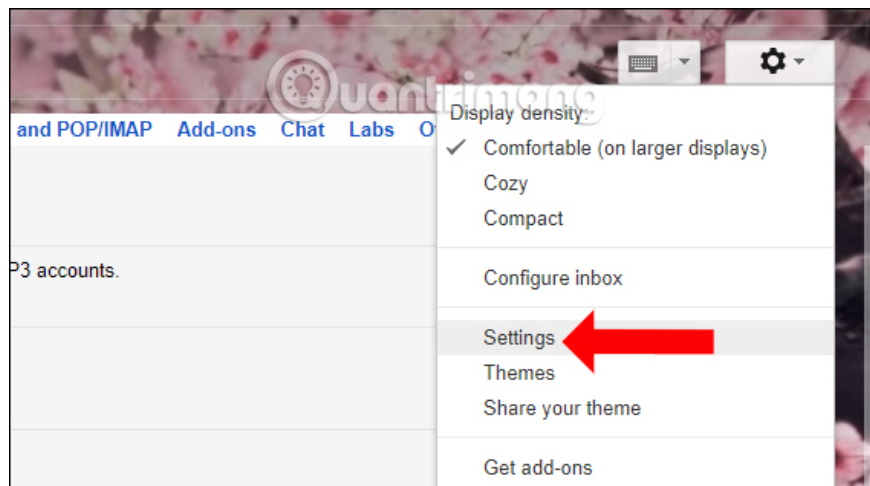

Instructions to change Gmail name

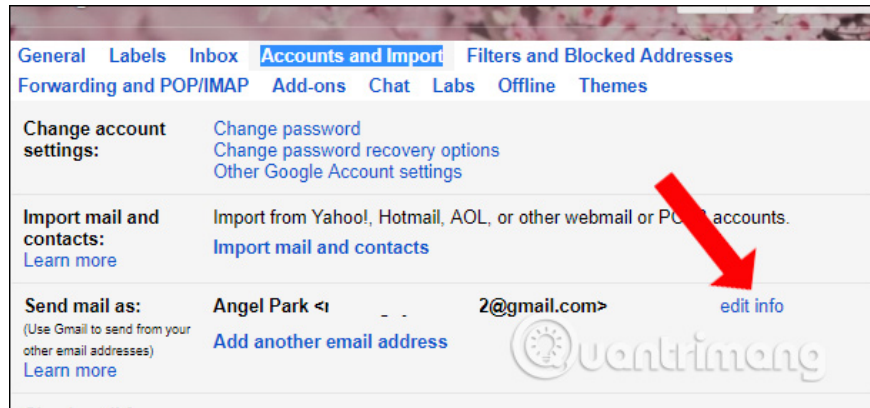
Step 1:

You access your personal Gmail account. At the interface click on **the gear icon** and select **Settings**.



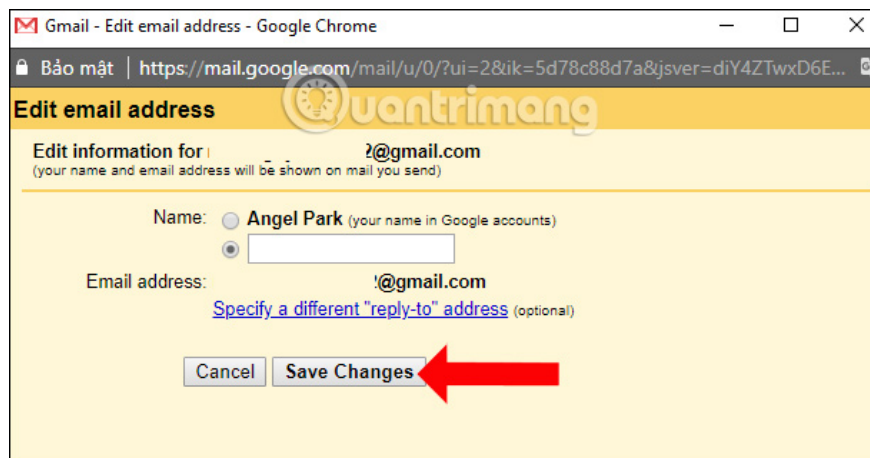
Step 2:

In the Settings interface, click on the **Accounts and Import** section. Then look below the Send mail as section, click the **edit info** button.



Step 3:

A separate dialog box appears. Please enter a new name in the rectangular box and check to use this new name. Then click **Save Changes** to save the new name for Gmail.



A trick is simple and easy to do, right ?! When you change to the new name for Gmail, the later visits to Gmail address we will see the new name appear instead of the previous name.
