

# How to protect your Facebook account from being hacked?

Many hackers use sophisticated tricks to hijack your Facebook account, and recently appeared how to checkpass Facebook to hack victim nick without password, login email. In this article we will help you with some tips to protect your Facebook nick.

The social network Facebook is getting bigger and bigger, as the number of users continues to increase. We can do everything we enjoy from making friends, entertaining, shopping or becoming a means of communication at work, even dating. However, this social network also gives users no less hassle, especially the hacked Facebook account.

Many hackers use sophisticated tricks to hijack your Facebook account, with strange links, malicious software when accidentally downloading. Even in recent times, it has appeared how to checkpass Facebook to hack victim's nick without password, login email. Therefore, it is very important to set up a security system for Facebook in addition to setting a password, if you don't want your account to be stolen in a heartbeat. In this article we will help you with some tips to protect your Facebook nick.

## Note to secure your Facebook account securely

1. You should not disclose, publicize phone numbers, emails, birth dates, ID numbers and photos to use to register Facebook on the wall or anywhere.
2. Be extremely cautious when logging into Facebook from an application or window without having a trusted browser with <https://www.facebook.com> or the official Facebook application on your phone.
3. Be careful with emerging trends on Facebook that require clicking on links, or using certain apps that are unreliable.
4. Always pay attention to login messages, if any, please cancel the login session immediately, by going to **Settings > Security and Login (Security and Login)** > clicking the dot next to the session **Log in > Log out** > then change the password immediately, and out of all other login sessions.
5. Check regularly **See the View Activity Log** to see if there is any unusual activity on your account, something you don't do, but it also appears. If so, your account may be in use by some "hacker", please change your password and log out of all other login sessions (on phone, Facebook Messenger, on computer, tablet .).

## Set up complex Facebook passwords

This is considered the first choice to help you protect your Facebook account. Do not set a password related to yourself such as name, identification number, date of birth. It's best to choose a password that has special characters, uppercase, lowercase, and numeric characters to avoid detection of passwords.

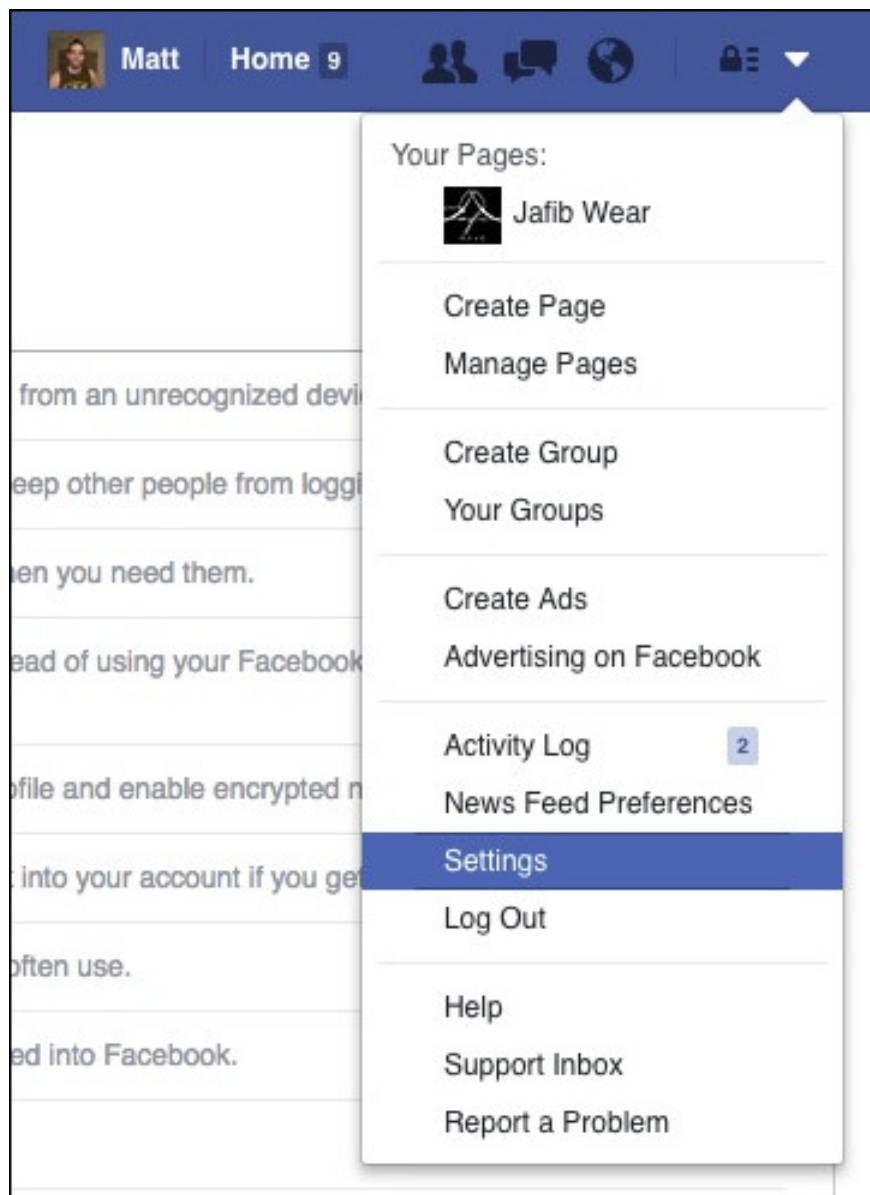
Tips for setting a Facebook password:

1. There are at least 8 characters or more, the longer, the more meaningless, the harder it is to read, the more special characters, uppercase and lowercase + the same number as possible, eg ~ N9u0`! Y3ucu ~ c0n9u0`! y3um0`! Kh0 ^ n9fa?! la`m! `nh ~ !!! Bu0`nnha (' mca'c0 ^ ngak @@: ((= (This kind of thing is hard to catch.
2. Password cannot be your name, email, phone number, address, date of birth, bank account number, identity card number, student code, personal information . of you, your relatives.

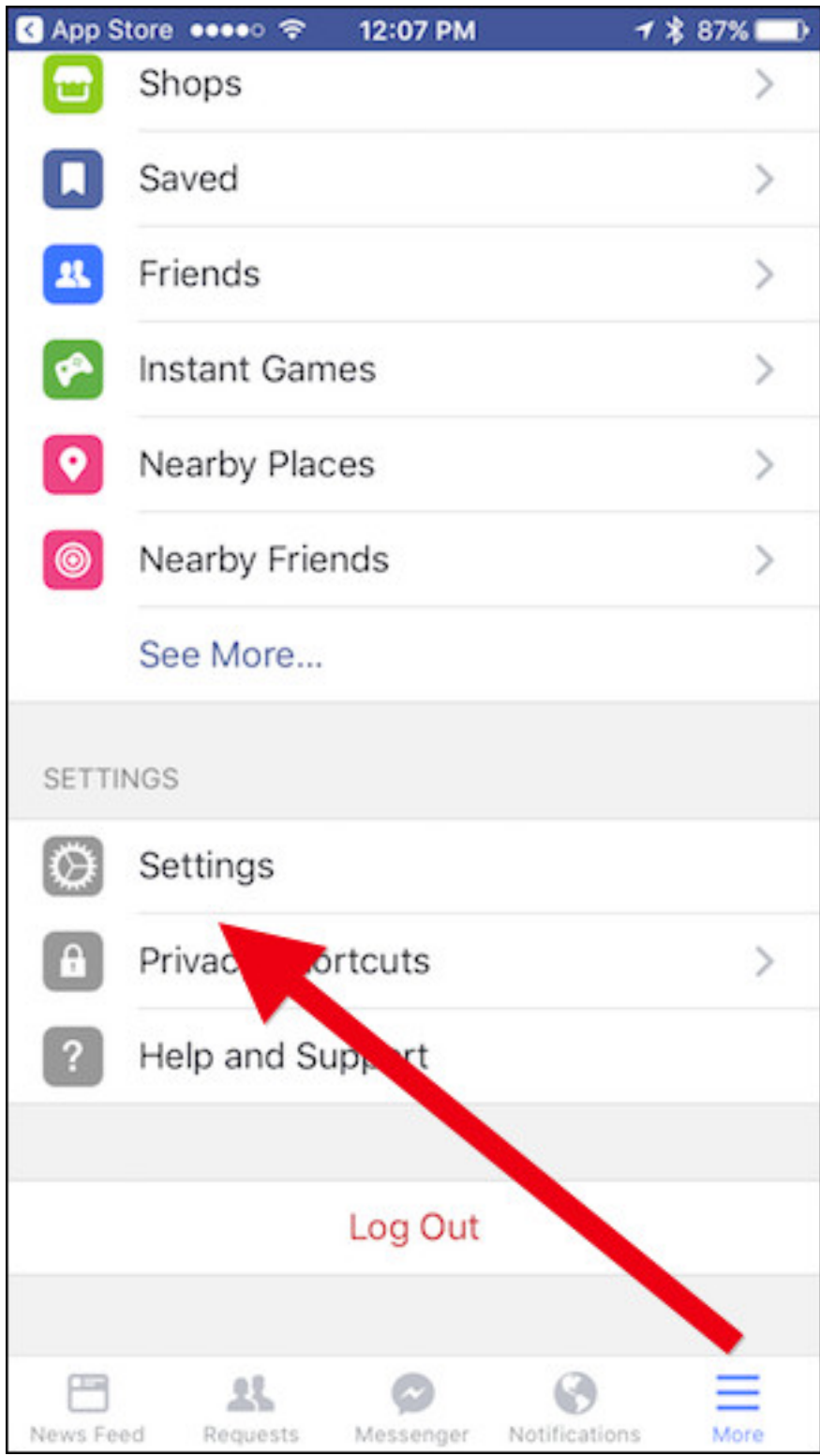
Most importantly, you should not use this password for any other account on the internet, each account should use a separate password and be random strings. That's why using a password generator and manager like LastPass is the best way to protect all your accounts.

Also, be careful with phishing tricks to steal your Facebook password like clicking untrusted links, such as links sent in e-mail, Messenger messages, love Please enter your password.

For Facebook on the web browser, click the arrow to the right of the screen in the drop-down menu select '**Settings**'.



In the mobile application, click the button in the lower right corner, then scroll to "**Settings** " and select '**Account Settings**'.

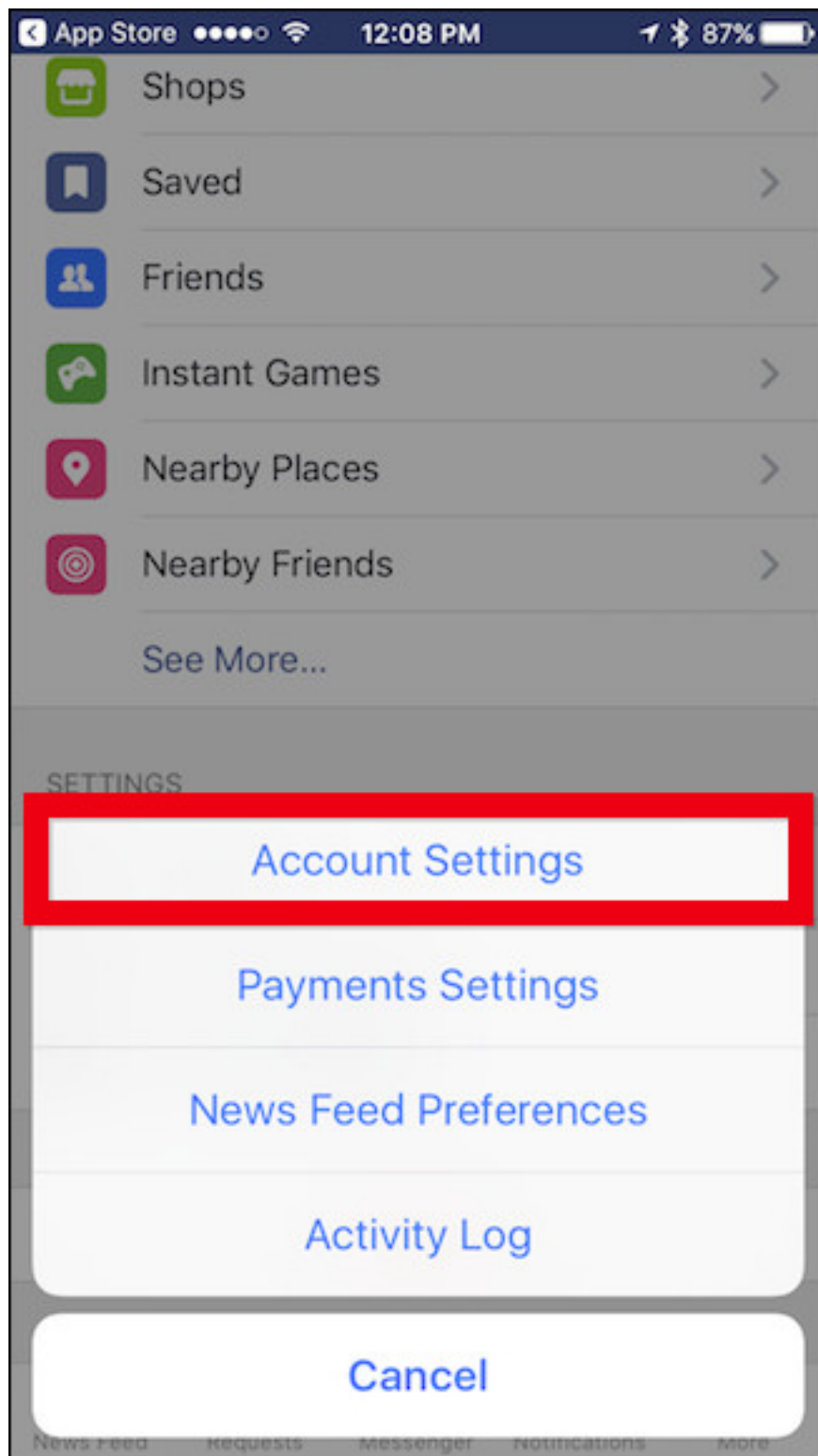

In the **Settings** section , select **Security and Login** in the left pane of the screen. You can change your Facebook password from the **Login** section.

## Add a valid contact email

In case you forget your Facebook password, you can use this email to retrieve Facebook or with hacked cases. Go to **Settings** , click **Email** . You will see the section **Add email or other mobile number** .

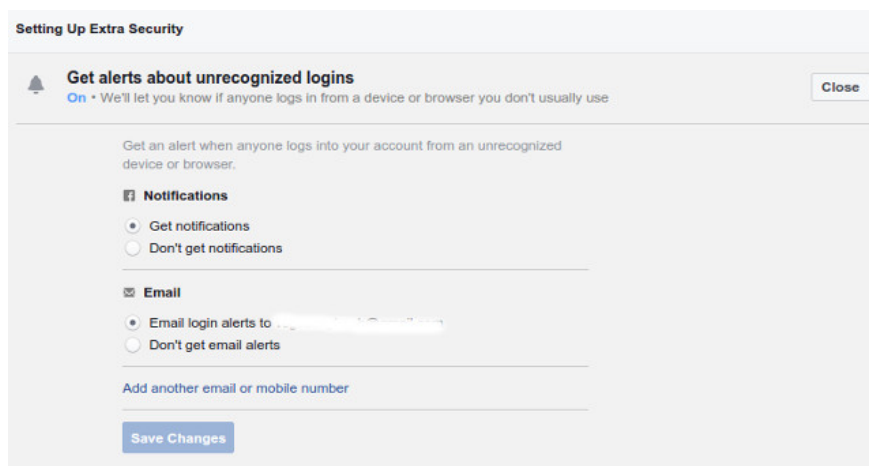

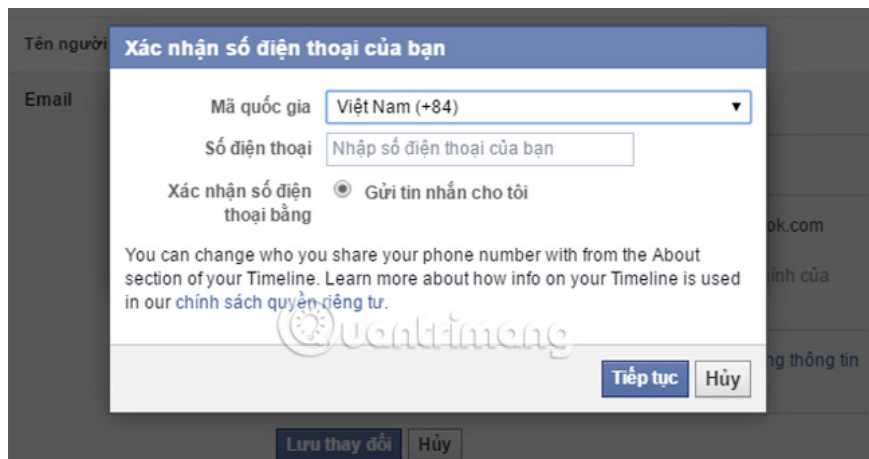
Note, you need to **use the email you are using** regularly. Avoid using email no longer in use. So will not remember the access password to retrieve Facebook pass when needed.

In addition, you can know who logged in to your account with another device by activating the notification feature in the **Security and Login** section . In the **Security and Login** section you will see the **Setting Up Extra Security** section , select **Get alerts about unrecognized logins** and check the **get notification** section, receive notifications via email or phone number. The next time anyone signs in from the device or the browser does not confirm, you will receive a notification.



## Add phone numbers to Facebook

Adding a phone number is also a way to secure Facebook, or retrieve Facebook when hacked or lost passwords. Please add at least one phone number still in use.



Whenever you change a new number and do not use the number registered with Facebook, remember to update to avoid account theft. After entering the phone number, you will receive a message to activate the phone number. You can refer to the article [How to secure 2-layer security for Facebook?](#) to know how to do it.

## Create a reliable contact to retrieve your Facebook account

This way you will rely on your Facebook friends, when you accidentally lose your password. You should choose the Facebook account of a family member, or a close friend to easily retrieve your password.

Facebook with **Trusted Contacts** will help us find the password when selecting 3 to 5 people to add a trusted item. If you do not know how to do it, please refer to the article [How to retrieve your Facebook password for friends](#).



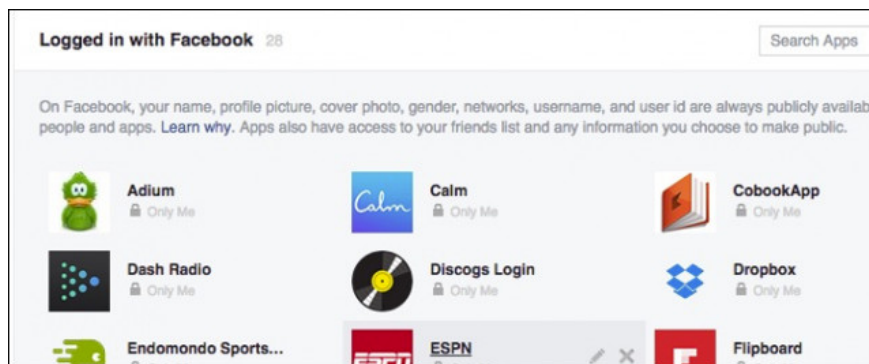
## Enter the correct date of birth information but to hide it

Entering your date of birth is the same as your identity card, but it may not be as strong as the above, but you may need it in the future. So don't let go of this problem. To be safe, you should not disclose your date of birth information on Facebook, just leave it with your friends and it is best to hide it.

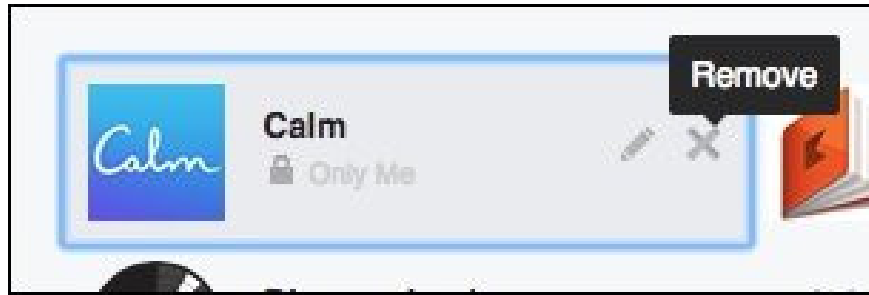
Increasing the security layer for Facebook will help us limit our ability to hack Facebook. Or you can easily get your account back when you accidentally forgot your password.

## Control which applications have access to Facebook accounts

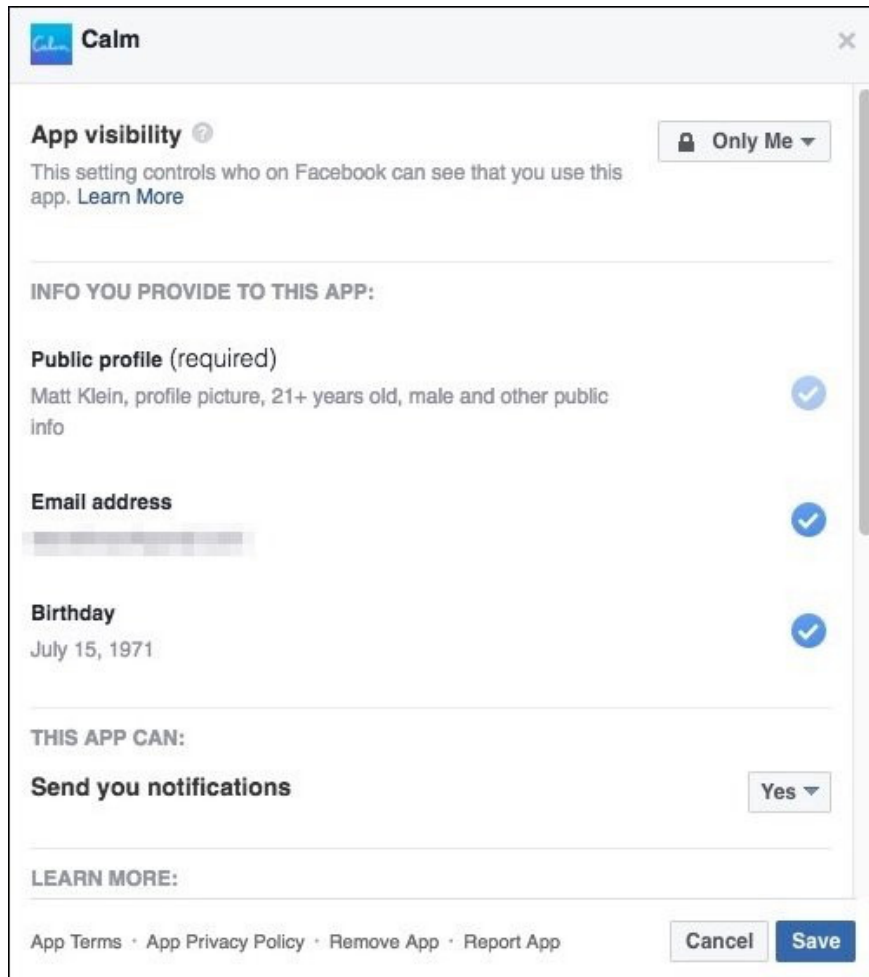
To control the application access to your Facebook account, select **Settings > Apps** .



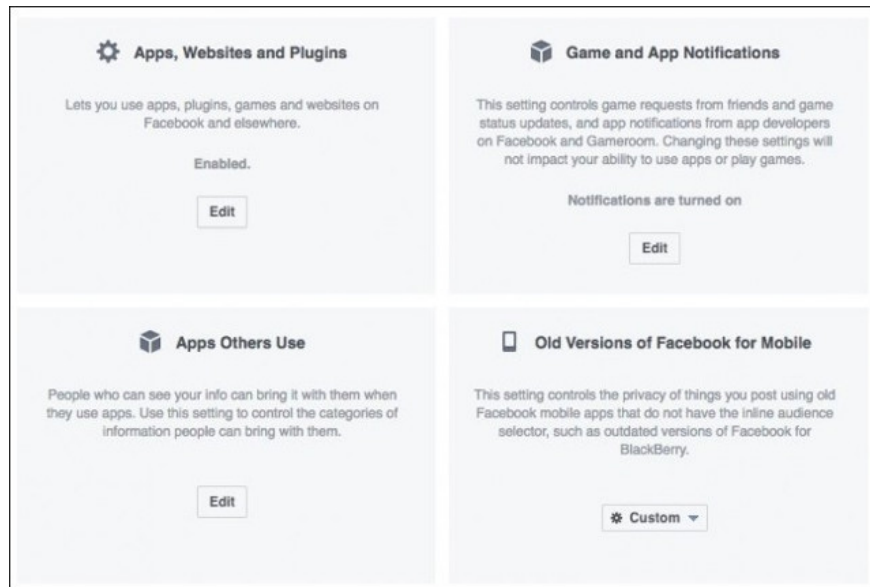
To delete the application, just hover to the application and click "X" on the right.



Alternatively, you can click the " **Edit settings** " button (right next to the Delete button, which has a pen image) to change the information you provide to the application.

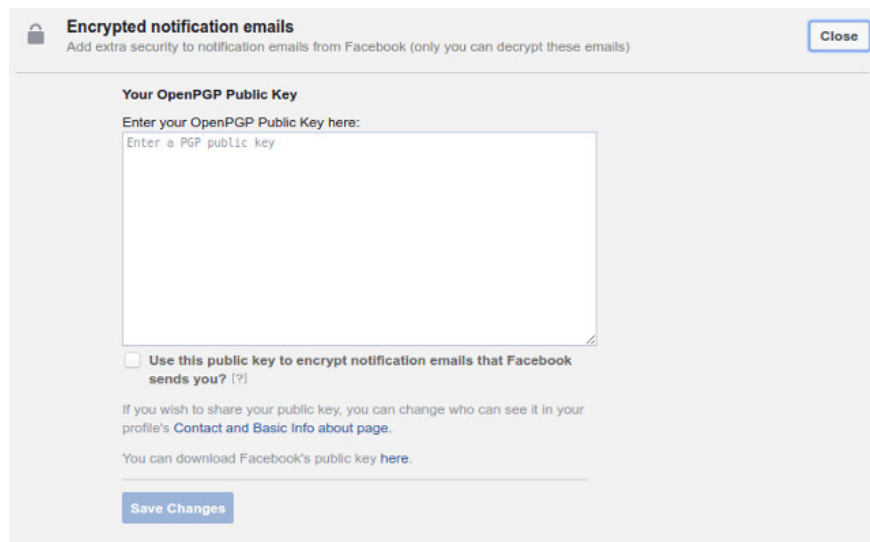


At the bottom of the **App settings** screen, you can change the settings for a number of different items.



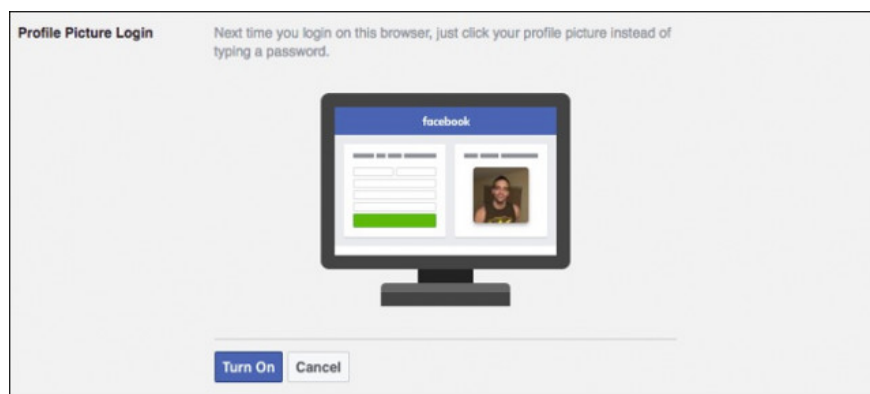
## Use public key

Most users will not use this feature, but if you want to encrypt "end-to-end" messages from Facebook, you can add the OpenPGP public key with this option. Still in the **Security and Login** section, see **Encrypted notification emails**, click the **Edit** button to open the OpenPGP public key.



## Be careful with logging in with your personal avatar

This is a new feature of Facebook, which allows you to click on a personal avatar to login instead of entering a password.



This Facebook avatar feature is very handy but anyone who has access to your browser can log in to your Facebook account. You should turn this feature off if you use a computer in environments where privacy is not as secure as a common room, library, and kiosk .

## Features Legacy Contact

Have you ever wondered what will happen to your Facebook when you die? So the feature of Legacy Contacts (the successor of Facebook account) is used for this purpose. You can choose someone (like a spouse or family member) to be your successor to your Facebook account, they can do things like pinning cards on your timeline, accepting the request. Make friends and update your profile picture. However they cannot post anything up the timeline as well as view your messages.

It is important to choose the person who "inherits" your Facebook account. When you die, hackers can access your account and use it for bad purposes. Alternatively, you can choose to delete the account. Facebook permanently.

## Lock account

This Facebook account lock is very useful when your account is hacked. Simply click " **Deactivate** ", enter the password and read through the instructions to perform.

Finally, you should not ignore the usual ways to secure your account. For example, when you sign in to an account from a public computer or someone else's device, make sure you always log out and, if possible, delete the history when you're done (or use the privacy mode of the program). Browser). Also make sure your computer and browser always update and install anti-virus and malware software.
