Step 1:

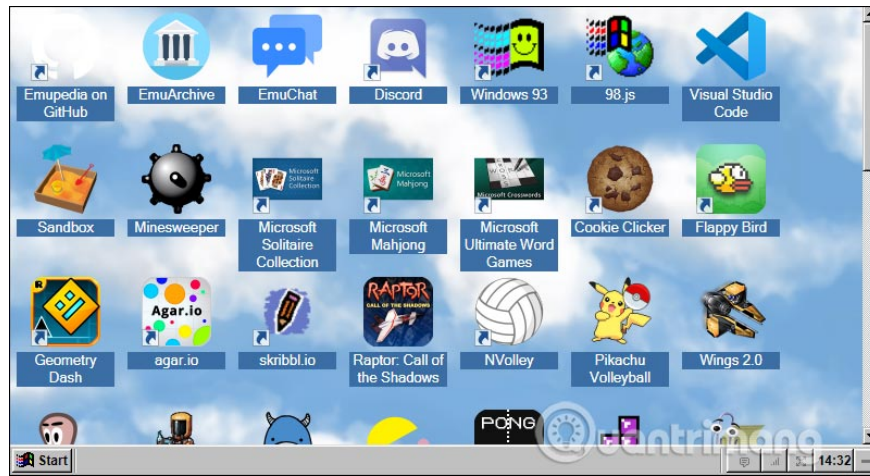
Users access EmuOS from the link below and then **select Windows 95** or another Windows interface, depending on you.
