

How to remove 'spy' apps on Facebook

To protect your Facebook account, you should remove suspicious applications on Facebook. However, how can I remove these applications? Please refer to some solutions below of Network Administrator.

For Facebook users, it is no stranger to Facebook games, entertainment, divination, etc. These applications are created, in addition to the benefits of the features that these applications bring, there are also many drawbacks, endangering users without them knowing.

1. How to detect sneaky people on your Facebook

The problem here is the personal information that these applications exploit since these applications are allowed to access the user's Facebook account information.

You may not know, applications on Facebook can:

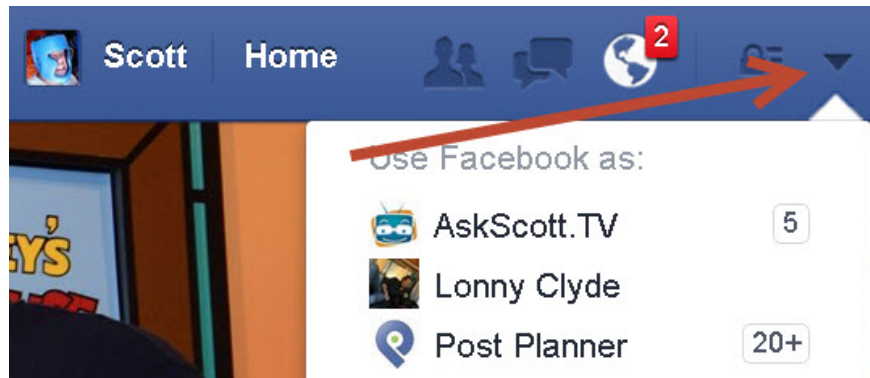
1. Access your demographic: Demographic is a quantitative statistic of a certain number of customers. Demographics is also used to identify quantitative studies of specific customers at a specific time.
2. Access your friends list on Facebook.
3. Access your email address.
4. Automatically post on your Timeline.
5. Automatically post on the pages you do Admin.
6. Send annoying notifications.
7. Access your Insight Facebook.
8. Target your ads.

Therefore, to protect your Facebook account you should remove these applications. However, it is important to remove new applications. Please refer to the following solutions of Network Administrator.

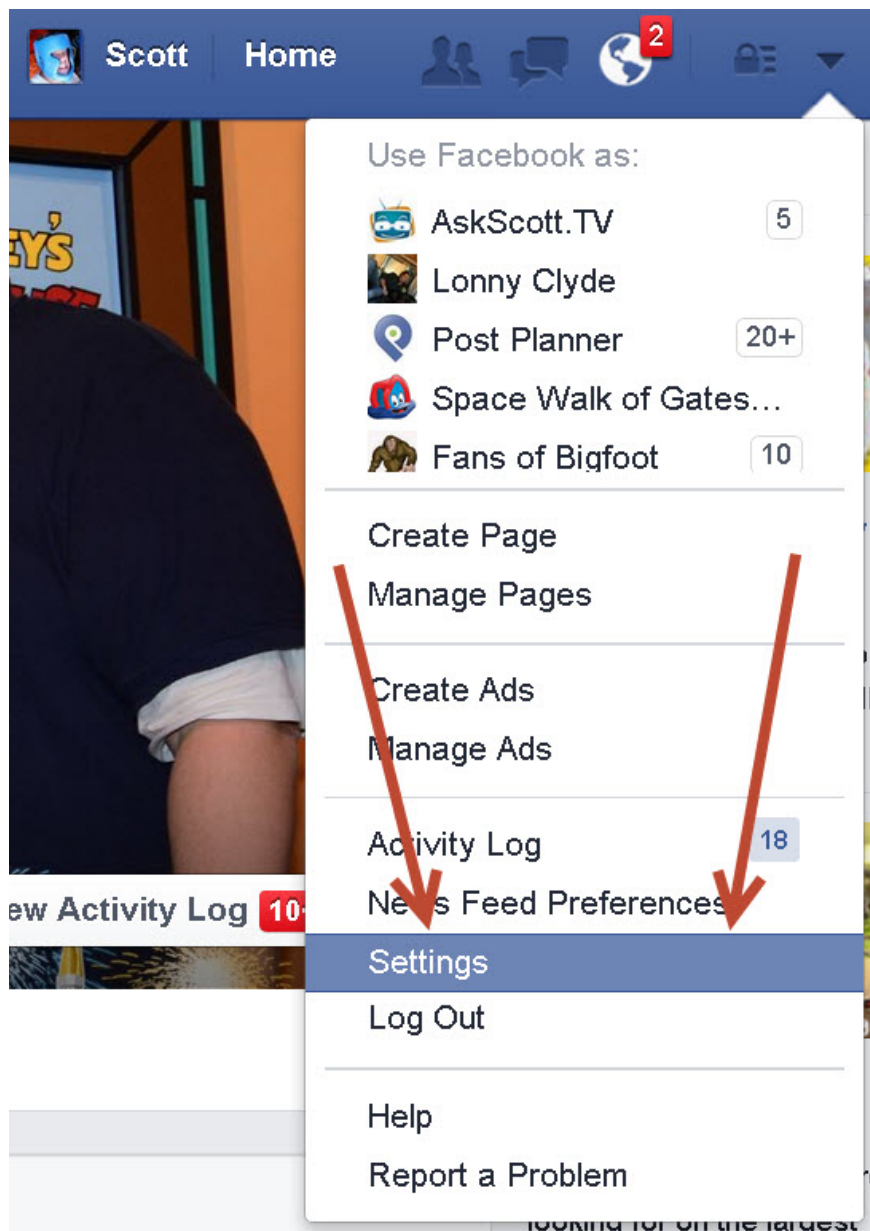
1. Remove "spy" applications on Facebook

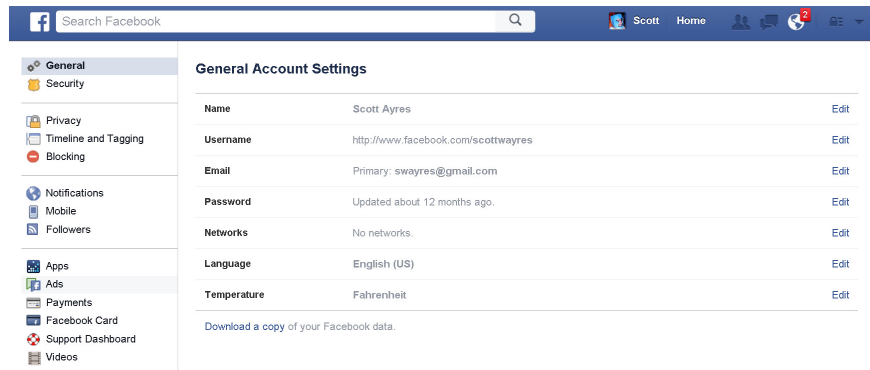
To remove "spy" applications on Facebook, follow the steps below:

1. Go to Facebook.com and log in to your Facebook account. Then on the Facebook page, click the arrow icon downward in the navigation bar (Navigation Bar).

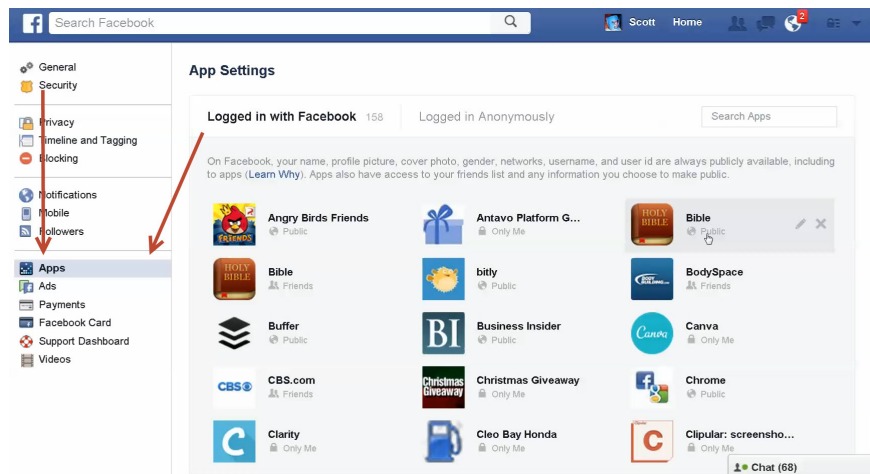


2. Next select **Settings** to navigate to the General Account Settings page (general account settings).



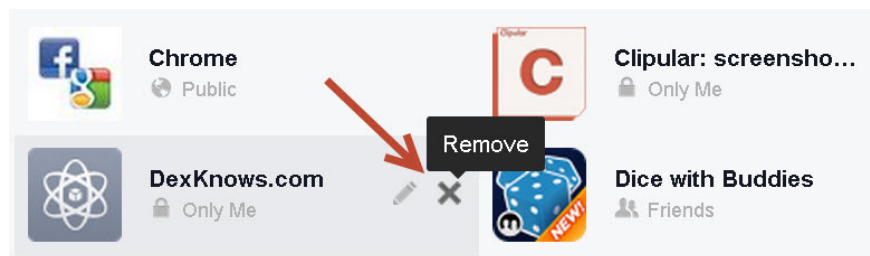


3. On the General Account Settings page, click the **Apps** option in the list of left frame items.

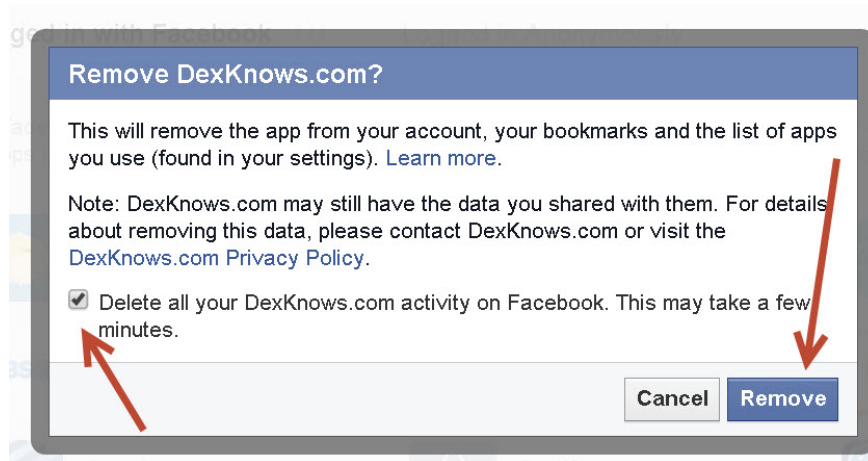


Now on the screen you will see all the applications you have connected on Facebook.

4. Look at which applications you do not know, you do not know, have not granted it, but it is already on this list. After identifying those apps, click on the **X** icon on each application to remove them.



5. Popup window appears, read carefully the information on the popup window and click **Remove** to remove the application.



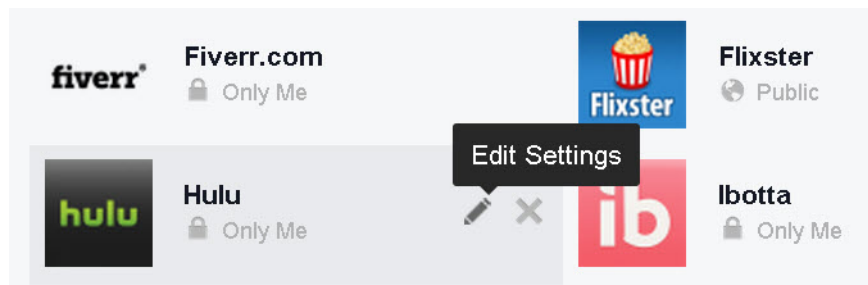
Also here you can choose the option to delete all activities on the application by selecting the option at the bottom of the popup window and then clicking **Remove** .

2. Customize application settings

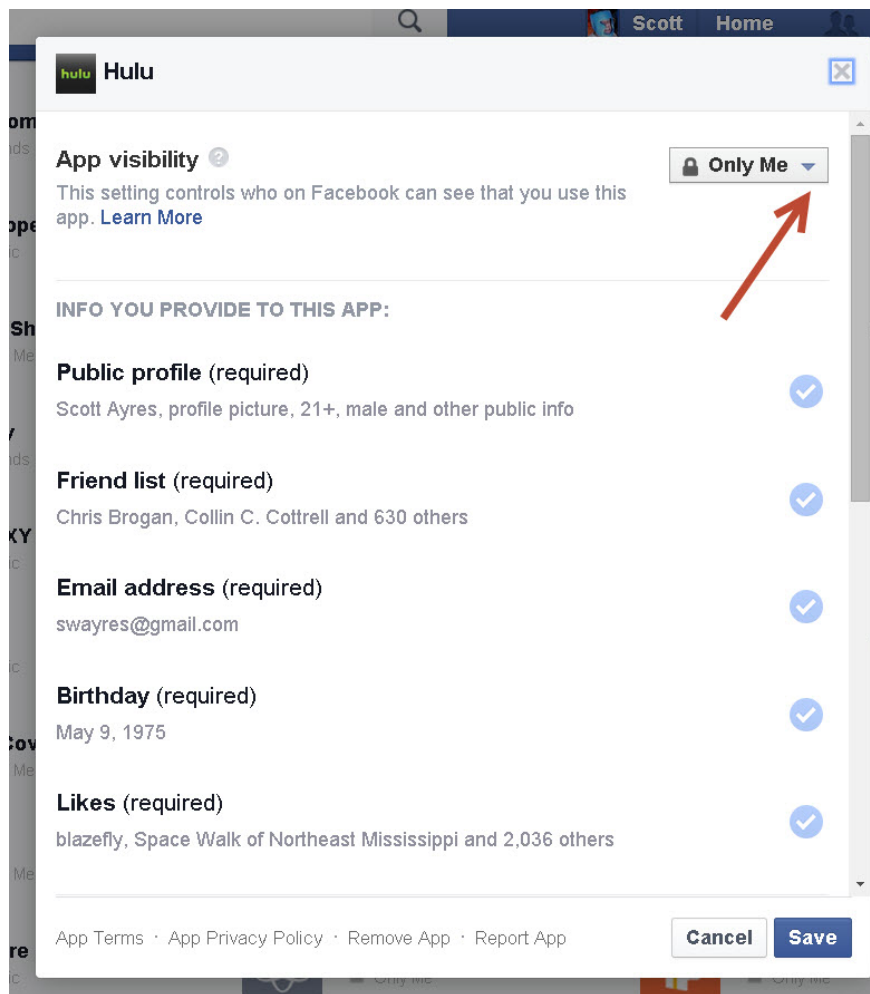
In addition to completely removing the application, you can apply additional ways to customize the application settings to limit the information that the application can access from your account.

To customize the application settings, follow the steps below:

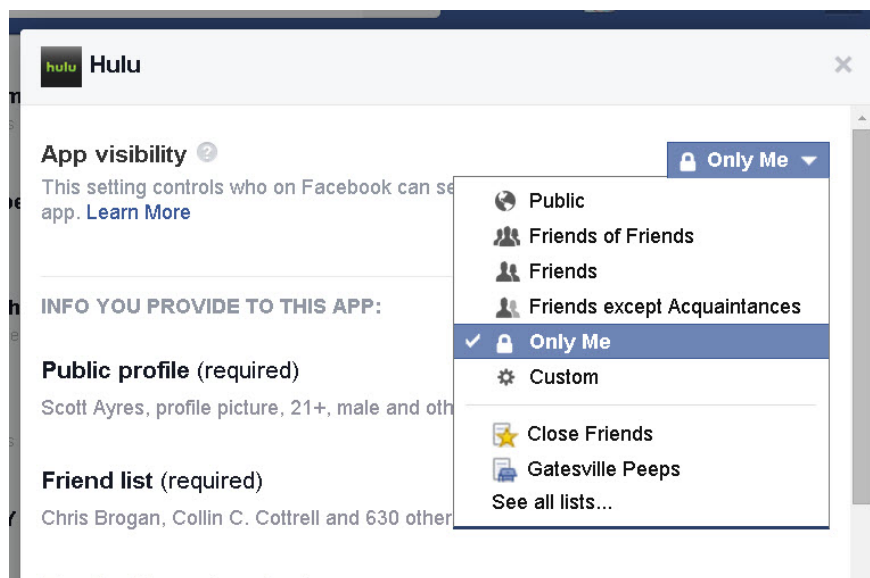
1. Follow the same steps as the steps to remove the above application, but to step 4, click the pencil icon next to the application.



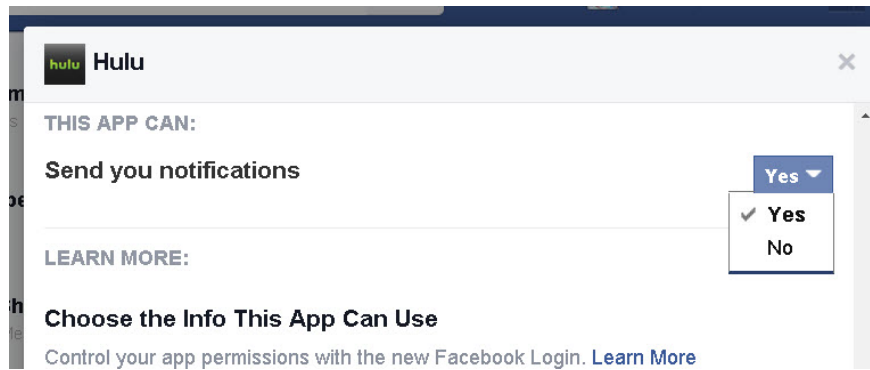
2. Preview and proceed with custom application settings.

In addition, you can choose whether you want to receive notifications from the application or not.



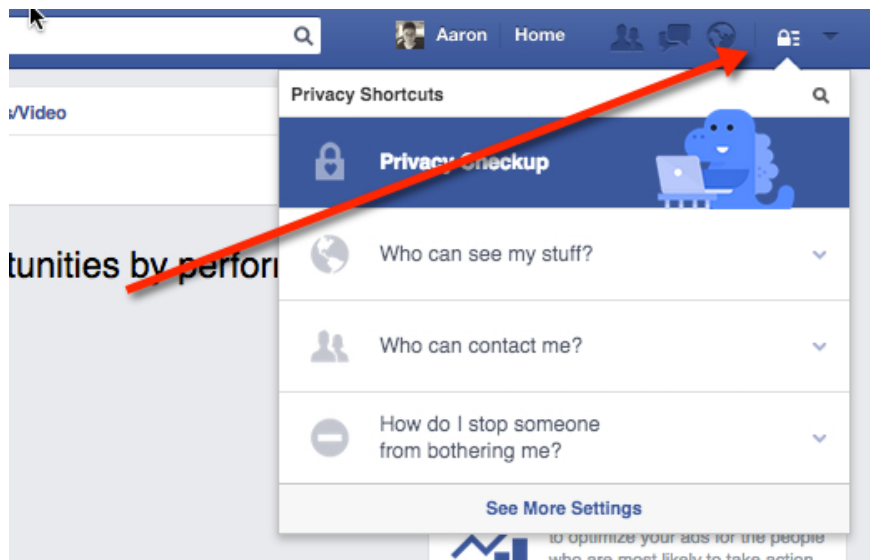
After you have finished customizing the application settings, click **Save** to save the settings.

3. Delete the Facebook application from Profile

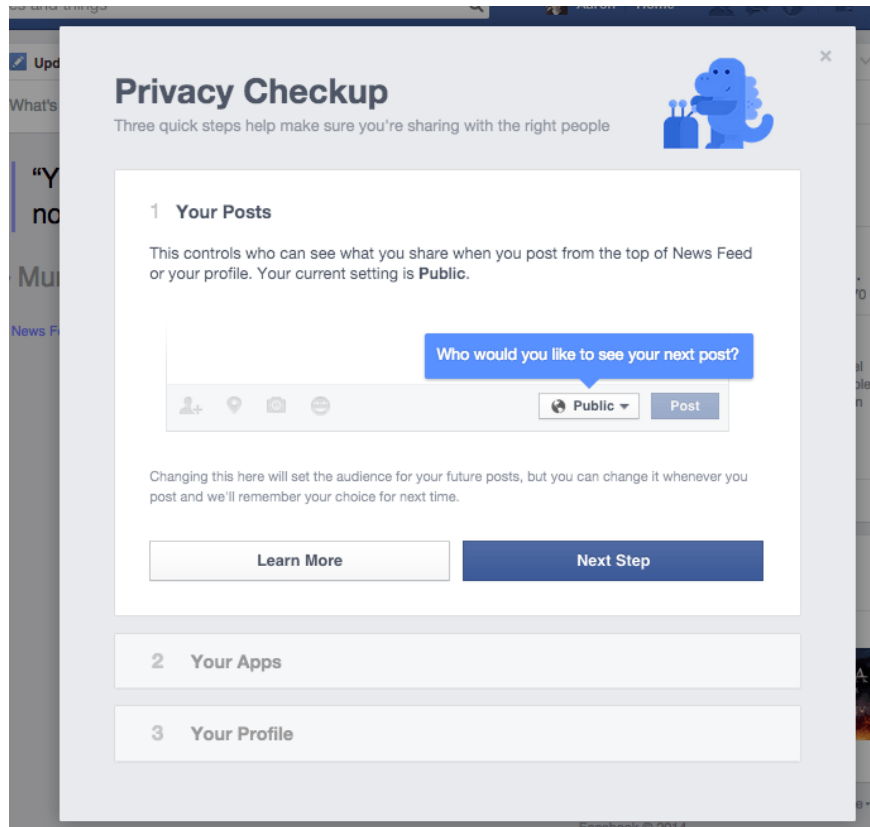
To remove the Facebook application from Profile, follow the steps below:

1. Go to Facebook.com, then log in to your Facebook account.

Next on your Facebook page, click the lock icon as shown below.



2. Click on the blue dinosaur icon to access the privacy check.


















3. Next, click **Next Step** to open the application installation page.

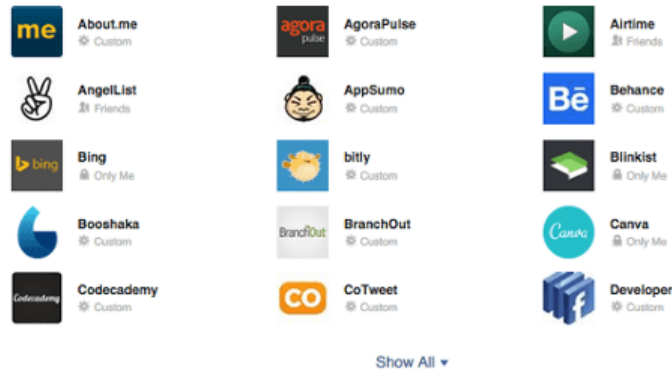
