

# How to quickly take Windows screenshots on Macbook

If you are looking for a way to take a screenshot of Windows on a Macbook to save the information and images that appear on the screen, readers can refer to the instructions directly in the article below and follow the steps to take a screenshot. Windows image on Macbook is fastest and most effective.

Perhaps there is no need to say too much about how to take a screenshot of a Windows operating system computer. Because this is a basic feature on computers, it is too simple to use. Just press the Prt Scr key on the keyboard, you have successfully captured the computer screen. However, with a Macbook using the Windows operating system, it is not so simple. To take a Windows screenshot on a Macbook, users must use another method. The simple reason is that on the Macbook keyboard there is no Print Screen key to support taking quick photos. However, you can still take a screenshot of your macbook with other shortcuts. Please immediately refer to TipsMake's following instructions if you own a Macbook.

## *How to take a screenshot of Windows on Macbook:*

First, pay attention to what type of keyboard your Macbook has. Because each type of keyboard has a different structure of number keys.

### *1. How to take a screenshot of Windows on Macbook Pro, Air*

If you own a Macbook Pro or Air, taking photos is quite simple. Just press the key combination **Fn + Shift + F11** at the same time and you have successfully taken a screenshot.



Then you save the captured image using the **Fn + Shift + F11** key with any image saving tool on Windows, maybe **Paint**, **FastStone Capture** .

However, if Windows is not installed on your Macbook, you can still use the screenshot feature on Macbook through the instructions for taking screenshots on Macbook here.

## ***2. How to take a screenshot of Windows on Macbook with Apple Pro keyboard***

If you own an Apple Pro keyboard. You need to pay attention to the row of F keys above. There will be more keys than the Windows keyboard. Compared to F1~F12 of the Windows keyboard, Apple Pro supports up to F15. And the Windows screenshot key on Macbook using the Apple Pro keyboard is the **F14 key**.

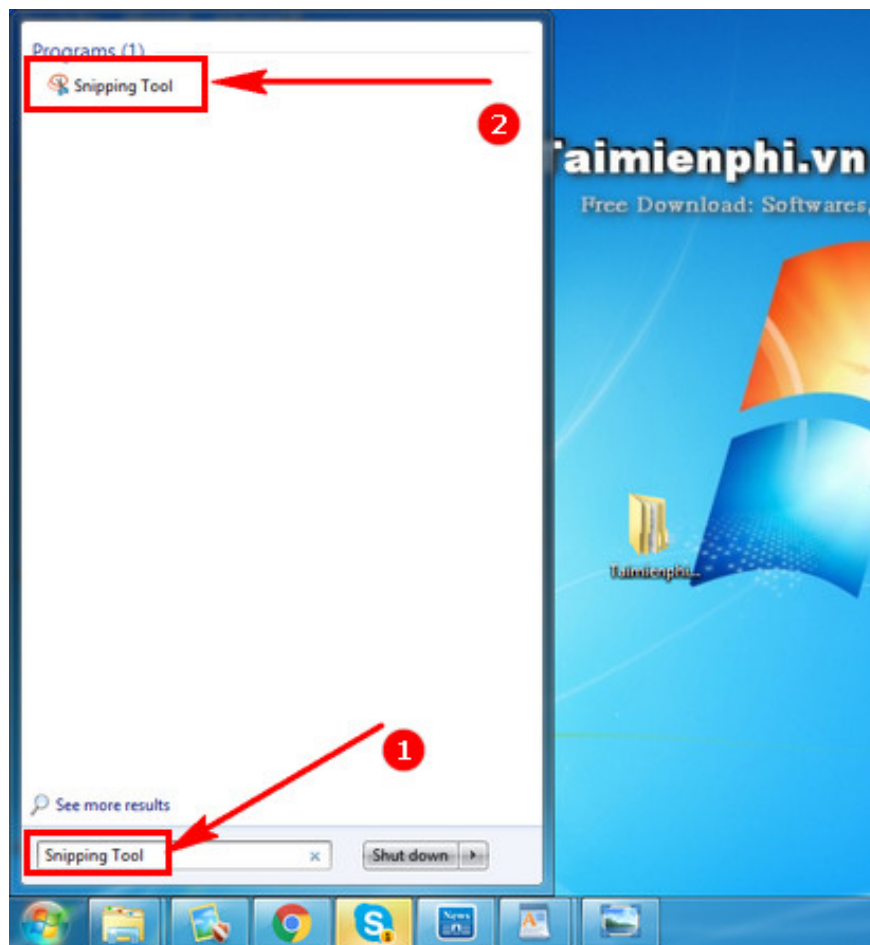


Then you save the captured image using the F14 key with any image saving tool on Windows, maybe **Paint**, **FastStone** .

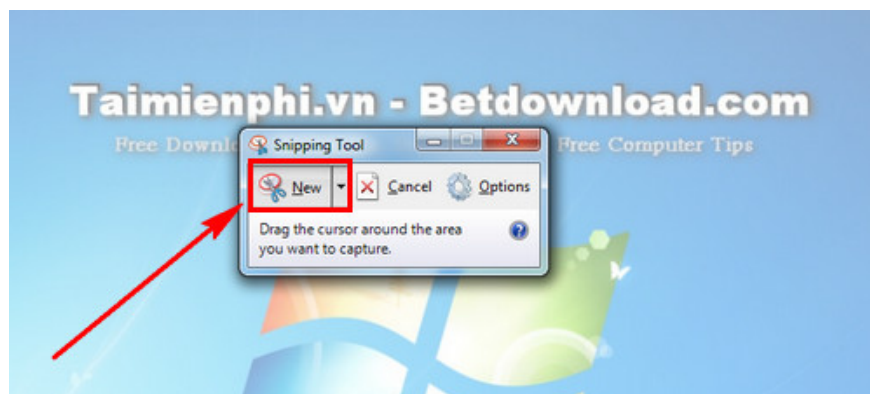
## ***3. How to take a screenshot of Windows on Macbook using Snipping Tool***

**Step 1:** On the Windows operating system, the **Snipping Tool** application is equipped to take Windows screenshots without the keyboard.

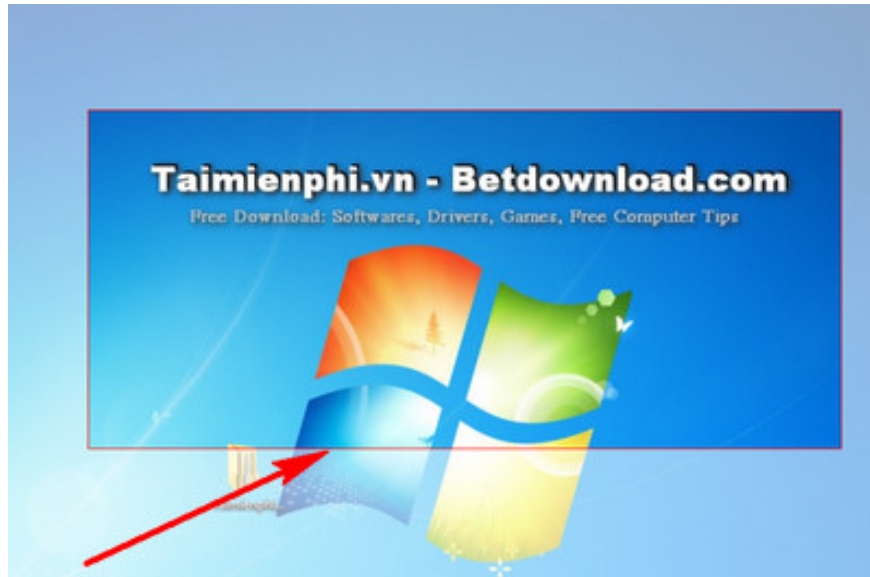
Click **Start** > search for the **Snipping Tool** application and open it.



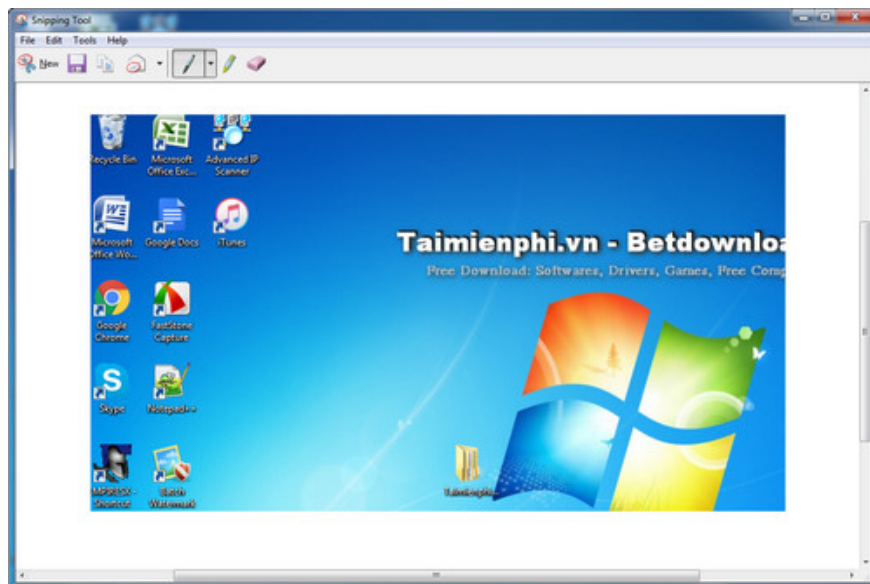
**Step 2:** In the Snipping Tool interface, click **New**.



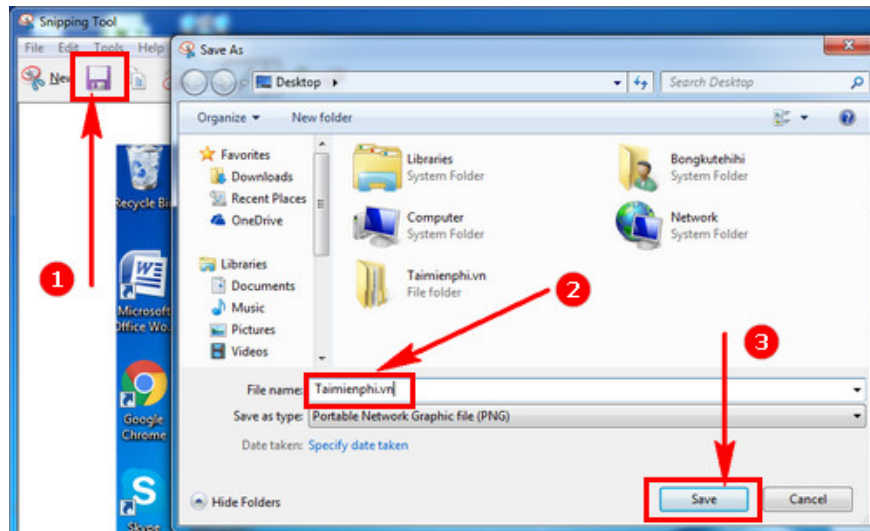
Then you **scan** the area you want to capture on the Macbook screen.



**Release the mouse** and you will have the newly scanned image on the screen in the Snipping Tool application.



**Step 3:** Finally click the **Save** icon . Create an arbitrary image name and click Save to save.



Above are 3 ways to support users using Macbooks to install the Windows operating system version to take Windows screenshots on Macbooks. Actually, the process is no different than on a laptop or regular computer, it's just that the location of the screenshot key on the Macbook is different from the computer keyboard. This is also how to take screenshots on the Macbook for those of you who Who doesn't know how to do it?
