

# How to remove software installed on a Windows 10 computer

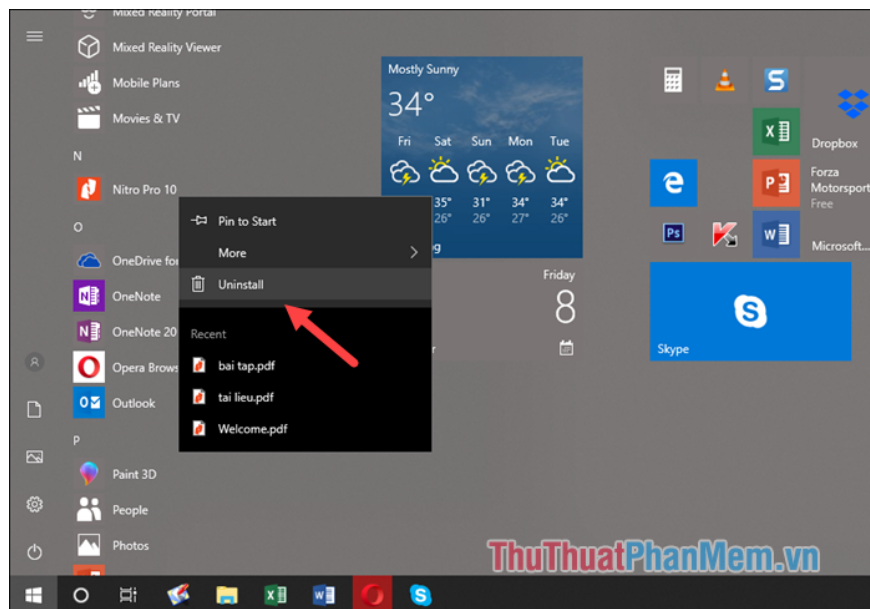

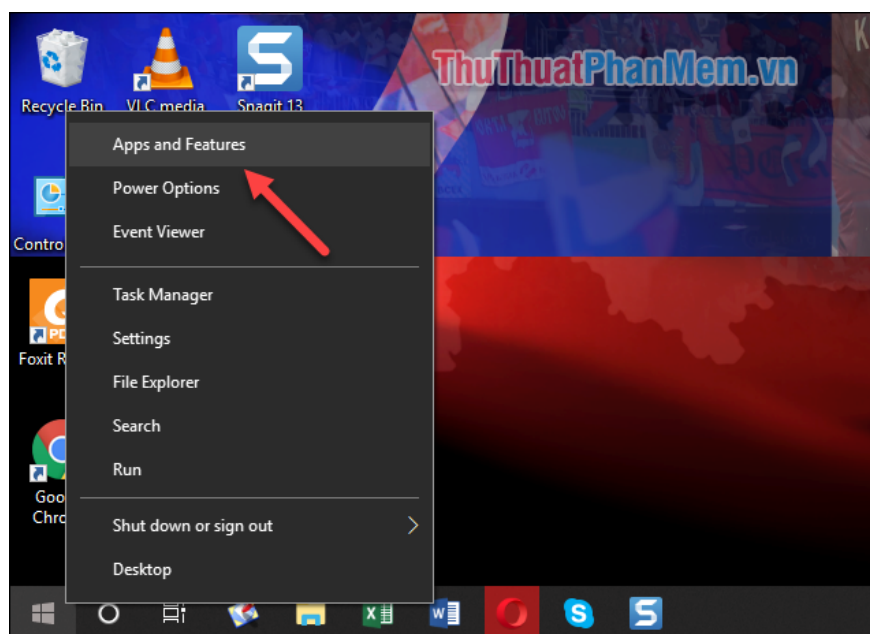
## Method 1: Uninstall from the Start Menu

This can be considered as the simplest way to uninstall software in Windows 10. You just need to open the Start Menu to find the application to remove in the list, right-click and select Uninstall to finish.

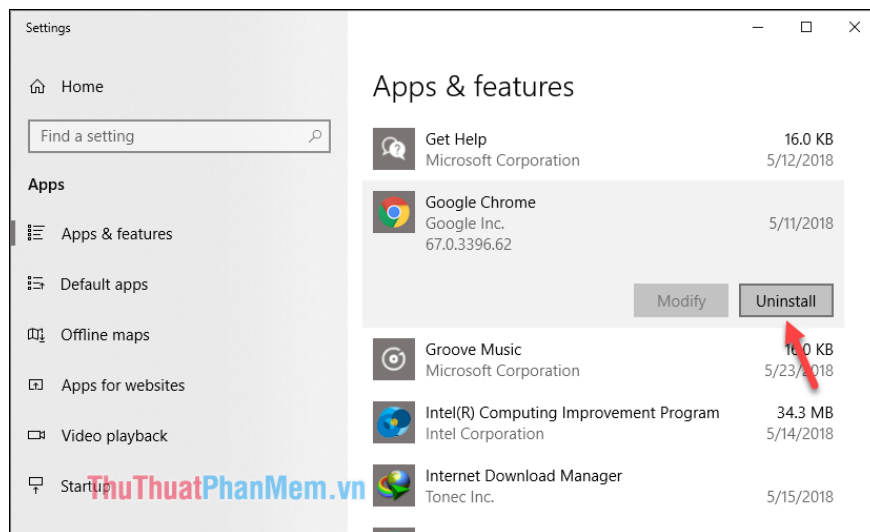


## Method 2: Uninstall the application in Setting

**Step 1 :** Right-click on the **Start** button and then select **Apps and Features**

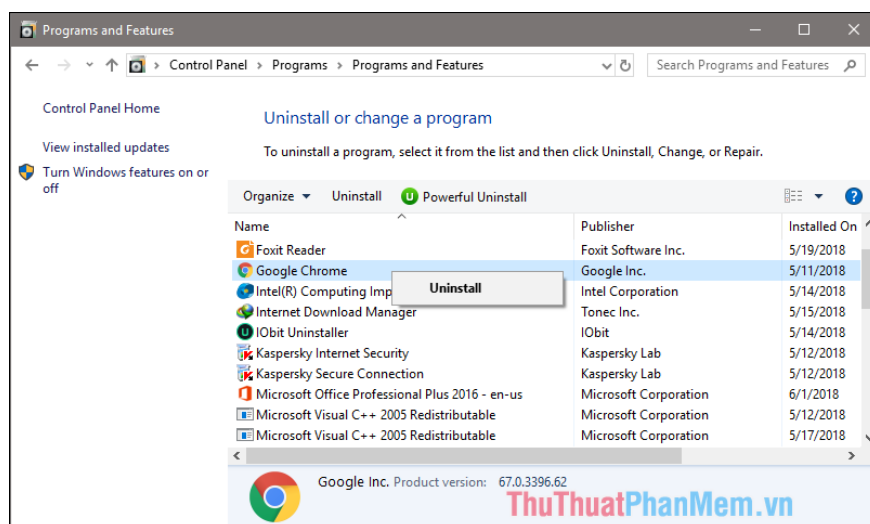


**Step 2 :** A new window appears, scroll down to see the list of installed applications on the computer. You want to uninstall any application just click on the application and select **Uninstall** is finished.



### Method 3: Uninstall the application in Control Panel

The same way as uninstalling applications on Windows 7. Go to **Control Panel**, select **Uninstall a program**, then right-click on the application to uninstall and select **Uninstall**
