

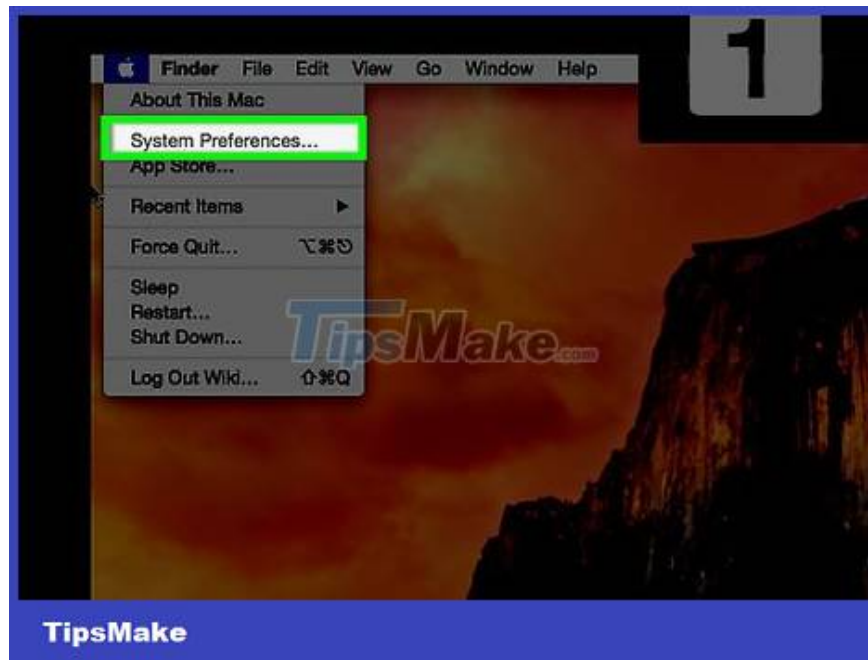
How to Reverse Mouse Scrolling on Mac

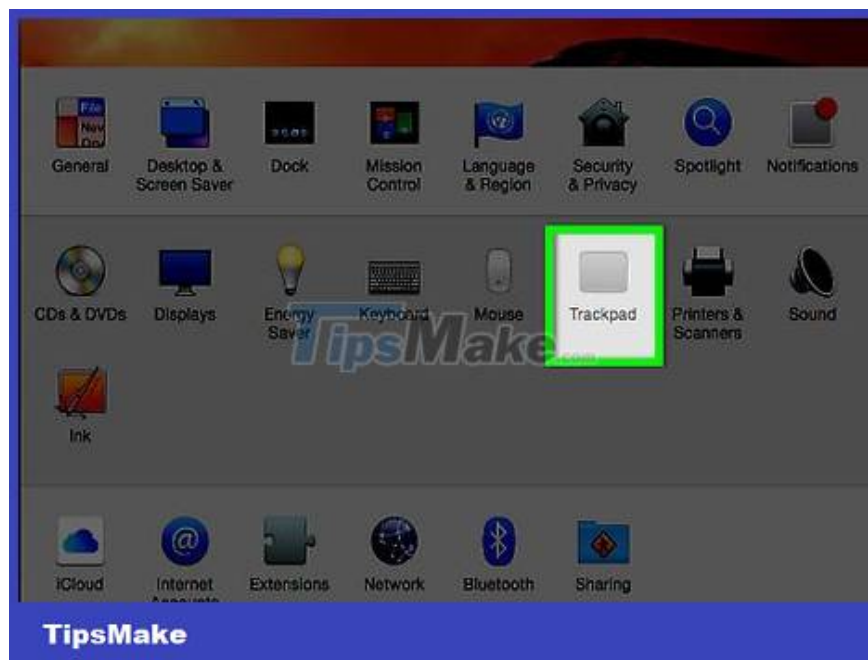
Use the touchpad



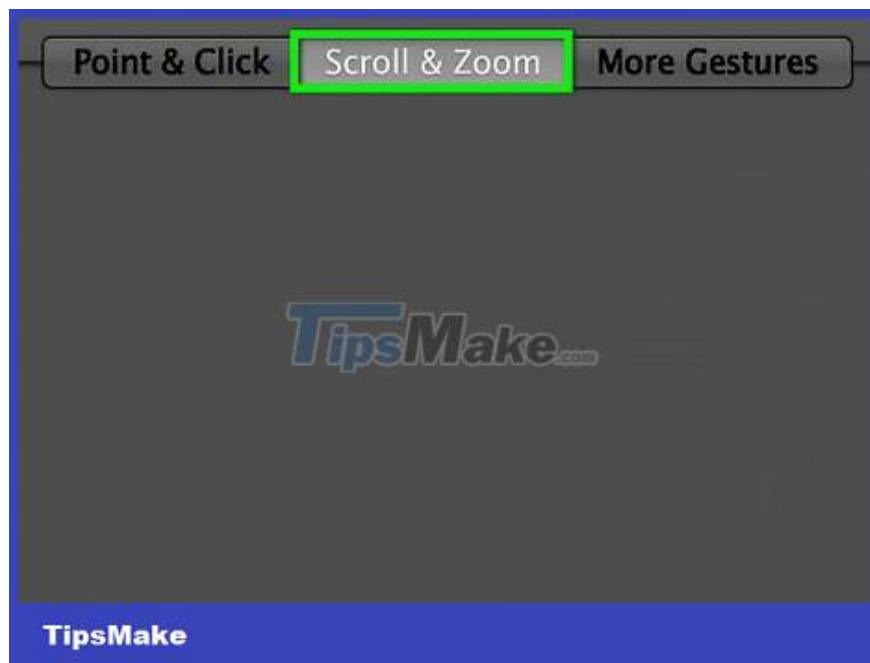
Click the Apple icon. Click the Apple logo in the upper left corner of the menu bar.



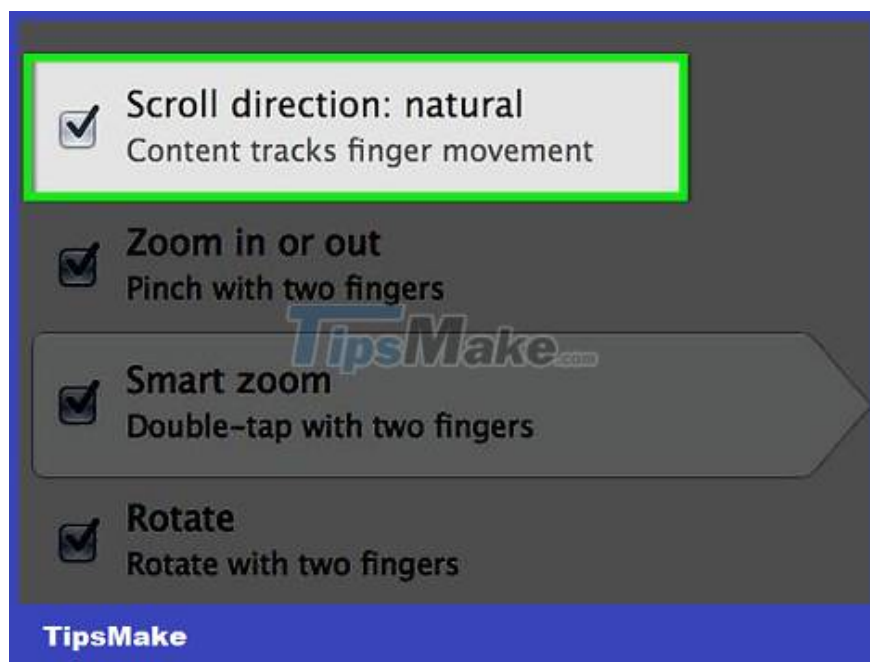
Click System Preferences .



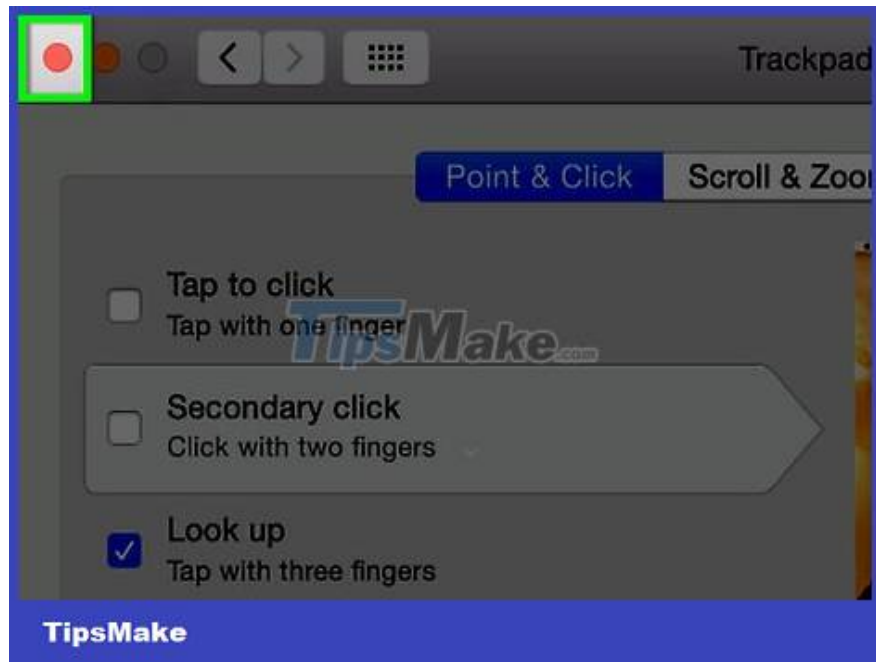
Click the "Trackpad" icon.

Click the "Scroll direction Natural" box to uncheck it.

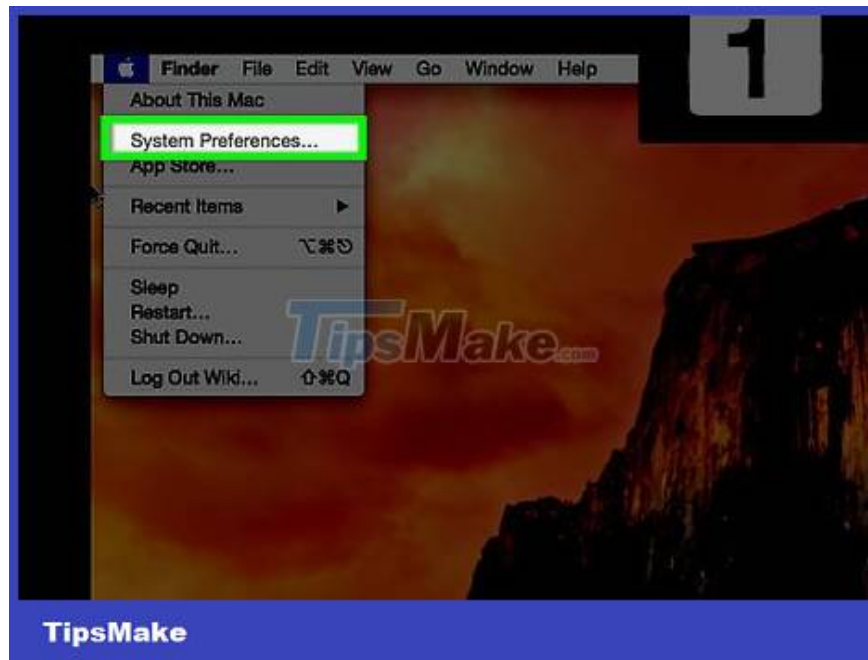


Click the red "X" button. The scroll settings will be saved.

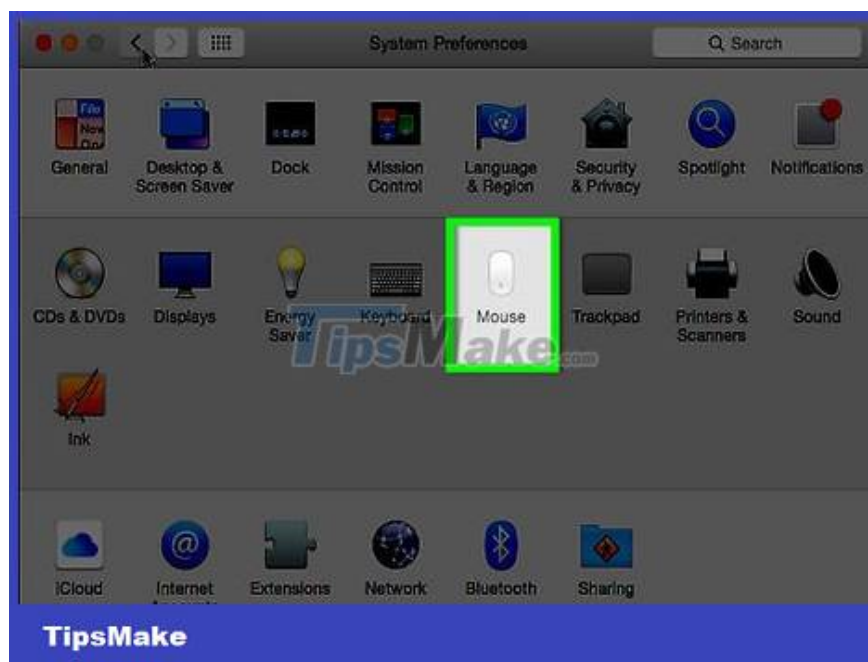
Use mouse



Click the Apple icon. Click the Apple logo in the upper left corner of the menu bar.



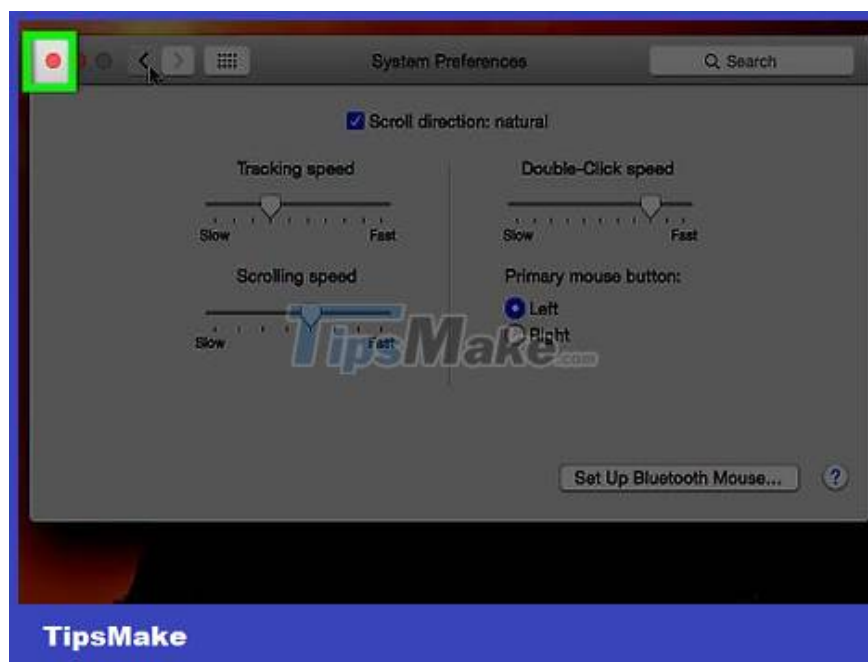
Click System Preferences .
