

How to renew household items

Here are a few ways you can help make old household items look new and clean

Household items made of metal, copper, glass, wood, old clothes, etc., when used for a long time, will get dirty and old. but don't rush to throw them away, we will guide you There are a few ways you can help make these old items look new and clean.



Refreshing household items

Refreshing metal objects

To remove rust on metal items, mix a little vinegar with a little hot water and then use a pot cleaner to rub the surface of the items to clean and help increase their shine.

Refreshing copper objects

If copper objects appear green rust, you can use a little lemon juice mixed with a little salt to clean the shine again.

Refresh pots and pans

1. To refresh the aluminum pot, mix water with vinegar into the pot, then boil for a few minutes, the aluminum pot will be clean.
2. The pot, pan is dirty inside, sprinkle salt on the stain and leave it for a few hours and then clean it with clean water.

Clean the kettle super speed

The super-speed kettle is scaled or yellowed, mix water with vinegar and fill it up, then turn on the electricity to boil water and let it cool. The dirt will come off and the jar will be cleaner.

Refresh the iron surface



Refresh the surface of your iron with Baking Soda

1. Irons, when used for a long time, are prone to dirt or burnt fabrics. To clean those stains, you can take Baking Soda mixed with a little water to make a paste and then rub this solution on the stains on the iron's surface.
2. If you want the iron to be used for a long time without lightning, you should use a candle to rub it. Of course then the iron must be hot and iron a rag to clean all the candles before ironing the clothes.

Refresh the plastic cutting board

You can clean a plastic cutting board simply with a sponge soaked in a mixture of salt and lemon juice, then rub this mixture on the cutting board to help it shine like new.

Refreshing glass objects

1. Add vinegar to water when washing or rinsing glass objects to make them sparkle.
2. Alternatively, you can clean glassware by soaking them in warm water and dropping a denture-cleaning tablet into it.
3. To prevent glass items from breaking when boiling water is poured in, when you first buy them, you should put them all in a pot of water mixed with salt and then bring to a boil. After that, you let the water cool down before taking it out and rinsing it with cold water.

Refresh the surface of wooden objects

1. Scratches on wood will make the item look ugly and old a lot. Mix a mixture of vinegar and olive oil in a ratio of 1: 1, then use a towel to absorb this mixture and rub it vigorously on the surface of the scratches.
2. The walls of your house have painted paints of all colors, yellow and stained for a long time, use Chinese tea to soak a towel, wipe it vigorously, the wall will be clean immediately.

Refresh leather sofa

Mix a mixture according to the following recipe: 1/4 cup olive oil + 1/2 cup vinegar in a spray bottle of water. Then, you spray this homemade mixture on the stains and wipe with a cotton cloth. Make sure items like sofas are as clean as you want them to be

Renew old clothes

1. If your clothes are yellow for a long time, take a boiled potato, peel it, let it cool, then rub it on the stain, then rinse it with clean water, dry it in a cool, windy place.
2. When you first buy fabric or colored clothes, immediately soak them in water mixed with vinegar for a while. This will help the clothes keep the color longer.
3. Old clothes are still strong, if you want them to be newer, wash them with boiling water mixed with vinegar.

Refreshing towels

To restore the warmth of your towels, wash them in salt water after rinsing. Plus, towels will last longer if they are dried in a well-ventilated environment or left to dry

Refresh your toothbrush

If you want to restore your old toothbrush, pour some hot water into a bowl and swirl it around so the bristles are as soft as new.
