

# How to re-register the Microsoft Store app in Windows 10

If the Store app doesn't open, hang, or work properly, re-registering the Microsoft Store app will fix this problem. The following guide will show you how to re-register the Microsoft Store application in Windows 10.

If the Store app doesn't open, hang, or work properly, re-registering the Microsoft Store app will fix this problem.


The following instructions will show you how to re-register the Microsoft Store application for your account or for all users in Windows 10.

**Note** : Make sure you have the correct time zone, date and time to avoid Store problems.

## Re-register the Microsoft Store application for existing users

1. Terminate the Microsoft Store application to make sure it is closed and not running.
2. Open PowerShell.
3. Copy and paste the command below into **PowerShell** and press Enter:

```
Get-AppXPackage *Microsoft.WindowsStore* | Foreach {Add-AppxPackage -DisableDeve
```



```

4. When done, you can close **PowerShell** and try opening the Microsoft Store application again.

## Re-register the Microsoft Store application for all users

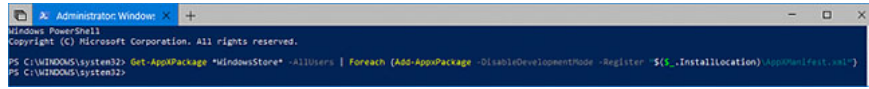
**Note** : You must be logged in as an administrator to perform this option.

1. Terminate the Microsoft Store application to make sure it is closed and not running.

2. Open PowerShell as admin.

3. Copy and paste the below command into **PowerShell** with admin rights and click Enter:

```
Get-AppXPackage *WindowsStore* -AllUsers | Foreach {Add-AppxPackage -DisableDevelopmentMode -Register "$($_.InstallLocation)\AppXManifest.xml" }
```



Re-register the Microsoft Store application for all users

4. When done, close **PowerShell**.

5. Restart the computer to apply the changes.

6. Try opening the Microsoft Store application again.
