

How to save battery when surfing Facebook on iPhone

Using Facebook too much often causes phone battery capacity to lose quite quickly. So how to surf Facebook all day on iPhone without consuming battery? A few small tweaks on your iPhone will save a lot of battery life.

However, using Facebook too much often causes phone battery capacity to lose quite quickly. So how to surf Facebook all day on iPhone without consuming battery? A few small tweaks on your iPhone will save a lot of battery life.

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1. Turn off video playback automatically when using Facebook

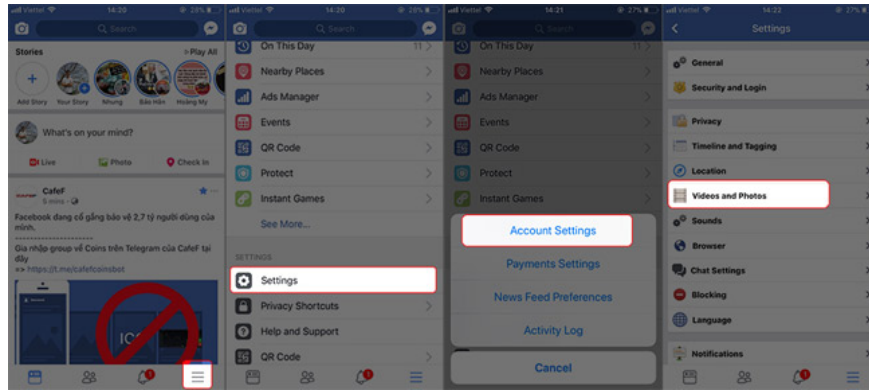
The feature of auto-playing video when you surf the message board on Facebook is quite good, but this is the reason why your iPhone consumes battery quickly. If you feel unnecessary and want to save battery power, you can choose to turn it off.

Step 1:

Open the Facebook application on iPhone, select the 3 dash icon as shown below. Then go to *Settings > Account Settings* .

Step 2:

Scroll down to *Videos and Photos* and select *Autoplay* , then change to *Never Autoplay Videos (never automatically play videos)* to save battery when surfing Facebook on iPhone.



2. Turn off location on the Facebook application

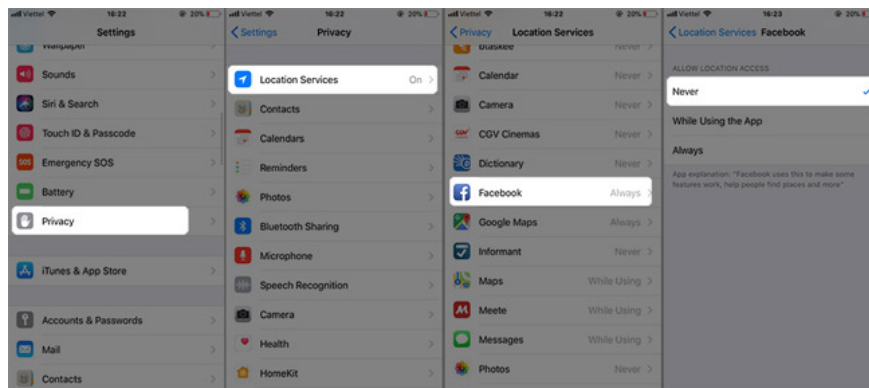
The next custom you should make to save iPhone battery when using Facebook is to turn off the location feature on Facebook, knowing that this feature is always active even when you exit the application. Therefore, if it is not necessary to use the Facebook location feature on iPhone, you need to turn it off in the following steps:

Step 1:

You go to the *Settings* section of the application, where you select *Privacy* and then select *Location Service*.

Step 2:

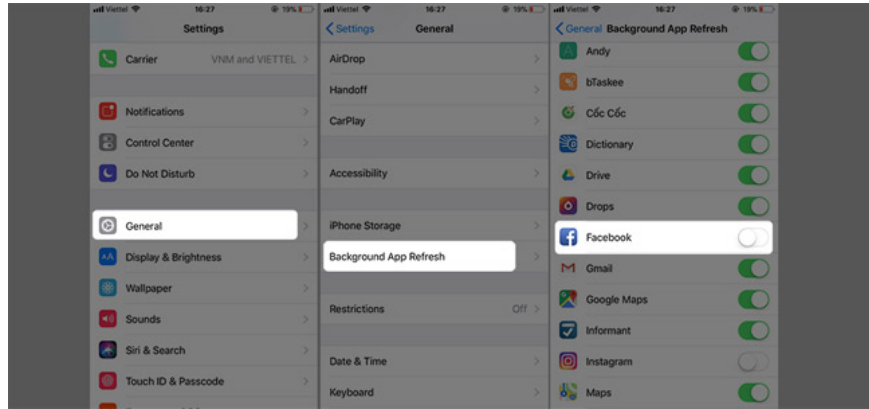
Next, choose *While Using the App* if you want Facebook to only track the location when you are using the app. Or select *Never* if you don't want Facebook to follow the location anymore (*Settings* > *Privacy* > *Location Services*).



3. Turn off Facebook's implicit running feature

Facebook is one of the most battery-hungry applications on the iPhone because it constantly runs underground even if you exit the application. To live virtually without worrying about running out of battery, turn off this feature by:

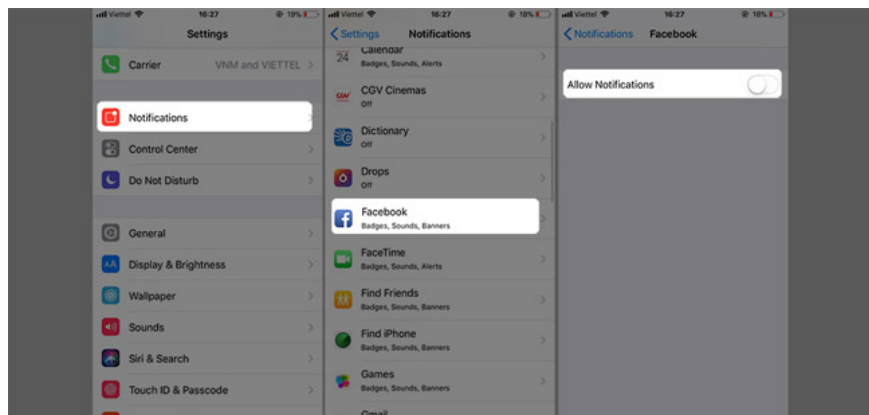
Go to *Settings* > *General* > *Background App Refresh* > Scroll down to find Facebook and swipe left to turn off Facebook's *background* running feature.



4. Turn off Notifications notifications

Notices do not waste a lot of battery, but every time you receive a notification will cause the iPhone screen to light up, so we just need to turn off the Facebook app notification feature to save battery when surfing Facebook on iPhone already.

To turn off Notifications, go to: *Settings* > *Notifocations* > Find Facebook application and drag the bar *Allow Notifications* left to turn it off.



With 4 simple steps above, you will definitely save a decent amount of battery for your iPhone and can use Facebook to "flatten".
