## 1. What is Archive.org?

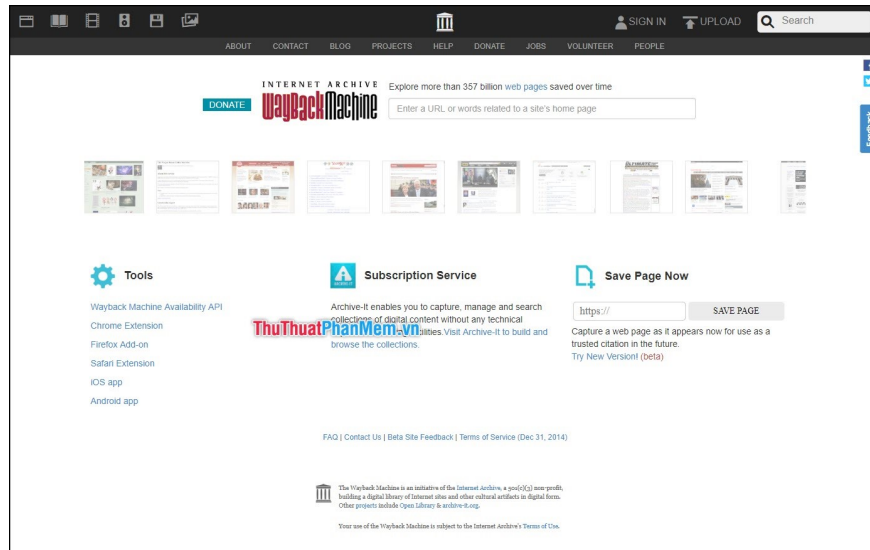

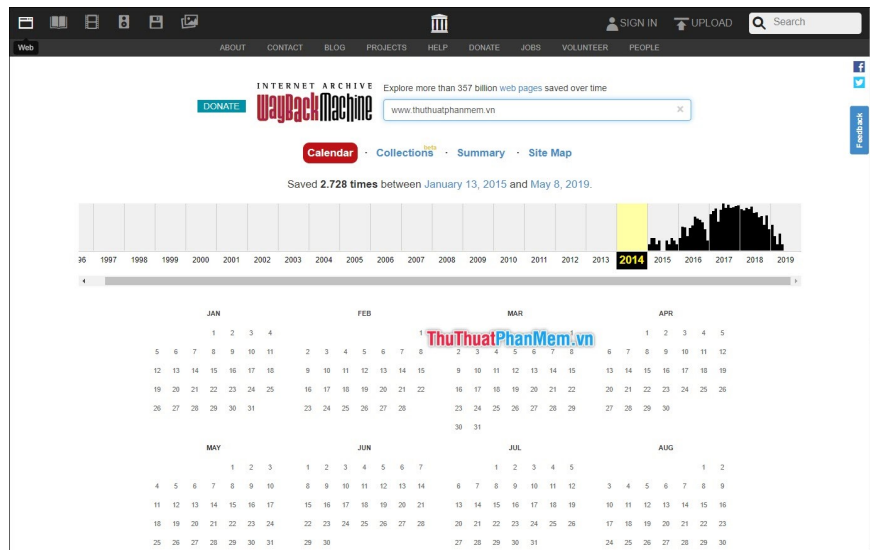
## 2. How to review old data on a website using Archive.org

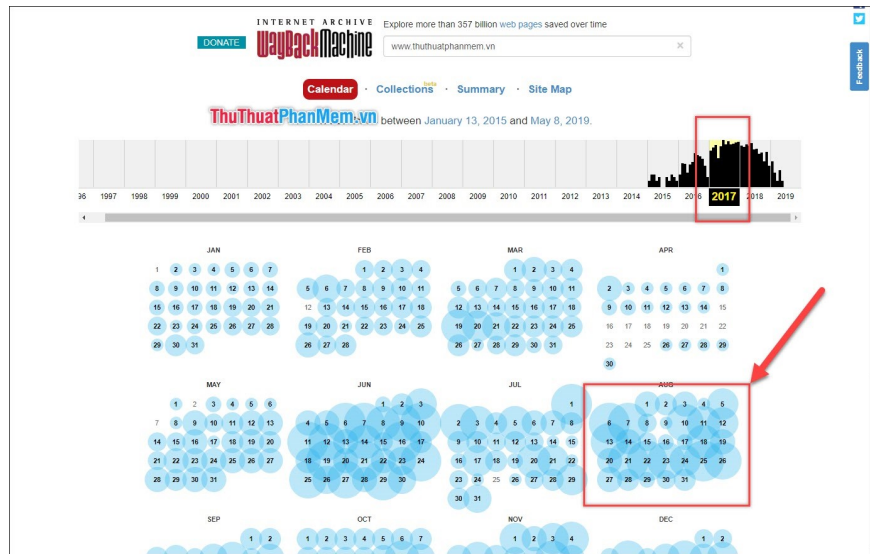
**Step 1:** You proceed to access the website to use the **Wayback Machine** feature .



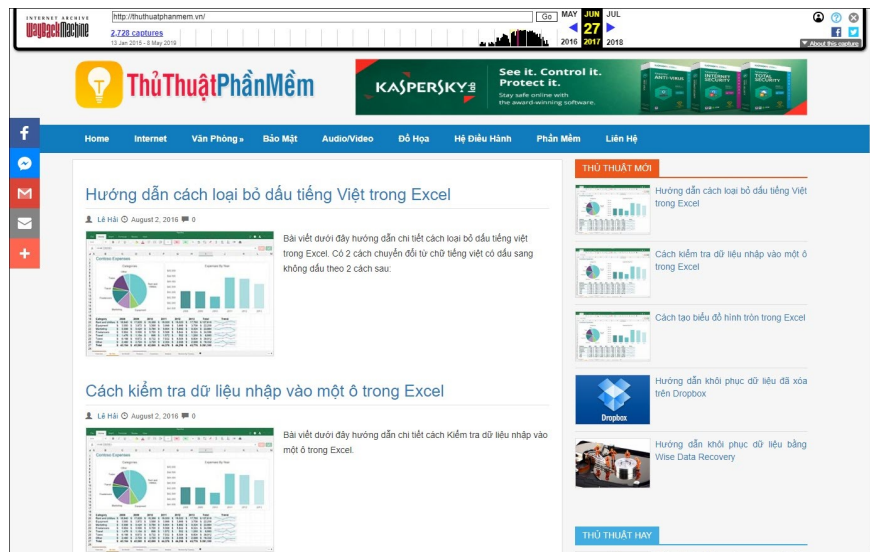
**Step 2:** You proceed to enter the name of the Web site that you want to see data in the search bar.



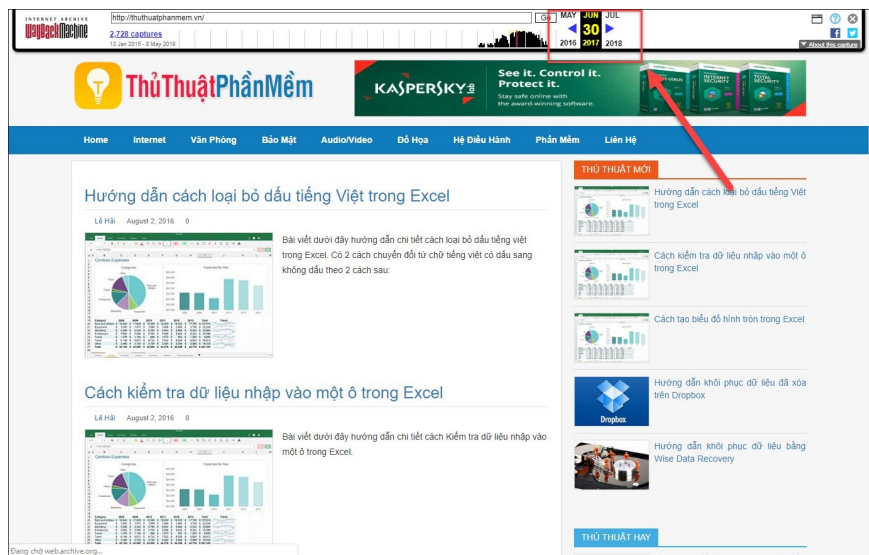
**Step 3:** Next, select the year you want to view the data and select the date you want to see. The green circles are the stored data circle, the size of the circle is proportional to the amount of stored data.



**Step 4:** After that, you will be redirected to the Web page you want to review. You can click on any part of the Web page to review it.



**Step 5:** If you want to change the date when you view the data, click the arrow in the toolbar.



That way you can review the site's old data through the archive.org's **Wayback Machine** .



With Wayback Machine, you can review the content of lost websites and make backups of the data quickly for many different purposes. Good luck!
