

How to remove the Gemini watermark from photos

If you want to keep your AI-generated photos looking clean and professional, here are the best ways to remove the Gemini watermark.

Gemini produces impressive AI images, but the visible watermark is a major drawback. Even when using the tool for minor edits, that tiny, sparkling dot still appears and easily distracts viewers from your work. If you want to keep your AI-generated images looking clean and professional, here are the best ways to remove the Gemini watermark.

Understand the difference between visible watermarks and hidden watermarks.

Before removing the Gemini watermark, it's important to understand the difference between visible and hidden watermarks. Along with the visible sparkling watermark, Gemini also uses SynthID to add hidden watermarks to pixels of AI-generated images. Even if you remove the sparkling watermark, the hidden watermark will still confirm to AI detection tools that the image was created by AI.

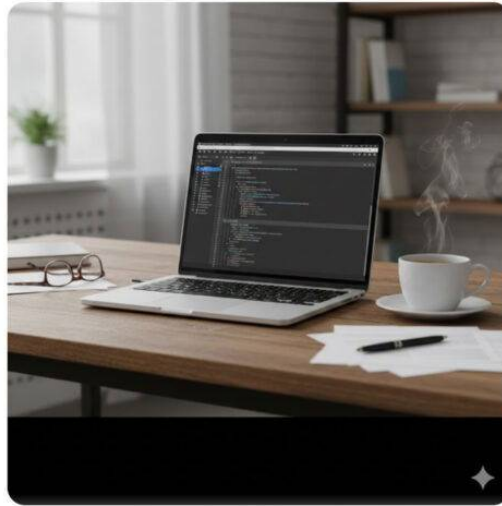
We've only removed the visible watermark here for aesthetic reasons. Anyone can still detect that the image was created by AI by looking at the hidden watermark or other clues. Simply put, don't upload an image with the Gemini watermark removed and claim it as yours. You'll easily be detected even without the visible watermark.

Remove the watermark by intentionally adding negative space to the image.

Gemini adds a watermark to the bottom right corner. Since the position doesn't change, you can edit the image to add space at the bottom so the watermark sits there. Then you can safely remove the empty space and the watermark along with it. Just add the following prompt to the end of your image prompt:

'Add a black border at the bottom, covering 5% of the total image area.'

With this command, Gemini will add a slightly larger black space at the bottom than the watermark area. You can then use any basic photo editing app to crop out the black space.



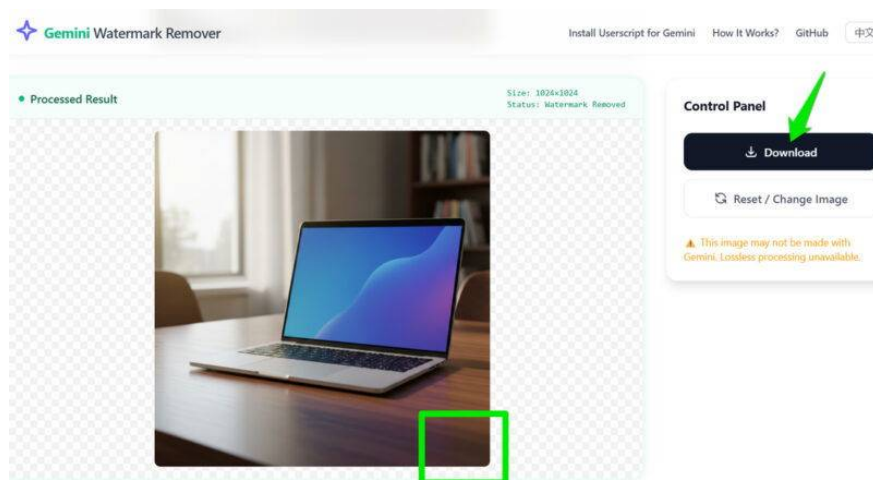

Use an online tool to remove the Gemini watermark.

You can also use an online tool to remove watermarks. Gemini Watermark Remover is a great tool for this purpose, it's free and open source. It doesn't erase or fill the watermark area. This tool performs mathematical reverse of the watermark to remove it. Gemini Watermark Remover uses a semi-transparent layer, which doesn't affect the pixels underneath. This tool simply reverses the process to remove the watermark from the image.

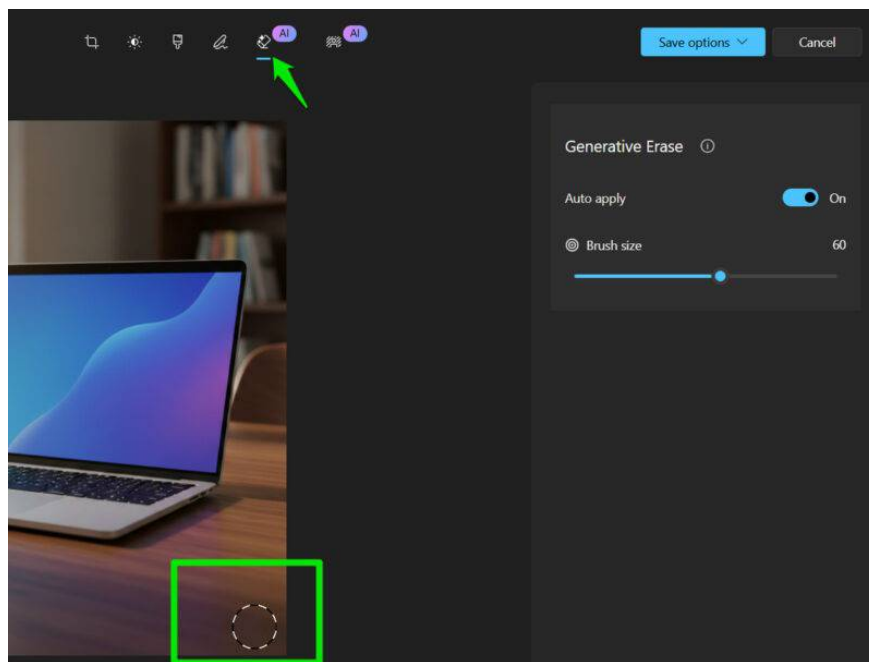
Simply upload your images, and the tool will automatically detect and remove the watermark immediately. Then, you can click the **Download** button to get your clean images. It will perfectly process almost all images you upload, except for one image that left a square mark when viewed at maximum zoom.



Remove the Gemini watermark using the generative removal tool.

The generative eraser is a common feature in most photo editing apps today, helping to remove unwanted objects from images and fill in the space with a suitable background using artificial intelligence (AI) . It won't perfectly restore the actual background, but it works quite well for AI-generated images, where most of the intricate details are concentrated in the center.

The Photos app in Windows also has this feature. Simply click the **Edit** button and select **Erase** from the tools at the top. Then you can use a brush to remove the Gemini watermark.



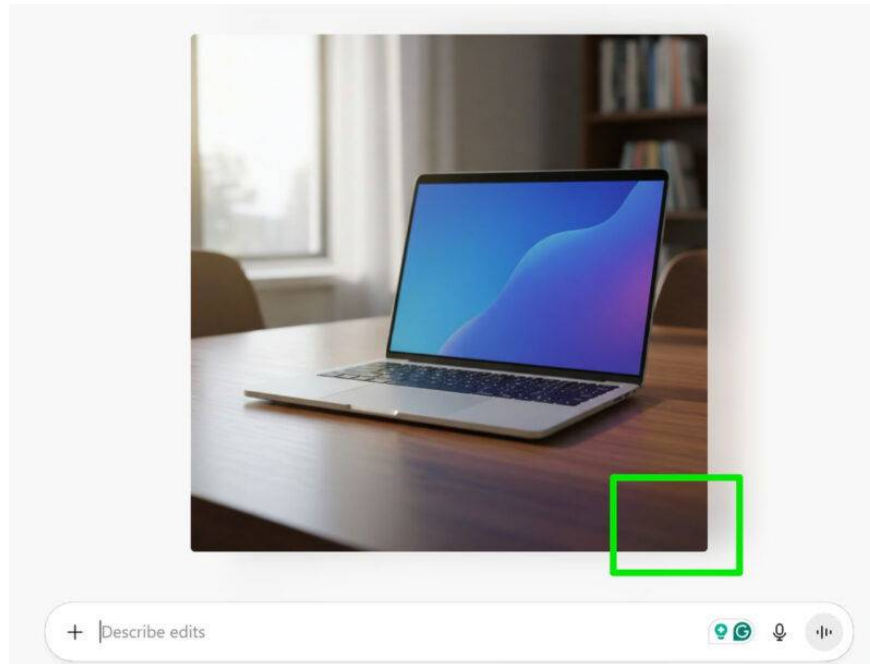
Use ChatGPT to remove the Gemini watermark.

ChatGPT doesn't add its own watermark to images, and it's really effective at removing objects from images – even basic models. You can upload Gemini images to ChatGPT and ask it to remove the Gemini watermark; it will do a great job.

Simply click the plus icon in ChatGPT and select **Add photos & files** to upload your photos. For photos, enter this prompt:

'Remove the Gemini watermark in the bottom right corner of this image.'

The processing will take a few seconds, and you will receive a watermark-free image to download.



The author of the article tested it with many photos and it perfectly removed the watermark without leaving a trace, even at maximum zoom.
