

How to remove a Windows 11 computer password

Users often set passwords to log into their Windows 11 computers to prevent unauthorized access. However, having to enter a password every time is quite inconvenient, so some users are considering removing it. So how do you remove a Windows 11 computer password? Here's everything you need to know.

The Windows login screen is a security feature that can protect your computer from unauthorized access. Someone needs your password to log in. If you don't enter the correct password to log into Windows, you will be denied access. When your computer is not being used by others or in public places, you can turn off the password protection screen in Windows. Below, TipsMake will guide you **on how to remove the password on your Windows 11 computer** .

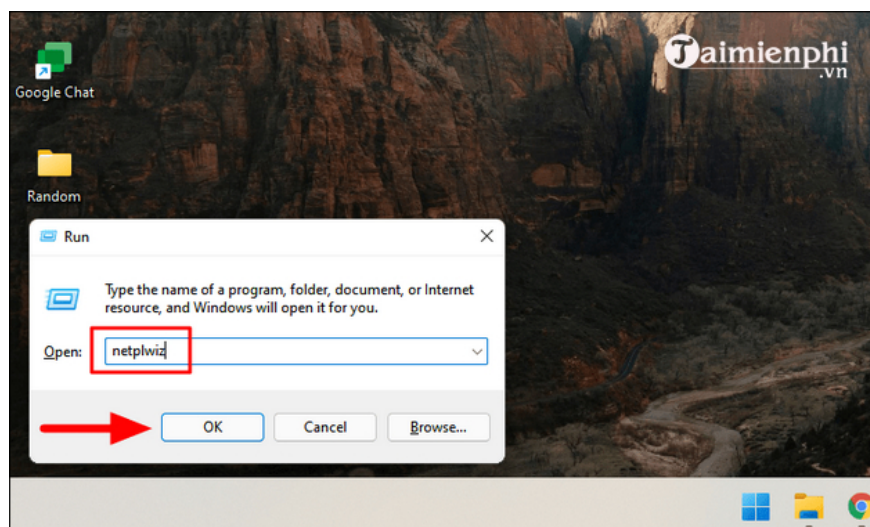
I. How to remove a Windows 11 computer password for a Microsoft account

Before we begin, there are some important things to note. If you're logged into your Windows 11 PC with a Microsoft account, you can't delete your login password, but you can disable it. You can only delete login passwords on locally created accounts, or what Microsoft calls offline accounts.

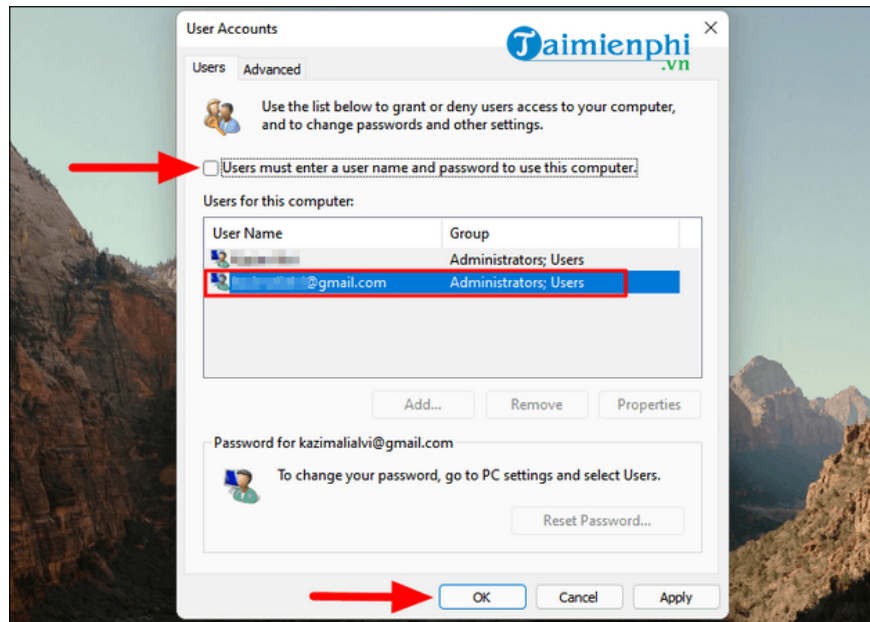
1. Remove the Windows 11 computer password through the User Accounts window.

This is probably the easiest way to disable login passwords on Windows 11 for both Microsoft and local accounts. Here's how:

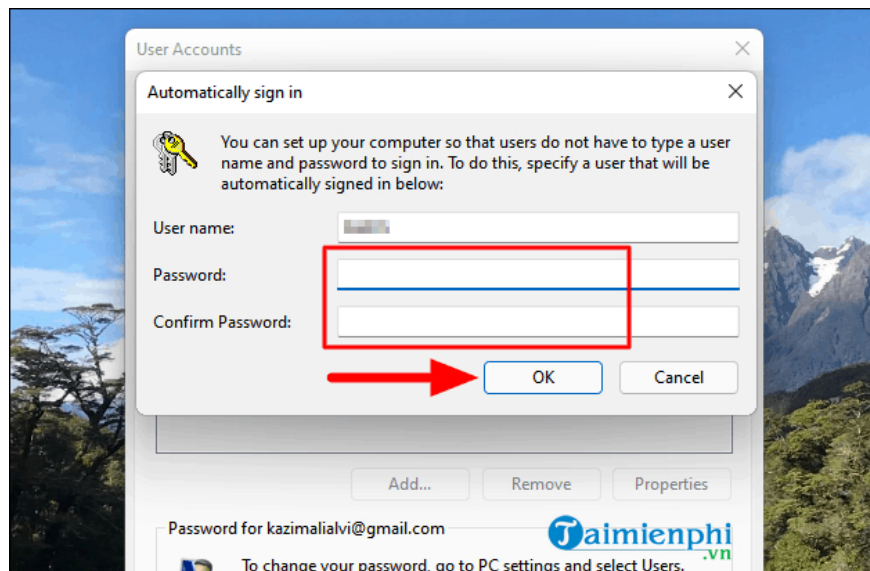
Step 1: Press the Windows + R shortcut key to open the **Run** dialog box . Then, type **netplwiz** and press **Enter**.



Step 2: In the User Account window , select the account you want to remove the password for and uncheck " **Users must enter a username and password to use this computer"** . Then, click **OK**.



Step 3: In this step, you enter the login information for the Microsoft/local account associated with your computer. You can enter a username or email address in the **User name** field and then enter a password in the following two fields. Finally, click **OK** to save the changes.



2. Remove Windows 11 computer password using Registry

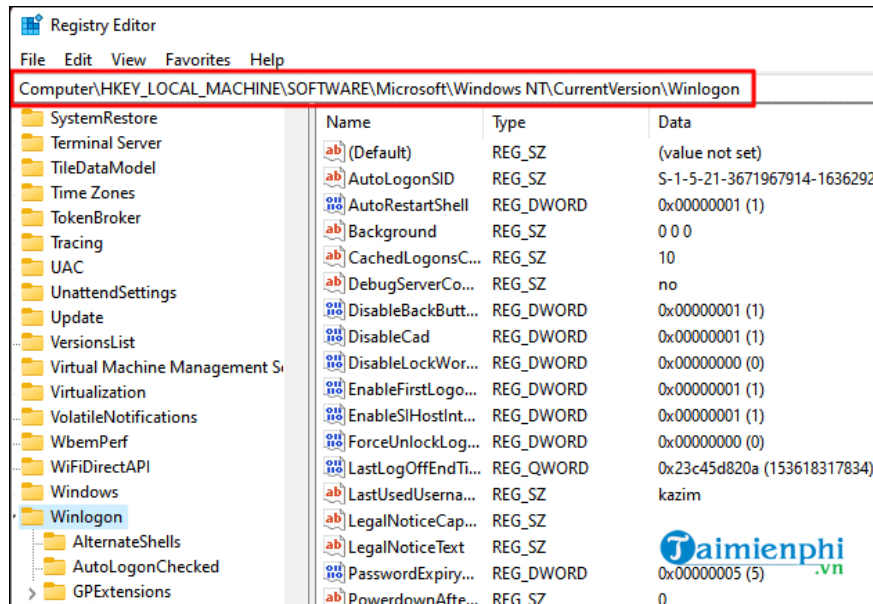
You can also disable your Windows 11 computer login password from the Registry. Making changes to the Registry requires extreme caution, as any mistake can cause system errors. Therefore, you should back up your Registry settings before making any modifications so you can restore them if problems occur.

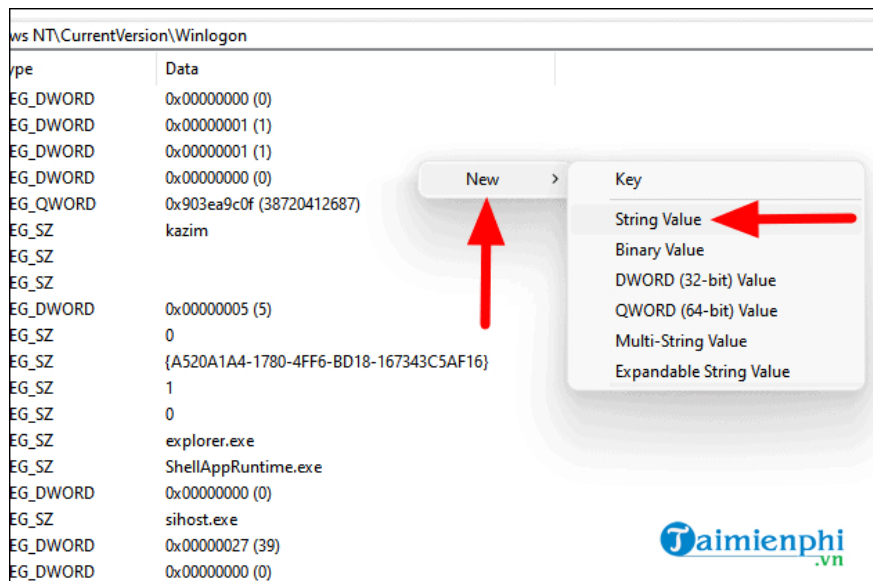
Step 1: Type " **Registry Editor**" into Windows Search and click on the corresponding search result.

Step 2: In **Registry Editor** , navigate to the following path or paste it into the address bar at the top and press **ENTER**.

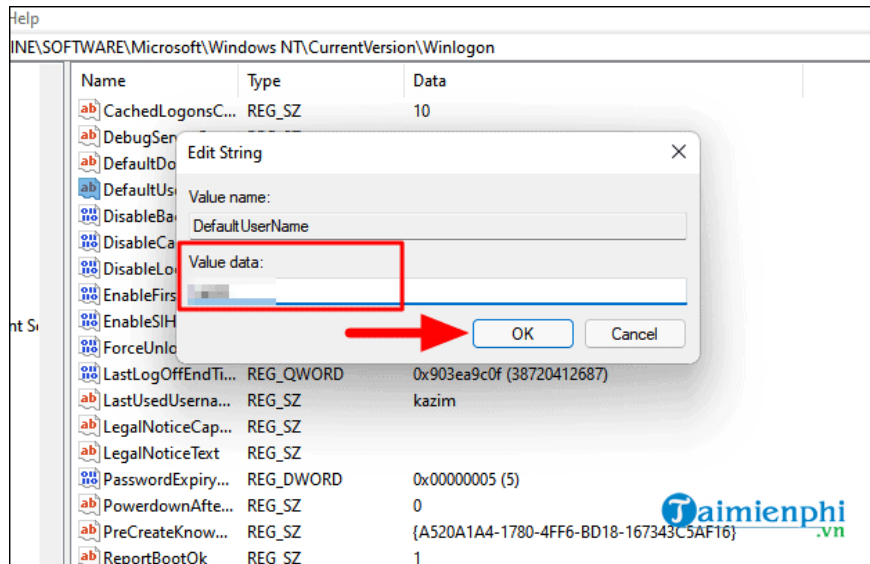
Computer\HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows NT\CurrentVersion\Winlogon



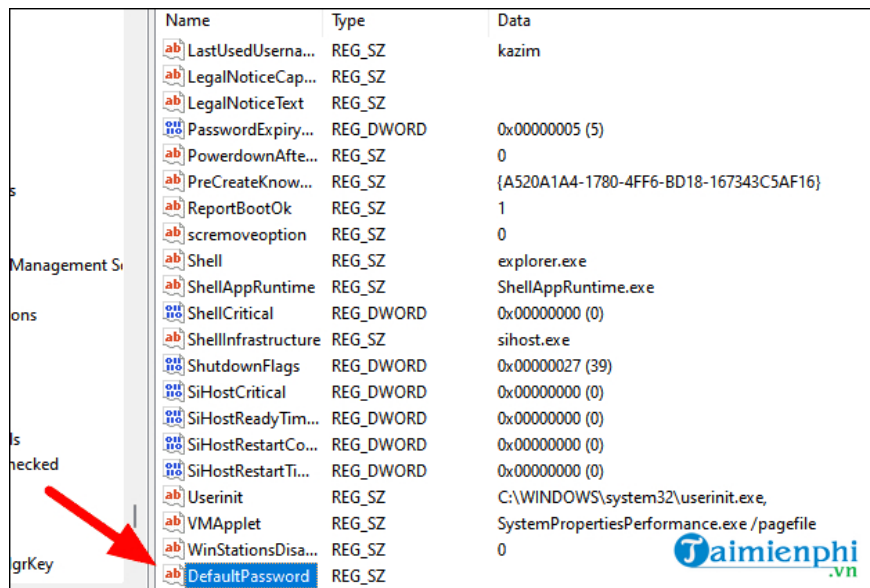
Step 3: In the **Winglogon** folder , find the string **DefaultUserName** e. If it's not there, right-click on the empty space, select **New > String Value** from the list of options, and name the string **DefaultUserName**.



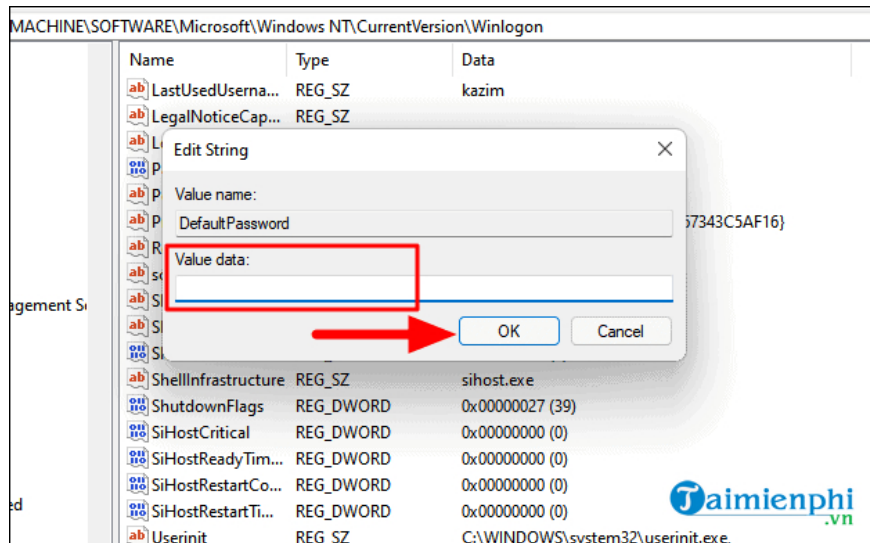
Step 4: Double-click the string you just created, enter your Microsoft account username or email address in the **Value data** field , and click **OK** to save the changes.



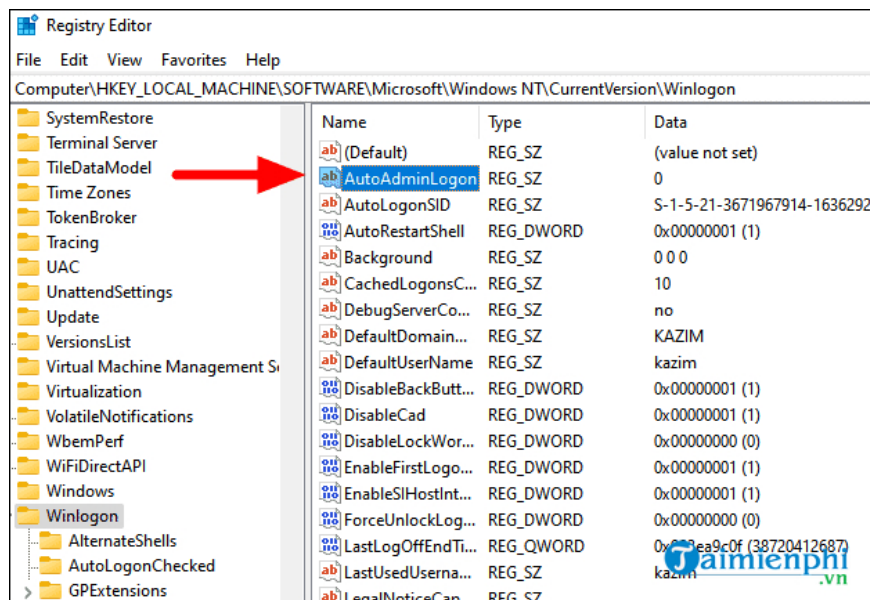
Step 5: Now, create another string by right-clicking on the empty space, selecting **New > String Value** , and naming it **DefaultPassword**.



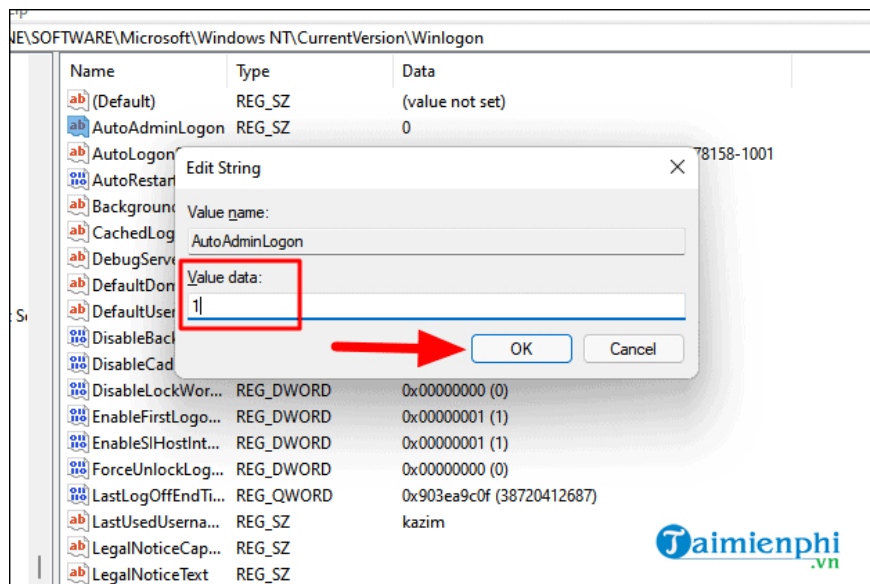
Step 6: Double-click the newly created **DefaultPassword** string , enter your Microsoft account password in the **Value data** field , and click **OK** to save the changes.



Step 7: In this step, find the **AutoAdminLogon** string in the **Winlogon** folder . If it's not there, create it using the same method as in step 3.



Step 8: Next, double-click on the **AutoAdminLogon** string , enter **1** in the **Value data** field , and click **OK** to save the changes. Finally, close **Registry Editor**.



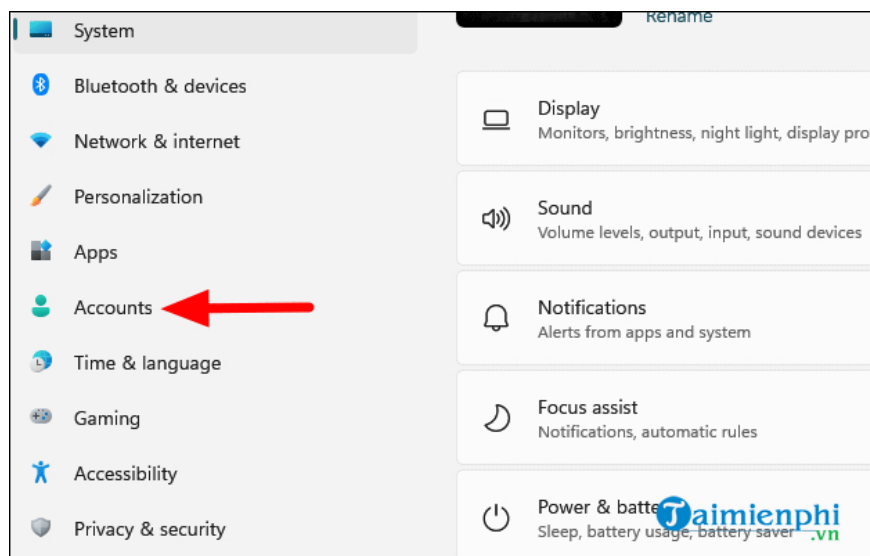
3. Remove the Windows 11 computer password by creating a local account.

The two methods above only disable login passwords, but if you insist on completely removing passwords from your PC, all you have to do is create a passwordless local account and then delete the Microsoft account. That way, you've successfully replaced the administrator account with a passwordless one. However, you'll have to sacrifice some Microsoft services, such as OneDrive, the Microsoft Store, and the ability to sync settings across multiple devices.

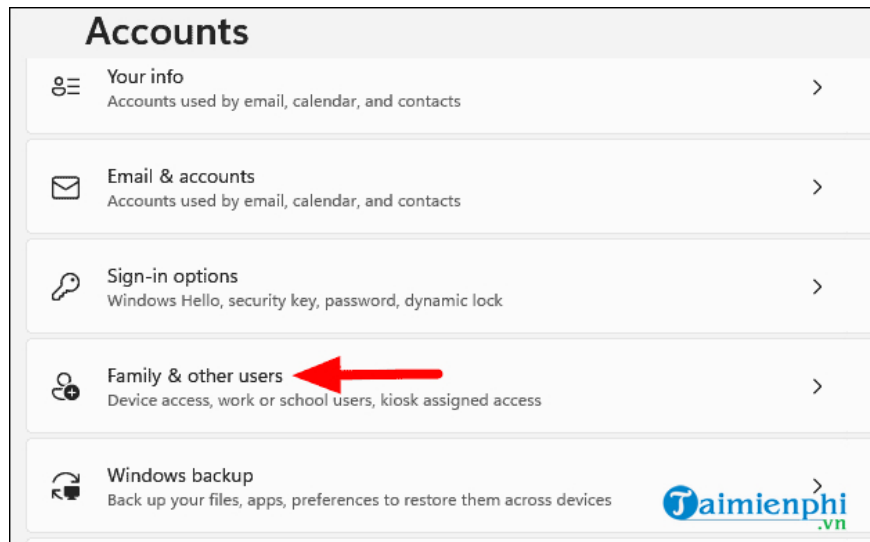
Follow the instructions below to create a local account:

Step 1: Click the **Windows icon** on the Taskbar and click **Settings**, or press the **Windows + I** shortcut to open the settings application.

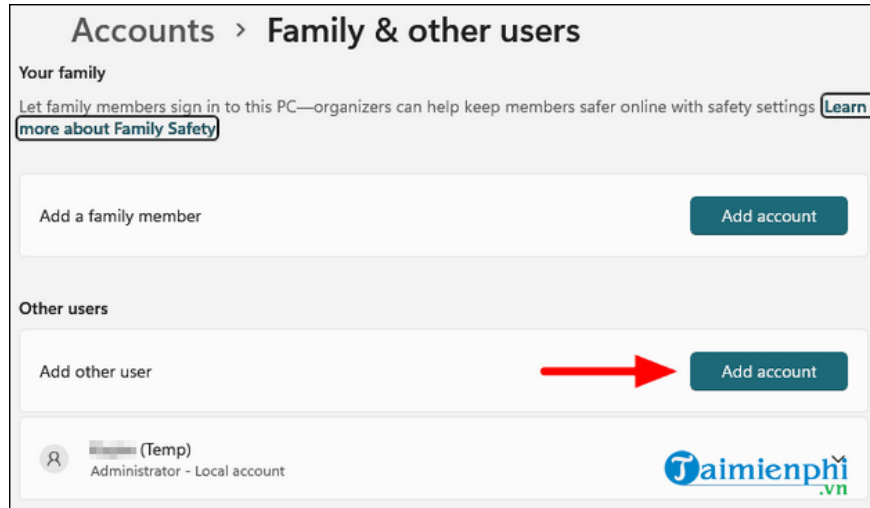
Step 2: Select **Account** in the right-hand pane.



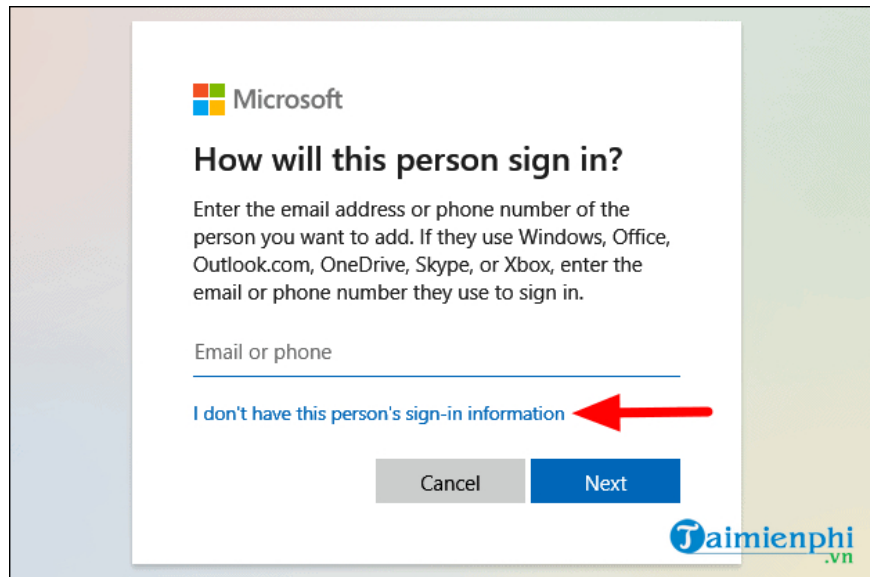
Step 3: In **Account** settings, click on the **Family & other users** option in the right-hand panel.



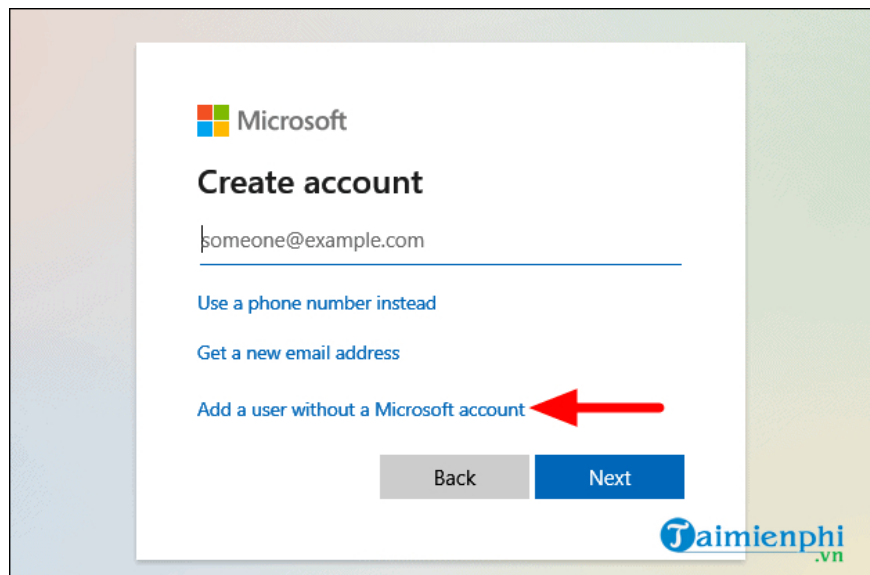
Step 4: Next, click the "Add account" button next to the "Add other user" option under "Other users".



Step 5: The Microsoft account window will open. Here, click on the "I don't have this person's sign-in information" link to create a new local account.



Step 6: Select **Add a user without a Microsoft account**.



Step 7: Now, enter your username and password. Then, click **Next** to continue.

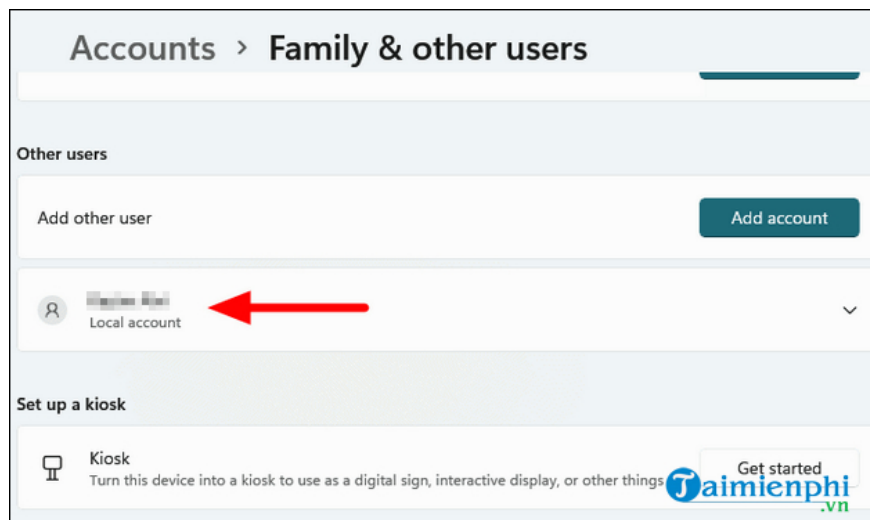
If you want to use a password, choose something that will be easy for you to remember but hard for others to guess.

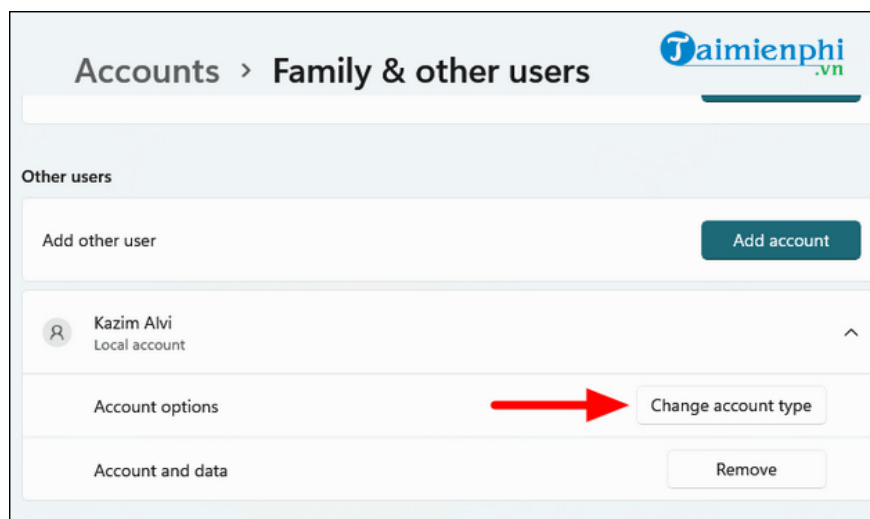
Make it secure.

- A Local Account has been created. However, it is currently a Standard Account. Follow the steps below to assign administrative privileges to this account.

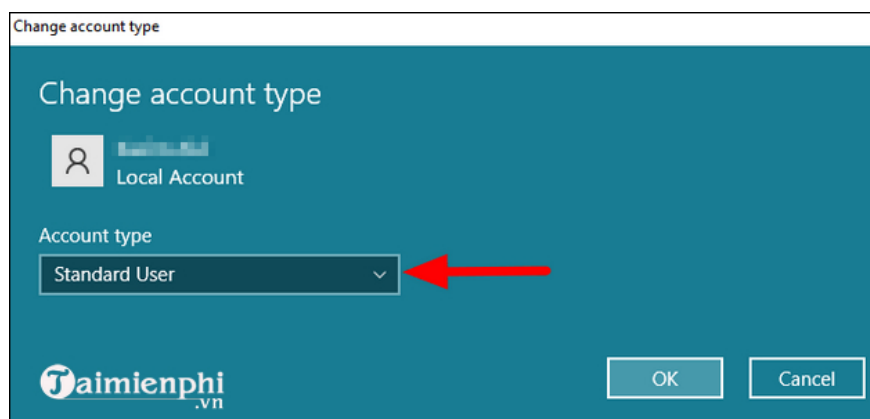
Step 8: To change the account type to **Administrator** , click on the account name listed in **Settings > Account > Family & other users > Other users**.



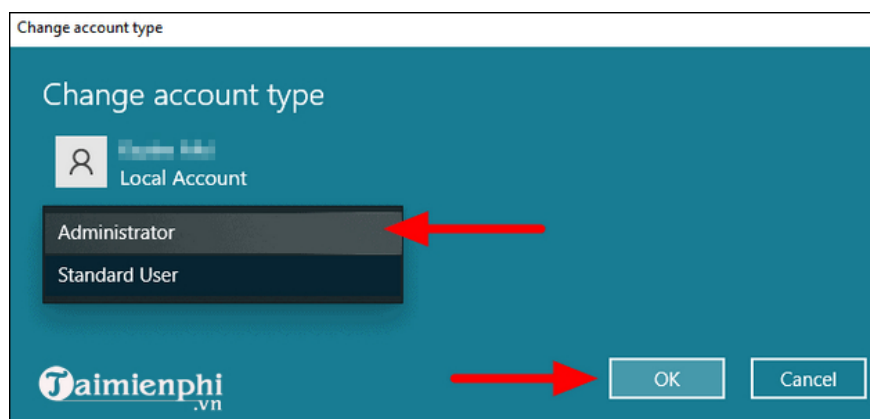
Step 9: Click the **Change account type** button next to **the Account options**.



Step 10: In the **Change account type** window , click the dropdown menu under **Account type**.



Step 11: Select **Administrator** from the list and click **OK** to save the changes.



Now you have a local account set up on Windows 11 with administrative privileges.

II - Removing the Windows 11 computer password for a local account

If you set up your Windows 11 PC with a local (offline) account, you can follow the steps below to remove your login password. It's important to note that these steps do not work with Microsoft accounts for security reasons.

Step 1: Click the **Windows icon** on the Taskbar and click **Settings** , or press the **Windows + I** shortcut to open the settings application.

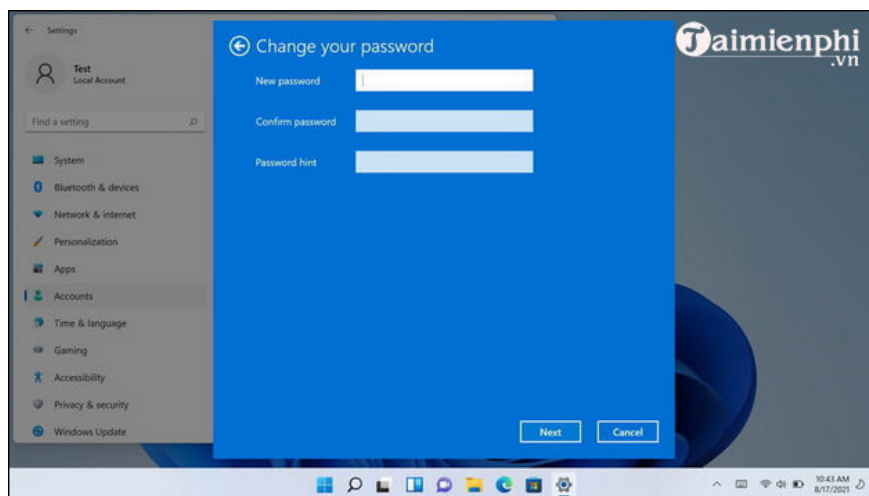
Step 2: Select **Account** in the right-hand pane.

Step 3: Under **Ways to Sign in** , scroll down and click **Password**.

Step 4: Click the **Change** button under **Password** .

Step 5: Enter your current Windows 11 login password and click **Next**.

Step 6: Leave the other fields blank and click **Finish**. Your Windows 11 login password has now been removed.



In general, you shouldn't delete your Windows 11 login password for security reasons. However, if you're the only one using the computer, you can remove the password for convenience. Besides that, you should also change your Windows 11 password regularly.
