

How to reduce photo size in batches with High Quality Photo Resize

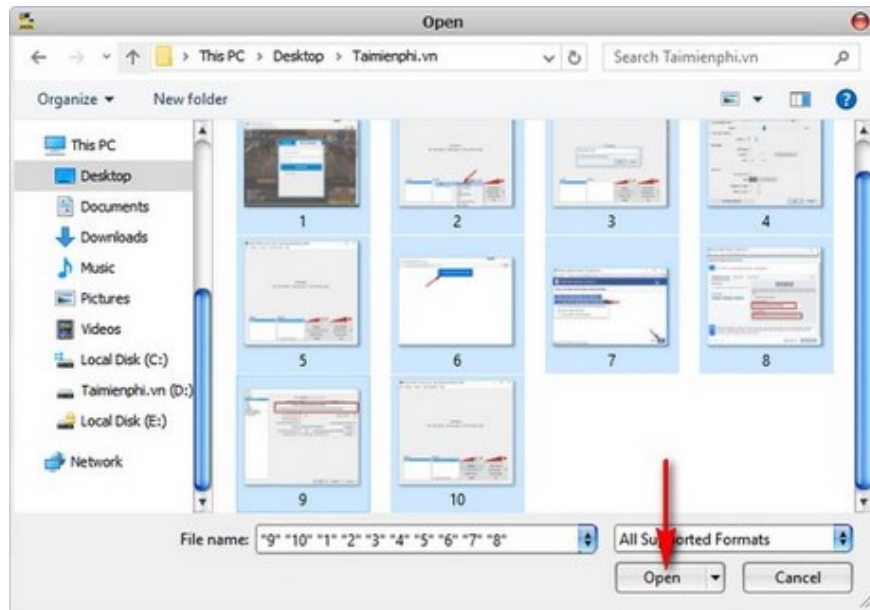
INSTRUCTIONS FOR REDUCING PHOTO SIZE IN BULK WITH HIGH QUALITY PHOTO RESIZE

Step 1: Download and install High Quality Photo Resize here: Download **High Quality Photo Resize**

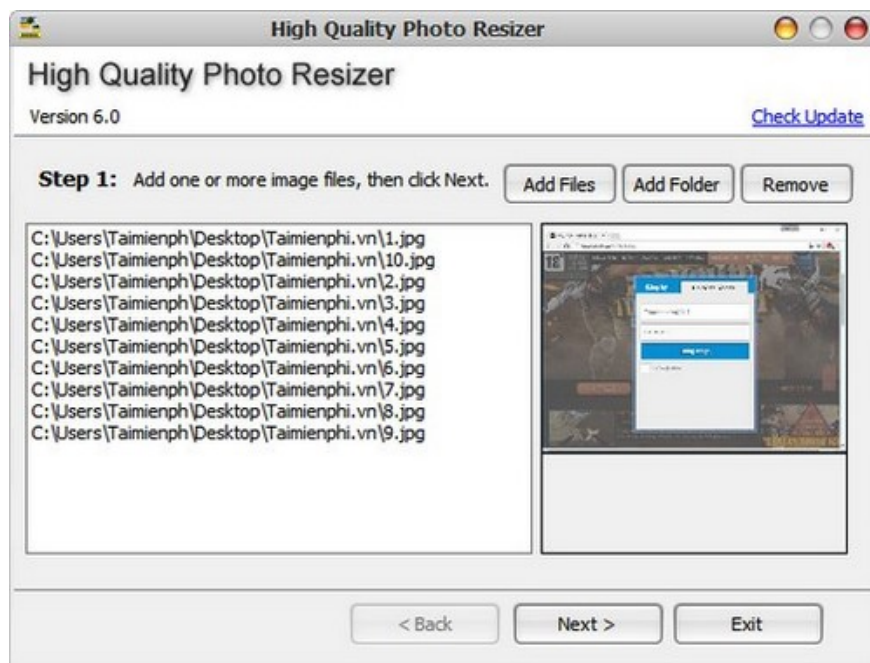
Step 2: After installing the High Quality Photo Resize batch image compression software, launch the tool. At the main interface of the tool, you can select **Add Files** to add one or more photos or select **Add Folder** to add all photos in a folder.



Step 3: The tool will automatically recognize all image files with extensions MP, DIB, EMF, GIF, ICB, JPG, JPEG, PBM, PCD, PCX, PGM, PNG, PPM, PSD, PSP, RLE, SGI, TGA, TIF, TIFF, VDA, VST, WBMP, WMF. Select one or more photos that you want to reduce the image size in batches and then select **Open** .



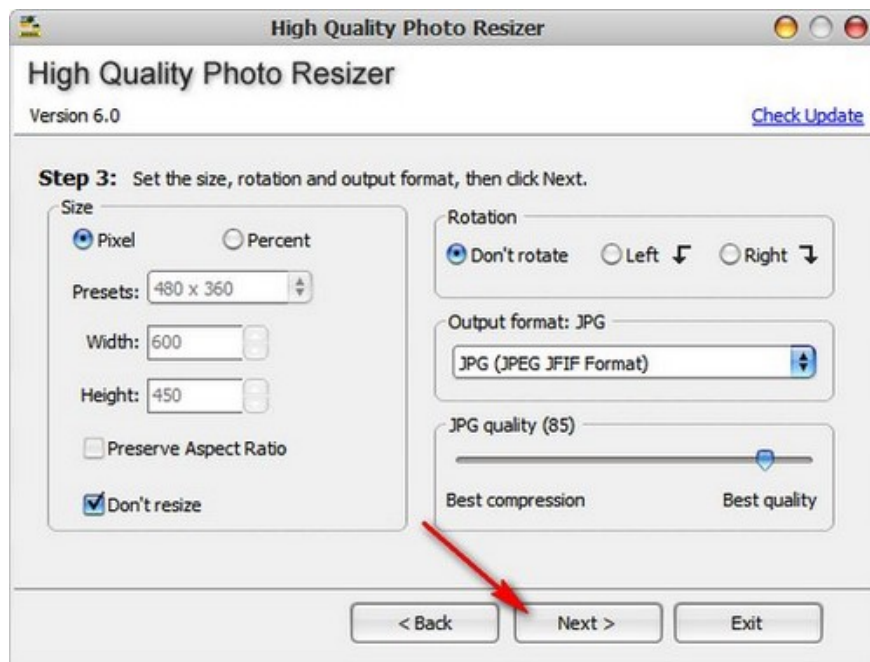
Step 4: After adding, the photos you choose to reduce the photo size in bulk are displayed in a list on the main interface of the application. Click **Next** to continue.



Step 5: Here you can choose the folder to store the compressed images at **Browse**. Note that the software will not automatically create a folder for you, so you need to create a separate folder and lead to that folder. After setting the path, click **Next** .



Step 6: Here, you have the options to change the size by pixel ratio (**Pixel**) or by percentage (**Percent**). Select **Don't resize** if you still want to keep the original size. In the **Rotation** section , you can choose to rotate all images to the left (**Left**) or right (**Right**), then select the output image format (**Output format**) and image quality (**JPG Quality**), the lower the image quality, the lower the image size. Click **Next** when you have finished setting up.



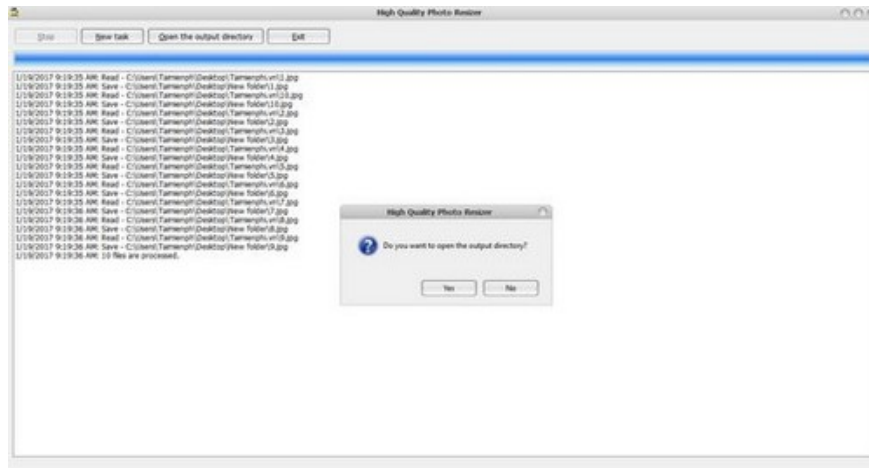
Step 7: The tool gives you many effects such as blur , noise , **fish** eye effect and many other effects you can add. Select **No effect** if you **do not** want to add any effects to the photo then click **Next** .



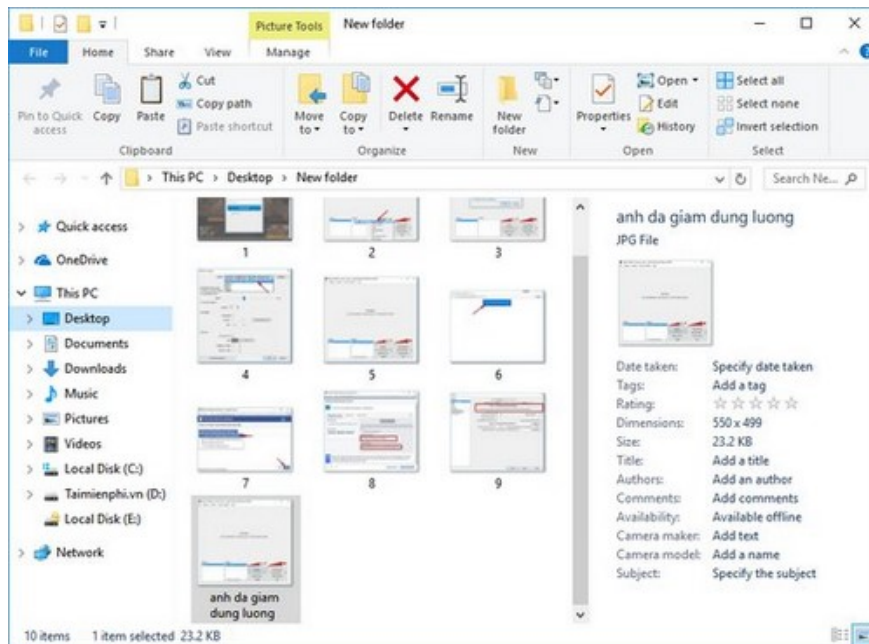
Step 8: Click **Start** to start reducing photo size in batches.



Step 9: After reducing the image size in batch, the tool will ask you if you want to open the output directory (**Do you want to open the output directory?**).



Step 10: You can compare the reduced image with the original image. In this example, Taimienphi has reduced the image size to 23.2 KB compared to 31 KB before reducing the size.
