How to run DVD on Windows 10 with pre-installed software

If you buy a computer with an integrated DVD player, it may come with its own DVD player software. Because Windows 8.1 and Windows 10 do not support DVD playback, computer manufacturers will add support software before packaging the product.

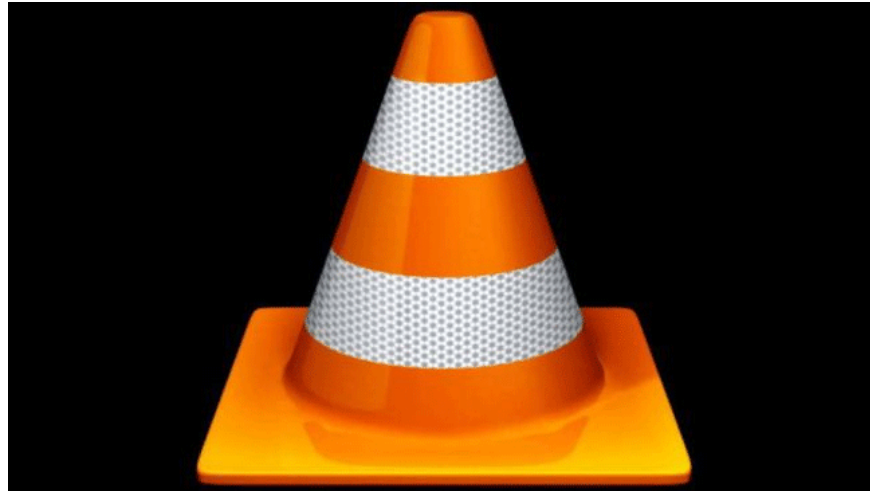
First you need to find the integrated DVD player software. If you have a computer manual, you can find instructions for playing the DVD in it or search the manufacturer's website to see the DVD player / media software they have installed.

Another way to find software is to open the Windows search bar and type **movies** or **DVDs** . Or if you're lucky enough to put the DVD in your computer's drive, the software will start automatically.

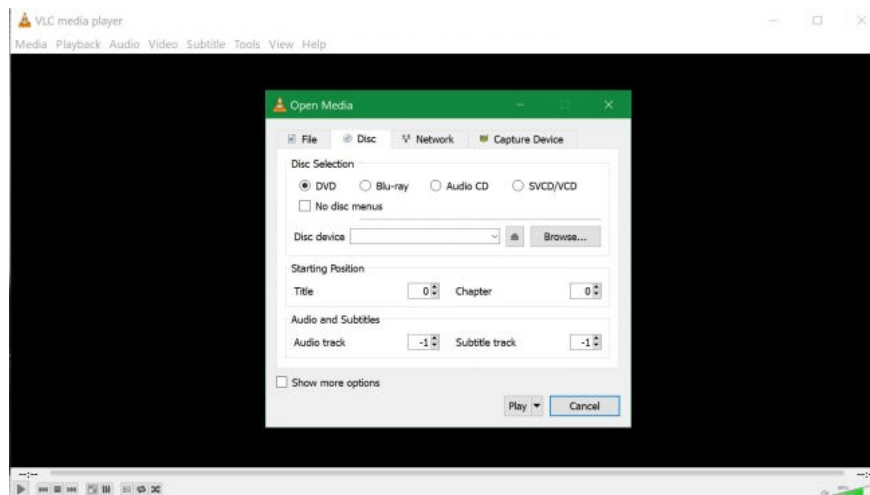
Once you have identified the pre-installed software you can easily play DVDs.

How to play DVD in Windows 10 with free software

If you are using an external DVD drive or cannot find any pre-installed software to play DVDs on your computer, you can use the software for free. VLC Media Player is one of the best free video playback software and it also supports DVD playback. You can also try the software that came with the external DVD drive if available.



To play DVD first launch VLC, then insert DVD into computer, it can run automatically. However, in case of not playing automatically, follow these steps:



Step 1 . Select **Media> Open Disc** or press **Ctrl + D**

Step 2 . In the pop-up window, in the **Disc Selection** section, select **DVD** and press **Play** at the end.

If VLC cannot locate the DVD, you need to specify the location of the drive by clicking in the **Disc Selection** section of the menu that appears and selecting the DVD drive from the drive option on the left of the File Explorer window.
