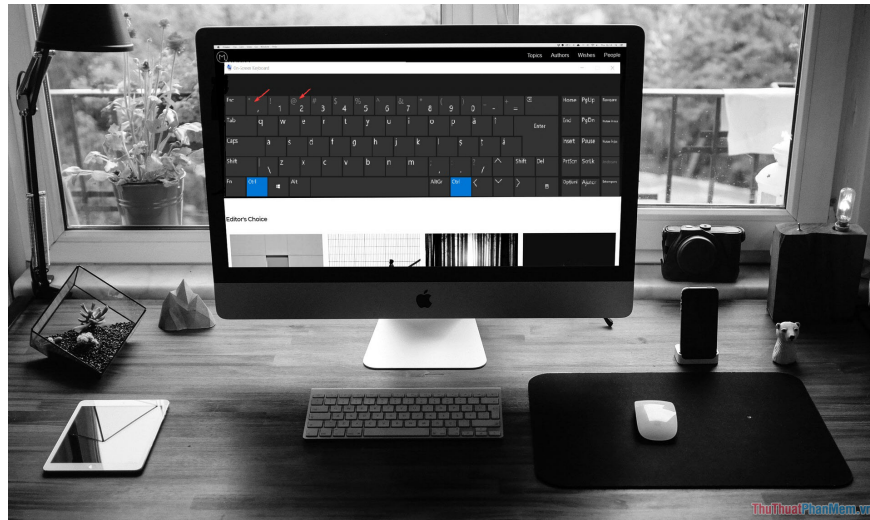

You may not know, entering data from a virtual keyboard instead of a physical keyboard is very effective in terms of security. For computers that are infected with input tracking keylogs, you can only use the virtual keyboard to avoid all tracking by bad guys.

On Laptops, people often use virtual keyboards to replace the physical keyboard they are using for a temporary fix. You can also use the virtual keyboard on MacOS and Windows Laptops to fix temporary keyboard paralysis errors. However, this method is not highly appreciated, in general it is still acceptable.

II. How to open virtual keyboard on Windows Laptop

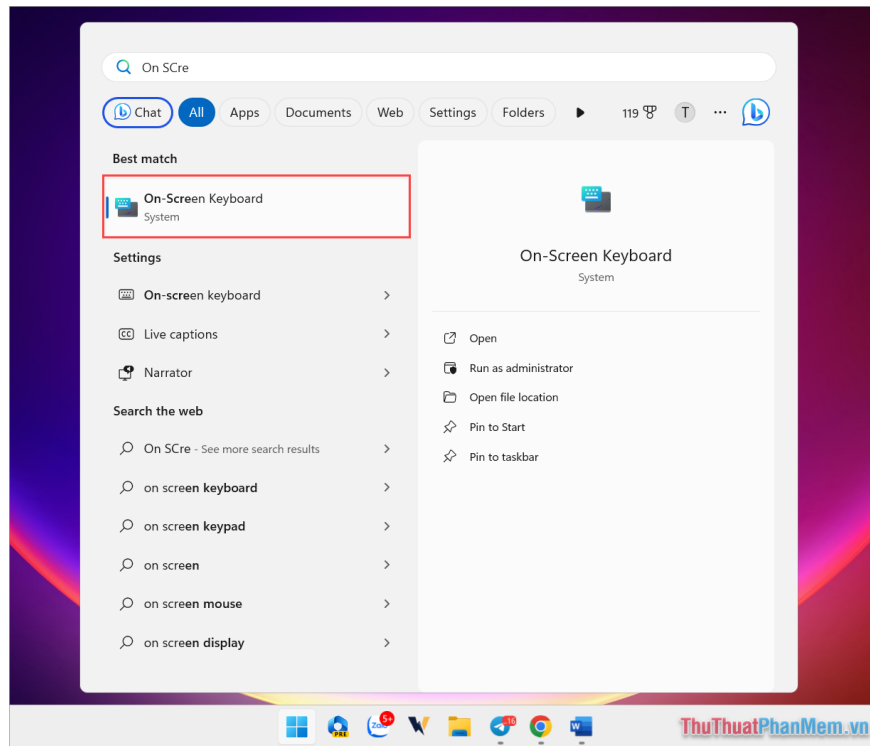

Step 1 : Open **Start Menu** , enter **On-Screen Keyboard** .

Step 2 : Select the On-Screen Keyboard tool to open the virtual keyboard on your Windows computer.

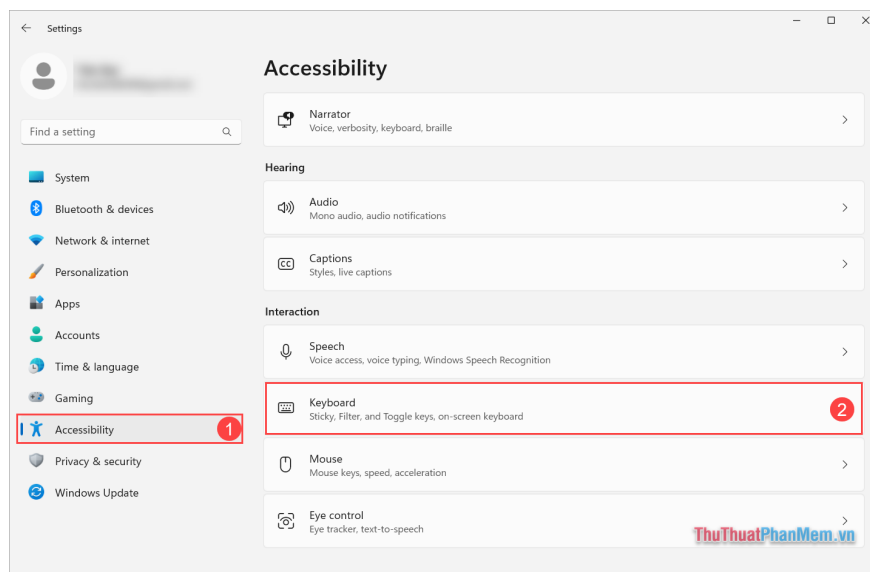


2. How to open the virtual keyboard on Laptop using Settings

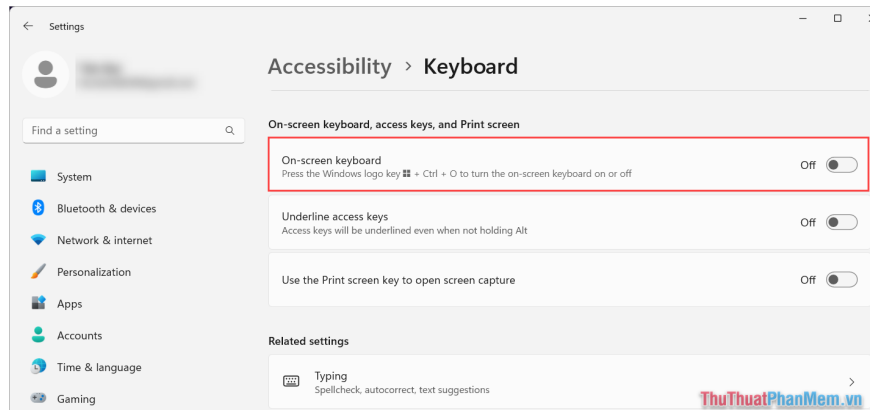
Installing on a Windows computer helps you launch system settings quickly, simply and conveniently. To activate the virtual keyboard on your Laptop, do the following:

Step 1 : Press the **Windows + I** key combination to open **Settings** on your computer.

Step 2 : In **Settings** , select the **Accessibility tab (1) ? Keyboard (2)** .



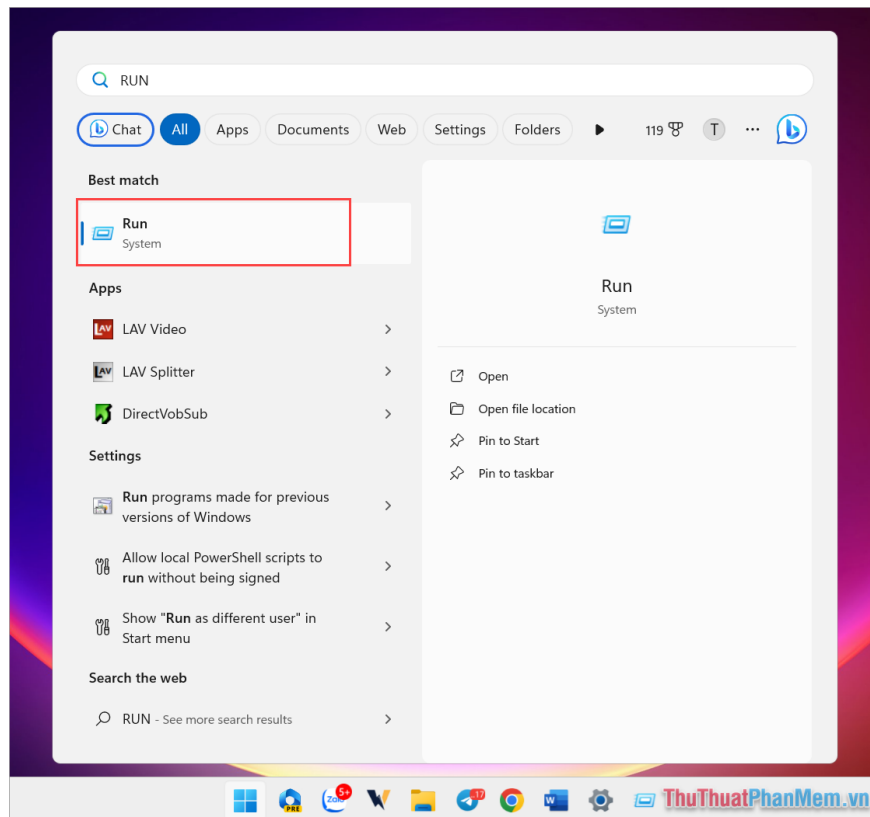
Step 3 : Then, activate the **On-Screen Keyboard** item to start the virtual keyboard on your Windows computer.



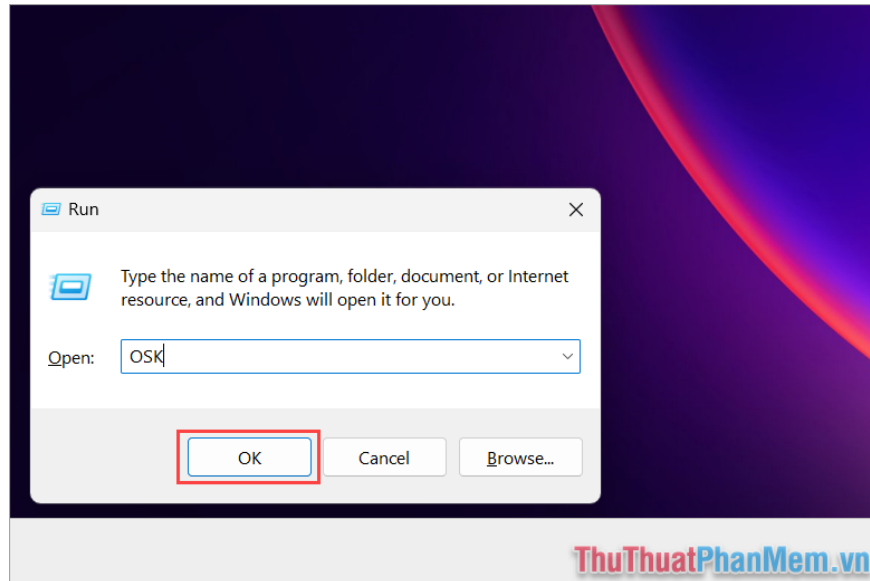
3. How to open the virtual keyboard on Laptop using RUN

The RUN window allows you to quickly open applications and quickly search for built-in tools and features on Windows.

Step 1 : Open **Start** , enter **Run** to open the search window.



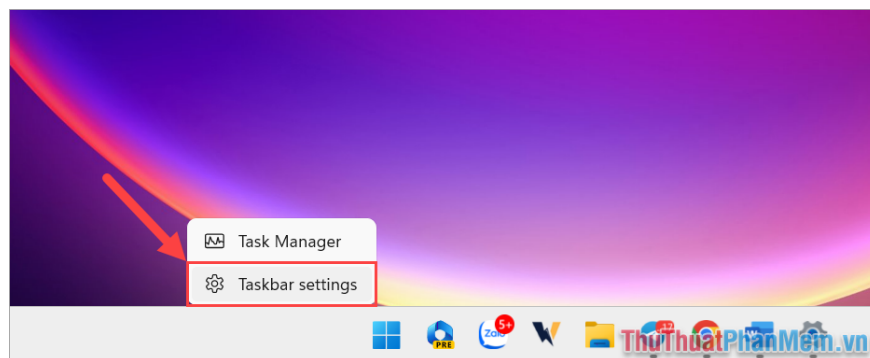
Step 2 : Then, enter **OSK** in the **RUN** window and select **OK** to start the virtual keyboard on your Windows computer.



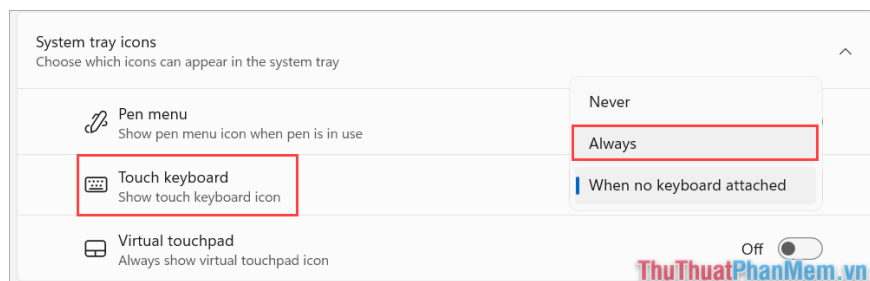
4. How to open the Laptop virtual keyboard on the Taskbar

The Taskbar on your computer also has many hidden features. If you know how to exploit these features, you will definitely discover many new interesting things. To activate the virtual keyboard on the Taskbar, do the following:

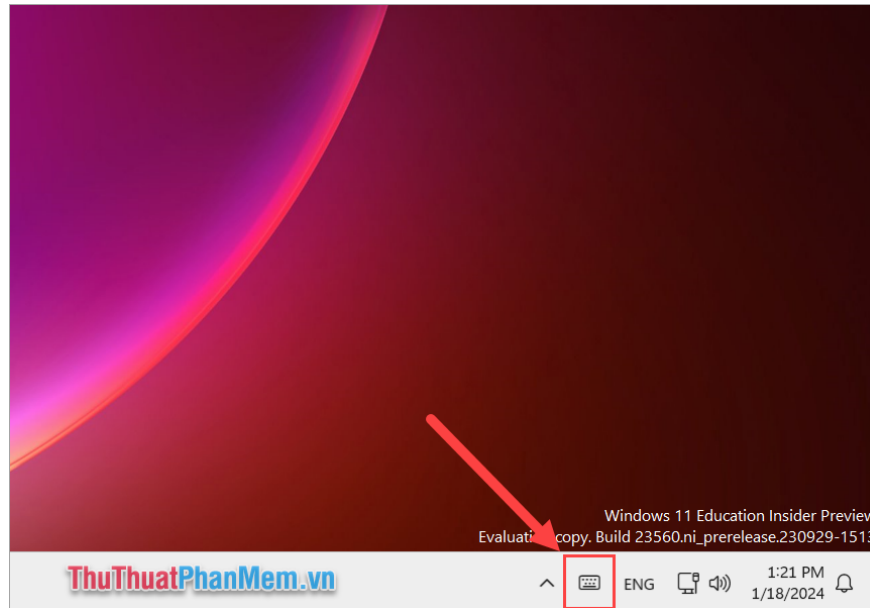
Step 1 : Right-click on the Start icon and select Taskbar Settings .



Step 2 : Then, select Touch keyboard and switch to Always mode .



Step 3 : At this point, a computer keyboard icon will appear on the toolbar. This is the virtual keyboard you can use on Windows. You just need to click on the keyboard icon and the virtual keyboard will appear on the screen.

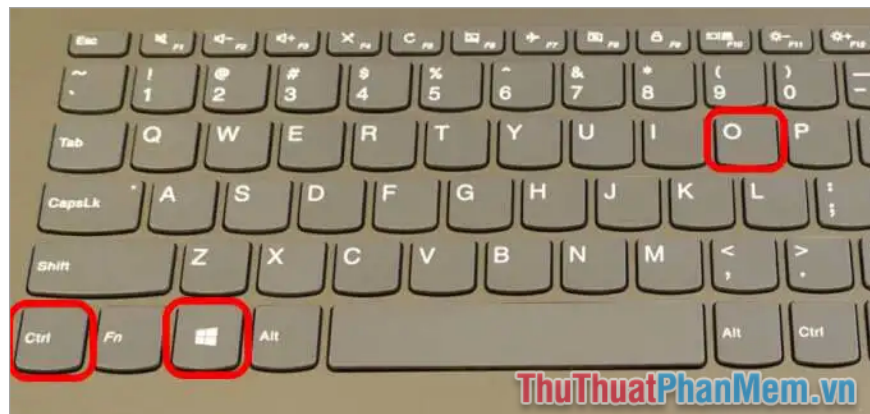


5. How to open the Laptop virtual keyboard with keyboard shortcuts

Shortcut to open virtual keyboard :

Windows + Ctrl + O

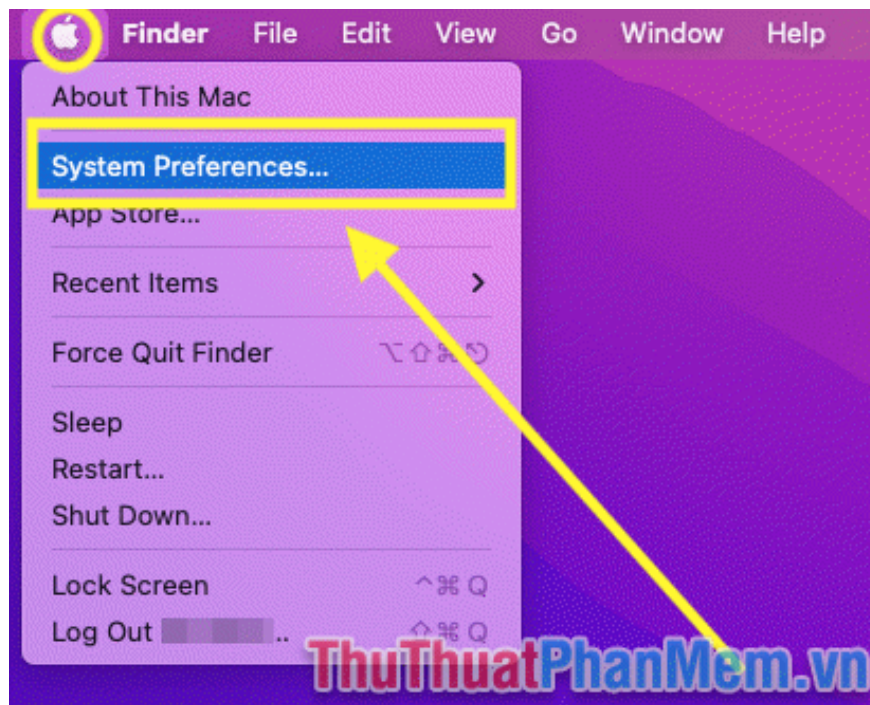


III. How to open virtual keyboard on Macbook Laptop - Mac OS

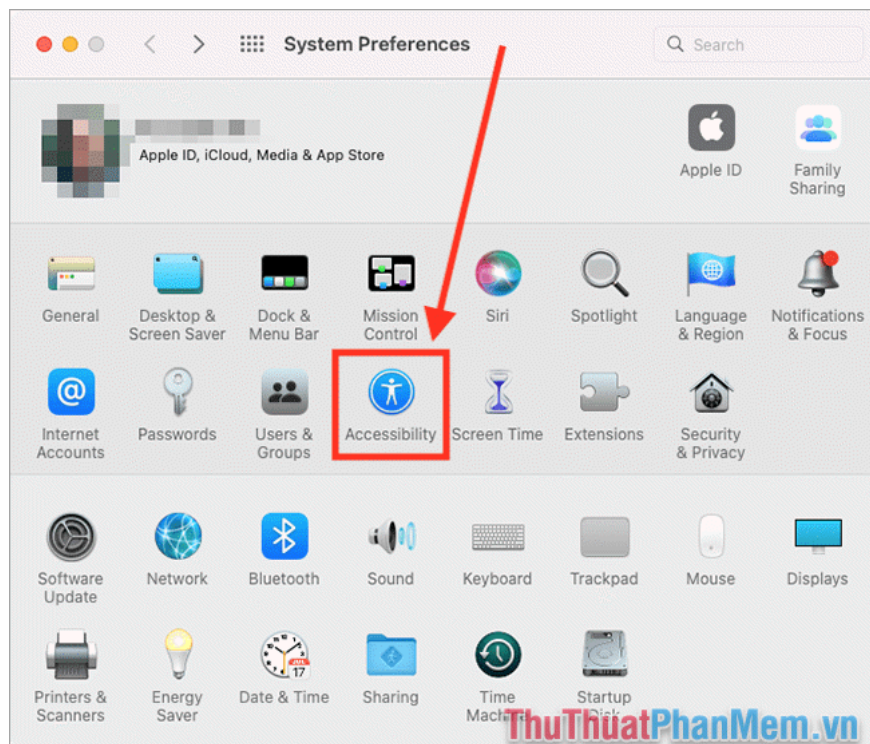

1. How to open the virtual keyboard on Mac OS 12 and below

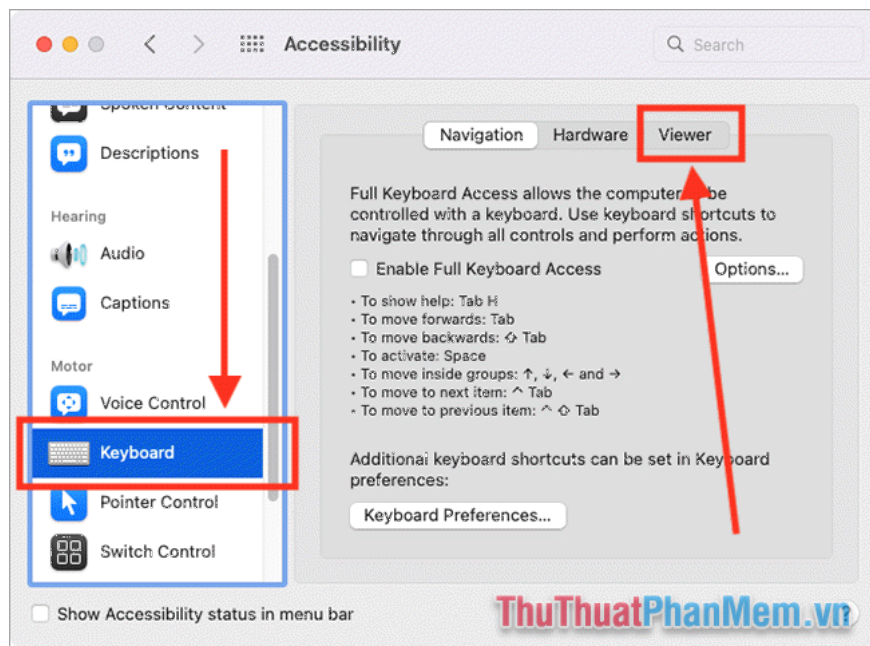
Step 1 : Select the **Apple** icon , select **the System Preferences** tab .



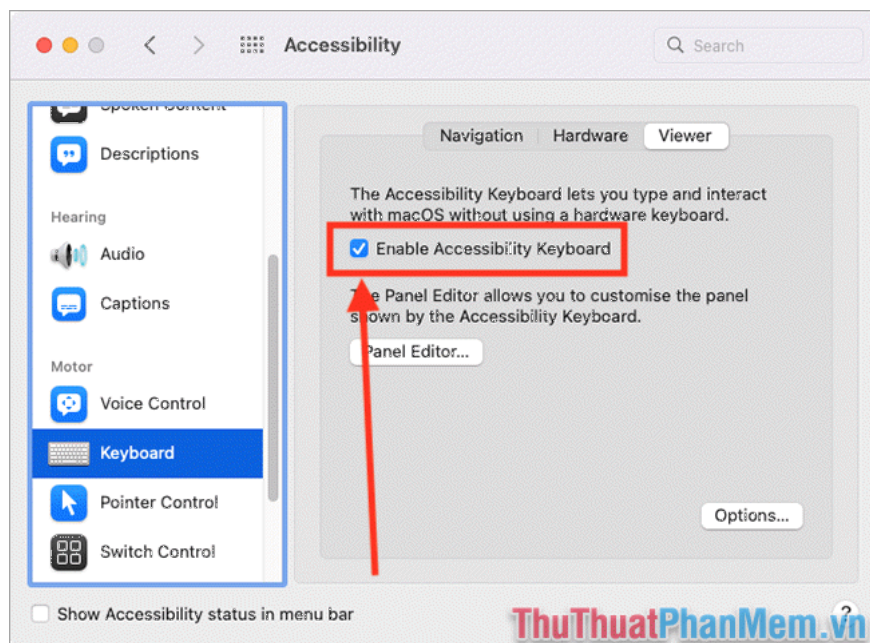
Step 2 : Then, select the **Accessibility** tab to open accessibility on the Macbook.



Step 3 : Next, select the **Keyboard** tab and select **Viewer** to view the built-in keyboard features on the system.



Step 4 : To open the virtual keyboard on Macbook, activate **Enable Accessibility Keyboard** .

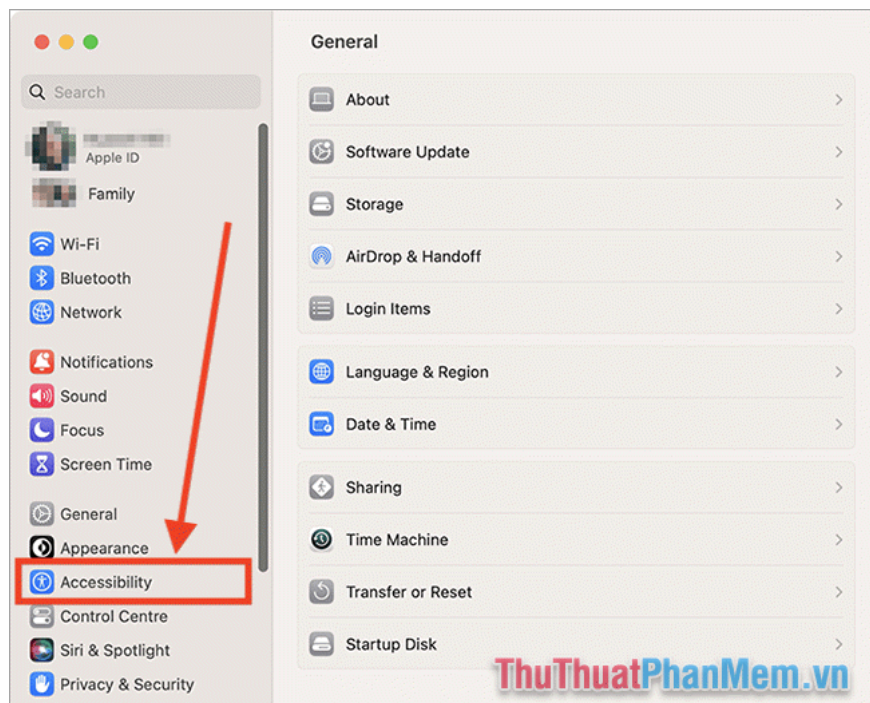


2. How to open the virtual keyboard on Mac OS 13

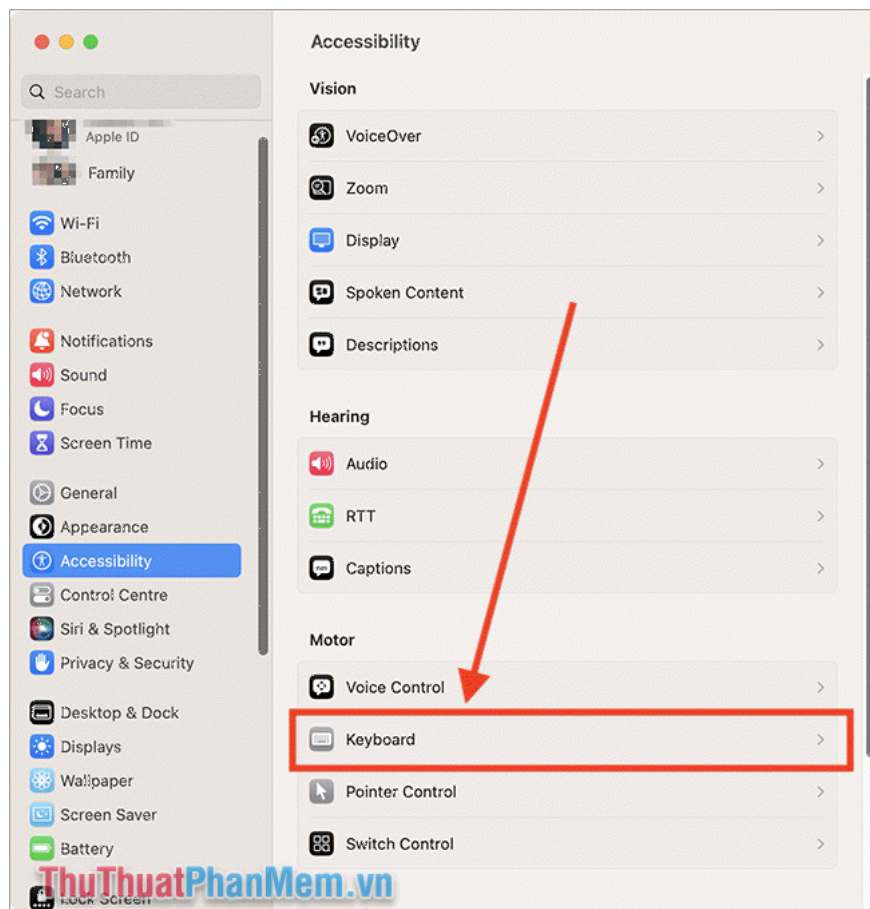
For Mac OS 13 series, the virtual keyboard feature continues to be in the settings. But the interface is different now, so you need to pay attention before turning on the virtual keyboard.

Step 1 : Open **Settings** on your Macbook computer.

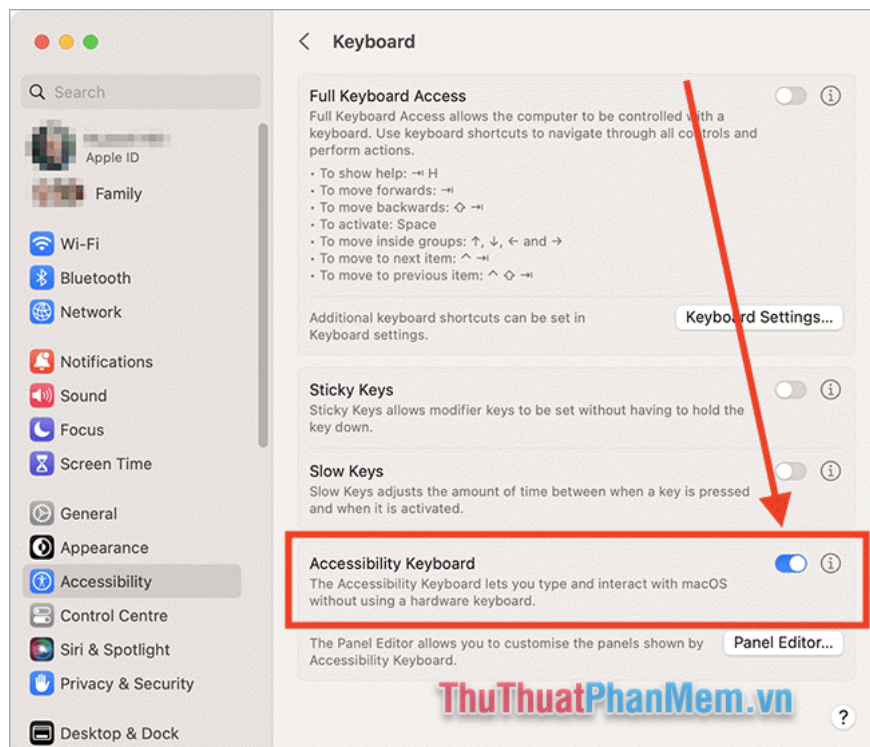
Step 2 : Then, select the **Accessibility** tab .
