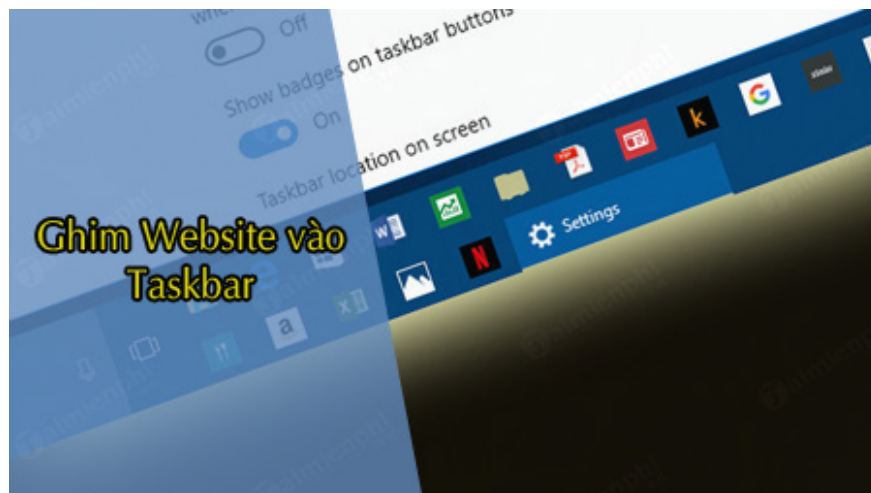


How to pin a website to the taskbar.

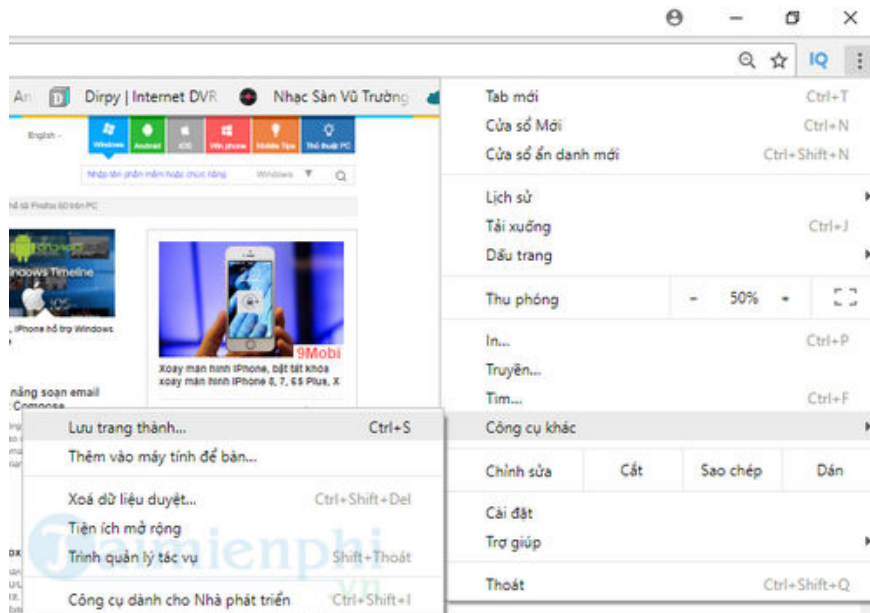

How to pin a website to the taskbar, Pin a website from Google Chrome

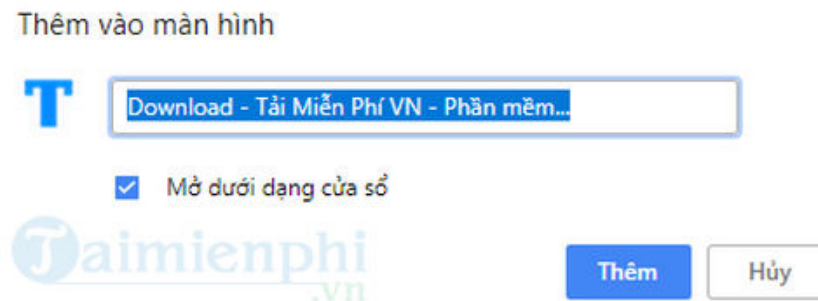
Follow the steps below to pin a website to the taskbar (Pin Web) from Google Chrome:

Step 1 : Open the Chrome browser on your computer, then access the website you want to pin to the Taskbar or Start Menu. For example, in this guide, we'll pin the TipsMake website.

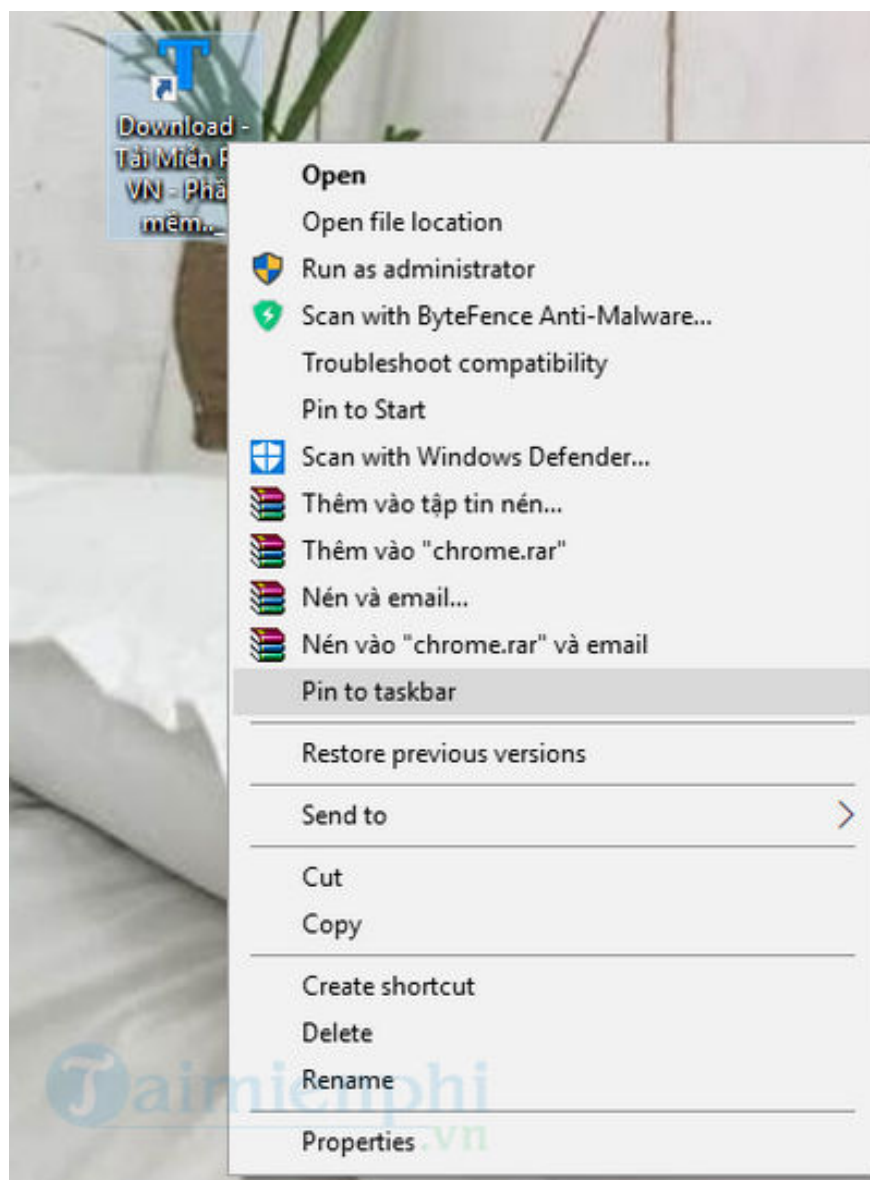
Step 2: Next, click the three-dot icon in the upper right corner of the screen, scroll down to "**More tools**" from the menu, and select "**Add to desktop**".



Step 3: A popup window containing the website name will appear on the screen. Click " **Add**" here . This will create a website shortcut on your desktop.



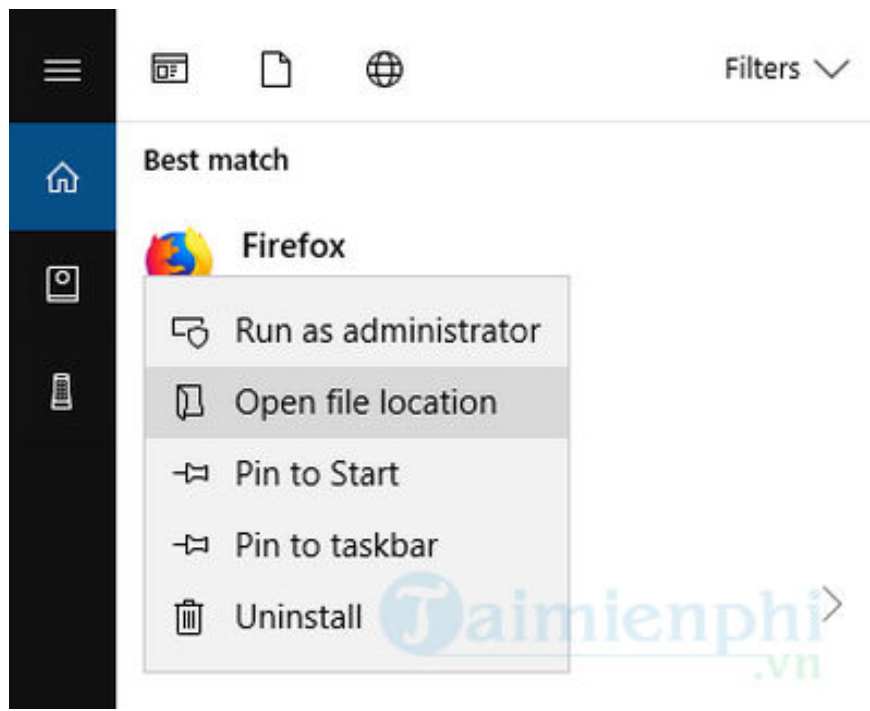
Step 4: Right-click on the website shortcut on the desktop and select "**Pin to Start**" or "**Pin to taskbar**" to pin the website to the taskbar, pin the website, or pin the website to the Start menu.



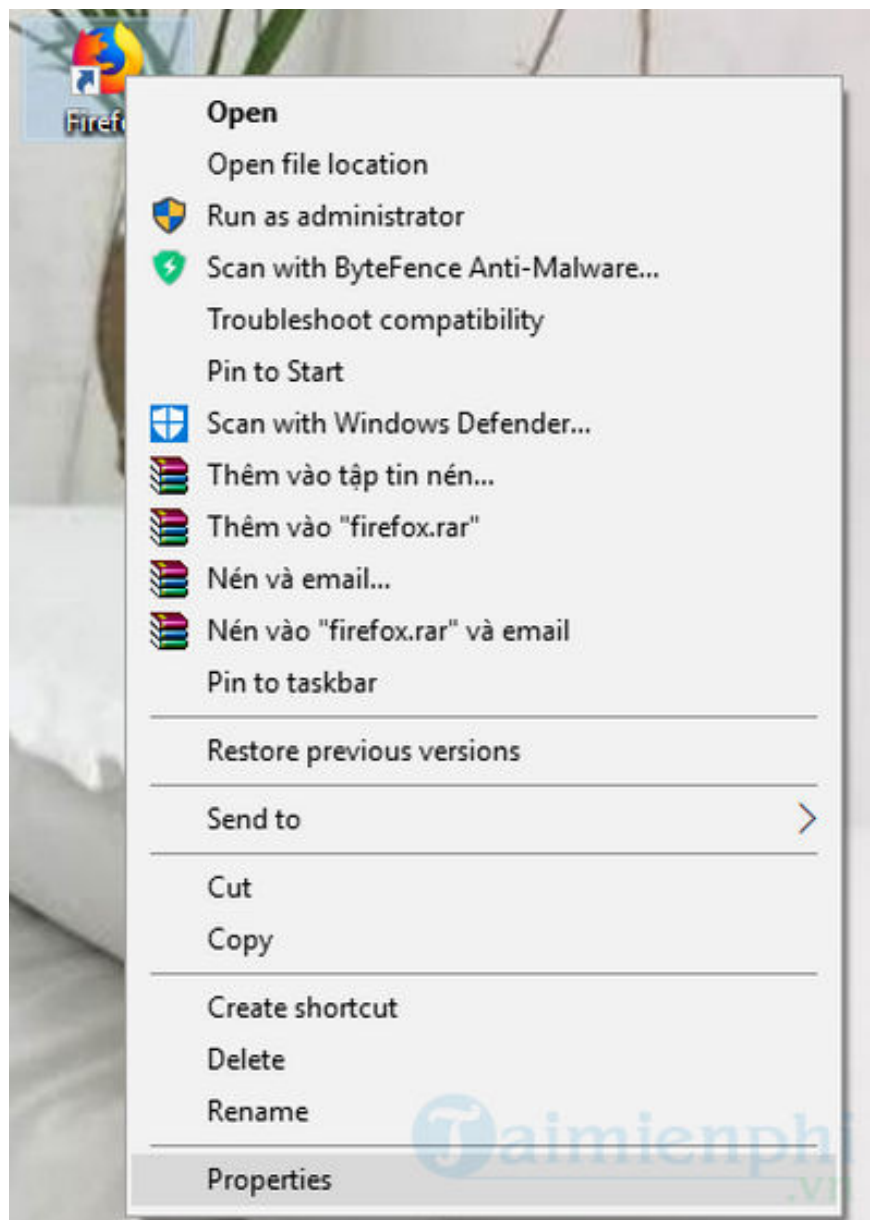
How to pin a website to the taskbar, Pin a website from Firefox

Unfortunately, Firefox doesn't have a built-in solution or option to pin website shortcuts to the taskbar like Chrome does. However, you can follow the steps below to pin a website to the taskbar from Firefox:

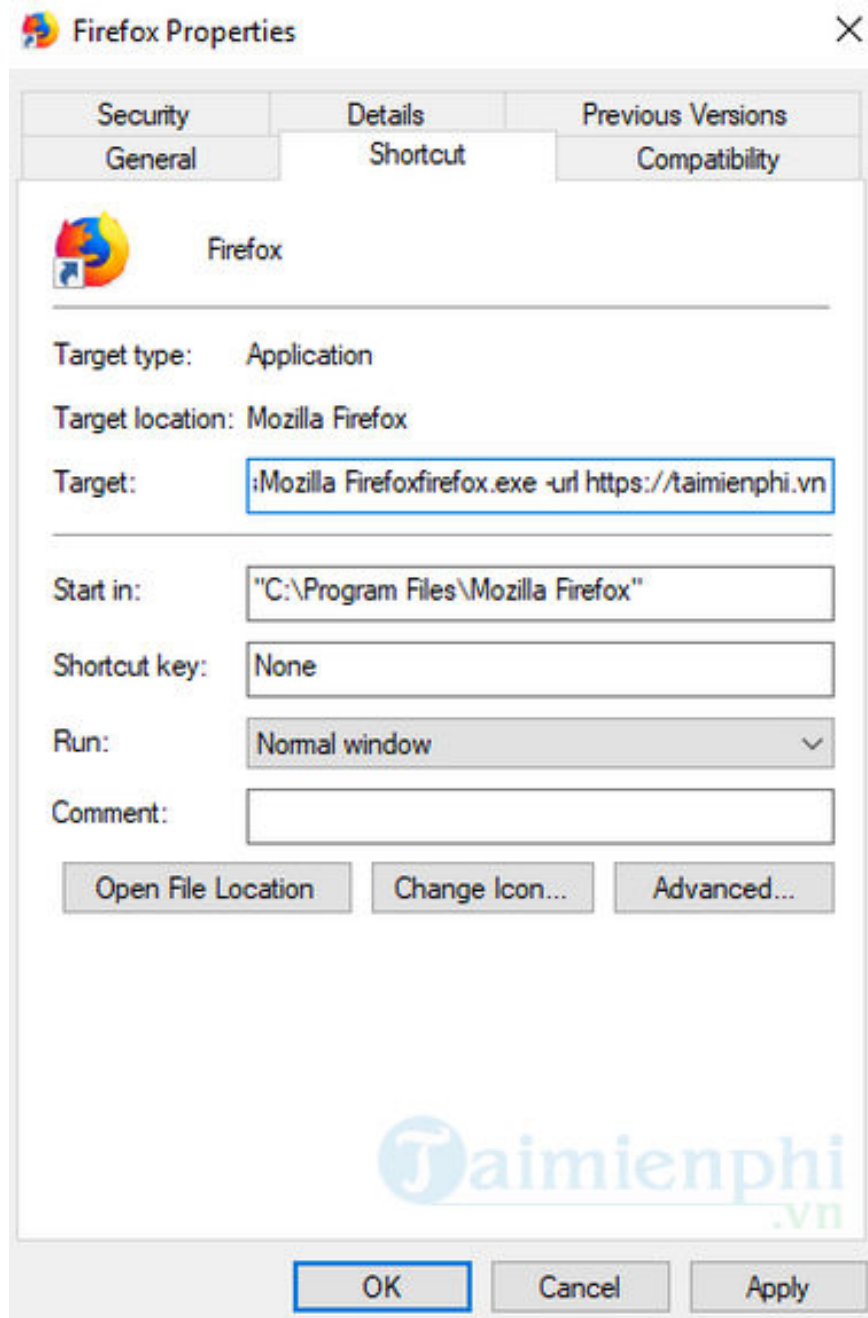
Step 1: Create a new Firefox shortcut. To do this, type "**Firefox**" into the Windows search bar. In the search results, find and right-click on Firefox, then select "**Open file location**". Next, click and drag the Firefox shortcut to your desktop, or copy and paste it there.



Step 2: Right-click on the new shortcut and select **Properties** .



Step 3: In the Properties window, in **the Target field** , add " **-url** " before the URL of the website you want to pin to the Taskbar. For example, " **C:Program FilesMozilla Firefoxfirefox.exe** " **-url** <https://taimienphi.vn/> " .



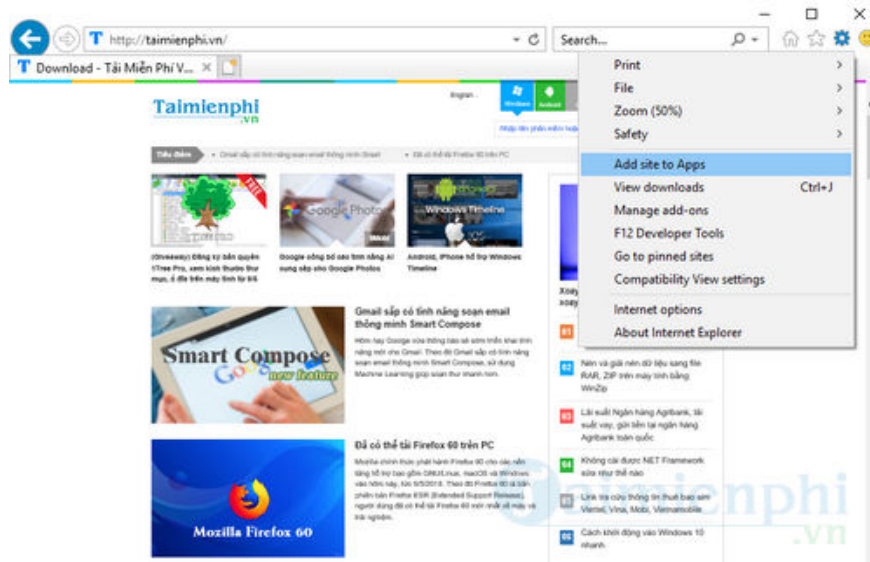
Step 4: Click **OK** , then right-click on the shortcut and select **Pin to taskbar** .

How to pin a website to the taskbar, pin a website from Internet Explorer.

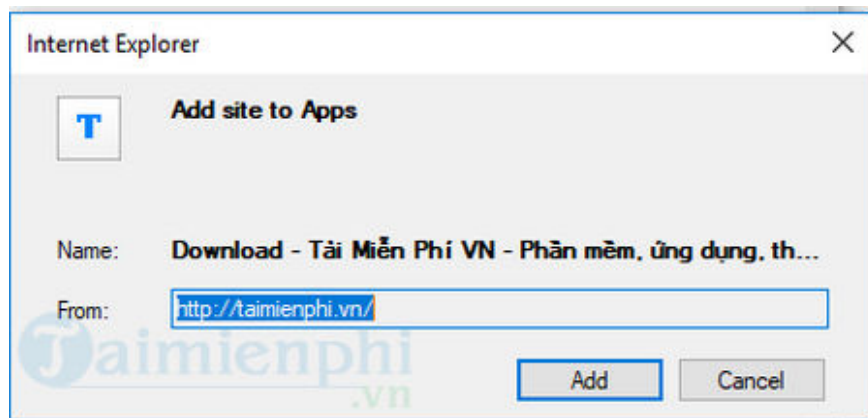
For security reasons, TipsMake recommends against using Internet Explorer; instead, you have many better alternatives. However, if you want to pin a website to the taskbar from Internet Explorer, follow the steps below:

Step 1 : Open Internet Explorer, then access any website you want to pin to the Taskbar.

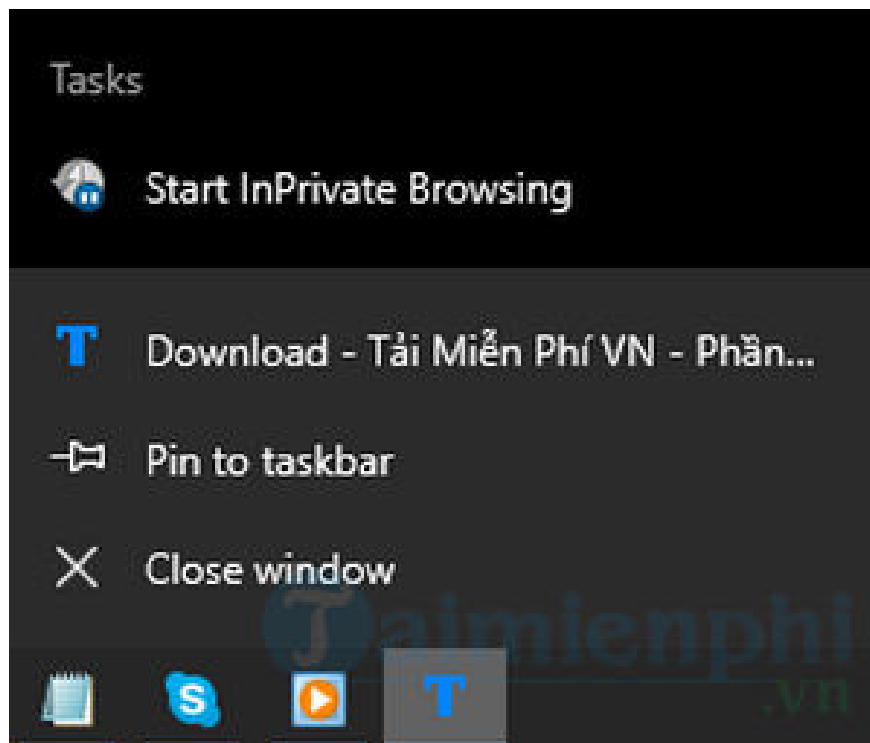
Step 2: Next, click on the Tools icon (gear icon) located in the upper right corner of the screen as shown below, then select **Add site to Apps** .



Step 3: A dialog box containing the website name and URL will appear on the screen. Your task is to click "**Add**".



Step 4 : The website logo will appear on the Taskbar. Right-click on the logo and select "**Pin this program to taskbar**" to pin the website to the Taskbar.



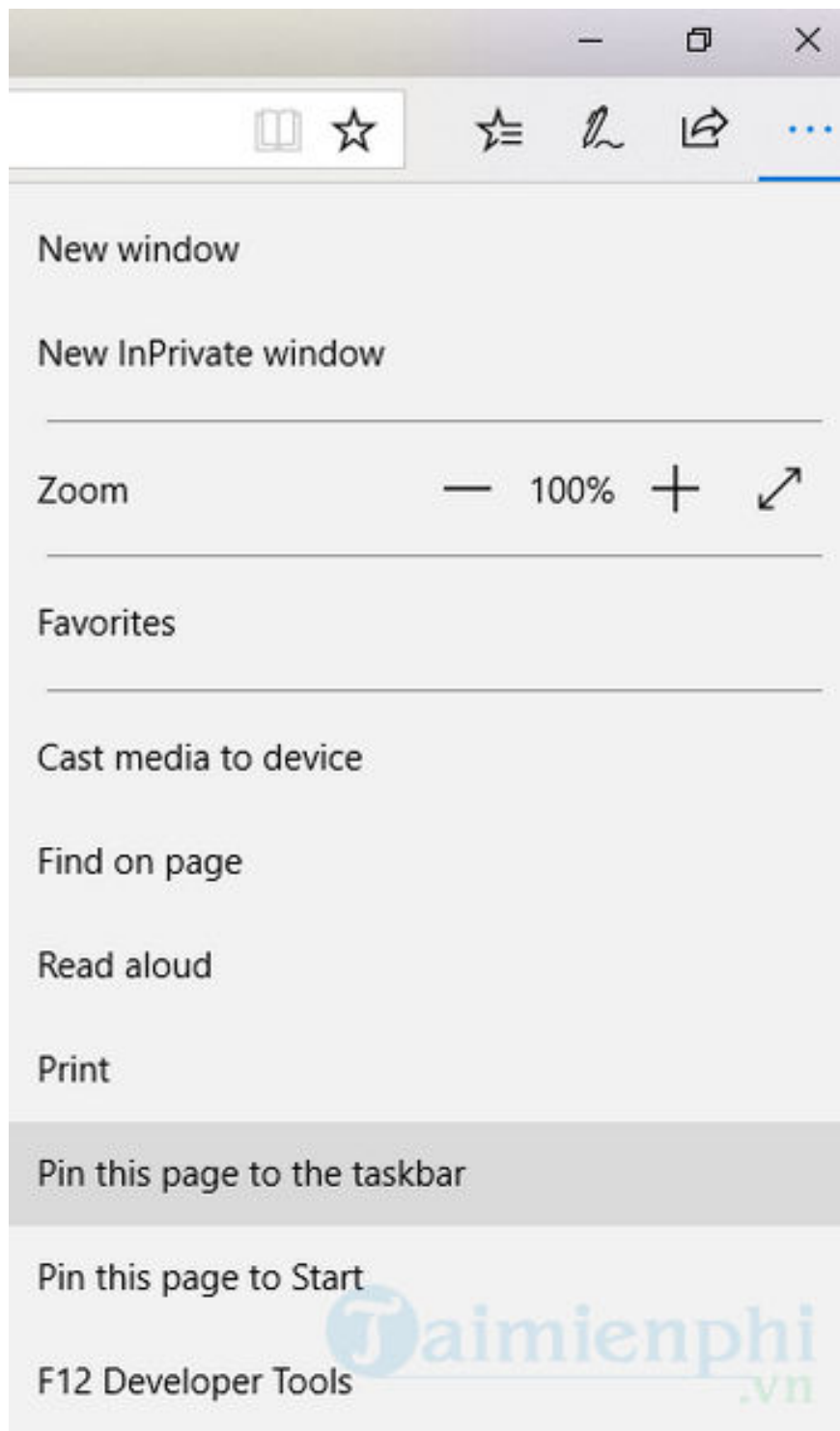
How to pin a website to the taskbar, pin a website from the Edge browser.

Pinning websites to the taskbar from the Edge browser is much simpler than in other browsers. Follow the steps below:

Step 1: Open the Microsoft Edge browser on your computer and access the website you want to pin to the Taskbar.

Step 2 : Click on the three-dot icon located in the upper right corner of the screen.

Step 3: Scroll down, find, and click on "**Pin this page to Taskbar**".



If you want to pin a website to the Start Menu, find and click the "Pin to Start" option .

By pinning a website to the taskbar, you can easily access your website quickly and easily, instead of having to open bookmarks, search, and open it, which is both time-consuming and prone to errors.
