We all know that reading is not important in terms of the number of books read but the quality. When we read books, we are immersed in that wonderful world, we live the lives of the people in the books, we dream and learn many things from them. However, what should we do when we need to read and analyze in large detail a large amount of information quickly? What to do when we need to read quickly to study and write a summary tomorrow? How to read quickly without missing out on the most important content and aspects of that book?

Each of us can **learn to read fast** . The first skill that everyone thinks of is fast reading, although it works but it is not the only way you can use it. Here are instructions to show you how to become one of the **fastest readers at a rate of 10,000 words in a minute** . Invite you to consult!

1. Stop listening to the voice in your head



Many of us are in the habit of " *listening* " to the words in our heads when reading but don't listen to them because they always slow down your reading. In your head you are " *pronouncing* " every word you read and your task is to turn off that voice. How can I do that? Try chewing gum or eating something while reading to avoid reading out loud. Besides, with the habit of reciting you can also apply this method.

2. Don't look back at the words you read

Our eyes often stop at the words we just read. The reason is not because the word is difficult to understand but simply a habit of slowing down our reading process. The simple way is not to look back at the words you've read just to read it again. If you yourself have this habit, it may be difficult to quit, but the first thing you need to do is be aware of it and avoid doing so later. You may need to practice for a period of time but you will definitely see the value of this.

3. Don't read every word



Reading word by word is not a good way when you want to read fast. To understand and analyze key information from what you read, you don't need to read every word in the sentence. Try reading a block of information: focus on the main point between the lines to read the whole and try to understand its meaning. Once you've mastered this trick, you can focus on the point at the center of the page and avoid the habit of reading line by line.

4. Avoid all distractions

Maybe you think you will read better when listening to music or sitting in a crowded cafe, but your reading speed will definitely increase if you minimize all the things that distract you. at a minimum. Try to find a completely private and quiet place to read, or if you still find this to be useless, you can use the ear plug to limit all noise.

5. Ignore the possible things



You do not need to read every word, every sentence or every chapter in a book or booklet to understand its meaning. A small but very effective tip is to skim over all kinds of books and scientific documents. Try the following: read the introduction to find the main content, then read the conclusion, then go back to the chapter to find and read the most important parts.

6. Don't read it over and over again

Many people have a habit of reading and rereading sentences or words to make sure they understand the meaning of each word, but this generally doesn't make sense. To avoid rereading, use a blank sheet of paper to cover the lines you have read.

7. Use hand pointing lines to focus more



You may find it difficult to focus your eyes on certain information, although smooth eye movement is essential and important if you want to read quickly. Some simple techniques such as putting your finger under each line and the page you read can help your eyes move and focus on the specific part of the writing. However, keep in mind that this trick may not work for everyone because it can limit your reading process but is useful to others.

8. Practice

Quick reading is not possible if you do not spend time practicing. A person cannot just sit and use all the tips below at the same time, because reading at a fast pace is not a technical process but a skill. No one can be skilled without training, so practice regularly, even if you don't have a deadline for reading.

9. Read a few books at once



Have you ever heard of **Jeff Ryan** , who can read 366 books in a year? Try doing the same by reading a few books at once to get information faster. The trick here is to distinguish the books you read, try reading different types of books to avoid confusion.

10. Listen to books

If you don't have enough time or the opportunity to **READ** all the books you need (*of course you can't always have a book in your hand*), use a little trick to **LISTEN** them. If you are not a person who likes to learn by listening, you may find it difficult to receive information in this way, but try to see what happens.

11. There is a clear purpose



This is very simple. Answer the questions: What do you read that book for? Do you want to have fun reading or want information? Setting a clear goal can help you read quickly, but if you read to get information, your goal

will be to find the main information and some specific information in the book, so you won't need it. Focus on unnecessary words, paragraphs or chapters.
