

# How to quickly hide photos on Google Photos, not allowing them to be displayed

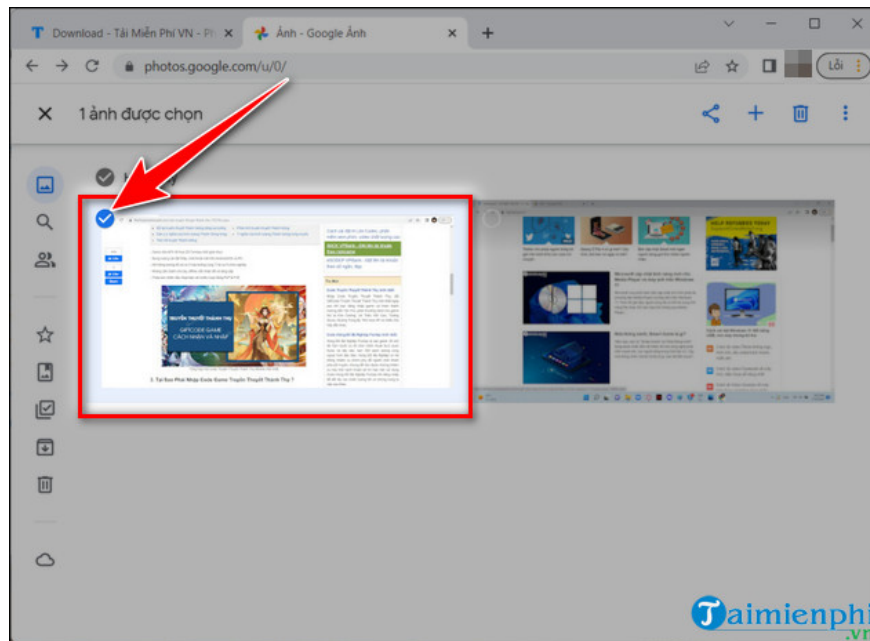
Currently, sharing photos on Google Photos is increasingly widely used by users. By allowing us to store and share high-quality photos, we can also hide photos on Google Photos to improve the necessary privacy with just a few simple steps.

**Google Photos** is Google's default app that helps users store images and use them everywhere. Those images are synchronized on the cloud storage space attached to the user's account, but sometimes we need to hide images on Google Photo, some private photos do not want to be seen by others.

## *How to hide photos on Google Photos*

*Step 1:* Access **Google Photos** [HERE](#) , log in to **your Google account** .

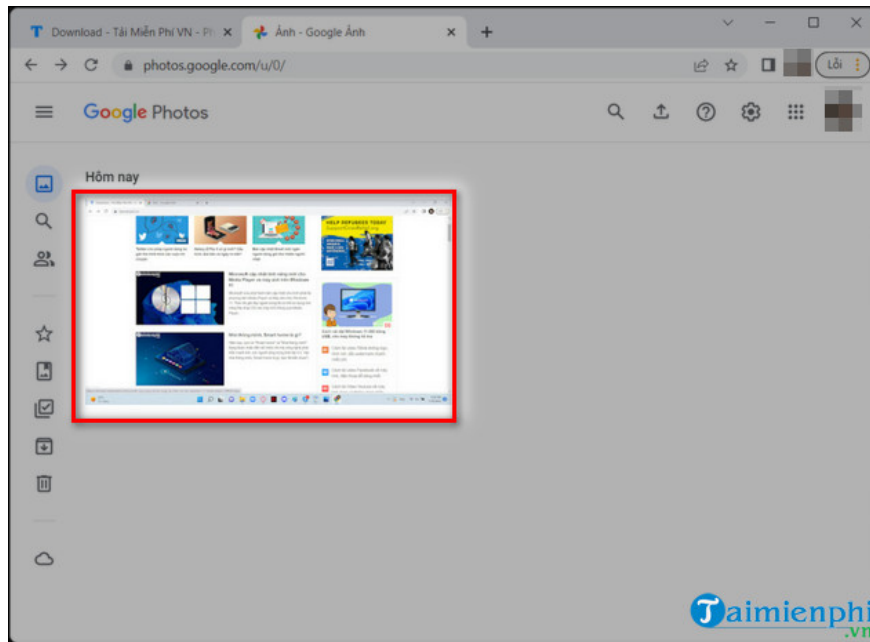
*Step 2:* Select **the photo to hide** by clicking the check mark in the left corner of the photo.



*Step 3:* Press the key combination **Shift + A** on the PC keyboard.

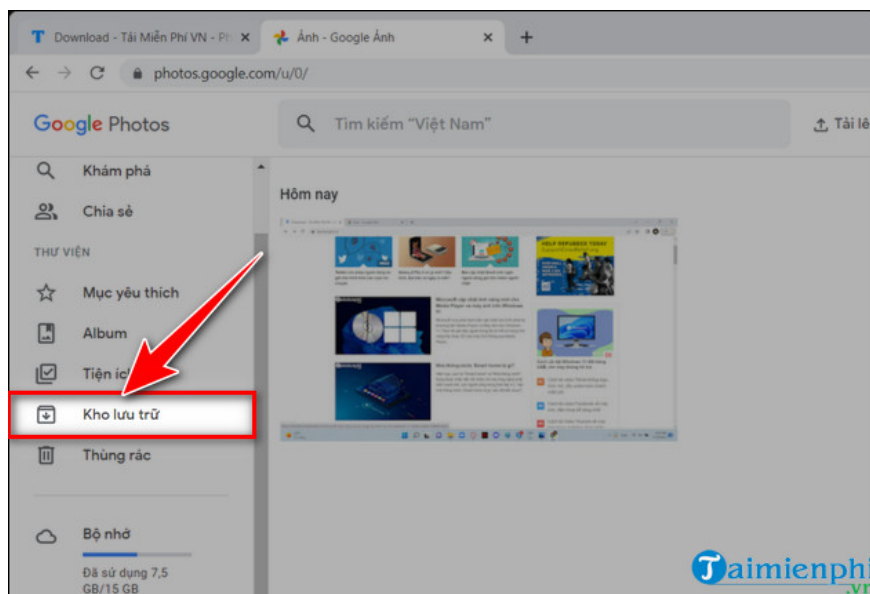


- Image results have been hidden



- If you want to see hidden photos, click on **archive** .

+ To restore hidden photos, select **the photo to restore** and press **Shift + A**.
