## *How to create more LDPlayer Android emulator windows at the same time*

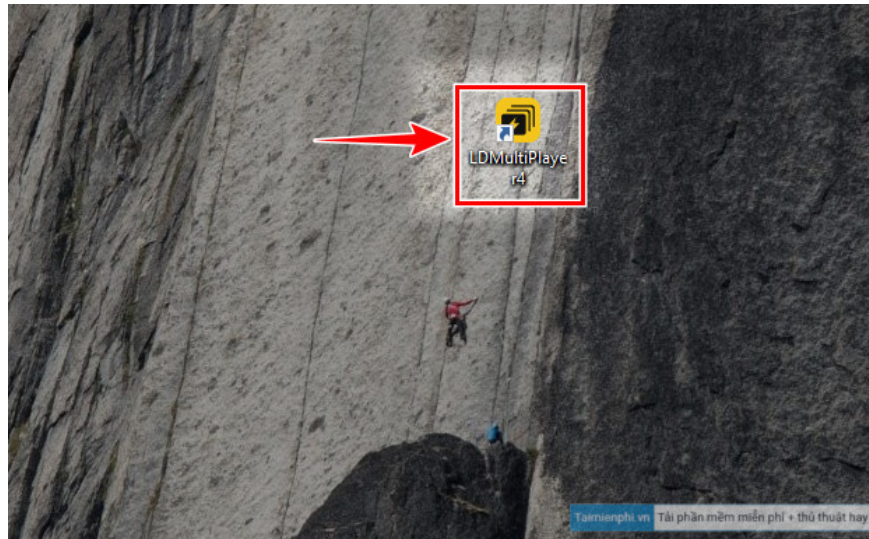
*Step 1: Download and install LDPlayer Android emulator*

- Click directly on the link below, download and **install LDPlayer** on your computer if you don't have it yet.



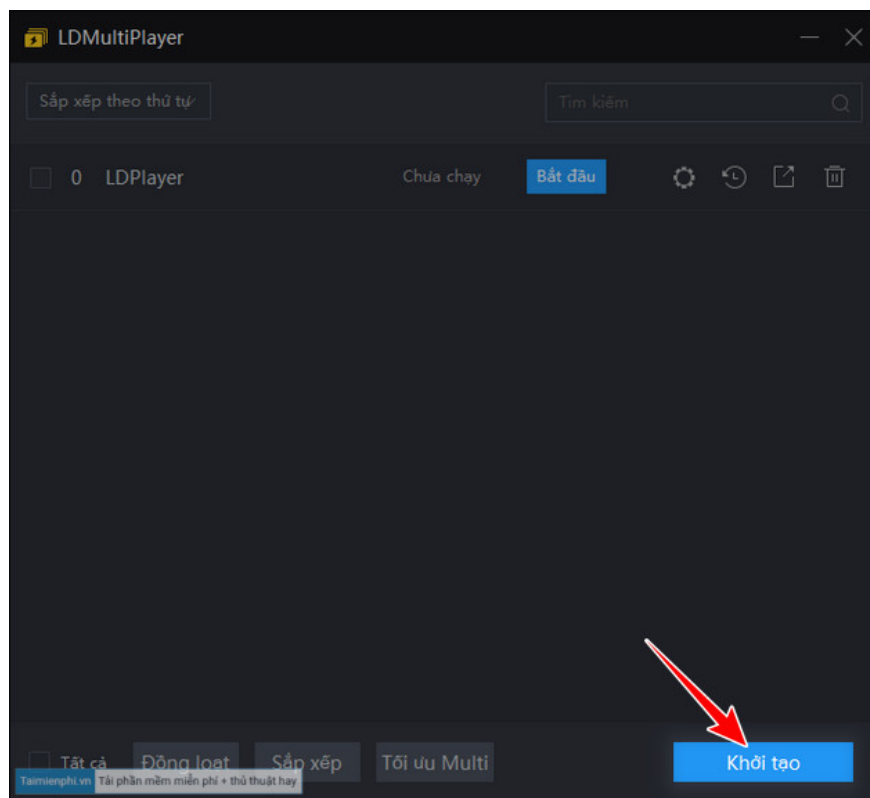
*Step 2: Click on the LDMultiPlayer icon*

- After successfully installing the LDPlayer Android emulator, you will see that in addition to the **LDPlayer** dummy icon , there is also **LDMultiPlayer** , click to open.



## Go to LDMultiPlayer to create multiple LDPlayer emulators

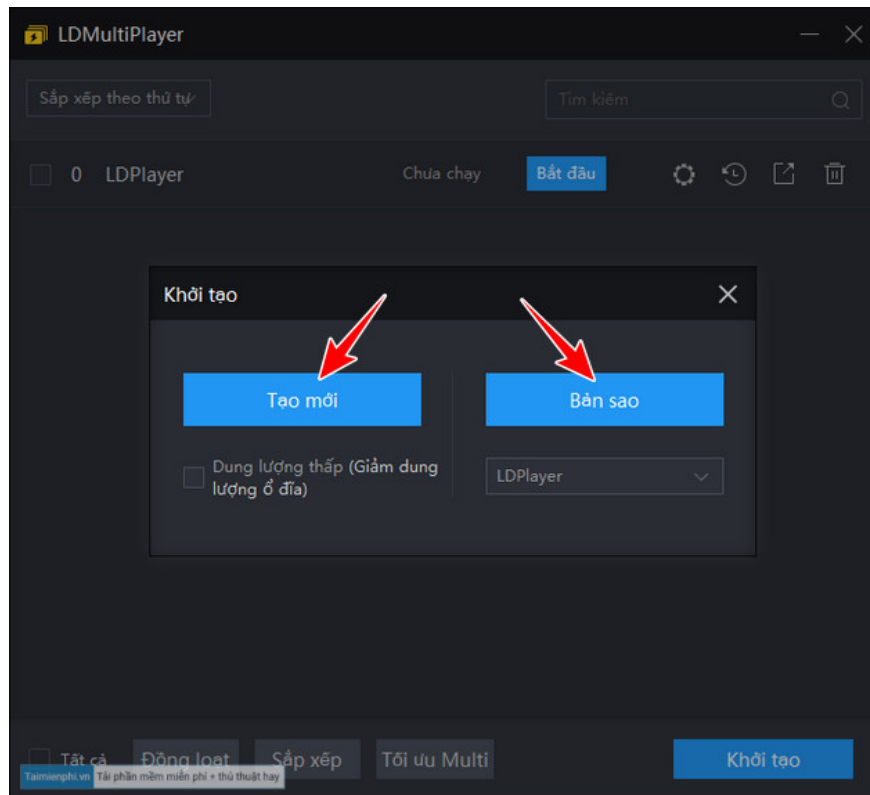
*Step 3: Create more LDPlayer Android emulator - In the LDMultiPlayer window , click **Create** .*



## Create more LDPlayer windows with the Create function

- Choose **the initialization method** you want, you can add as many LDPlayer Android emulator windows as you like, depending on the strong or weak configuration of your computer you can create.
- + **Create New:** Create a completely new LDPlayer emulator, without logging into Google Play or installing any applications.

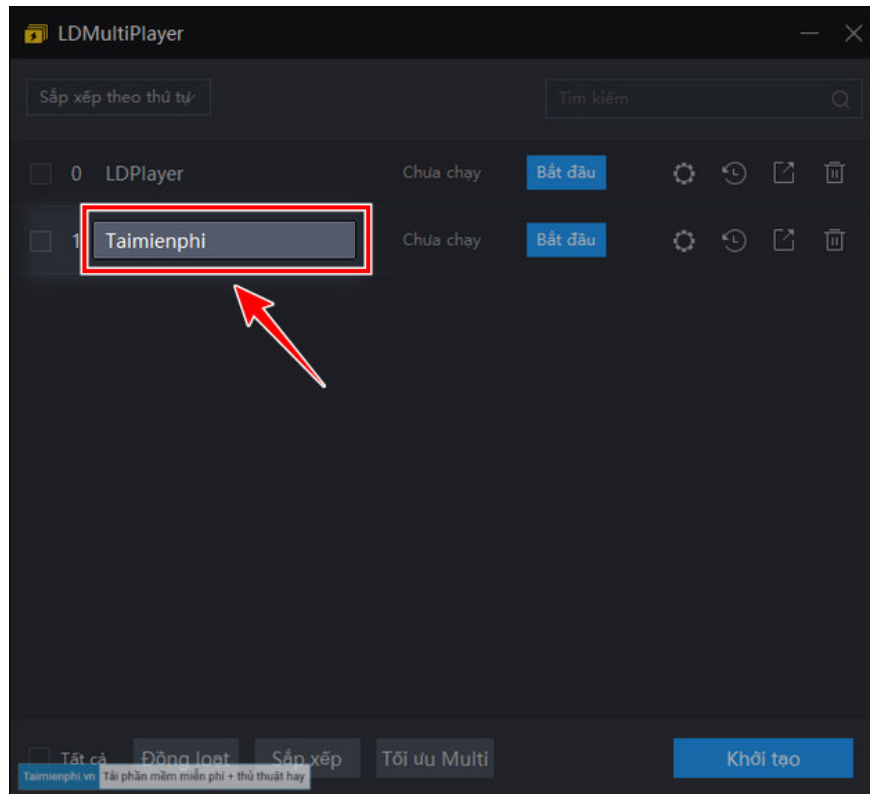
+ **Copy:** Create an additional LDPlayer Android emulator identical to the existing LDPlayer version (available), select the LDPlayer version you want to copy in the window under the word Copy before creating.



## Create a new or Copy of LDPlayer

*Step 4: Rename the LDPlayer Android emulator window*

- Click **directly** on the LDPlayer emulator name you want to change, enter a new name => press **Enter** .



## Give the LDPlayer window a memorable name to easily distinguish it

### *Step 5: Launch multiple LDPlayer Android emulators*

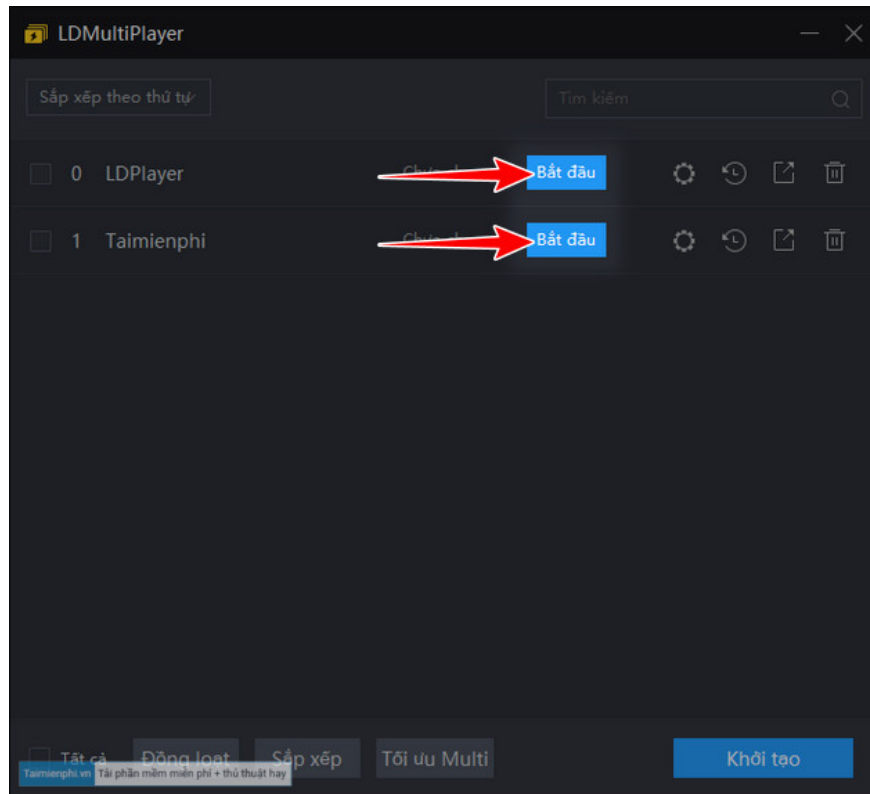
- In case you want to launch multiple LDPlayer Android emulator windows, to play multiple games at the same time, click **Start** .

+ **Gear icon:** Set up LDPlayer Android emulator, adjust the configuration of the corresponding version.

+ **Clock icon:** Copy or restore information and data from existing files.

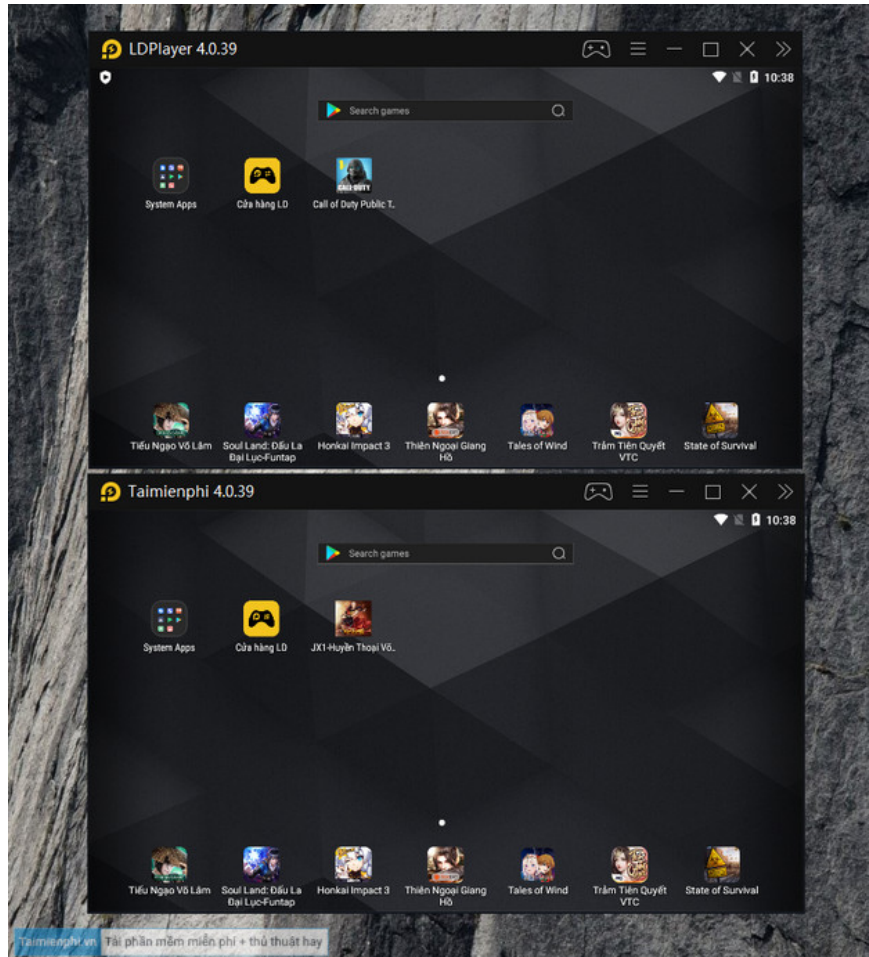
+ **Square icon:** Create Shortcut off the Desktop screen.

+ **Trash icon:** Delete the corresponding LDPlayer Android emulator version.
