After prolonged use, Windows 7 can encounter various problems. These errors are often caused by third-party software, accumulated junk files, or viruses.

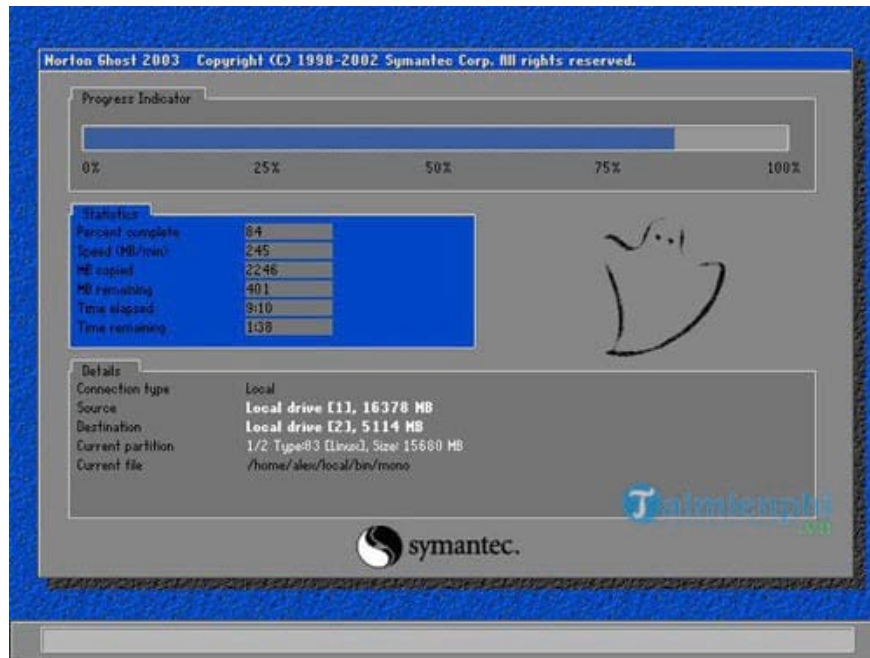
Instructions on how to reset a Windows 7 computer.

3. Reinstall Windows 7



If you don't want to use the two methods above, you can reinstall Windows 7 from scratch. This is the best way to return the system to its original state. Microsoft also recommends that users reinstall Windows periodically for a better experience. If possible, install Windows 7 using a USB drive as this method is faster and more convenient.

The three methods above will help you reset Windows 7 to its factory settings. However, if you want a more modern operating system, consider upgrading to Windows 10. Most current hardware supports Windows 10 well, and you will receive regular updates. If your system is slow, you can also reset Windows 10 to its original state. Good luck!
