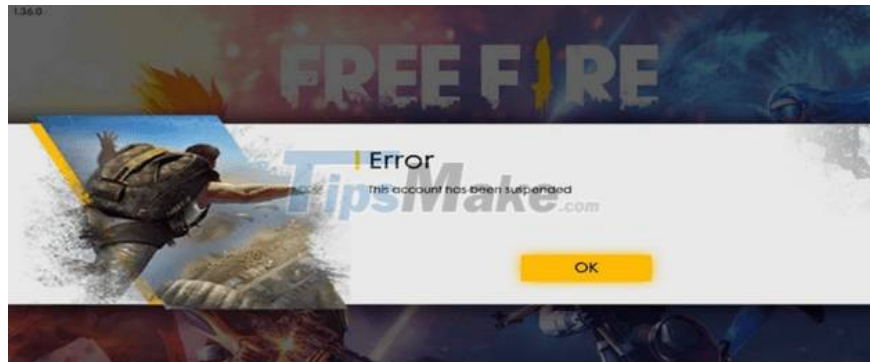

1. Loan your account

Account loan is the reason why your account is lost. Furthermore, for a stranger, lending an account is like opening the door for unknown people to enter your home. And they can take over your account.



Besides, if you put your favorite Free Fire account in the hands of someone else, even if not taken, there's a chance that the borrower can use cheats to make your Free Fire account banned.

2. Access and use of phishing websites

Web phishing is something you may come across while surfing the web. Never try to visit these phishing sites, let alone provide a variety of sensitive data as they often tempt you with many attractive free prizes.



Remember, by providing data such as passwords and email addresses, the phishing website manager will most likely take over your account. Meanwhile, those tempted by attractive prizes will not really benefit from not receiving the reward and losing their Free Fire account.

3. Tempted by the free Diamond / Magic Cube from unknown sources

Aside from the web scam, there's also something called a Generator that supposedly gives you a Diamond, Magic Cube, gun skin, and more. But similar to phishing sites, these will only deceive you.



Usually the appeal of getting diamonds or Magic Cube comes from unknown sources. Some people out there say there is a free Magic Cube event, for example, but to get them you are required to enter personal data on Google Forms or something similar. If you do encounter this, you should immediately stay away and ignore it.

4. Don't use 2-factor authentication

Ultimately, this is something Free Fire players often forget. Not having 2-factor authentication enabled will make your Free Fire account more likely to be a target of hacker attacks.



Besides enabling 2-factor authentication on Facebook, you should use the same functionality for email as well. And even with 2-factor authentication enabled, don't do anything as mentioned above to protect your Free Fire account.

Nowadays, there are a lot of use of 3rd party software to interfere with the game, making the balance in the game so you need to pay attention to avoid encountering it.
