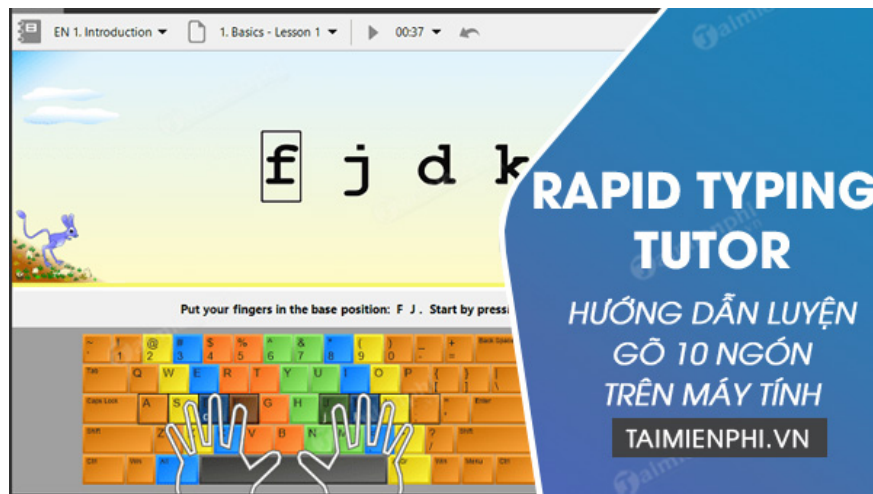


# How to practice 10-finger typing using Rapid Typing Tutor on a computer.

Practice typing quickly with all ten fingers using Rapid Typing Tutor.

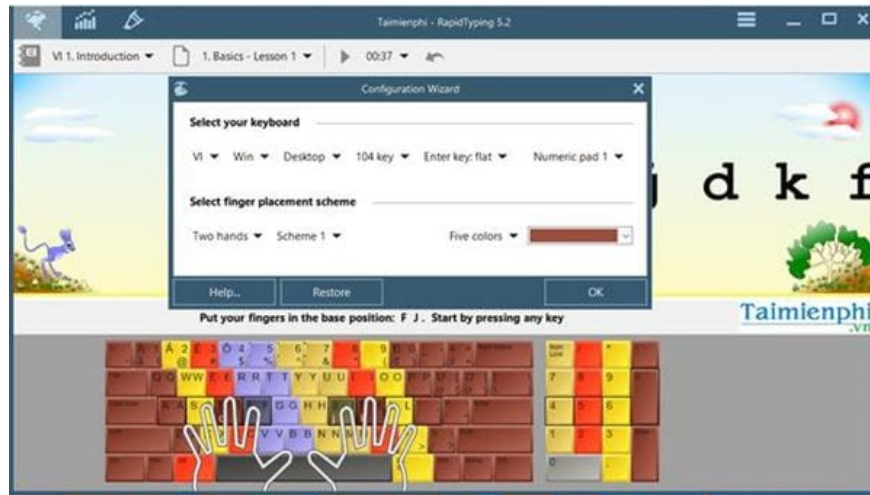
## ***HOW TO PRACTICE TYPING WITH 10 FINGERS USING RAPID TYPING TUTOR***

To use Rapid Typing Tutor software, you need to download and install it.

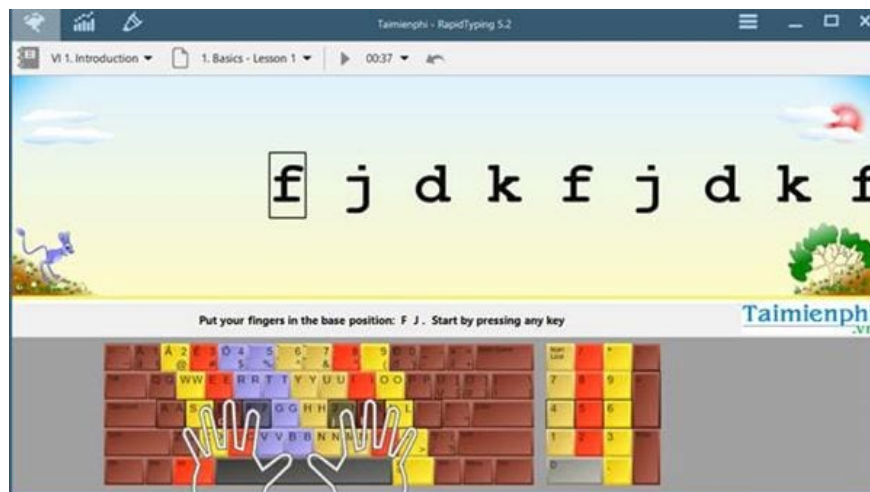
If you encounter difficulties installing the software, please refer to the guide below on installing the 10-finger typing practice software.

Follow the steps below to practice typing effectively.

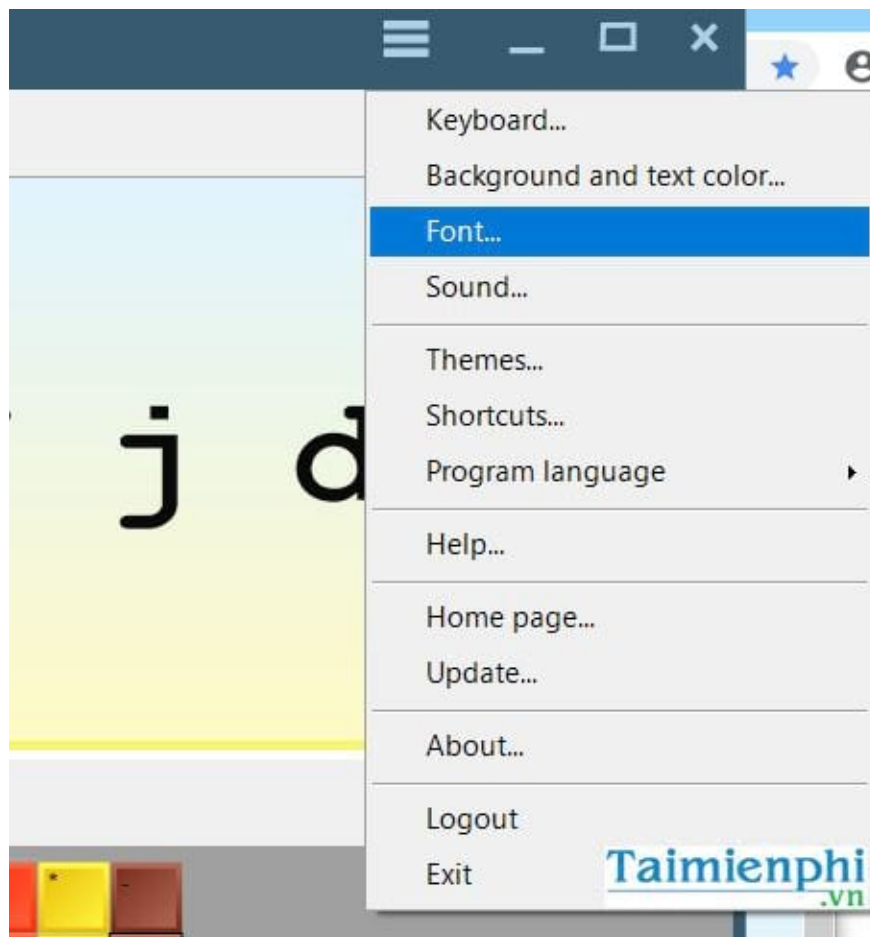
**Step 1** : Open the Rapid Typing Tutor software you just installed. Select your desired options in the "**Select your keyboard**" and "**Select finger placement scheme**" sections , then click **OK** to start using it.



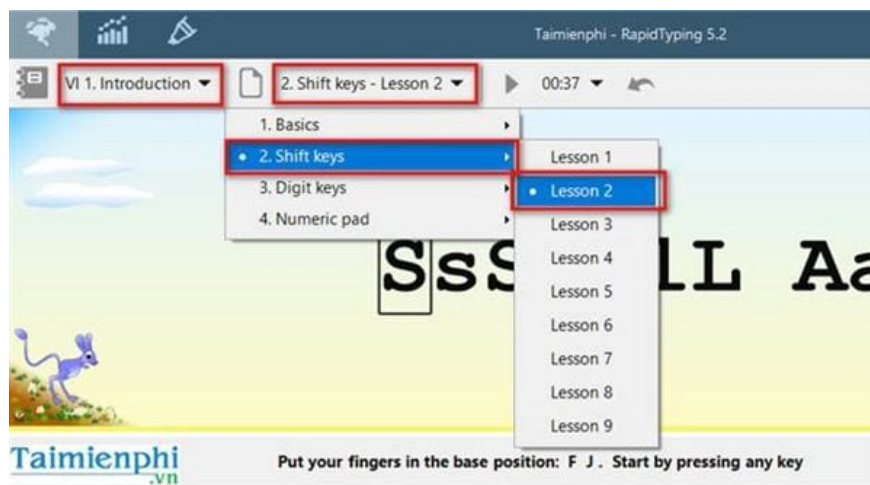
The interface after selecting **OK** :



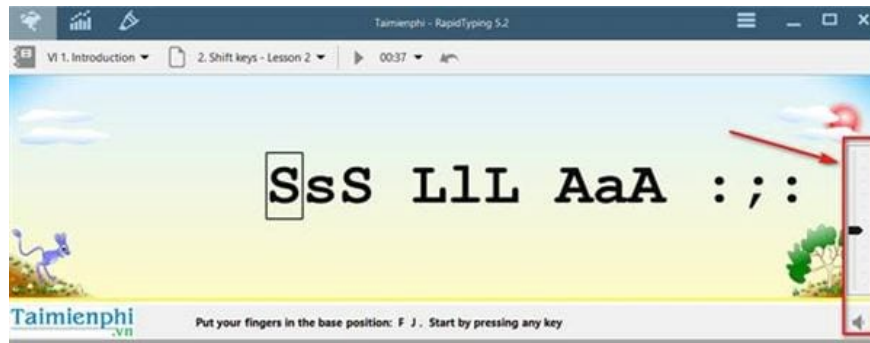
You can customize several settings in the **Options** section . You can configure the keyboard layout (Keyboard), colors (Colours), fonts (Font), sounds (Sound), background themes (Themes), and select the display language (Program language).



You choose the program and lessons you want. If you don't choose anything, the program will start from the beginning.



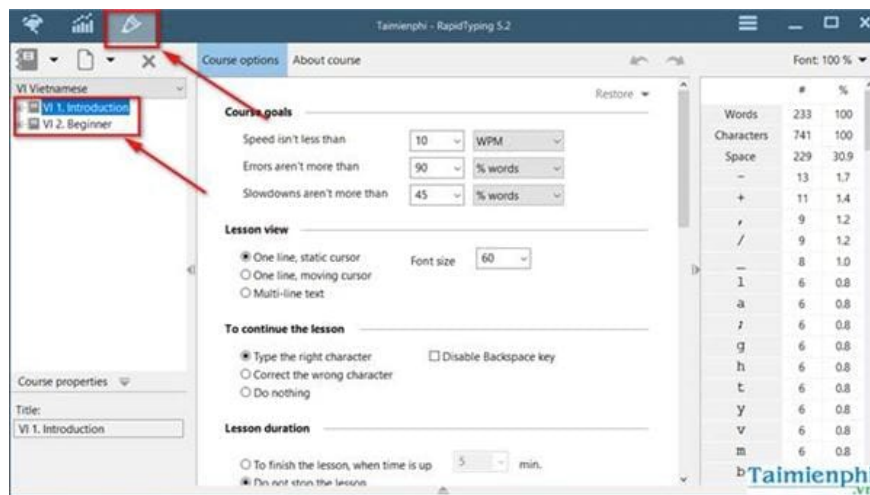
You can increase or decrease the program's audio volume:



You can track and check your typing speed after you finish typing:



You can see information about commonly misspelled words and the percentage of errors for each word, as shown in the image below:



**Step 2** : Start practicing 10-finger typing with **RapidTyping** .

**1. Position your fingers as shown in the illustration below.** Each finger will be responsible for typing the keys of the same color as shown in the image.



*Left hand:*

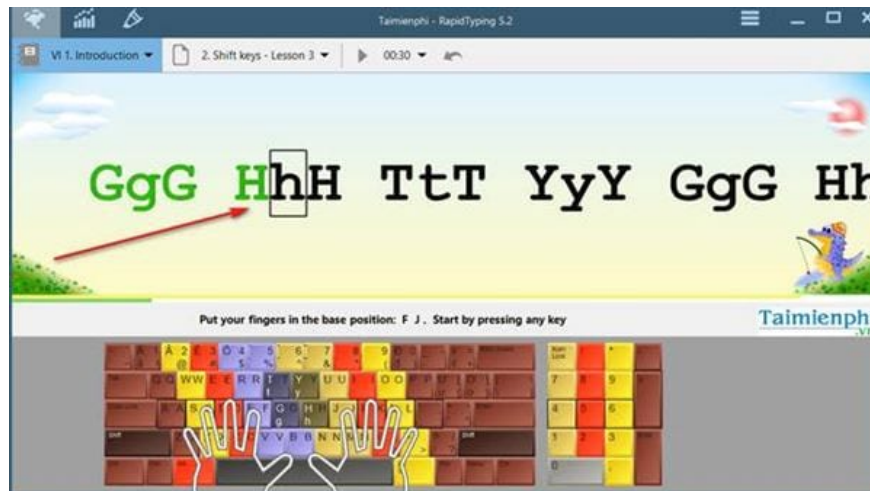
- **Little finger:** Always placed on the **A** key and type the **Z, Q, 1, ` , Tab, Capslock, Shift, and Ctrl** keys .
- **Ring finger:** Always placed on the **S** key and type the **W, X, ALT, and 2** keys .
- **Middle finger:** Always placed on the **D** key and type the **E, C, and 3** keys .
- **Index finger:** Always placed on the **F** key and type the **G, V, B, R, T, 4, and 5** keys .
- **Thumb:** Type the **Space** key .

*Right hand:*

- **Little finger:** Always placed on the **;** key and type the **P, O, Backspace, Enter, Shift, Ctrl** keys .
- **Ring finger:** Always placed on the **L** key and type the **O, >, 9** keys .
- **Middle finger:** Always placed on the **K** key and type the **I, , alt, ctrl, >** keys .
- **Index finger:** Always placed on the **J** key and type the **J, H, M, N, U, Y, 6, 7** keys .
- **Thumb:** Type **Space**.

**2. You practice typing from easy to difficult, going through the sections and lessons within each section in order.**

You press any key to start **the lesson** . The character you type will turn green and move to the next character; the **space** key is for spaces .



Once you've finished typing the entire lesson, you should switch to checking your typing speed as instructed above. Regular practice with the lessons in **RapidTyping** will gradually improve your ten-finger typing speed, and eventually you'll be able to type accurately without looking at the keyboard.
