

# How to rotate the video in reverse, tilt with Windows Movie Maker

Windows Movie Maker is a video editing software available in Windows Live Essentials, which allows users to record videos at 90-degree angles.

It's not too difficult for you to find a video editing software and install it on your computer. However, for those who use the Windows operating system, perhaps Windows Movie Maker software has become extremely familiar.

Windows Movie Maker is software located in the Windows Live Essentials suite, installed on Windows. Basically, users can create a complete video when using images available on the computer and add sound if desired. In addition, the software also provides users with a lot of video effects, or editing features such as changing video angles, rotating videos when tilted or reversed on Windows Movie Maker. In the article below, Network Administrator will guide readers to rotate videos in different angles with Windows Movie Maker.

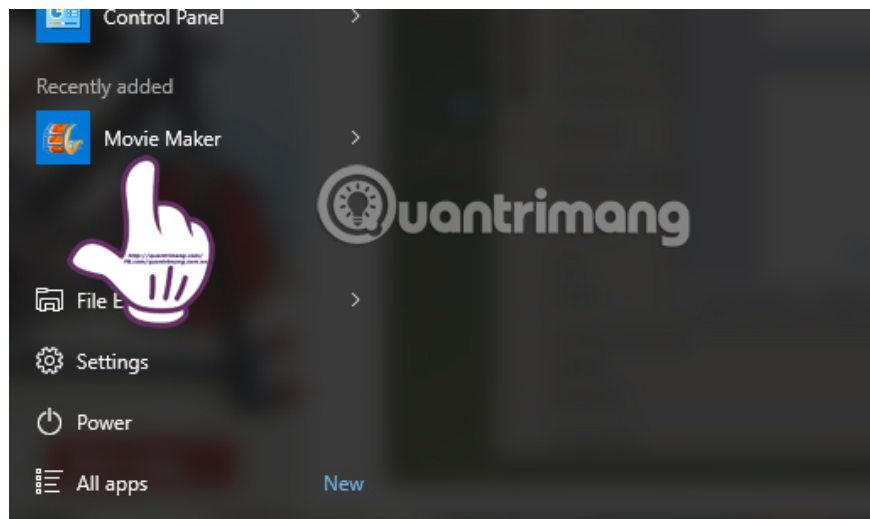
## Step 1:

First, you install Windows Movie Maker software under the Windows Live Essentials toolkit.

1. Download Windows Movie Maker

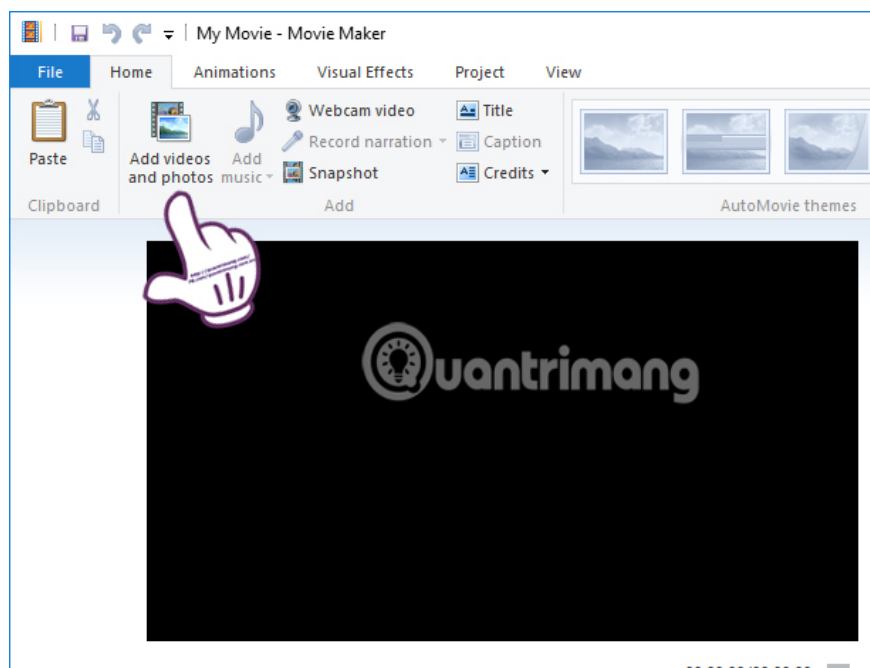
## Step 2:

After installing Windows Live Essentials on your computer, we will open Windows Movie Maker software.

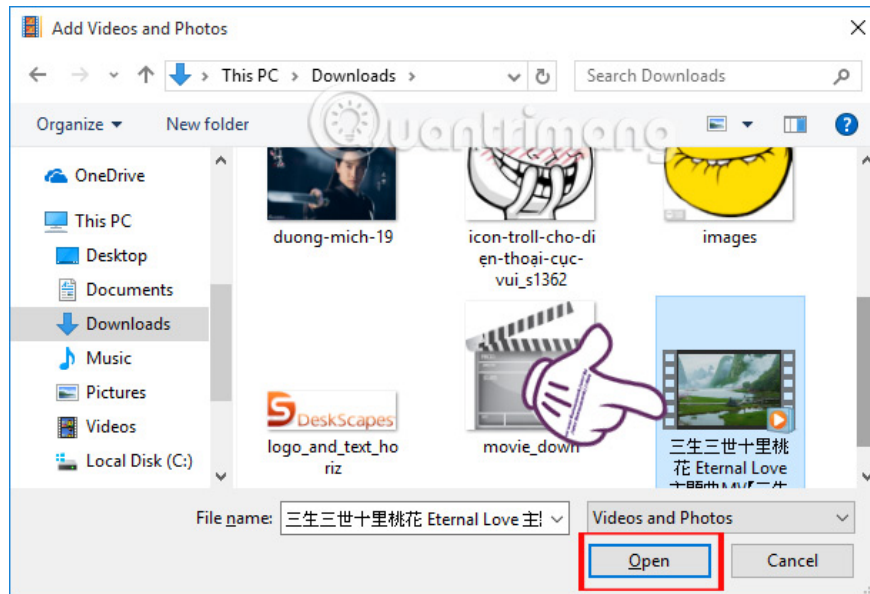


### Step 3:

At Windows Movie Maker tool interface, click **Add Photos and videos** to open the folder containing the video or press Windows + I.



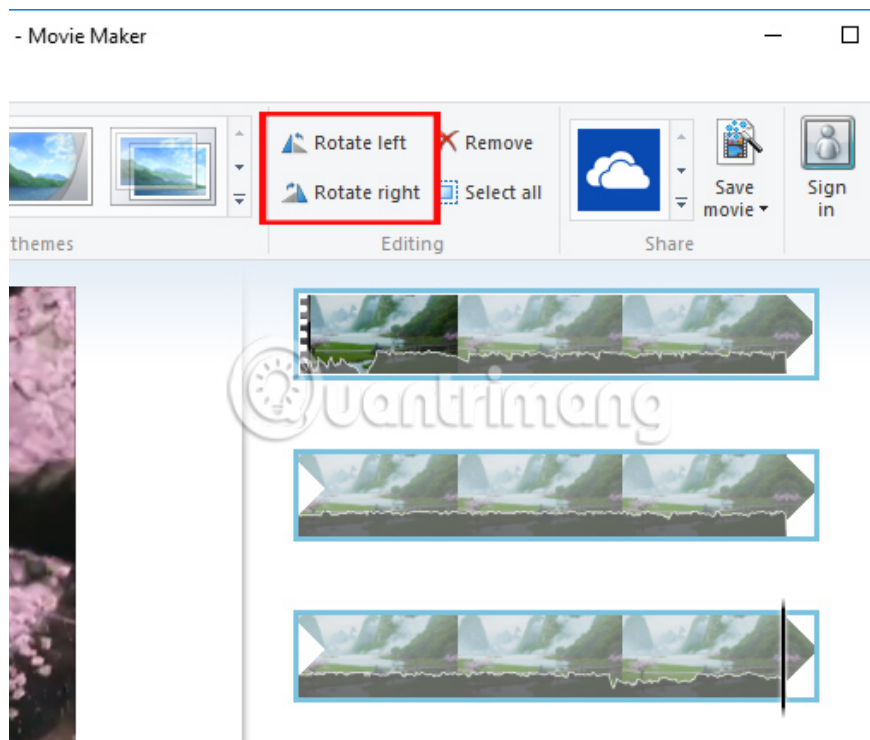
Then the folder interface appears on the computer, we will click on the video you want to rotate and click **Open** .



## Step 4:

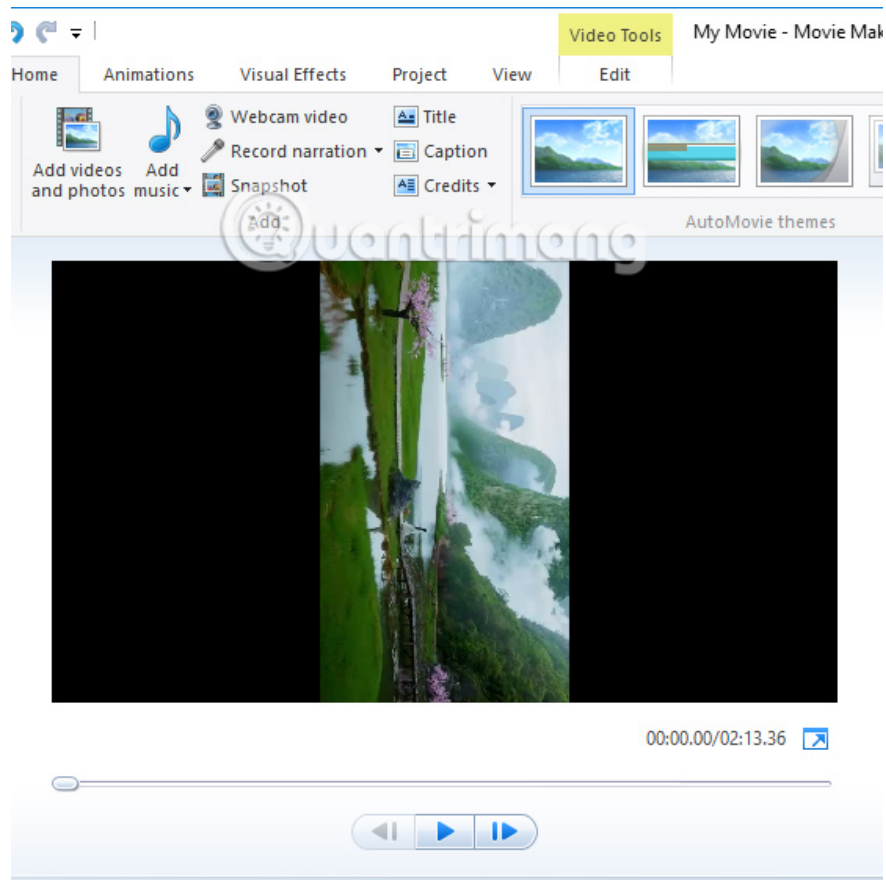
Next, in the main interface of Windows Movie Maker we will see 2 options including **Rotate left rotate video 90 degrees to the left** , **Rotate right rotate video 90 degrees to the right** .

Now you just need to select the angle you want to rotate the video in the left or right direction, then click the corresponding option.



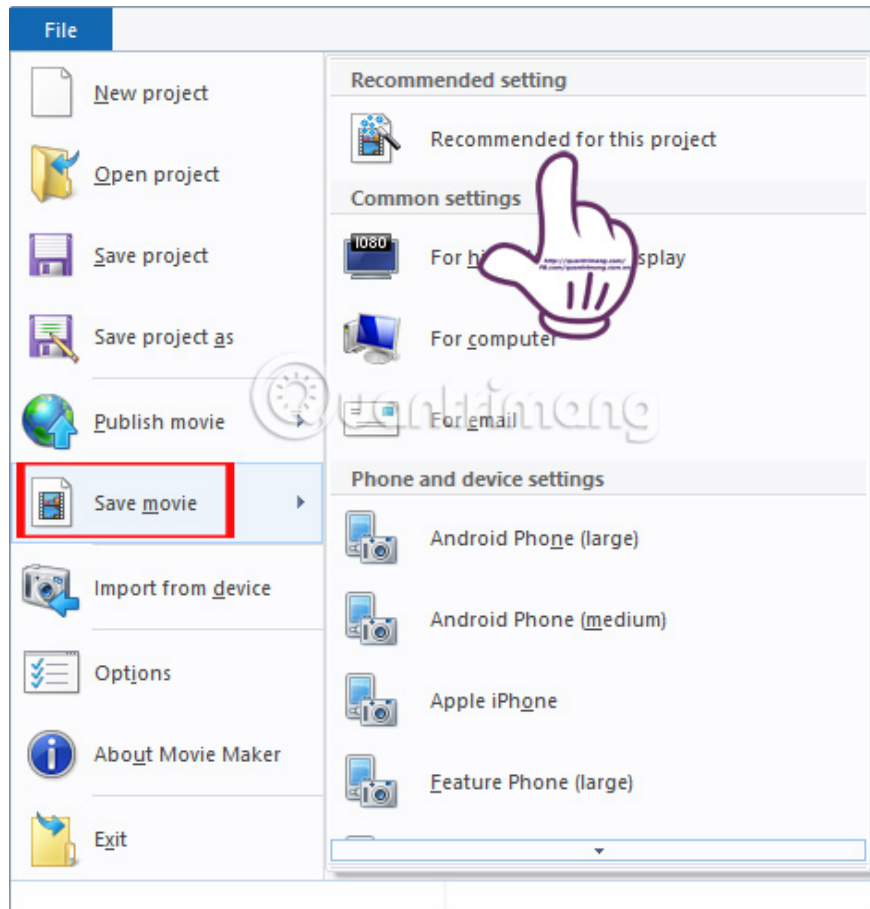
## Step 5:

We can rely on the video preview on the left side of the screen to check if the video has taken the right angle.



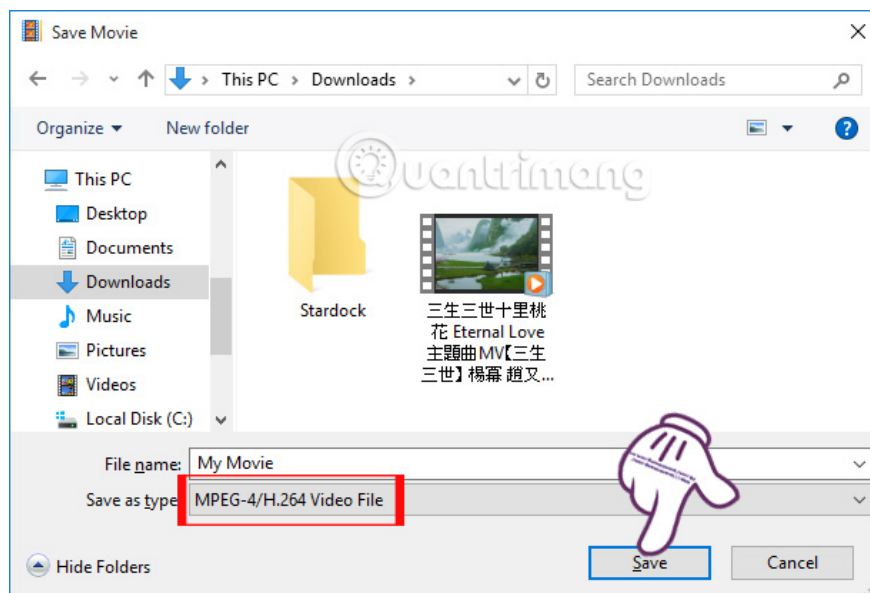
## Step 6:

After making sure of this new angle for the video, click on **File** then select **Save movie** and then select **Recommend for this project** .



Then select the folder where the video has been rotated with Windows Movie Maker, select the **MPEG-4 / H.264** video **format and** finally click **Save** to save.

**Note** , if we just click the Save option normally, the video will be in wlmv format.



So you can rotate the video at different 90-degree angles with Windows Movie Maker software, installed on your Windows computer. Not only does it bring the video creation feature from the image, Windows Movie Maker also helps you to adjust the video angle according to the users' wishes.
