

How to remove color on photos extremely fast in Photoshop

Dying is a phenomenon in which your photo appears a strange, unwanted color.

Dying is a phenomenon in which your photo appears a strange, unwanted color. Haunting occurs when the subject in the image is haunted by the color of the main light or from the reflected light of other objects. This makes the photo look less natural and unattractive

To identify whether the image is haunted, you can look to the parts of the image that are white (pure white is best) and enlarge to observe. If the white is not stained, still pristine, then the image is 'clean', whereas the photo is haunted to be corrected if there are some other colors such as purple, blue on the white.

To remove the color noise to help the image return to the original color, you can use the **tools in Photoshop** to edit.





Specifically, the following article will show you how to use the **Camera Raw filter** to white balance an image and remove the color of an image when shooting.

Details of the steps to perform image color reduction very quickly in Photoshop, you can see in the video below.

First, we will use the White balance tool (Eyedropper tool) to neutralize the image, then use the Tonal slider to control the brightness of the image.

In addition to **how to remove colors**, this video shows you how to change the overall color tone of an image to adjust to your purpose.
