

How to optimize the system Windows 10 Creators Update

When installing Windows 10 Creators on low-configuration computers, experiencing new features on this operating system will not be as expected.

Immediately after the release of the official version of Windows 10 Creators from Microsoft, many computers upgraded this new version to experience the updated features, as well as upgrade than before. However, if your computer has a low profile, the installation and use of features on Windows 10 Creators will be a bit difficult.

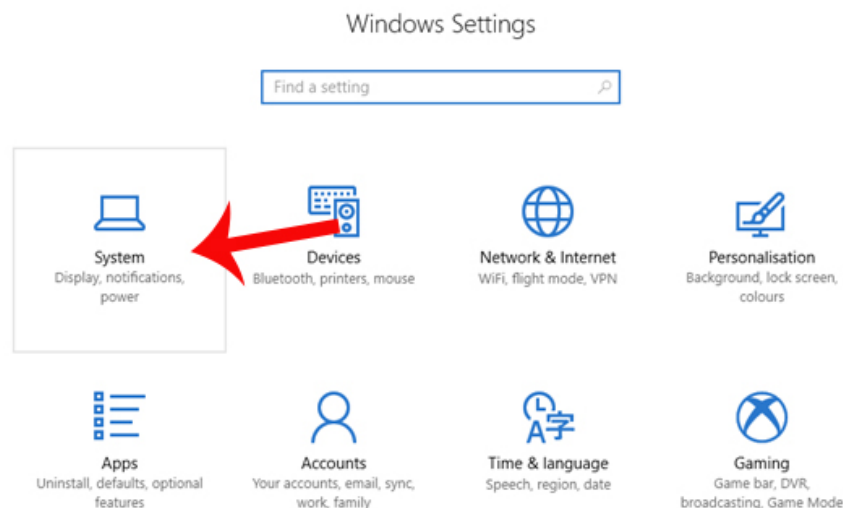
To overcome this situation, users can optimize the operating system on the computer to increase the workability and performance of the computer system when installing Windows 10 Creators.

1. Clean up junk files on Windows 10 Creators:

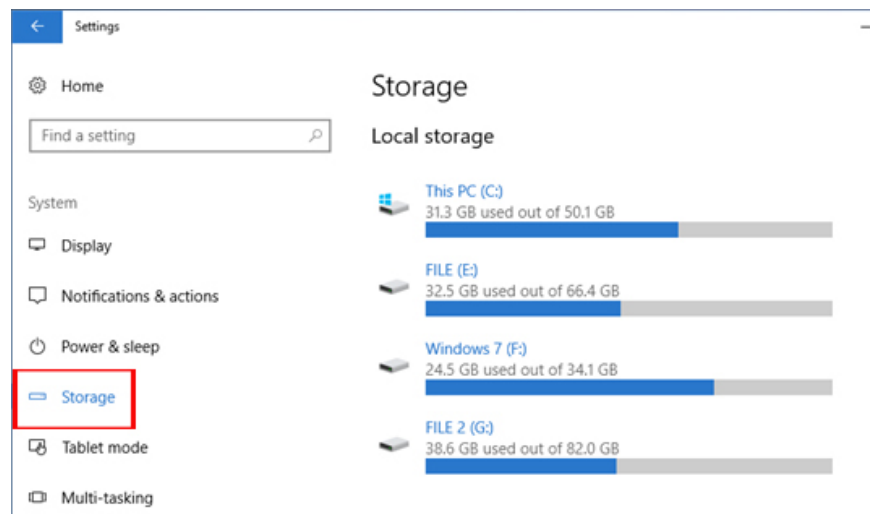
Step 1:

At the interface on the computer, we access **Settings** later, select the **System** setting.



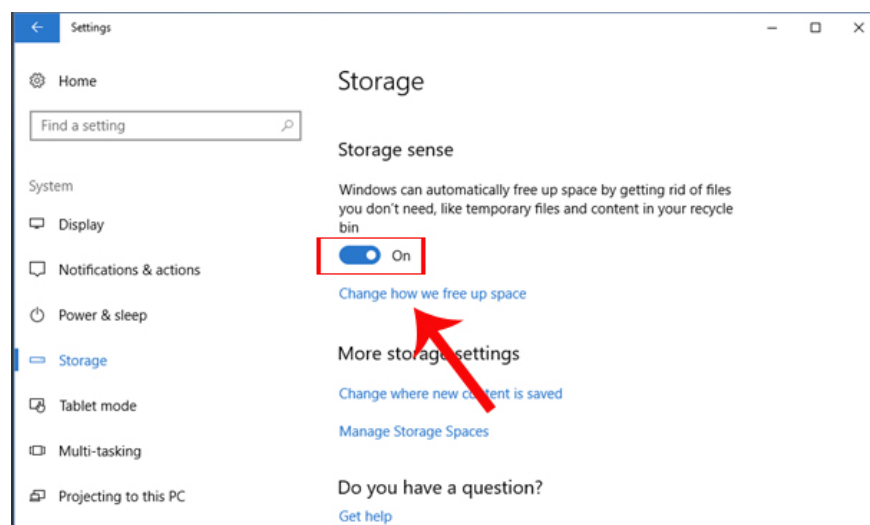
Step 2:

In the System interface in the list to the left of the interface, we find the **Storage** settings section.



Step 3:

In the right content, users find down below and at the **Storage sense** section, switch to **On mode** by swiping the horizontal bar to the right. Continue you click on **Change how we free up space**.

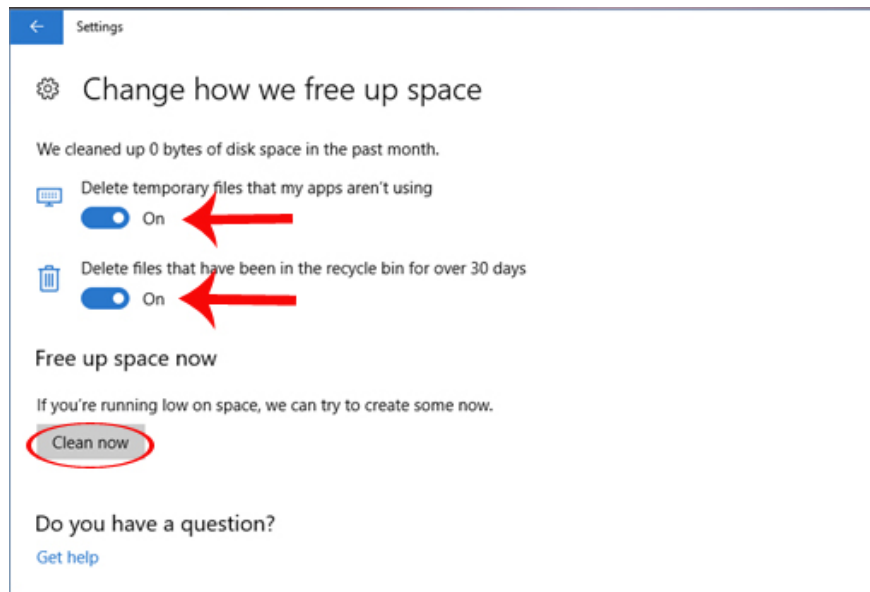


Step 4:

In this new interface we will have 2 options for system compacting including:

1. Delete the temporary files that my apps aren't using: choose to delete all temporary files that are not in demand on the system.
2. Delete files that have been in the recycle bin for over 30 days: choose to delete files that exist in the Recycle bin when it is past 30 days.

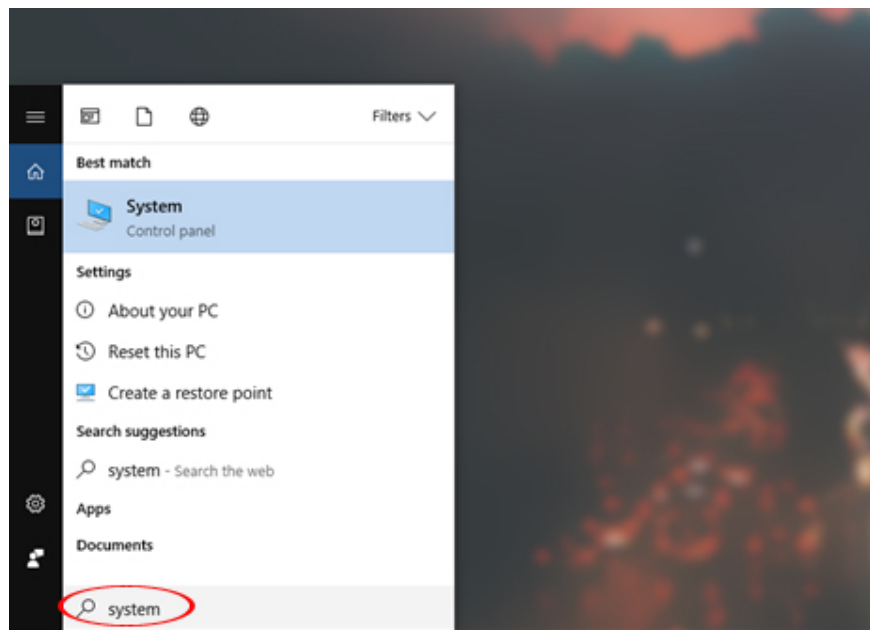
Users will **switch to On mode in both of these options** to clean up files that do not need to be used on the computer. Then click **Clean now** to finish deleting files, cleaning up junk files on your computer.



2. Speed ??up Windows 10 Creators system:

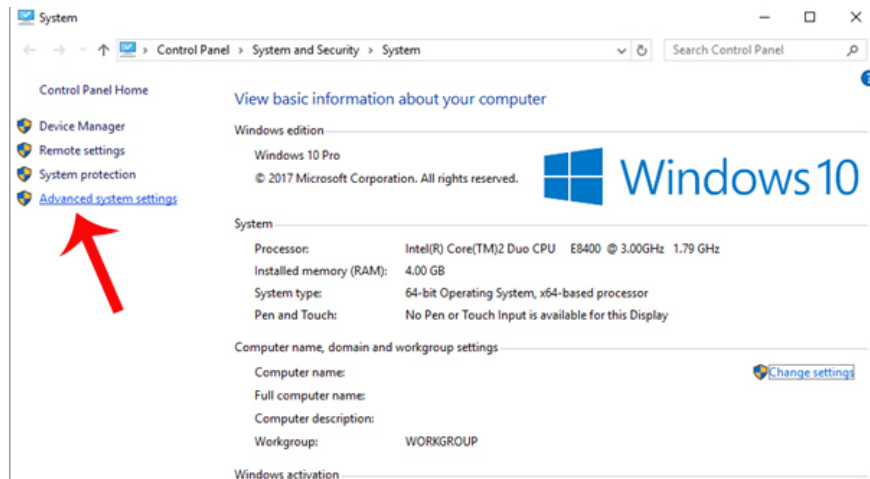
Step 1:

When you enable the Storage Sense feature on Windows 10 Creators, delete junk files to increase the space for the system, users continue to adjust the system speed. At Cortana, enter the **System** keyword and click on the search result.



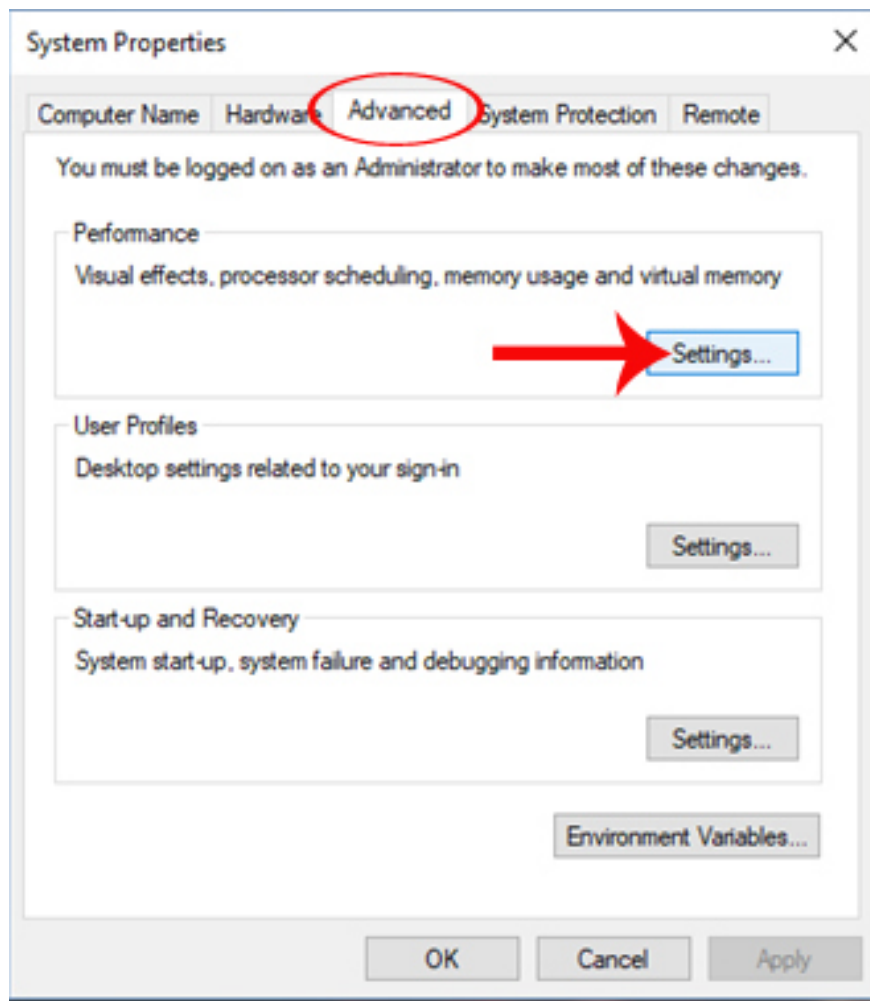
Step 2:

In the system information view, navigate to the **Advanced System Settings option** on the leftmost menu list of the interface.



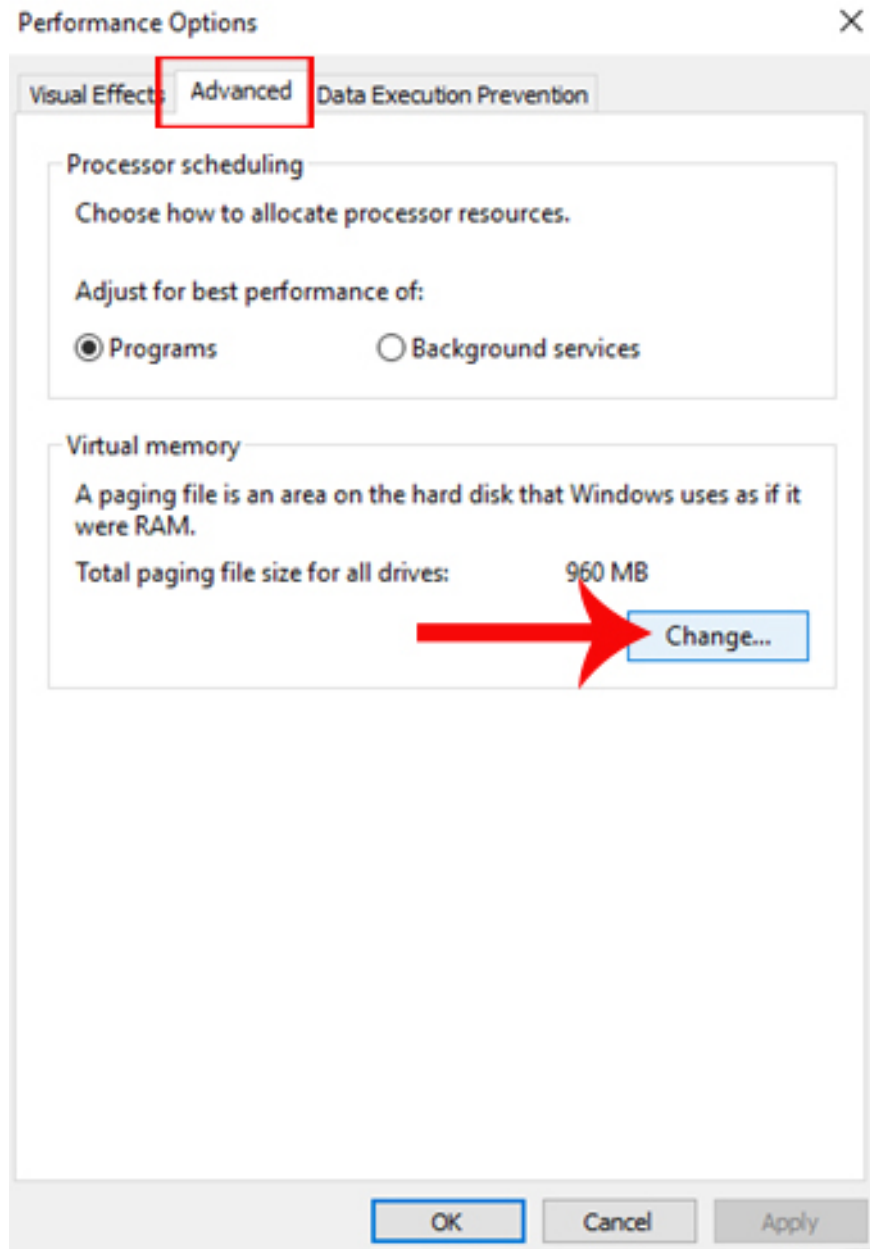
Step 3:

Appears the **System Properties** interface, click on the **Advanced tab** and then click on the **Settings** button below the **Performance** section.



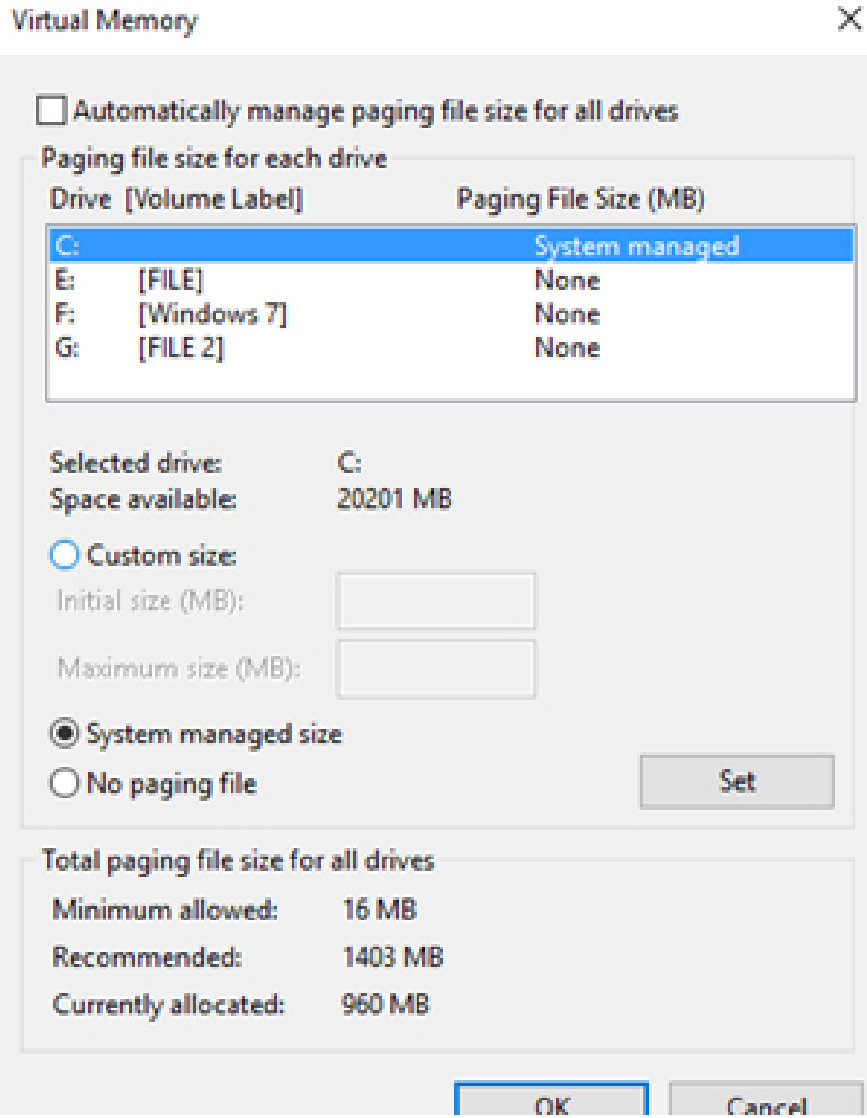
Step 4:

Switch to **Performance Options** interface, we continue to click on **Advanced** button and click on **Change .** in **Virtual memory** section below.



Step 5:

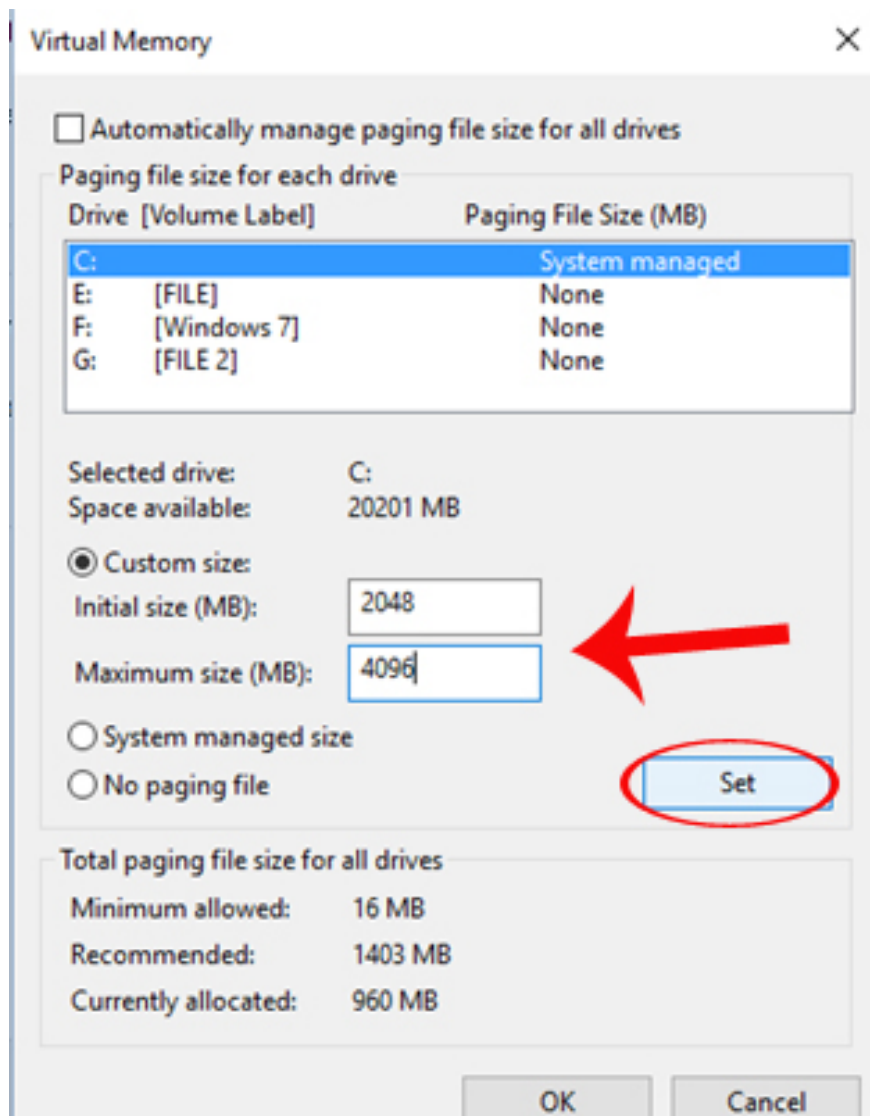
Virtual Memory dialog box, **uncheck the box at Automatically manage paging file size for all drivers** . Then click on **the C drive partition** in the list below and select Custom size.



Step 6:

Here the user will proceed to adjust the capacity in the **Custom size** section. Depending on the current available volume on the computer, we change the values to **Initial size (MB)** and **Maximum size (MB)**. We can enter Initial size of 2048 and Maximum size of 4096.

Finally click the **Set** button below to change the new settings.



As soon as the user has cleaned up the junk files, as well as adjusted the system, the computer will operate more smoothly, remedy the slow running situation in weakly configured computers, when installing the operating system. Windows 10 Creators Update
