The game is very simple, but there is something addictive here like discovering these cats like toys or stumble upon a new cat playing in your yard when opening the game, etc. . there are many attractions from this Neko Atsume game.

If you are a newcomer to Neko Atsume, or are trying to get the latest cat or a last Momento (thanksgiving gift), hopefully this article will bring you useful instructions.

## Expanding yard ASAP



When first playing Neko Atsume, the player was only offered five spots. It is important to unlock the yard so that it can be increased to 10 because more and more places have more places to place toys to attract more cats.

To earn 180 goldfish, players need to expand the garden with as many toys as 'producing' gold as possible. There is no official list of toys that bring the most gold, but here is a list of cheap toys that tend to bring higher profits of silver and gold, depending on the type of cat (500 silverfish). can be exchanged for 10 gold):

1. Zebra Grass Gadget (90 silver fish)
2. Green Cushion (100 fish gamblers)
3. YellowCushion (100 fish gamblers)
4. Thick Cooling pad (130 silver fish)
5. Nature Tent (170 silver fish)

Try to buy these items soon to quickly create as much gold as possible. Different types of cats like different dishes, players should take pictures of them to find out their favorite and each Catbook will look better when each cat has a avatar.

Don't waste gold on expensive food, especially when you first start playing. Frisky Bits cost 30 silver fish for a three-pack bag, creating more gold over time. Players should use Frisky Bits and add to the food plate every six hours.

Once you start focusing on collecting rare cats, players can experiment with other foods, but rare cats are not 'picky people', so don't waste expensive meals. on them. It is sometimes just a way to entice them faster, but not necessarily.

## Innovation is the key to success



Expanding the yard is only a part of the game, players need to upgrade and re-decorate their yard. Different landscapes and decorations seem to attract even more cats. Many users say Zen Garden is the most lucrative way to attract cats to every part of the yard and should only put 140 goldfish on the Zen Garden.

The nature of cats is also very curious, so players should prepare a few layouts in the yard. Wait until there are no cats in the yard before setting up the layout change. Otherwise, all the cats in the yard will disappear and receive only a silver fish from each of them. The first refurbishment costs only 140 goldfish, but after that, the remodeling amounted to 280, so choose wisely.

**Note :** To refurbish the pitch, go to **Menu> Other> Remodel.**

## Maximize space



When the treasury has grown with lots of silver and gold fish, be sure to have some Goodies that can contain many cats. For example, Cat Metropolis can hold up to six cats across two spaces (large objects occupy two spaces in the yard). Stump House and all Cube can contain two cats in one place. More cats mean more gifts.

## Find rare cats



After setting up the field, players can start using gold and silver fish for objects that attract rare cats. You will quickly notice that the first two cats are ready and visit your yard.

Here is a list of some items (but not all) that every rare cat likes:

1. Peaches - Cat Metropolis
2. Apricot - Green Cushion
3. Toy Capsule Ganache
4. Macchiato - Mister Dragonfly

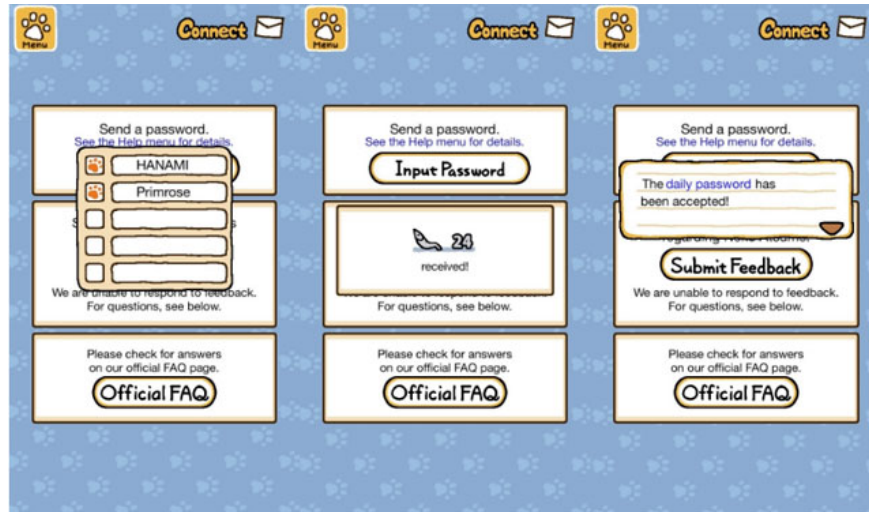

All near and rare cats like Frisky so players can use them faster than expensive food. For example, Lady Meow-Meow likes Sashimi, while Sapphire, Jeeves and Bengal Jack like Deluxe Tuna Bits. Whiteshadow is a rare breed of cat that is particularly attracted to food, "he" doesn't care about toys and appears like a ninja cat.

### **Receive daily rewards**



Daily rewards may not be much, but players can earn some silver and goldfish every week if sending passwords daily. After sending five passwords, the player will earn a Ritzy Bits box. To send a password, select **Menu**> **News**> **Daily Password**> **Input Password** .

## Thank you gifts from cats



Each cat will leave a special small gift at some point, it could be a handkerchief or Cicada. That's how every cat says thank you.

The way to get a Memento is to make cats visit many places, they will need to visit anywhere from 10 to 15 times before leaving you with something. If you notice any cat that has not left a thank you gift, look at their page in the Catbook and put one or more Goodies on the list of their top three favorite items in your yard to make sure they appear. more often.

To see thank you gifts, press **Menu** > **Cats** and then **Mementos** .

## What is the energy level?



The energy level determines the type of cat that is prioritized to play first. If a cat has a higher energy level than other cats, it will take over Goodie.

## Buy wallpaper in the hospital



In Neko Atsume, players can also buy high resolution wallpapers for their favorite cats. Each wallpaper costs 20 gold fish. However not all wallpapers are available, players unlock "when certain conditions are met".

For example, the wallpaper can be unlocked by visiting the Snowball cat 100 times or visiting Speckles 50 times. Some wallpapers unlock when players receive souvenirs from cats like Frosty or Bengal Jack. Buy wallpaper by tapping **Menu**> **Shop**> **Gallery** .

## Other tips:

The player can kick a cat out of Goodie if he wants to welcome another cat with a lower energy level. Touch the item in the Goodies archive to 'kick' it off the field. Then, press again to place it, the previous cat will disappear (leaving the only silver fish).

1. Tubbs is too lazy to go inside to eat food, so if you don't want 'him' to eat expensive food so fast, put it in the house.
2. If you put the Giant Cushion in the house, Frisky Bits (or something more expensive) in the indoor bowl and leave the outdoor bowl empty, or just for Thrifty Bits, Tubbs will go inside and choose a favorite cushion. .
3. Frosty has a straw shirt. When 'she' visits the outside of her house she will wear a jacket, when inside, she will remove it.
4. Frosty has the lowest energy level of all cats in Neko Atsume (up to this point), so she rarely visits. If another cat is sitting on Snowy Pillow, Frosty will not come, so the player can kick the cat out to try to attract Frosty.
5. The snow on the ground has nothing to do with Frosty, which has nothing to do with the real weather. It is simply a feature that developers at Hit Point decided to add to the game update.
6. Whiteshadow will stay in your yard, even after fixing it back and forth. So when the "guy" appears, you can switch pitches and take a photo of this cat with all the redesigned backgrounds.
7. Although Nightview Egg Bed is only for a cat, Hermeowne will share this bed with another cat.

These are tips and tricks for Neko Atsume game, hopefully the article will be useful to you.
