

# How to properly turn off your iPhone 15, 14, 13, 12, and 11 when it freezes.

Turning off your iPhone is a basic operation that helps save battery and protect the device from damage, fixing some errors such as freezing or crashing, and preventing apps from stopping. ## *1. How to turn off your iPhone using the physical buttons*

*2. Instructions on how to turn off an iPhone with a Home button.*

*Step 1:* Press and hold **the power button** .

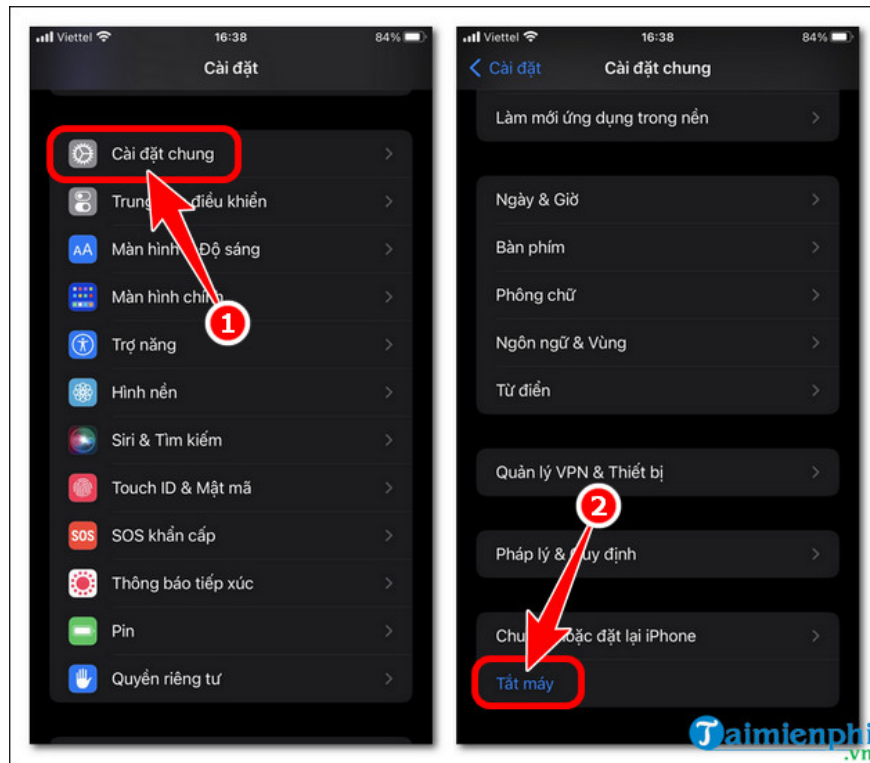
*Step 2:* A **slider** will appear on the phone screen; swipe horizontally to turn off the power.



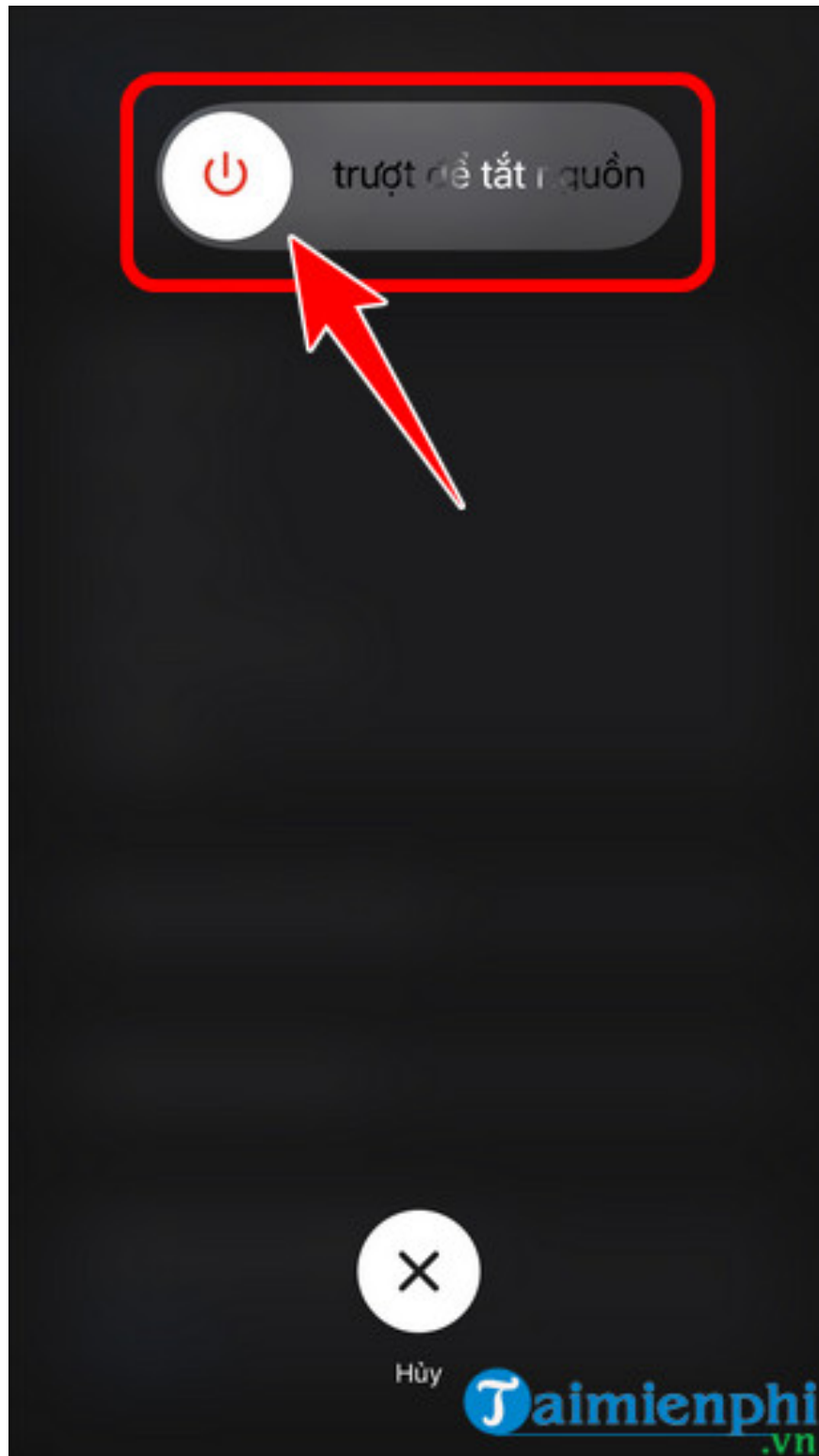
## ***II. How to turn off your iPhone using the Settings app***

Besides the physical power button, you can also turn off your iPhone through Settings. However, for this method to work effectively, your device must be running iOS 11 or later.

*Step 1:* Open **Settings** , select **General Settings** => Scroll to the bottom and tap **Shut Down** .



Step 2: Next, slide **the slider** to the right to turn off your iPhone.



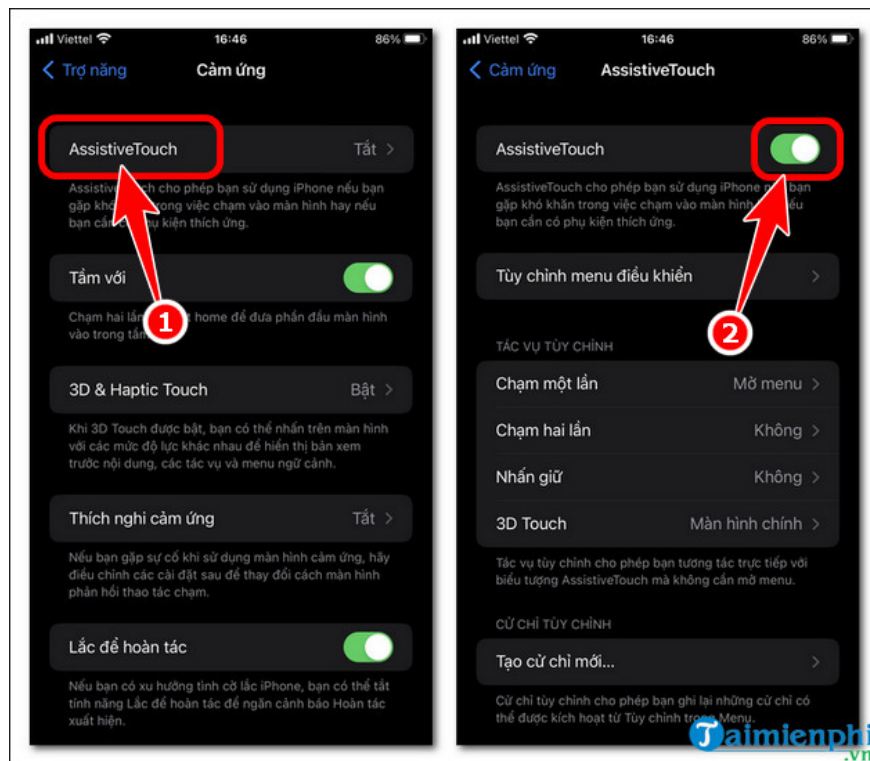
### ***III. How to turn off your iPhone using the virtual Home button***

AssistiveTouch is an accessibility button on the iPhone that allows you to use built-in features, including turning off your iPhone.

Step 1: Open **Settings** , click **Accessibility** => select **Touch** .



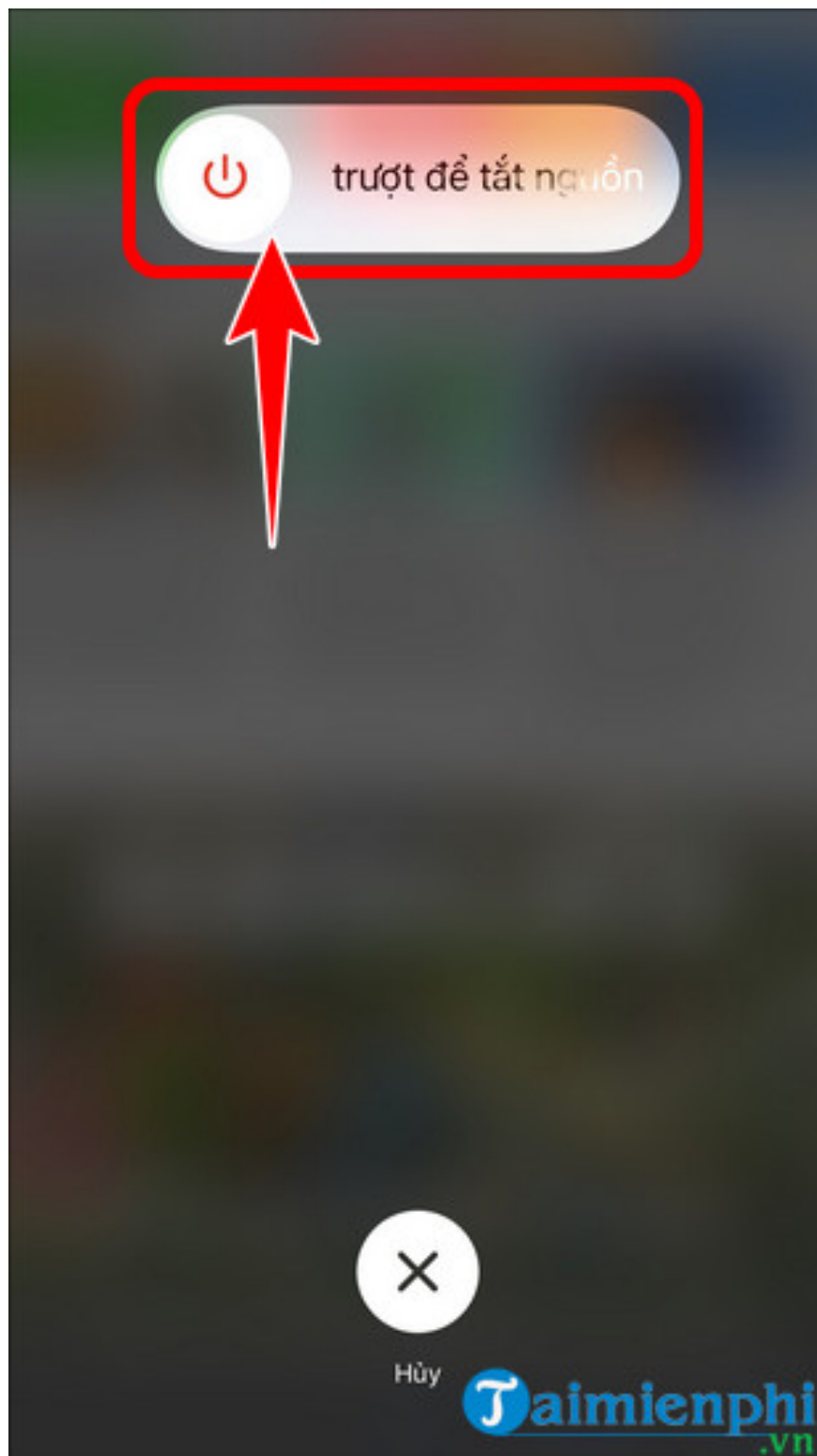
Step 2: Press **AssistiveTouch** => turn on **AssistiveTouch** .



Step 3: Open the **virtual Home** button , select **Devices** => press and hold **Lock** screen .



*Step 4:* Slide the **horizontal bar** to turn off your iPhone.



#### ***IV. Tips for turning off your iPhone using supporting software.***

If the above methods are ineffective, you can try turning off your iPhone using supporting software. Currently, there are many software programs that integrate iOS power-off functionality, however, 3uTools is more stable
