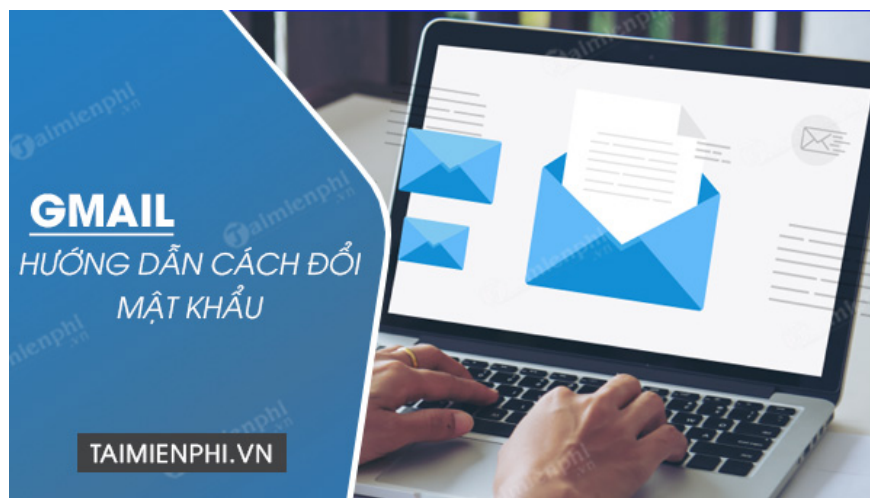


How to quickly change your Gmail password on your phone or computer.

Changing your Gmail password regularly is a way to protect your account from unauthorized access and prevent hacker attacks. Or, for some reason, you might want to change your Gmail password to something easier to remember, making it convenient to log in on different devices.

This method allows you to easily change your Gmail password on your computer/phone.

If you use your Gmail account to send and receive business emails with clients and partners, and frequently have important content that you don't want to disclose, instead of setting a complicated password with many characters, you should make it a habit **to change your Gmail password** periodically. This will help you avoid forgetting your password and prevent it from falling into the wrong hands.



Change your Gmail password, reset your Gmail account password.

The number of Gmail users is constantly increasing, as evidenced by the growing number of new Gmail registrations. However, if you don't have a strategy to change your Gmail password regularly, it can lead to your password being compromised, and your transaction information being leaked. This can result in your account being lost, forcing you to register a new Gmail account. Gmail passwords can be compromised for various reasons. If your Wi-Fi router's password is compromised, other users can easily access your modem and steal your activity information, including your Gmail account data. Therefore, changing your Wi-Fi password is very important, as each Wi-Fi modem has a different configuration and organization, so the method for changing your Wi-Fi password will also vary.

To increase security, you should occasionally change your **personal Gmail password** and avoid including your date of birth. Doing so will enhance security and protect your Gmail account information.

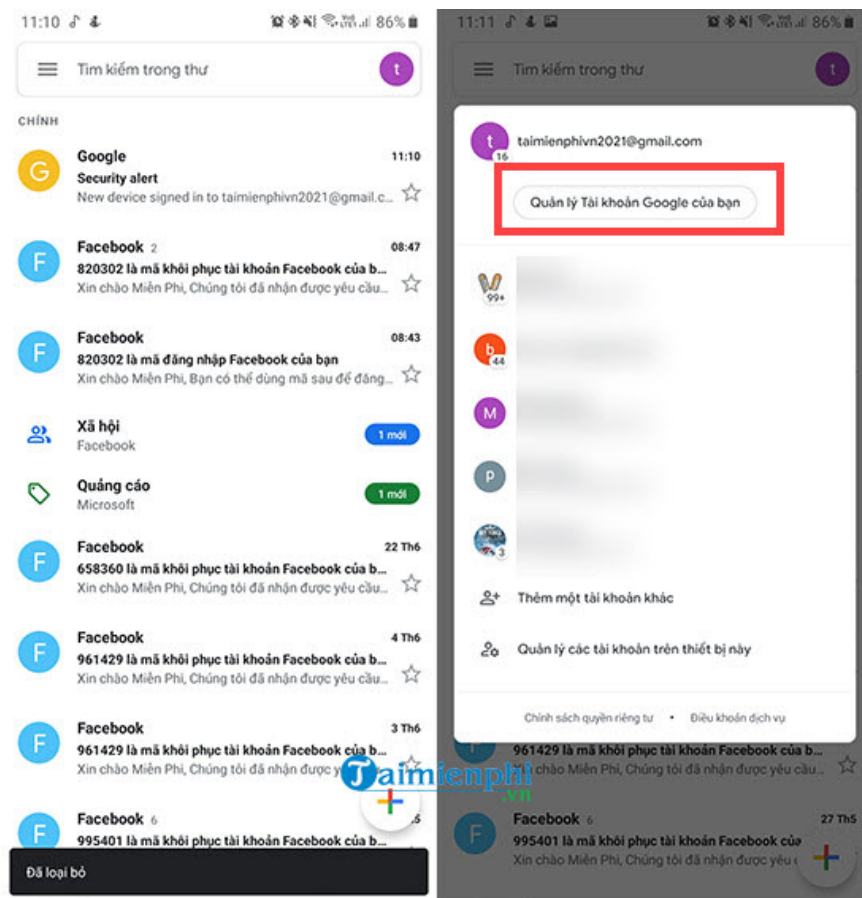

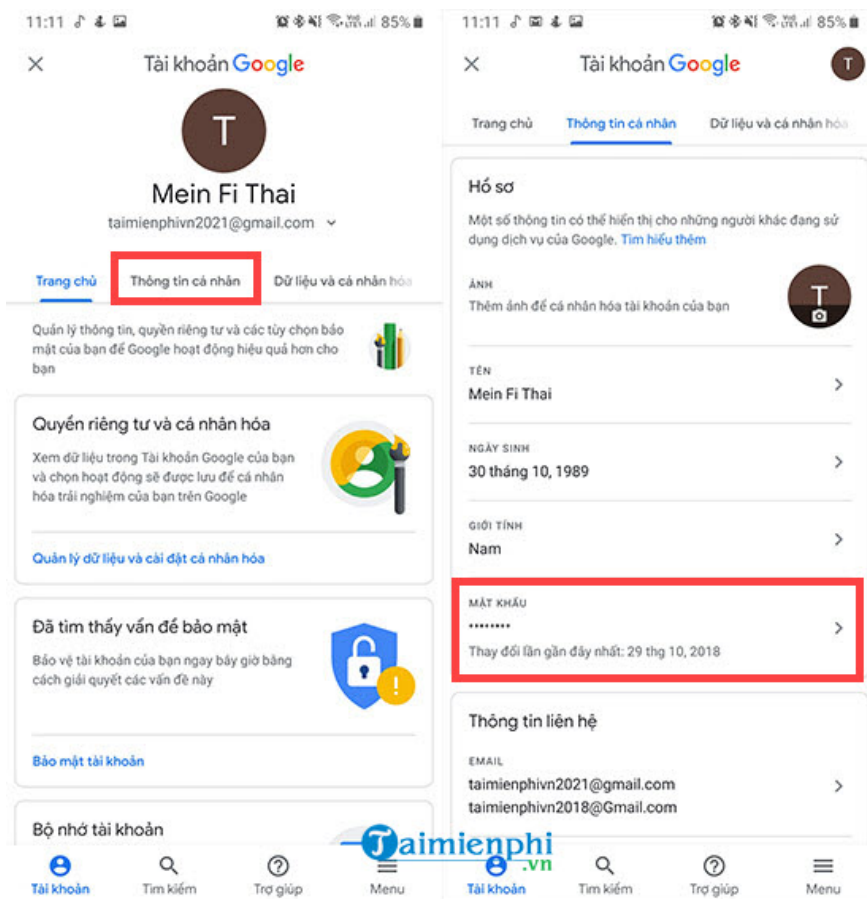
1. Change your Gmail password on your Android or iPhone.

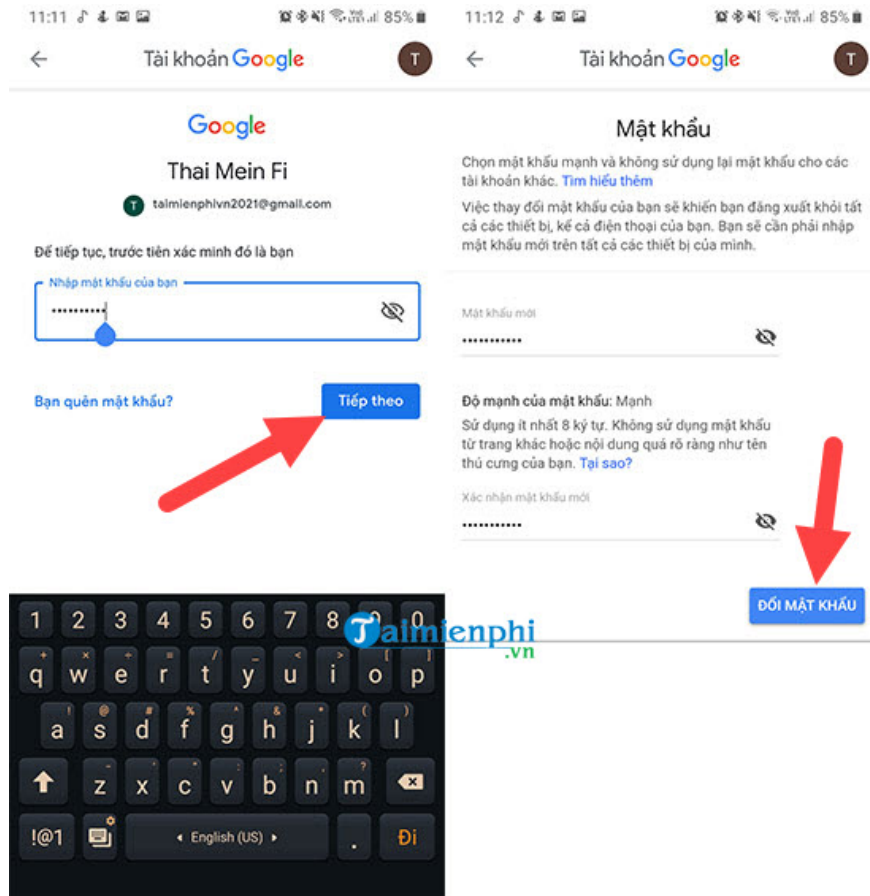
Step 1: First, open the Gmail app on your phone, then tap your account icon in **the top right corner** > select **Manage your Google account** .



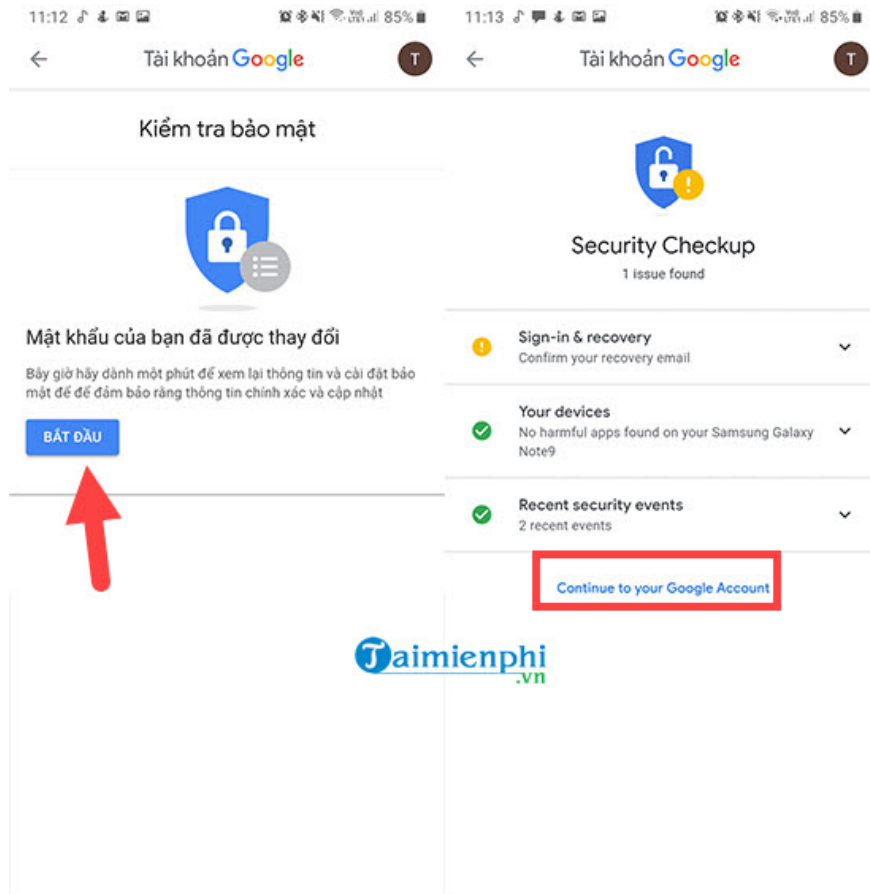
Step 2: In your Google account management interface, click on **Personal Information** > scroll down and select **Password** to change your Gmail password.



Step 3: Of course, before changing your Gmail password to the new one, you must confirm your old password. Then, enter your new password and confirm it twice.

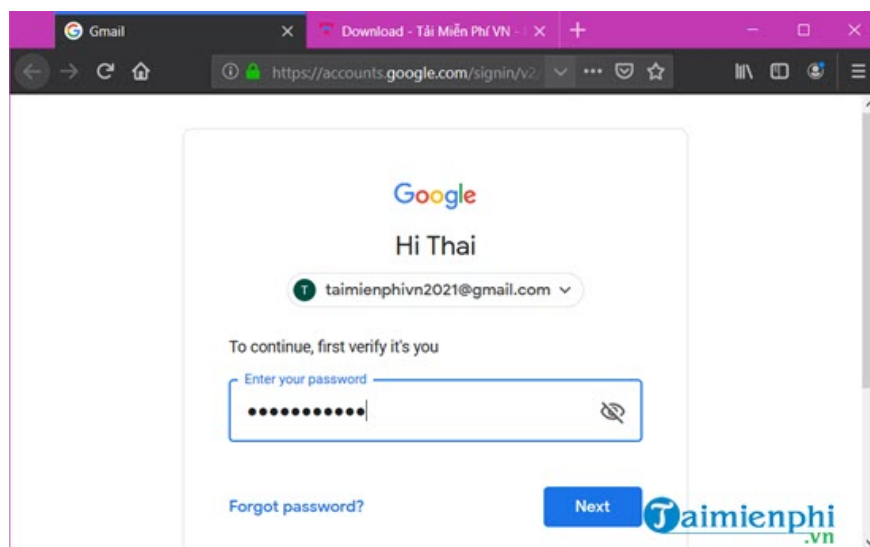


Step 4: A Gmail password reset notification will appear, and that's it, you've successfully changed your Gmail password.

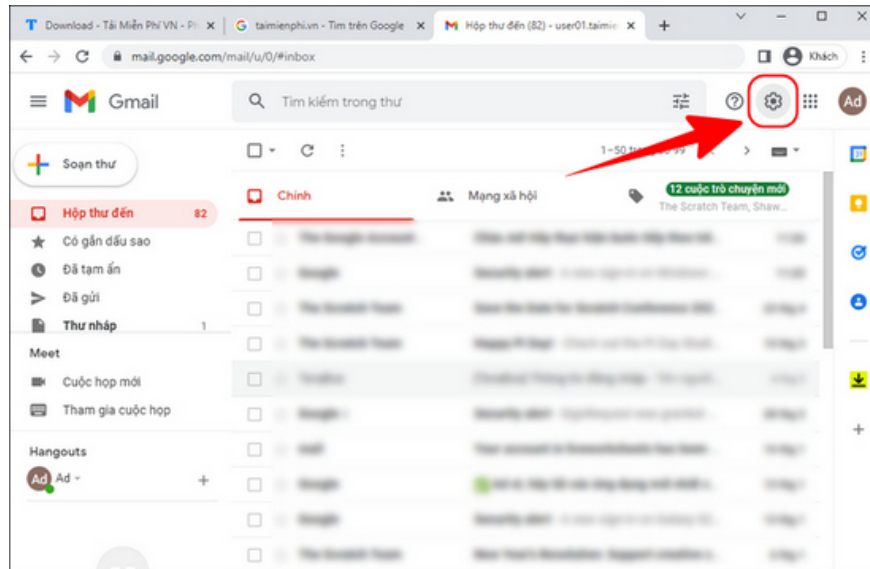


2. Change your Gmail password on your computer.

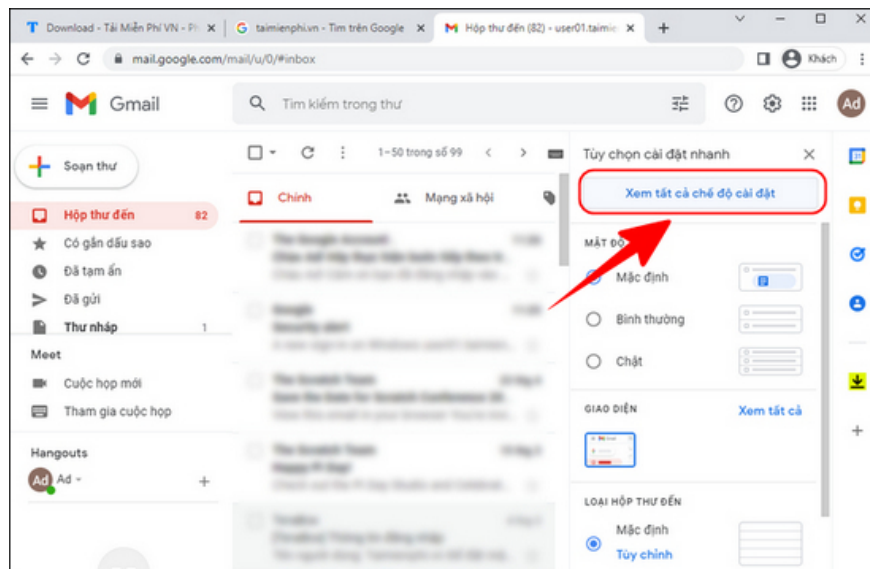
Step 1: The method for changing your Gmail password on the computer version is slightly different. First, log in to Gmail if you haven't logged in before.



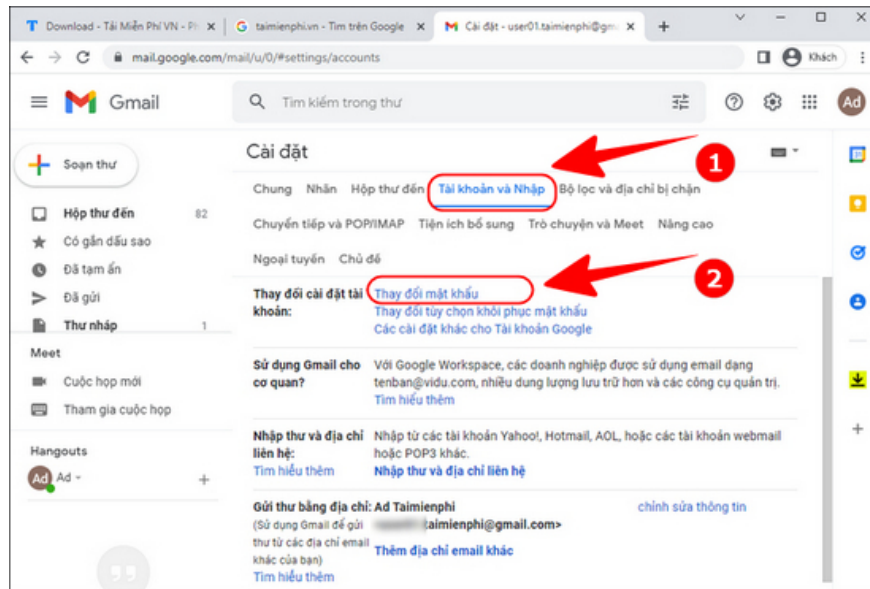
Step 2: Here, pay attention to **the gear icon** > click on it to bring up a menu bar, and in this bar, simply click on **Settings** .



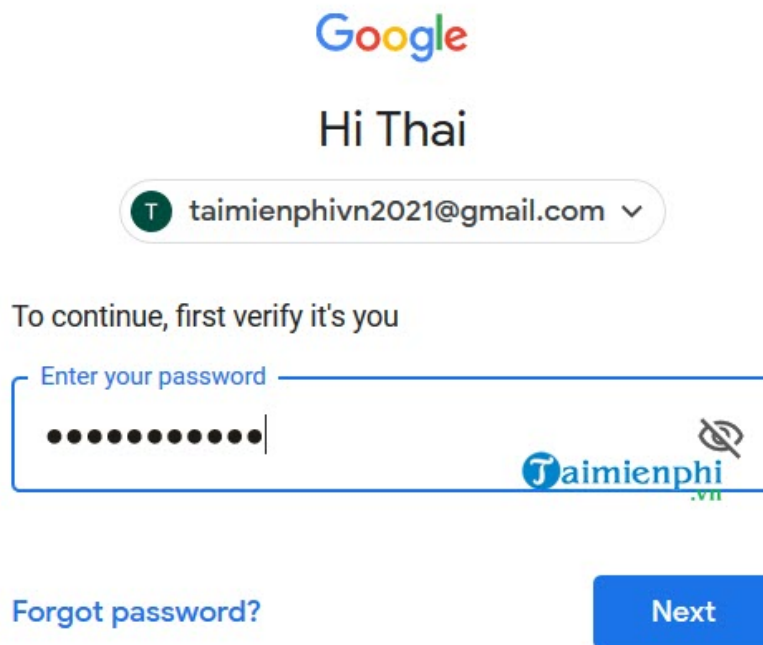
Select **View all settings**



Step 3: In the **Settings** section , select **Accounts and Import** -> choose **Change Password** to change your Gmail password.



Step 4: Next, re-enter your Gmail password to confirm it once more before proceeding with the password change.




Step 5: Then, simply enter your new password twice consecutively and click "Change Password" to complete the password change.
