

How to quickly delete iPhone lock screen notifications

To quickly delete notifications on iPhone, users can install LSPullToDismiss tweaks.

New notifications on the iPhone will display in turn on the lock screen or on the device's Notification Center. For iPhone devices that do not support 3D Touch, deleting the notification will take a lot of time, must click on the X in each notification.

If your device has been jailbroken, LSPullToDismiss can be installed, to reduce the operation of deleting notifications on the iPhone screen. Users will only need to perform one operation only. The following article will guide you how to use LSPullToDismiss tweak on iPhone.

Instructions to quickly delete iPhone notifications

Step 1:

We will install the LSPullToDismiss tweak on the SparkDev repository in Cydia. You can go to Cydia to search for tweaks or settings via the link below.

Step 2:

After the installation is complete, it will automatically work on the device that users do not need to change any settings of the settings on Settings, like other tweaks.

When displaying notifications on the lock screen, or notification center, users simply swipe down from the edge of the screen. Notifications will disappear from the screen.

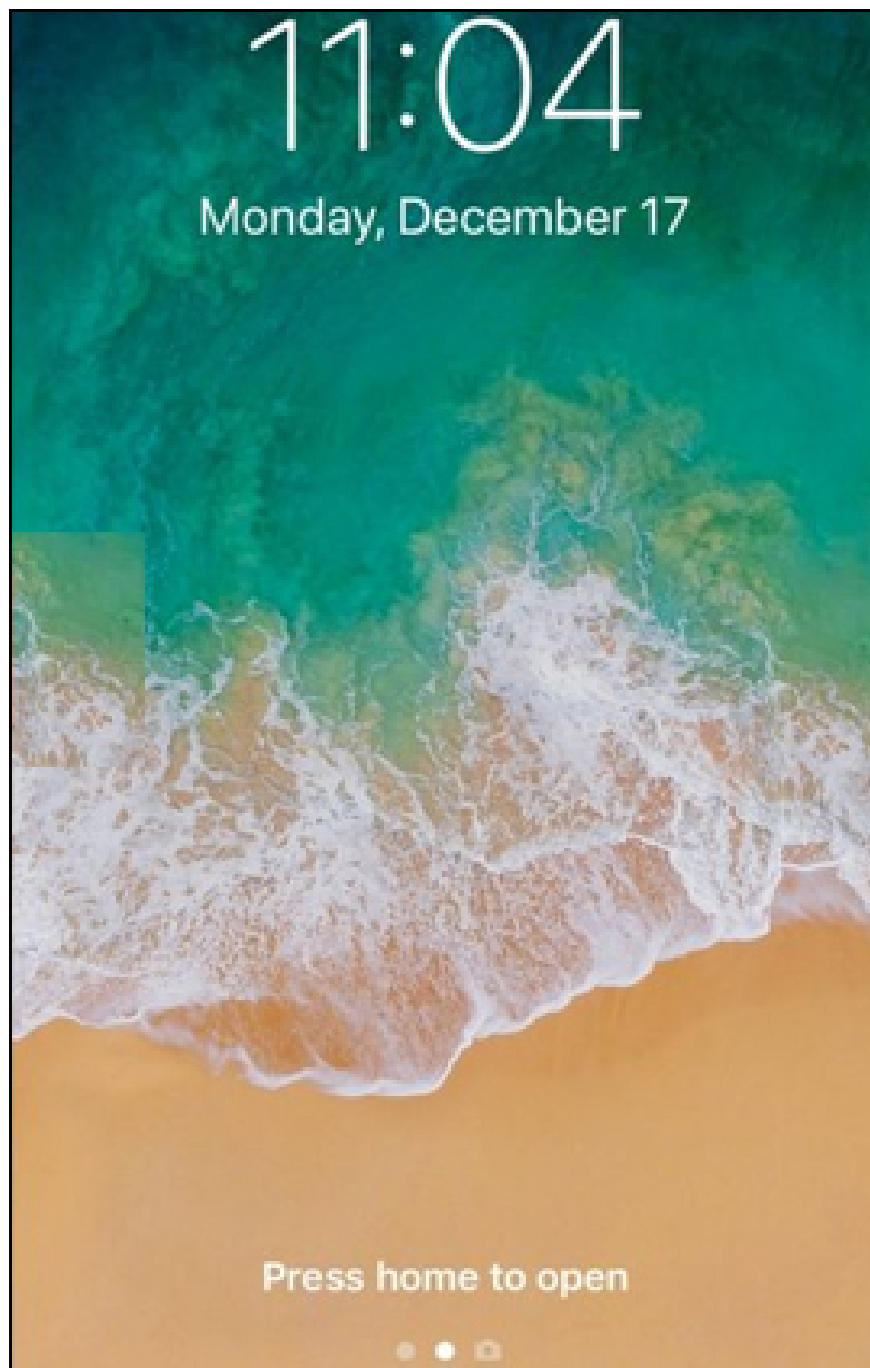

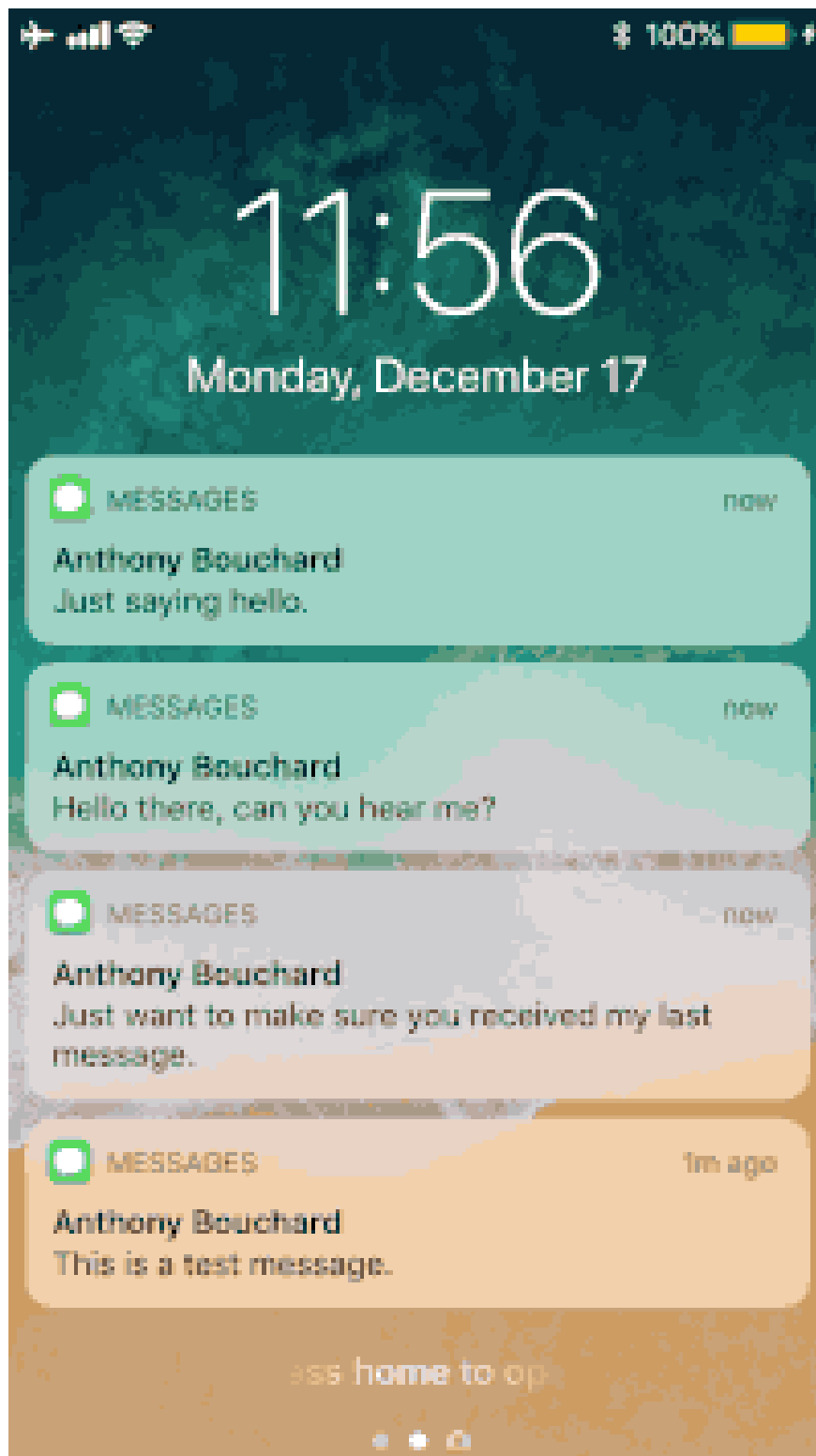

With devices that are not 3D Touch enabled, LSPullToDismiss tweaks will definitely be very helpful in deleting notifications. Instead of having to delete each message, now you just need to swipe once from the top edge to the bottom of the iPhone screen.
