Step 1:

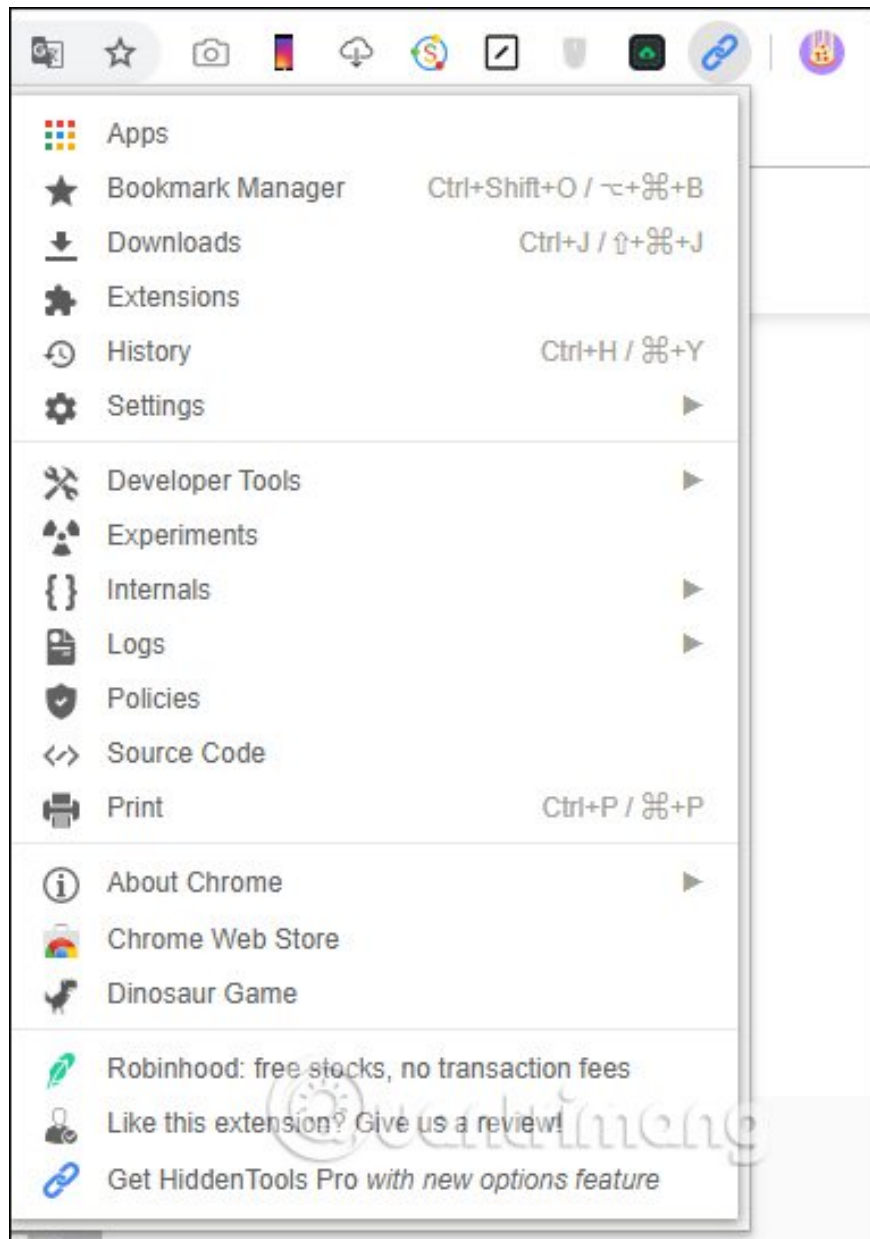
Users visit the link below to install the HiddenTools for Google Chrome extension.

1. Download the HiddenTools for Google Chrome extension

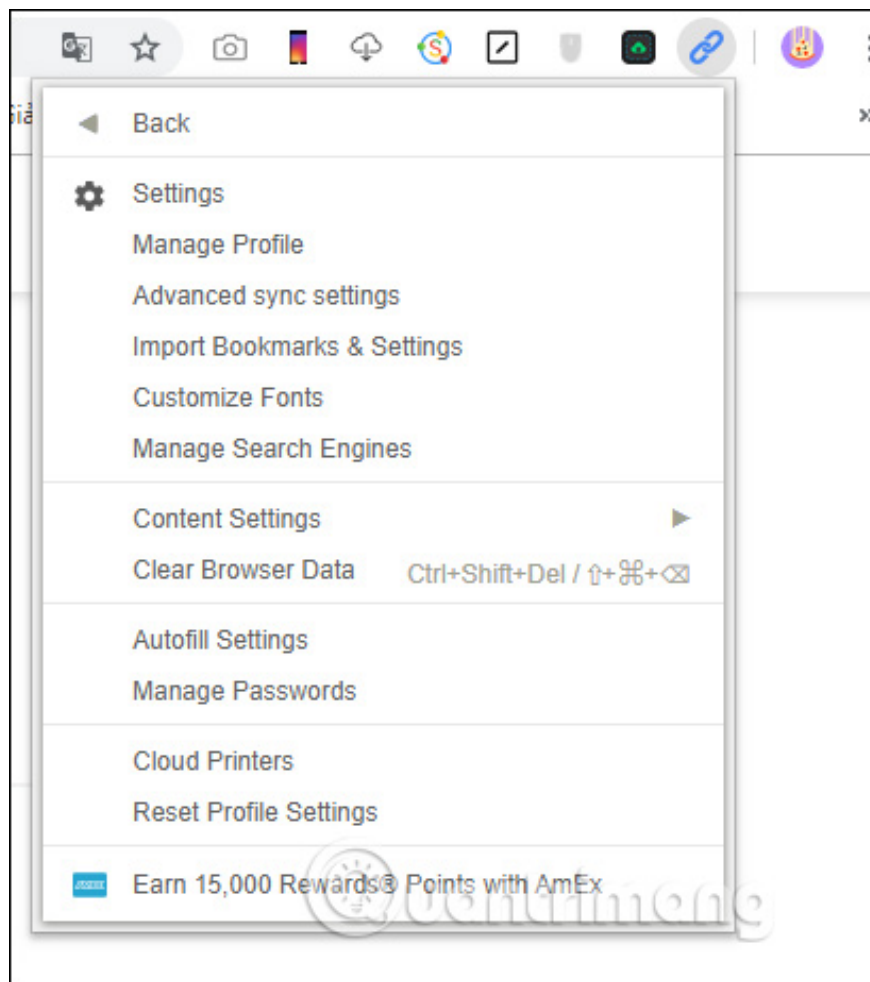


Step 2:

Then users just need to click on the utility icon to display a list of installation tools, settings that the user is allowed to access.



Options with additional settings will display a triangle icon as shown for your further access. We just need to click to access.



The setup pages that the HiddenTools for Google Chrome extension supports you to access include:

1. Apps: Install apps on Chrome.
2. Bookmark Manager: Chrome bookmark manager.
3. Devices: Devices connected on the network.
4. Developer Tools: Stealth settings for developers.
5. Dinosaur Game: Dinosaur game.
6. Downloads: Recently downloaded content.
7. Extensions: The utility is installing.
8. Experiments: Accessing experimental features on Chrome that have not been officially released is the <chrome://flags> link.
9. History: Your browsing history.
10. About Chrome: Information about Chrome.
11. Settings: Browser settings.Chrome Web Store: App store, interface, Chrome extension.
12. Print: Print the current page of Chrome.
13. Source Code: View the source code of the current page.

With HiddenTools for Google Chrome, users now have a list of hidden tools and settings on Chrome for quick access.
