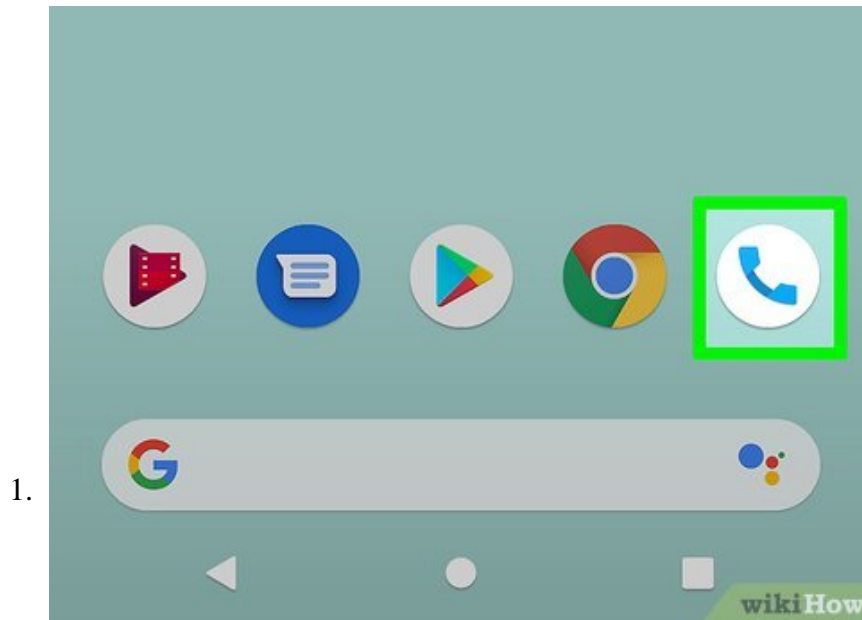


How to Recover Deleted Voicemail Messages on Android

Method 1 of 2:

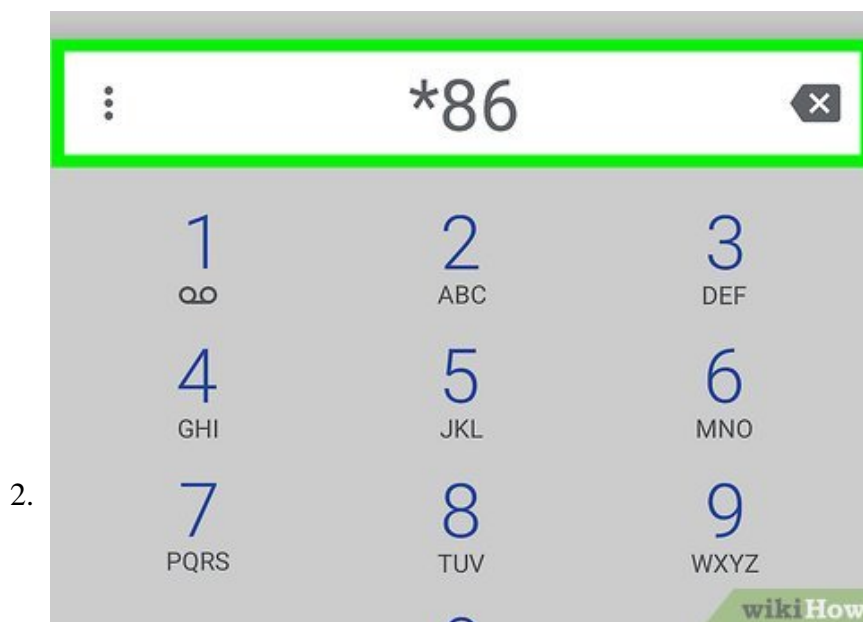
Recovering a Voicemail on the Voicemail System



Open the

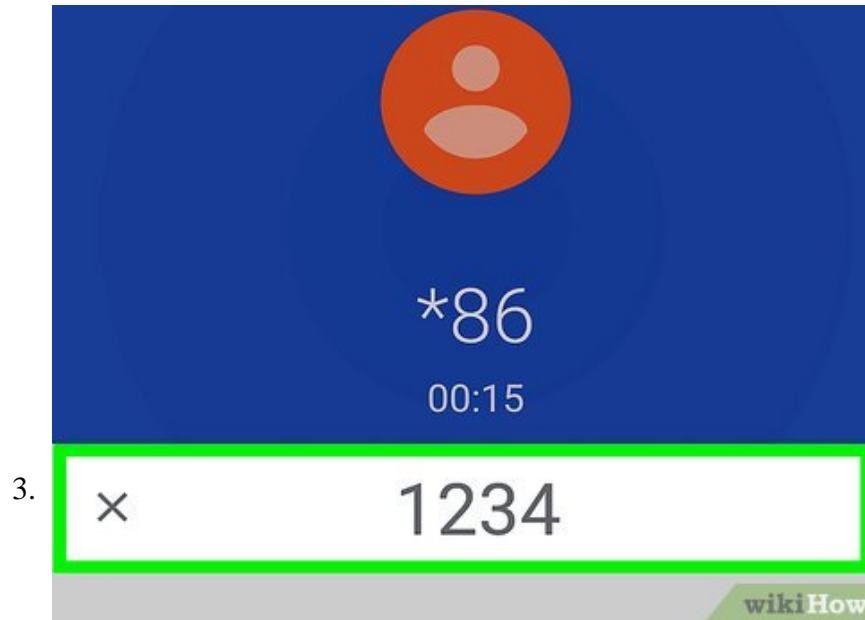


Phone app. This will typically be on the home row at the bottom of your screen. Check your app drawer if it is not there.

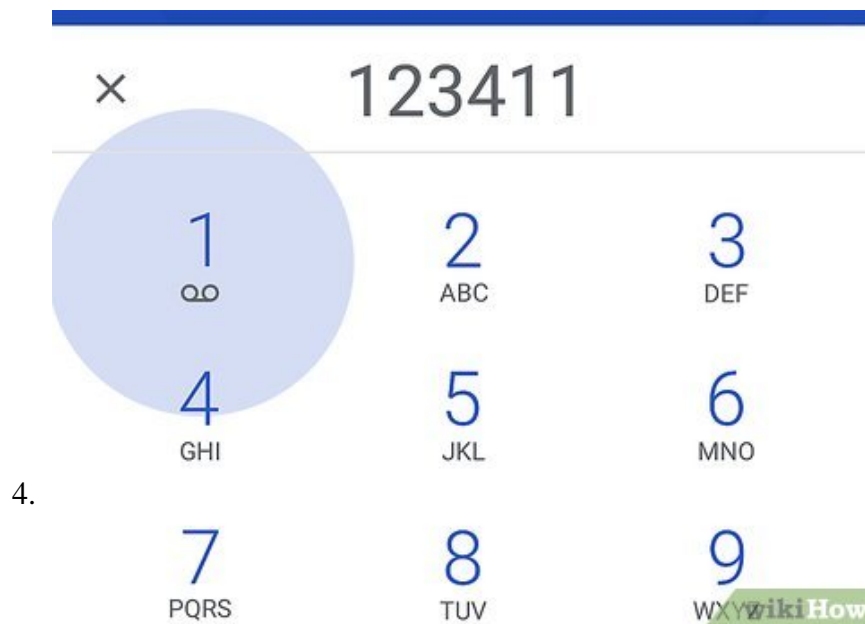


Call the number for your voicemail system. This number will vary based on your provider.

1. Call ***86** on Verizon Wireless or U.S. Cellular.
2. Press and hold **1** if you are on AT&T, T-Mobile, Sprint, Cellular One, or Metro PCS.



Enter your voicemail password if prompted. You may need to contact your service provider if you can't remember the password.



Listen to your new or saved voicemails. New messages will usually play automatically, or you can press **1** to listen to your saved messages.

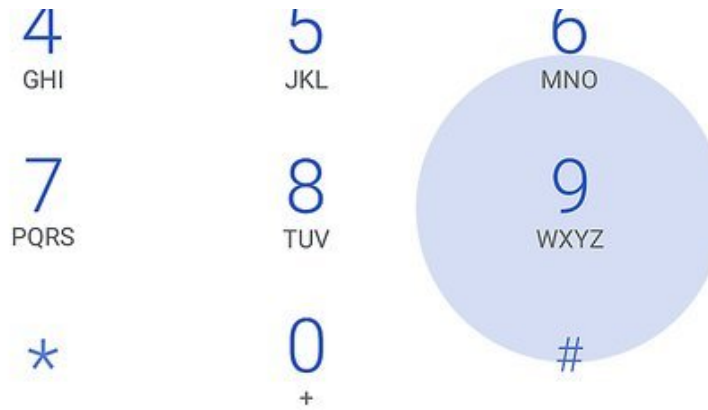

Press 7 to delete a voicemail.

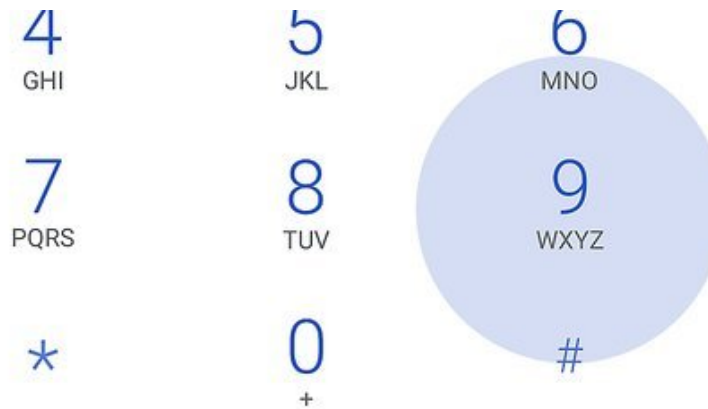
Press 1 on the Message Playback menu.

Press 9 to Check Erased Messages.

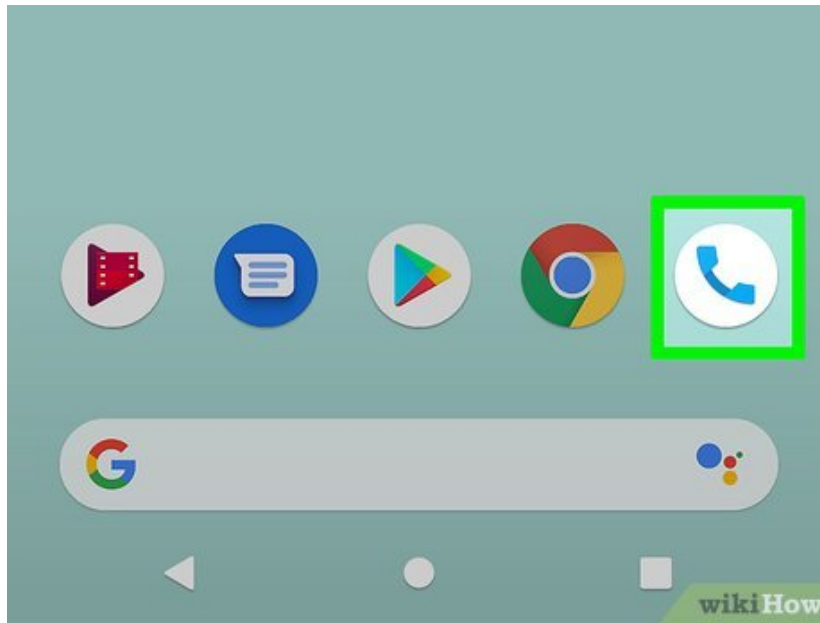
Press 9 to save the message to your voicemail box.^[1]

1. If you already hung up, the only way to recover a voicemail is through third-party programs.

Method 2 of 2:

Undoing an Accidental Deletion

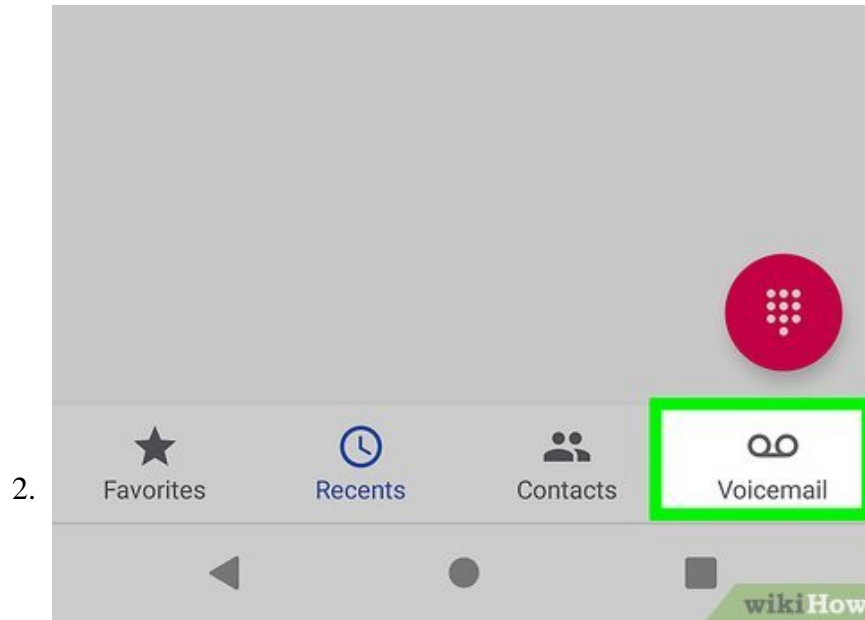

Open the

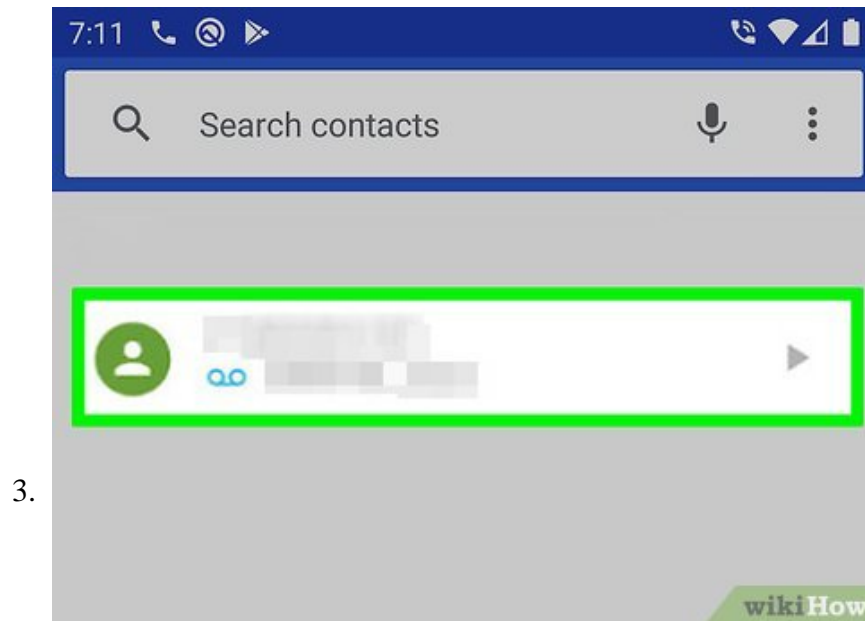


Phone app. This will typically be on the home row at the bottom of your screen. Check your app drawer if it is not there.



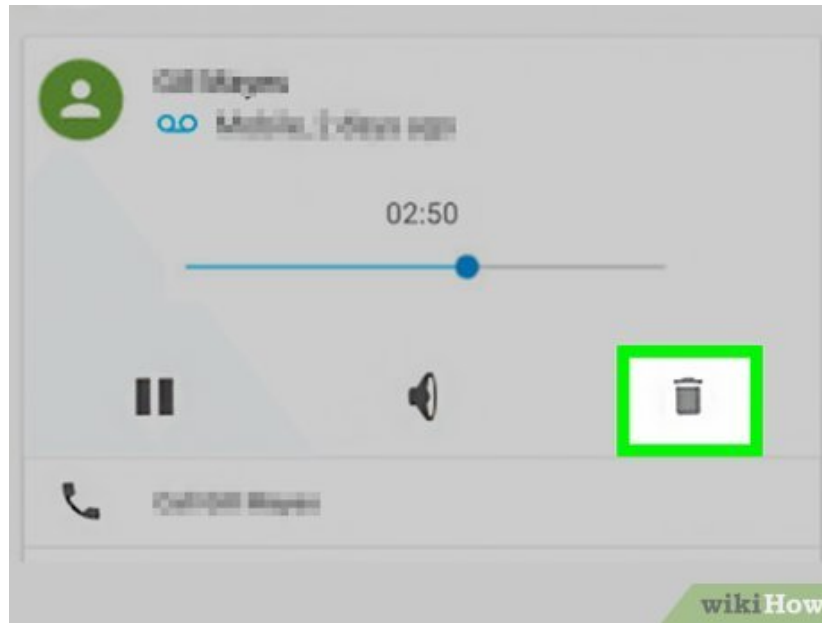
Tap on **Voicemail**. This should be on the bottom left-hand corner of the screen.

1. Some devices will have **Voicemail** as its own app. If this is the case, then check your app drawer for **Voicemail**.

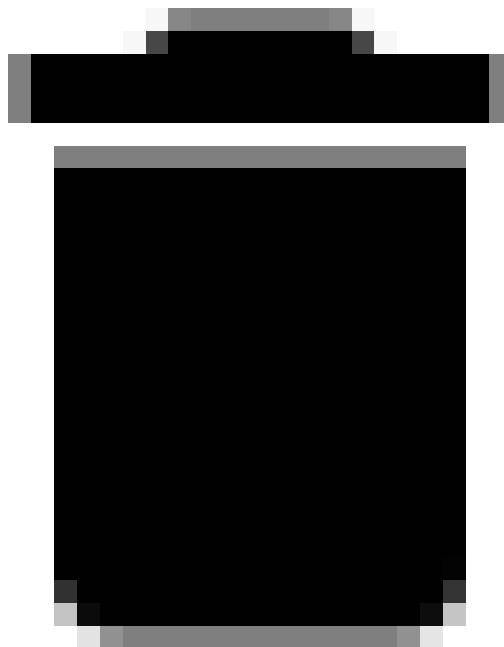


Tap on a voicemail from the list.

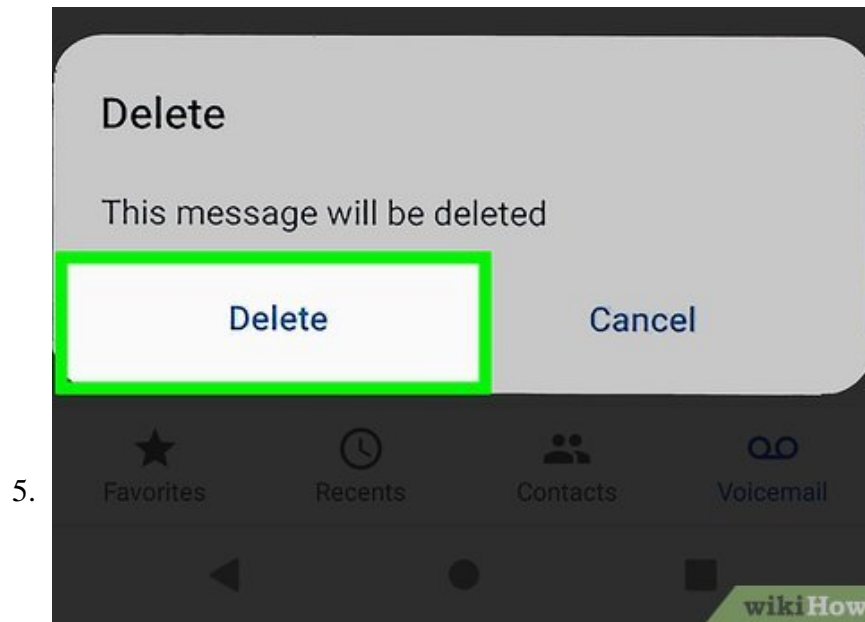

Tap on the



delete button. This will delete the voicemail.



Tap on on the pop-up screen at the bottom. You will only have a few seconds to do this, so you will need to quickly tap on . Once the pop-up screen disappears, there is no way to recover your voicemail without the use of third-party programs.

1. Your device may also list this option as **Undelete**.^[2]
