

# How to remove the software rooted on Windows

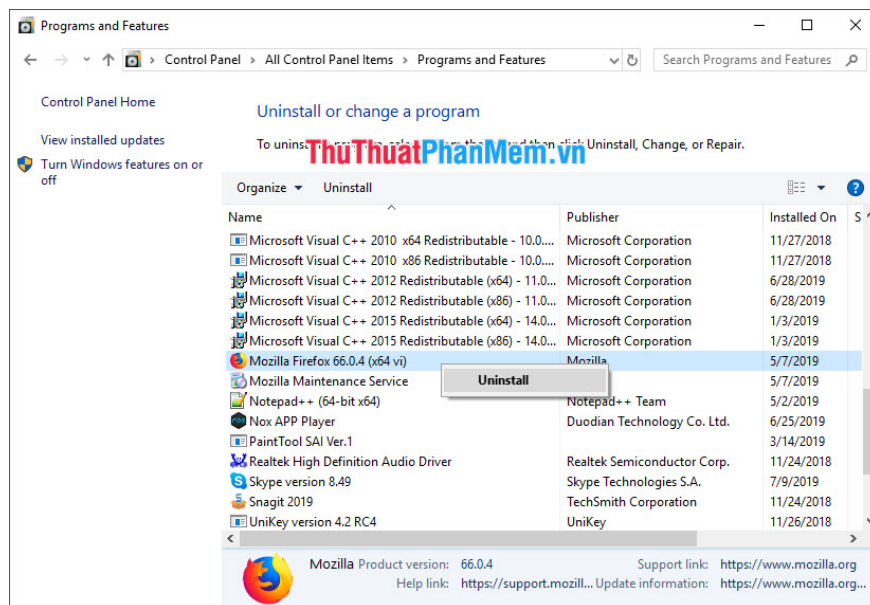

## 1. Remove the software from the root by using the Registry function of your computer

Although using **Uninstall** of Windows can help you uninstall a software on your computer, it is very likely that the software you have uninstalled has not deleted all the subfiles contained in your computer. This will make your computer heavier over time.

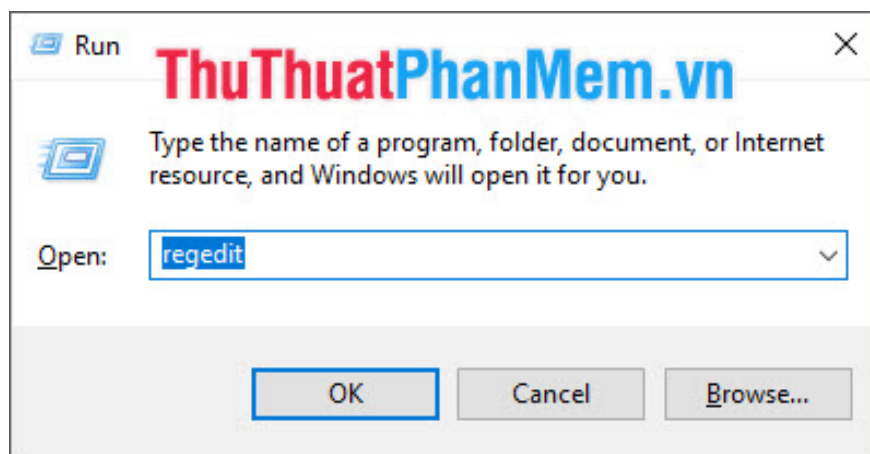


And to delete all those files, you can use the Windows **Registry** function .

**Registry** is a type of registry management of software running on the Windows operating system of your computer. In other words, any software that wants to "live" in your computer must be registered through it.

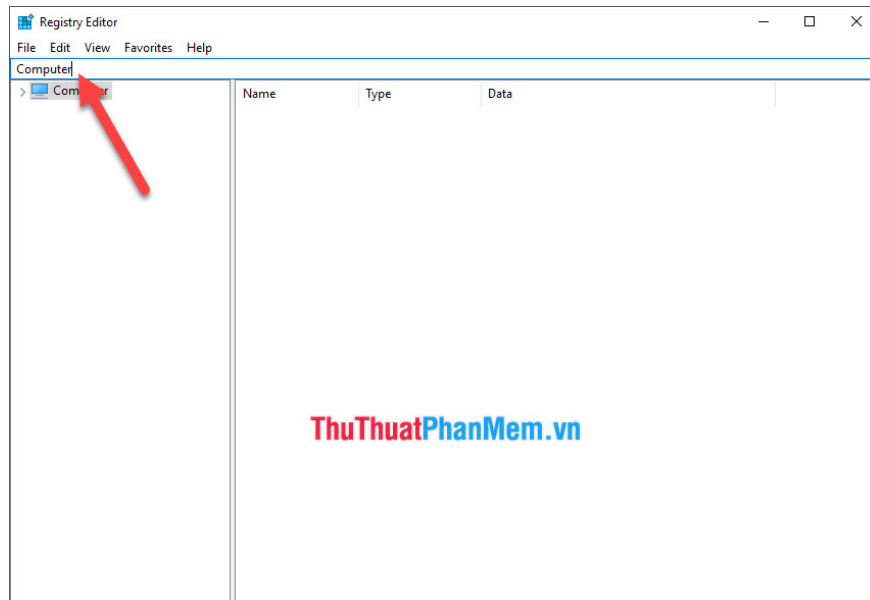
So you can use it to get rid of the leftover files in your computer that haven't been removed yet.

To open this Registry function, you need to access it via Windows Run. Open **Run** using the **Windows + R** key combination .



Then you enter the keyword *regedit* in the **Open** box and then click **OK** or press Enter to confirm the path.

The **Registry Editor** window will appear on your screen. First it will be white exactly like the picture below you see.

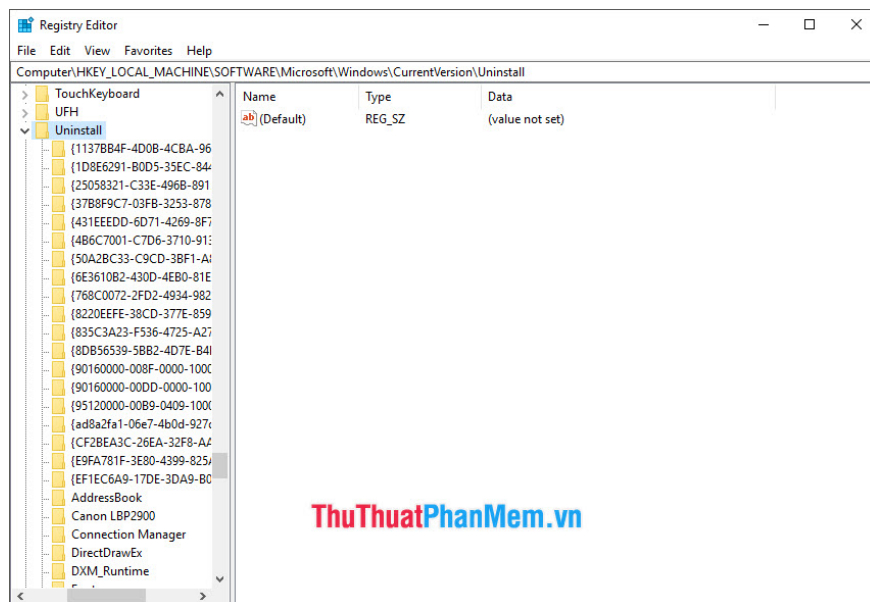


To open the **Uninstall** section , you need to put the cursor behind the word Computer available in the address line, then copy the following line and then press Enter:

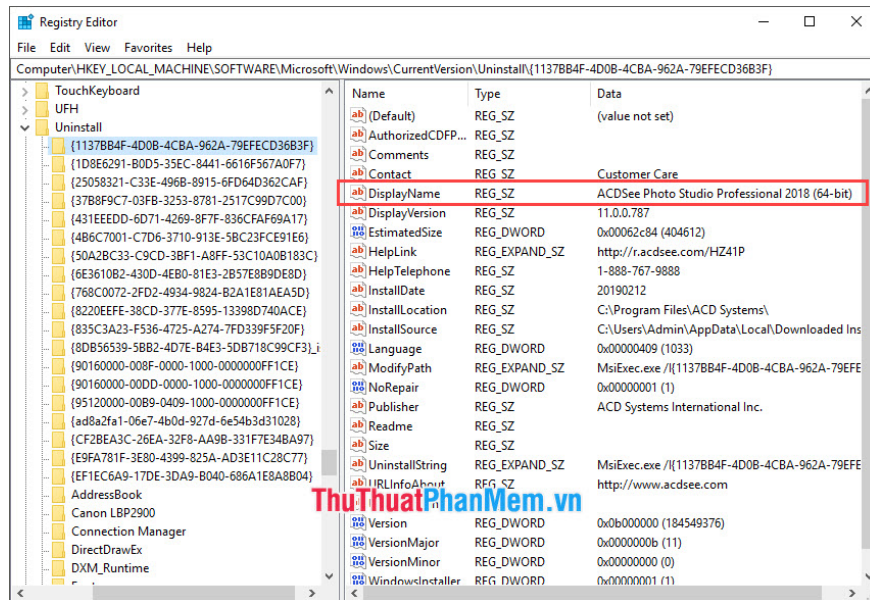
***HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Uninstall***

In the **Uninstall** folder you can see a vertical list of installed folders on your computer.

Some directories are named with symbols that you do not fully understand. Click on one of the folders in it.

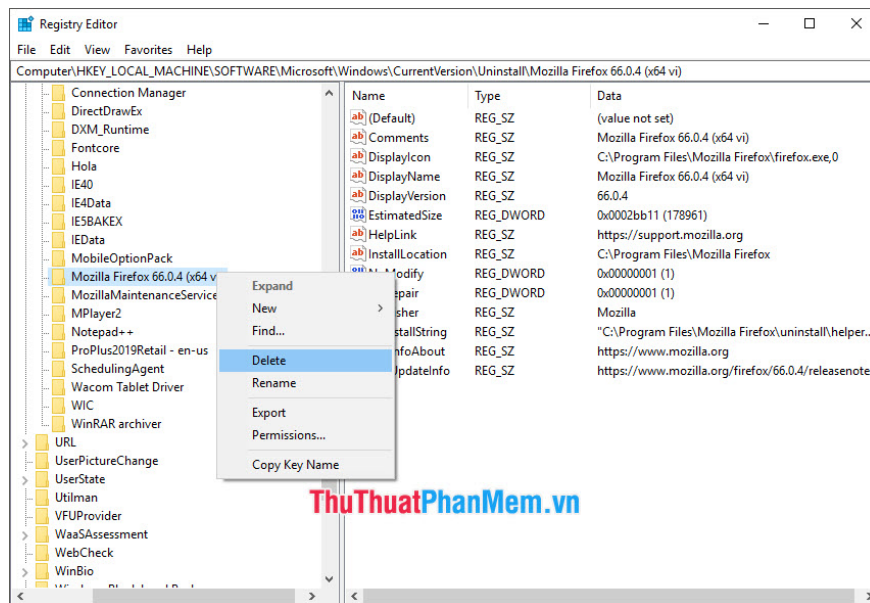


You can see the related software name in the **DisplayName** line . You can use the up and down arrow buttons to navigate through folders and search for the name of the software you want to delete.



Of course, there are also directories that specify the name of the software you want to delete, so you won't need to rely on **DisplayName** to search anymore.

And to delete the file associated with it, just right-click on the folder and select **Delete** to delete.

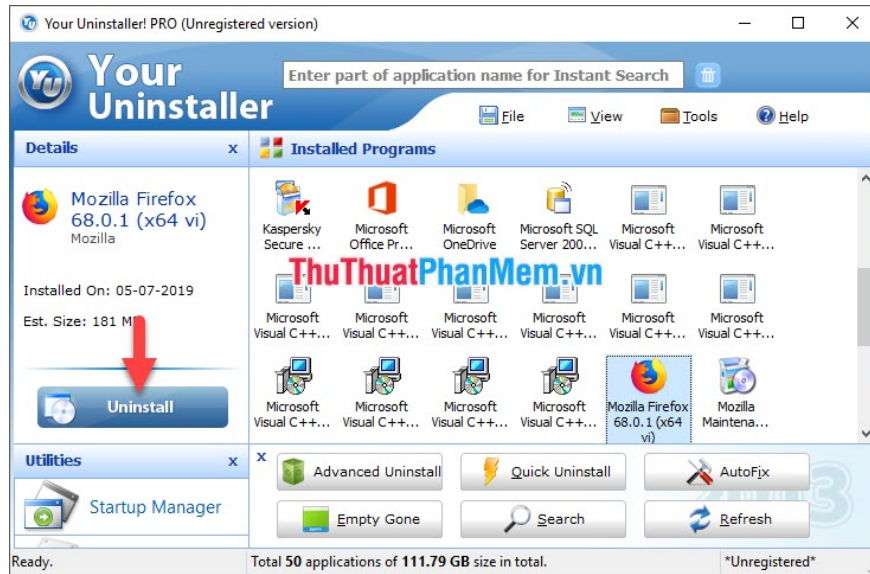


## 2. Remove the software from the root by Your Uninstaller

Your Uninstaller helps you to uninstall stubborn software in your computer completely and thoroughly. To download this software, you need to visit the following address: <http://www.ursoftware.com/>

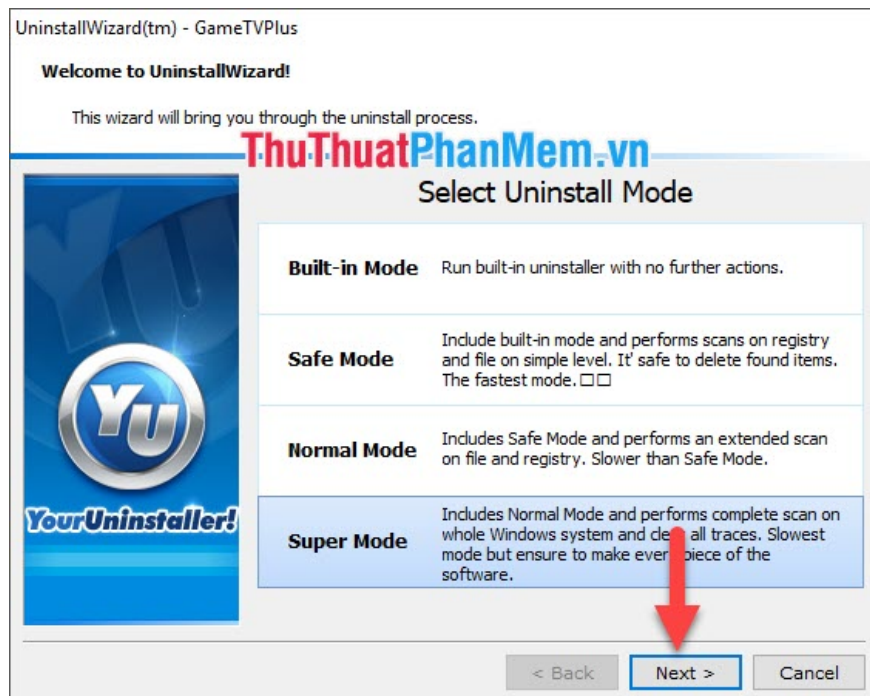
After downloading and installing it on your computer, open this Your Uninstaller software. The interface of Your Uninstaller is easy to understand and easy to use, you can see a list of software installed on your computer on the right hand side of **Installed Programs** .

Select the software you want to remove, then click on the **Uninstall** icon on the left.

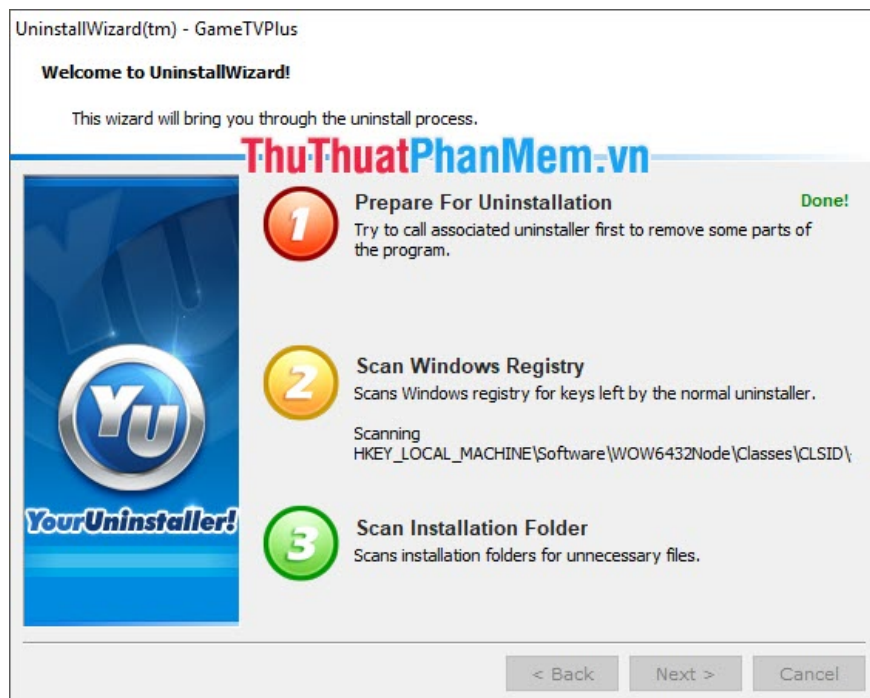


Next you need to choose the type of software removal that Your Uninstaller provides. With **Super Mode**, you can take root and delete data related to the selected software.

Click **Next** to continue.

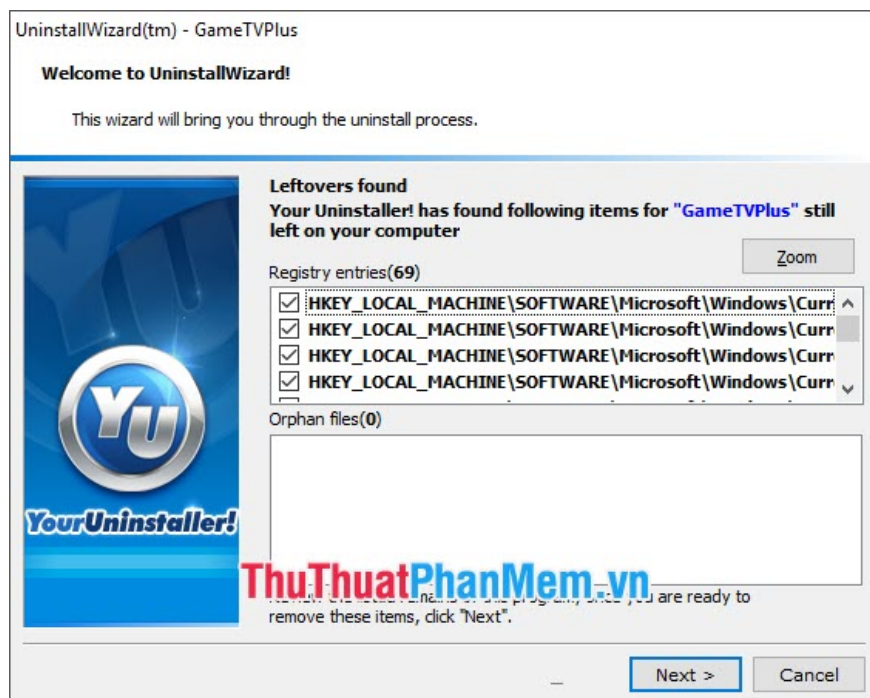


Uninstalling may take some time, you should wait until Your Uninstaller has completed its statistical work.

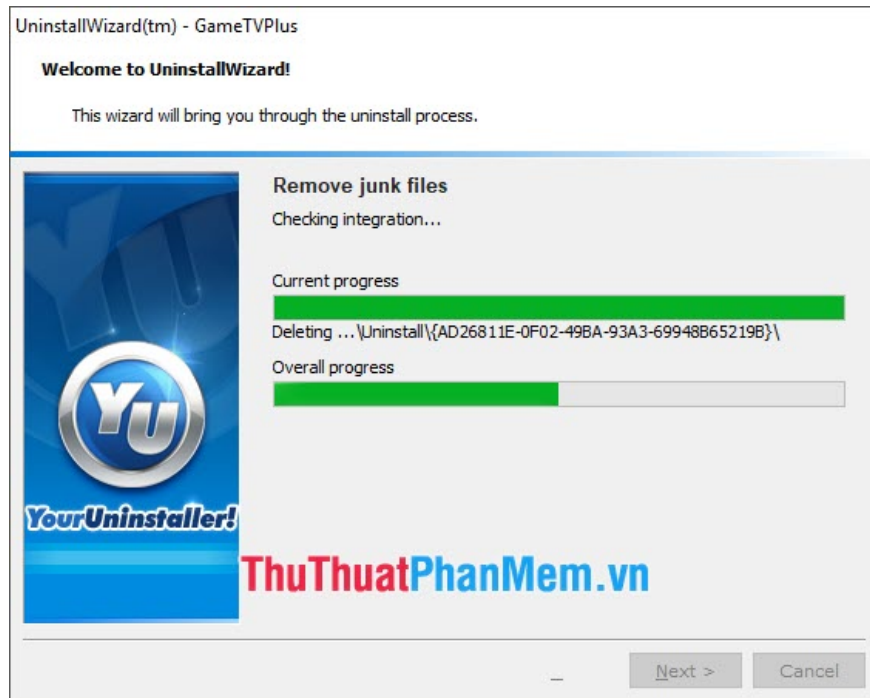


Your **Uninstaller** will show you the list of files that will be deleted from the computer, you can uncheck the file that you do not want to delete.

Then click **Next** .



The deletion will be completed when both lines are filled with blue.
