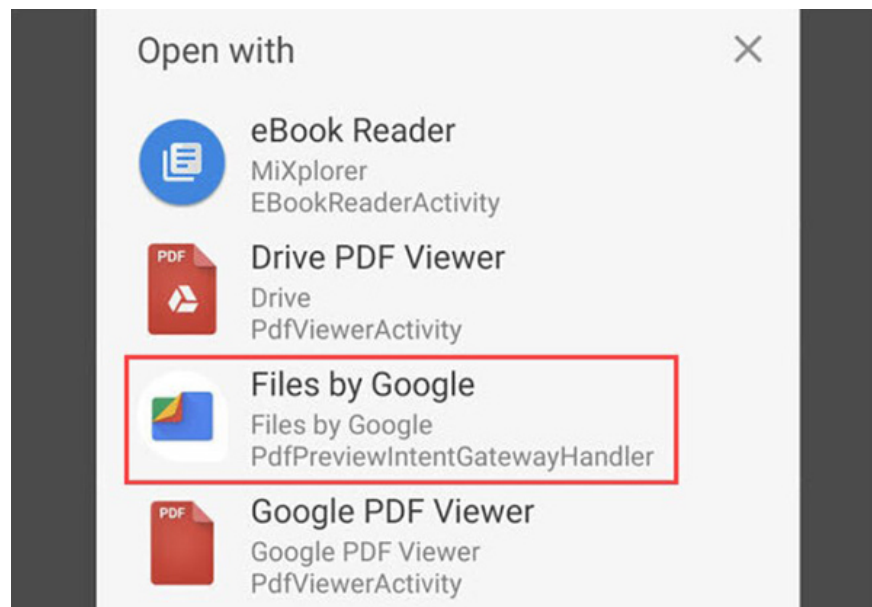
To find out if there is an application that opens PDF files, try each potential application one at a time. Go to the file manager on your Android device and find a PDF file on your device. Any application that can open a PDF file will appear in the drop-down menu.

Select one of the applications and the PDF file will open.

If you don't have an app that can open PDF files, you can choose to download one of the following. You can use **Google PDF Viewer**. This is not a traditional file opening application, so you cannot use it to open files directly. However, it is still listed in the list of applications that can open PDF files.



Also **Files by Google** is another option. This app is a full file manager with PDF file opening built in the tool. After installing this app on the device, it appears as an option every time you intend to open a PDF file.



However, please note that these apps only allow you to view PDF files. If you need a more feature-rich PDF tool, you should install **Adobe Acrobat Reader** for Android or something similar.
