

How to put Windows 7 Start button on Windows 10 computer

With Classic Shell software, you can easily put the Windows 7 Start button to Windows 10 computers easily. If you see the Start menu on Windows 10 is too messy and inconvenient as on Windows 7, you can follow the tutorial below.

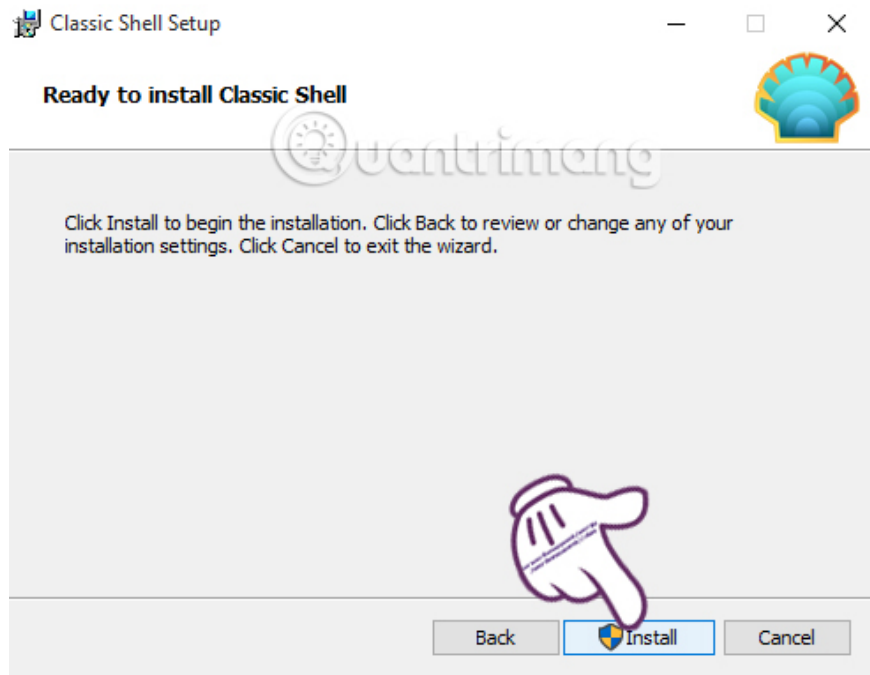
For those who prefer the Start button of Windows 7 or Windows 8 will not be very interested in the Start menu on Windows 10. Many people reflect that the Start menu on Windows 10 makes them confused and does not have the simplicity as on Windows 7.

The best solution is to put the traditional Start button on Windows 7 on Windows 10. It sounds incredible, but it can be done easily when you install the Classic Shell program on your computer. Network administrators have ever instructed you how to put Windows 8 search bar on Windows 10. And today will be to bring Windows 7 Start button to Windows 10. Follow the tutorial of Network Administrator offline.

Step 1:

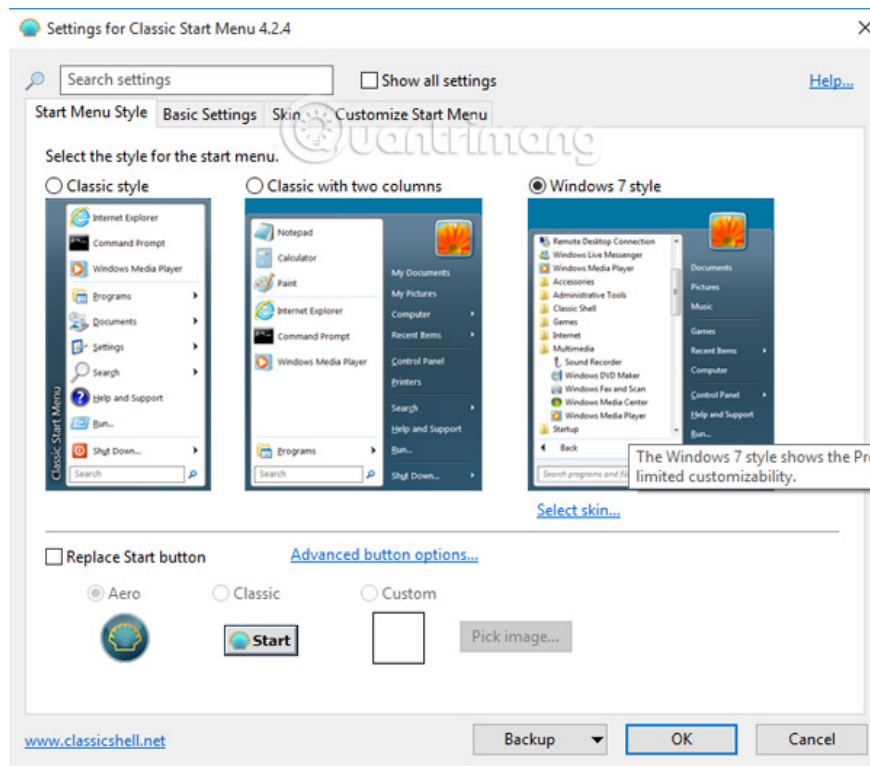
Download **Classic Shell** using the link below and install it on your computer.

1. Download Classic Shell software



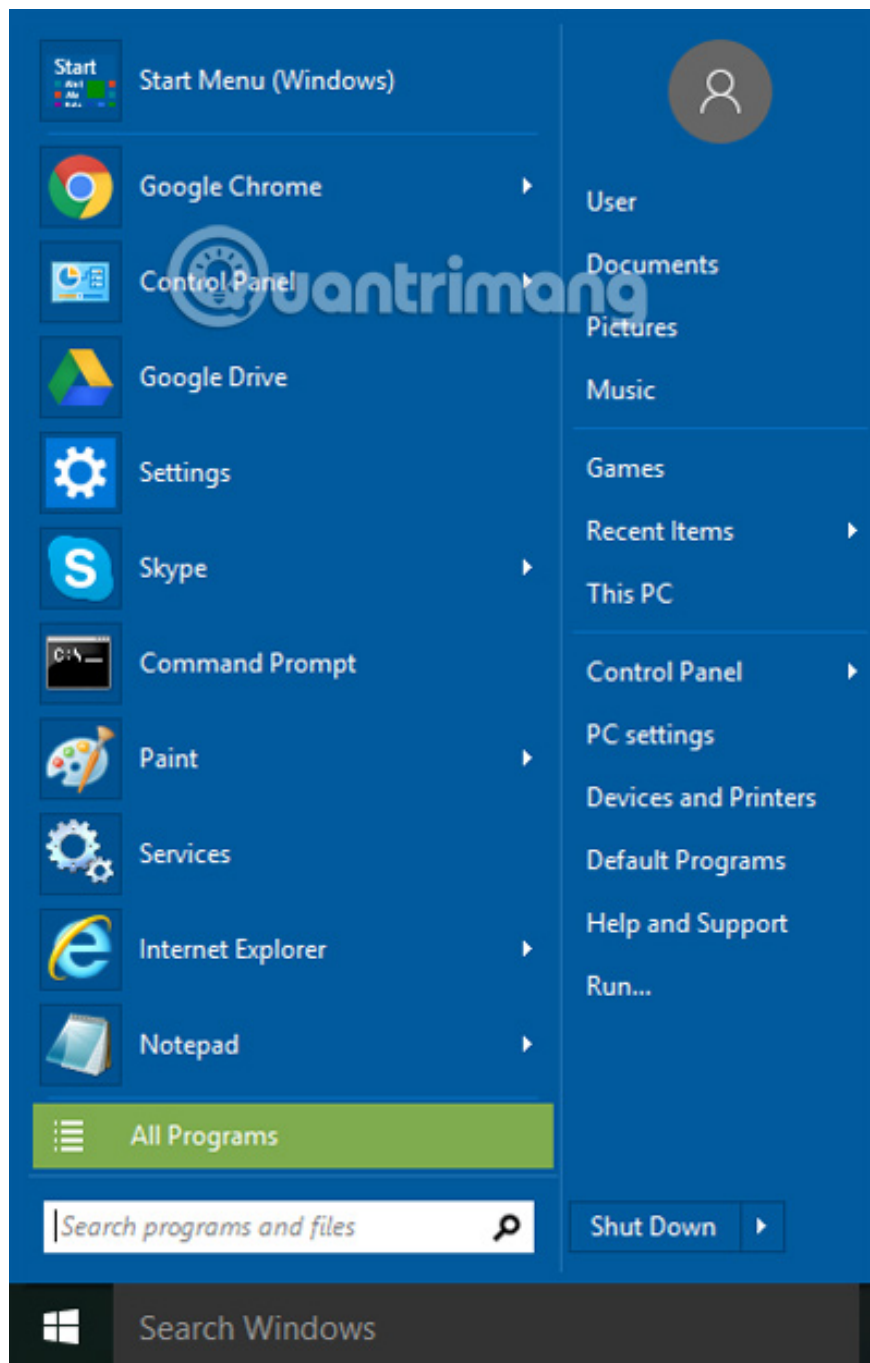
Step 2:

Immediately after successful installation on the computer, click on the **Start** button and no menu appears. Instead, the **Settings** dialog box will appear.



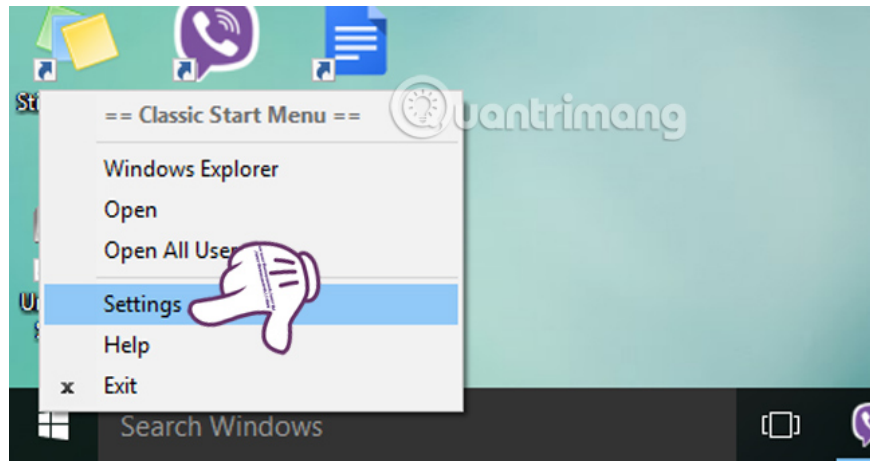
Step 3:

If we close this dialog box and click on the Start button again, we will see the "god" Windows 7 Start menu appear on the screen.



Step 4:

Next, **right-click on the Start button** on the screen and select **Settings** .

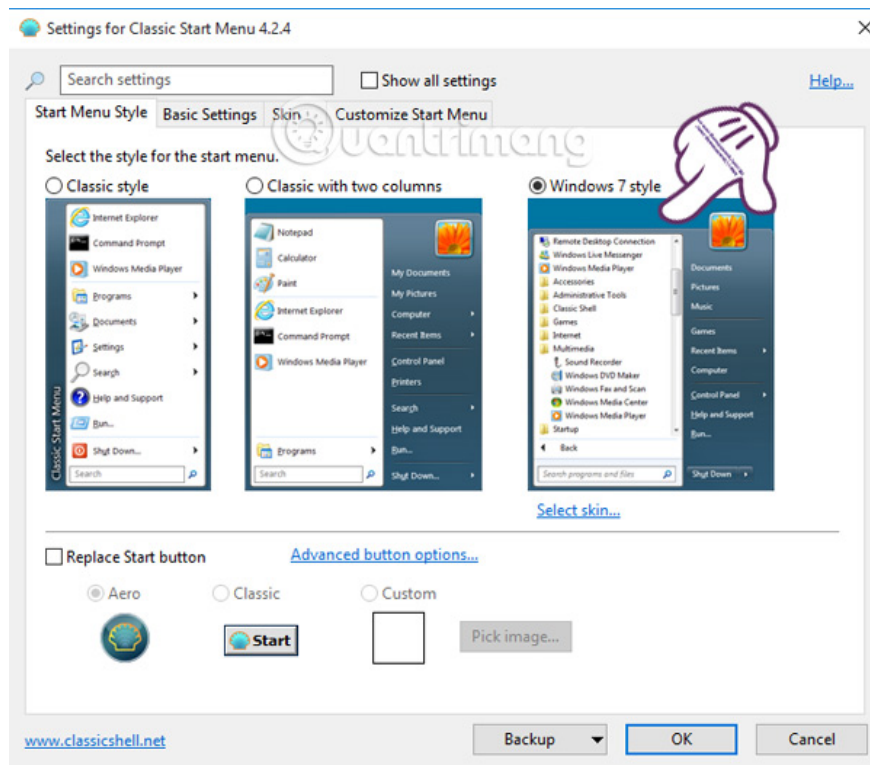


Step 5:

Soon the **Settings dialog box** of the program will appear. Here, we can choose **3 different menu** types, including:

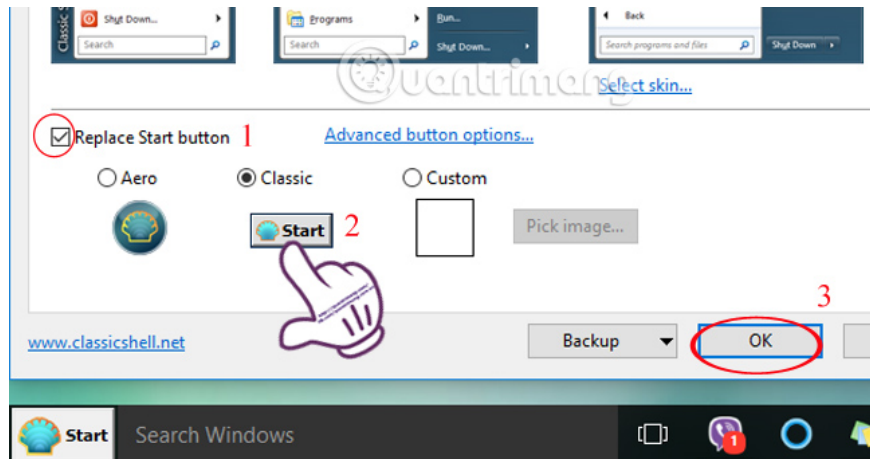
1. **Classic Style** : like the menu of Windows XP but adds search.
2. **Classic with two columns** : has the same characteristics as Windows Vista.
3. **Windows 7 Style** : the default menu of Windows 7.

If you want to choose any design interface, check the item to select it only.



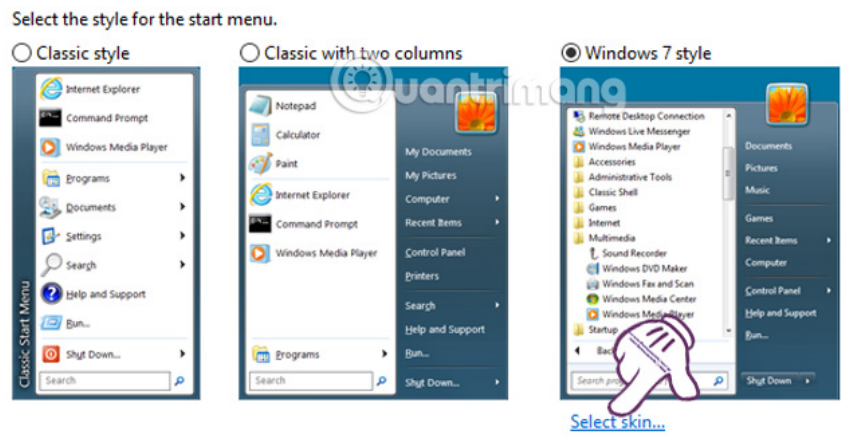
Step 6:

When you choose the Start interface type, we can choose **to change the Start button interface** right below. Check the **Replace Start button** and select the type of Start button design you want. The program will provide 2 options are **Aero** and **Classic** with Classic Shell icon included. And **Custom** is selected icon when clicking **Pick image** .

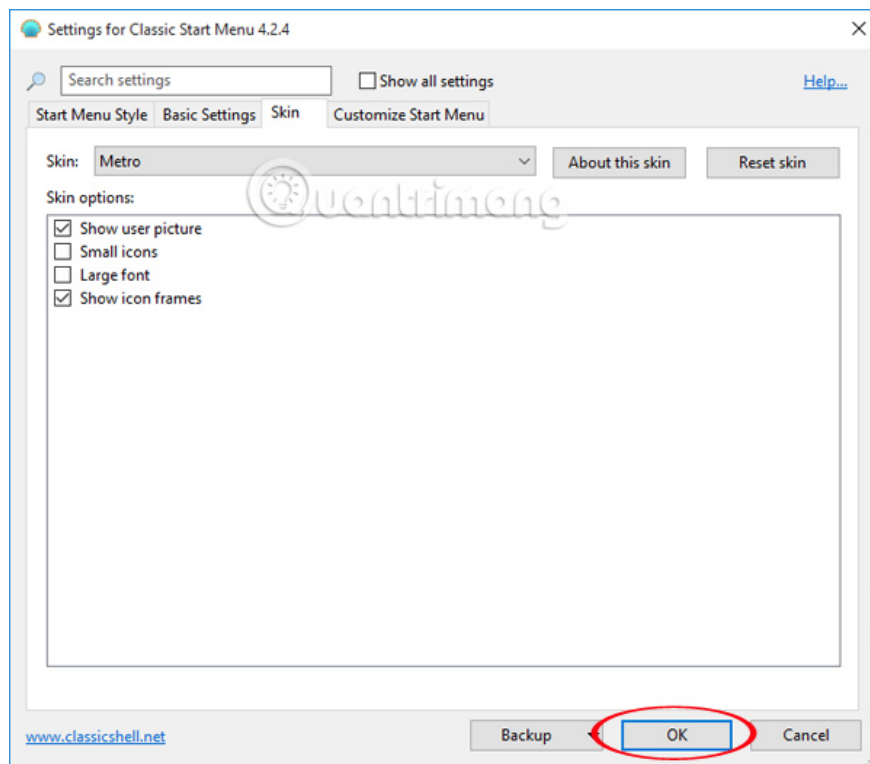


Step 7:

In addition, we can **adjust the design for 3 menu types** when clicking **Select skin** . right below when you select a certain menu interface type.



The setup dialog box will appear shortly. Here you can optionally adjust items with the Windows 7 Start menu. Finally, when finished setting click **OK** to save.



Finally, you have successfully brought the Windows 7 Start menu back to Windows 10. Simple steps, light software does not occupy much of the machine's capacity. Besides, we can customize other options in the Settings dialog box according to user purpose.
