

How to recover audio files on an Android phone: Simple and easy steps

You accidentally deleted an audio file and now want to recover it on your Android phone but don't know how. Read this article on how to recover audio files on your Android phone for the easiest and most effective way to retrieve them.

There are two ways to recover audio files on an Android phone: the first is to use a backup, and the other is to use third-party software. TipsMake will provide detailed instructions below; please refer to them.



The most effective way to recover deleted audio files on an Android phone.

Method 1: Recover audio files via backup.

Android devices automatically sync data to Google Drive . Therefore, the first solution for recovering deleted audio files on an Android phone is to use a backup.



Note: If you choose this method, make sure you have enabled the backup option before any data loss occurs.

Follow the steps below:

Step 1 : First, log in to your Google account to access Google Drive and retrieve your data.

Step 2: Next, find and open the **Recent Backup** folder to access the data synchronized from your Android device.

Step 3: Open the folder containing your audio files and notes, then select the audio files you want to restore.

Step 4: Save these files to your desktop and transfer them to your Android device.

Method 2: How to recover audio files on an Android phone using software - Recoverit Data Recovery

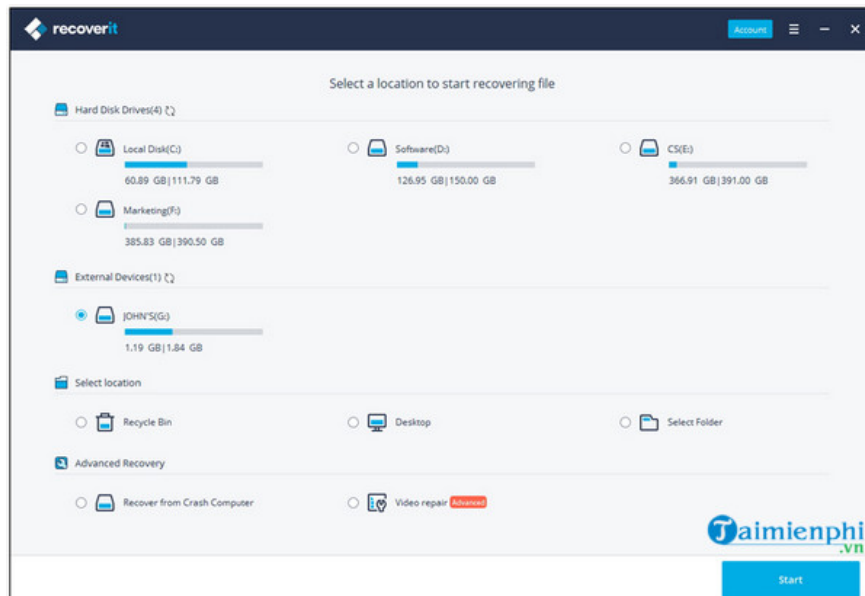
Another way to recover audio files on an Android phone is to use Recoverit Data Recovery. The software integrates a range of data backup and recovery features , including the recovery of deleted audio files.

Follow the steps below:

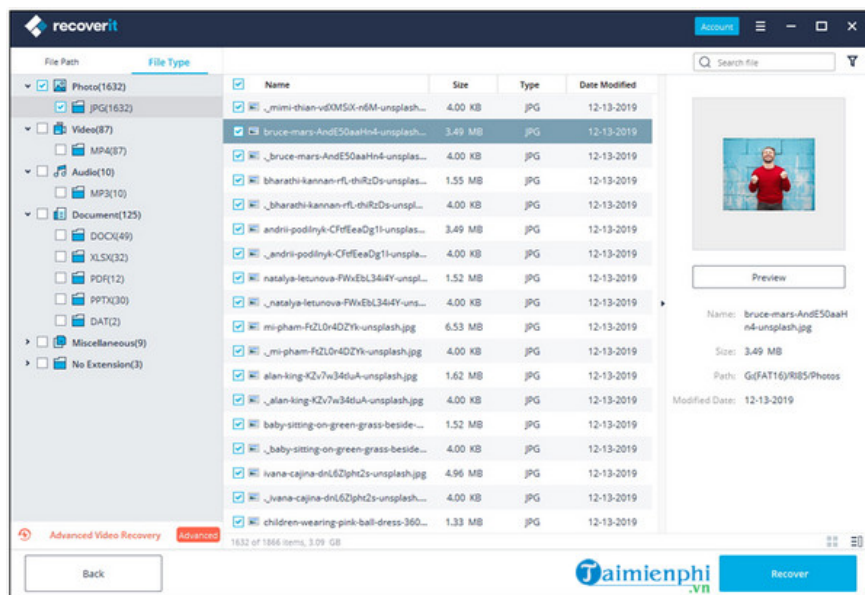
Step 1: Download Recoverit Data Recovery to your computer.

Step 2 : Connect your Android device to your computer using a USB cable.

Step 3 : Select your device, then click **the Start button** to begin the scanning and data recovery process.



Step 4: Wait until the scanning process is complete. This process will be faster or slower depending on the number and size of your audio files.



Step 5: A list of recoverable files will now appear on the screen. All you need to do is review the list, then click the **"Recover"** button to recover and save the files to a safe location.



Note: Avoid saving the recovery file to the original location to prevent overwriting data.
