

# How to properly charge AirPods helps extend battery life

## What is the concept of AirPods?

AirPods are wireless headphones, used by connecting to other electronic devices via Bluetooth. The biggest advantage of AirPods is that they are compact and easy to carry when traveling. Besides, Apple designed AirPods with a carrying case, which is also a battery charger for the headphones.

AirPods headphones have built-in infrared sensors. Thanks to that, this device will help stop the music when the user removes the headset, and the music will continue to play when the headset is reattached to the ear. Besides, the headset's sensor is also connected to Siri (or installed by the user) by tapping twice on the back of the AirPods. Two sound sensors help users recognize when sound is coming out and have the function of preventing noise during conversations.

## Harmful effects of improper charging of AirPods

In fact, many users today have incorrect habits of charging their AirPods headphones. This has many potential risks of damage, battery damage, and can even cause a fire or explosion, endangering the user. Many people do not know the dangers of incorrect battery charging habits. Or be subjective, deliberately disregarding the level of harm that can occur. This is a completely wrong concept that you need to change as soon as possible.

## 4 ways to know when to charge AirPods

So how do you know if your AirPods need to be charged? Below are the 4 most popular ways to know when to charge your AirPods headphones today.

### Method 1: See the battery level on iPhone

Users can monitor the battery capacity of AirPods headphones and charging box right on the phone. In the battery capacity notification section or **Control Center**, full information about the battery capacity will be displayed. The way to check on the phone is as follows:

1. **Step 1:** Connect AirPods to your iPhone or iPad with Bluetooth enabled.
2. **Step 2:** Open the lid of the AirPods charging box and bring it close to the phone. The screen will display connection options, select **Connect** to connect the headset.

1. **Step 3:** After the two devices are successfully connected, the screen will display the battery percentage of the headset and charging box.

**Note:** To do this, the charging box needs to be near the phone, open the lid and the headset needs to be placed in the charging box. Normally the phone will display the battery capacity after a few seconds. In case it is not displayed, you just need to close the lid and reopen the charging box.

## **Method 2: Recognize through notifications on the headset**

The second way is that users can recognize through the low battery notification on the headset. When the AirPods headphones are almost out of battery, there will be a low battery warning sound. Besides, when the battery is completely depleted, there will also be a notification sound for the user.

## **Method 3: Identify through the charging box**

Users can check battery capacity through the light color on the AirPods charging box. With the wireless charging case, the status light will be on the front. As for the wired charging box, the light will be between the two headphones.

When the headset is placed inside the charging box, the indicator light will indicate the battery status. Conversely, when the lid of the box is open but there are no headphones, the display light is the battery status of the charging box. The green light means the AirPods are in a full battery state, while the yellow light means the battery capacity is below 80%.

## **Method 4. Through the color of the LED light on the charging box**

Users can observe the LED light color on the charging box to know the battery status of AirPods as follows.

1. Blue shows the battery capacity is full when charging or over 80% when in use.

2. Red shows that the battery is not fully charged while being charged or the battery is below 80% when in use.

## The best way to charge AirPods

According to information from Apple, the battery capacity of AirPods headphones can be used and charged for the following time:

1. Use for 24 hours with the included charging case.
2. Use more than 5 hours after full charge and without charging case.
3. Charge for 15 minutes for 3 hours of continuous use.

Through these indicators, users can estimate for themselves how long it takes to recharge the battery. Below is how to charge AirPods as well as the most correct way to charge AirPods pro that users can refer to:

1. **Step 1:** Place the headset in the charging box.
2. **Step 2:** Close the lid of the charging box and charge the headset while the headset is in the box and close the lid.
3. **Step 3:** Simultaneously charge the AirPods headphone case using a USB Lightning charging cable or compatible wireless AirPods charger.
