

How to save bookmarks on Firefox to your computer

Saving Firefox bookmarks to your computer will help you restore bookmarks when needed.

Saving Firefox bookmarks is essential to keeping all of the essential, important websites you bookmarked when surfing the web in Firefox. Creating bookmark sites will help you find them quickly when needed, just open the bookmark list to find it. And to make sure that all of the bookmarked data in case of reinstalling Firefox, reinstall the operating system, users should back up Firefox bookmarks.

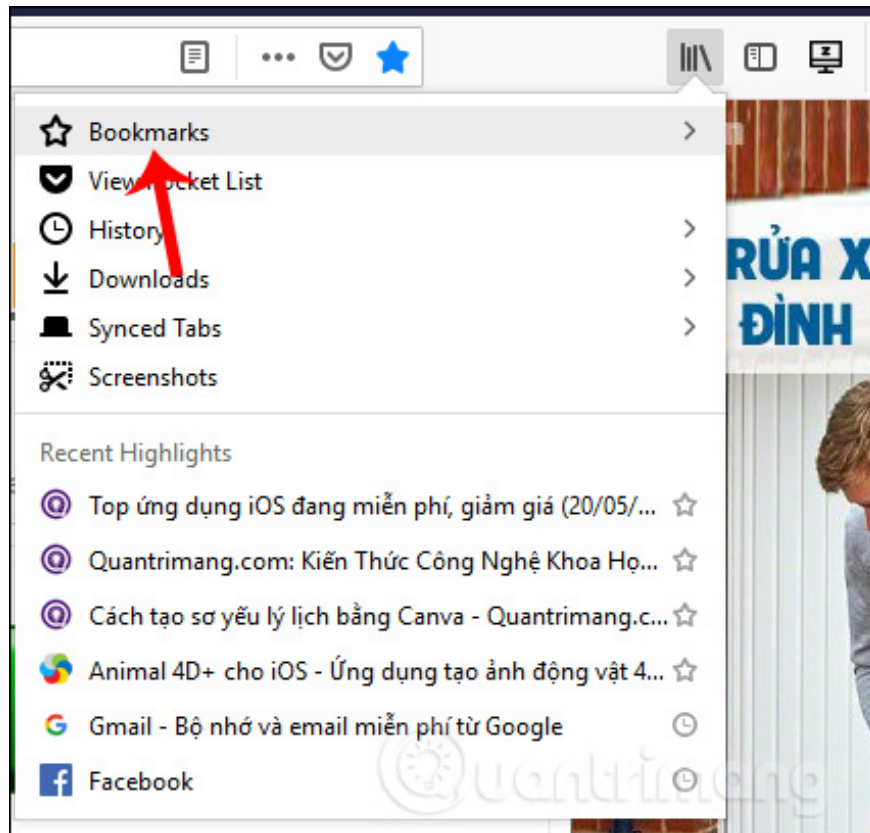
When performing backups, bookmarked sites are compressed into HTML files and saved as normal files on the computer. When you want to retrieve the bookmark, you just need to import the HTML bookmark file into Firefox browser. The following article will show you how to backup and restore Firefox bookmarks on your computer.

1. How to backup and backup bookmarks on Firefox

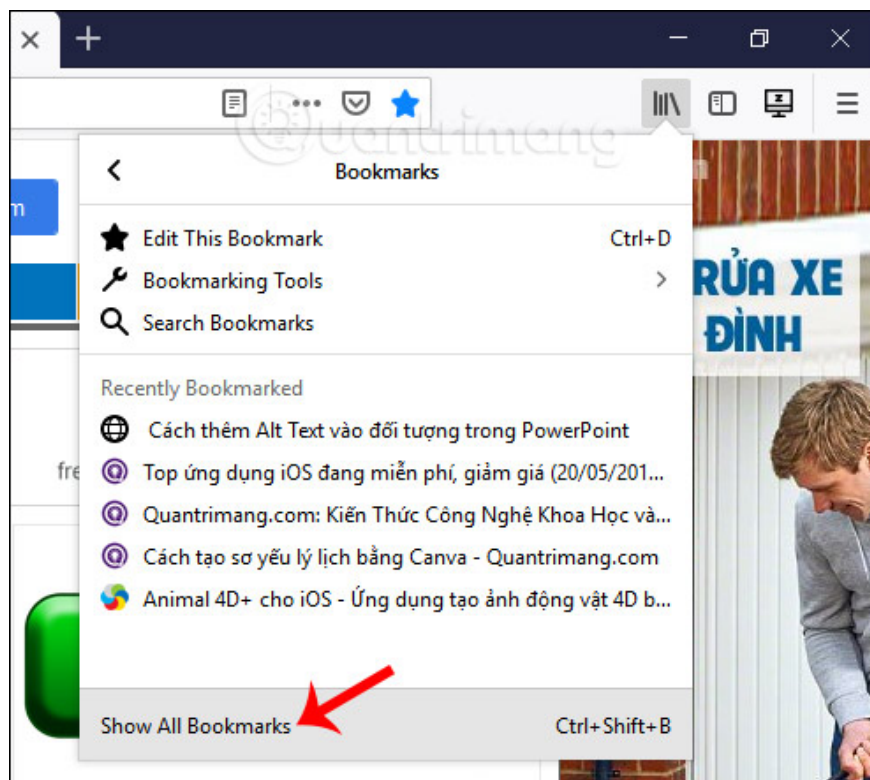
Step 1:

At the Firefox browser interface, click on **the Library icon** as shown below and click on **Bookmarks** in the displayed list.



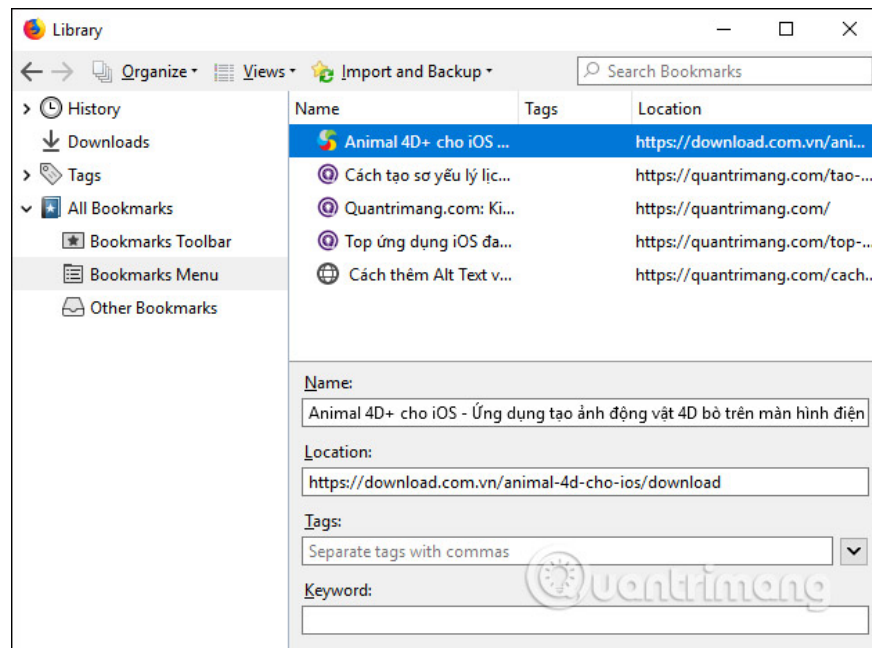
Step 2:

Next, click **Show All Bookmarks** at the bottom of the list.

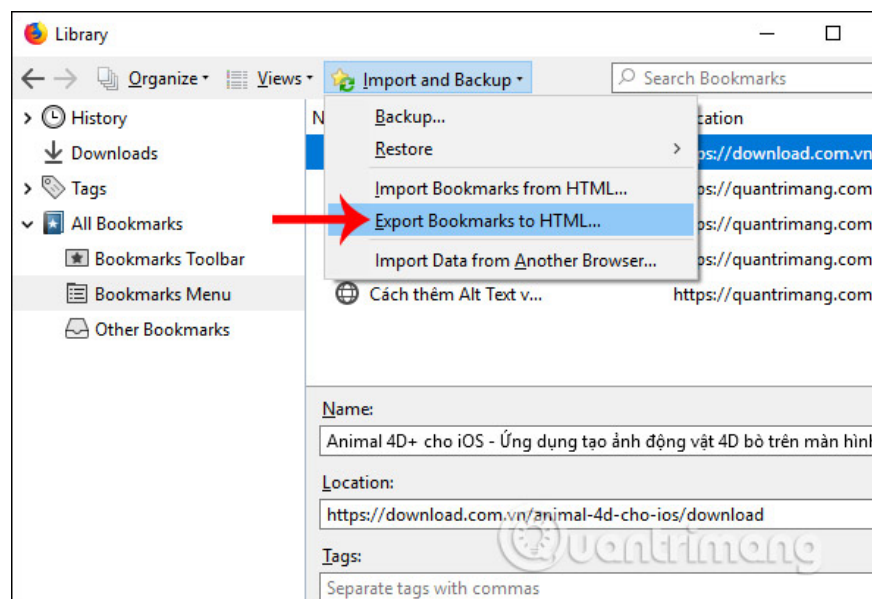


Step 3:

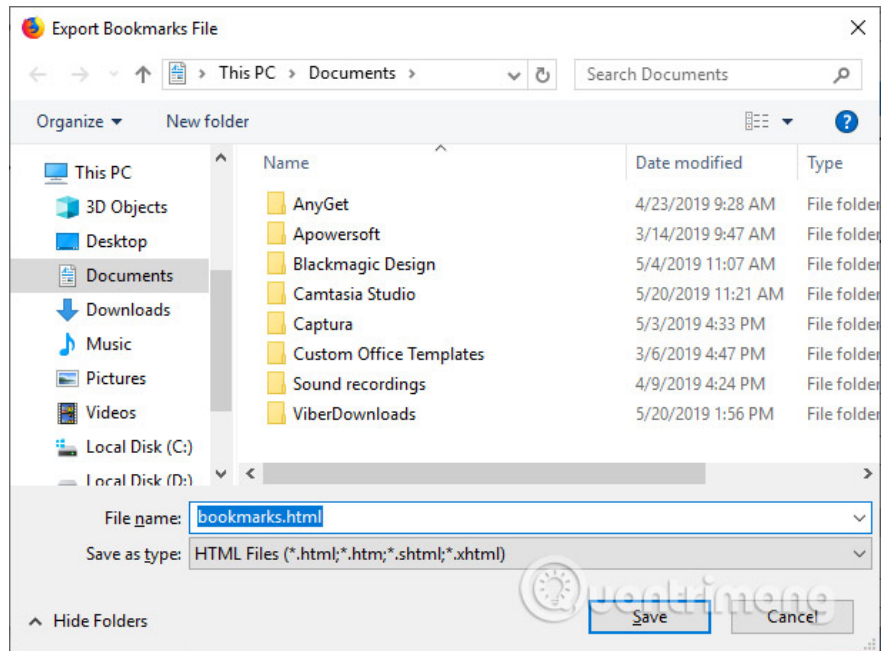
Display the Library interface with a list of browser management items, including bookmarks. Saved web pages will display in different management categories, depending on whether the user has created a bookmark folder or not, we choose where to save the bookmark to export the file.



To **back up your browser bookmarks**, users click on **Import and Backup** at the top of the interface, then select **Export Bookmarks to HTML**. We can also save the bookmark file in JSON format by clicking on **Backup** at the top of the list.



Name this HTML file and **click Save** to save it.

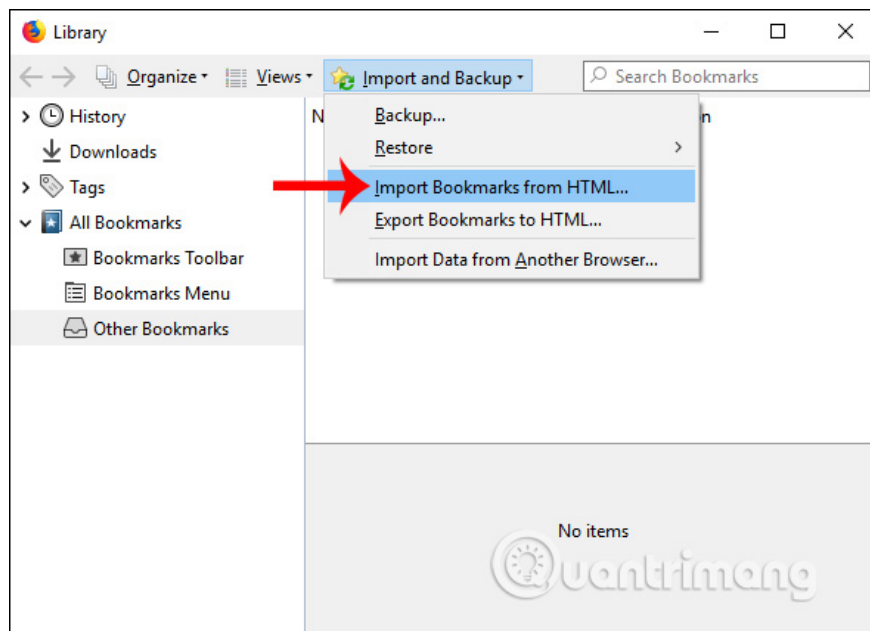


2. How to restore and restore bookmarks Firefox

Once you've reset your browser, reinstall your computer, you can restore your backed up bookmarks.

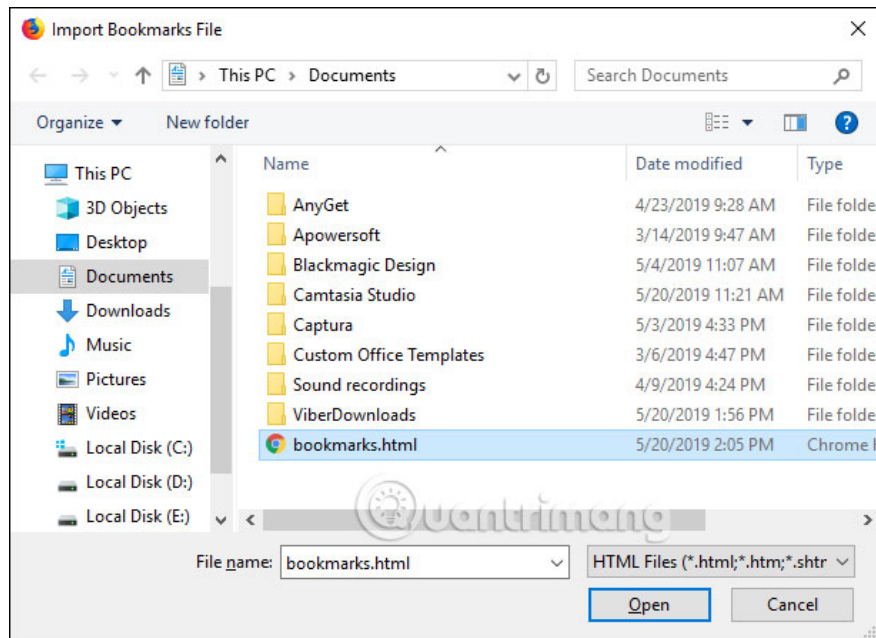
Step 1:

We also access the Library interface by backing up the bookmark above. Then click **Import and Bookmarks** and select **Import Bookmarks from HTML** if you have exported the HTML bookmark file.

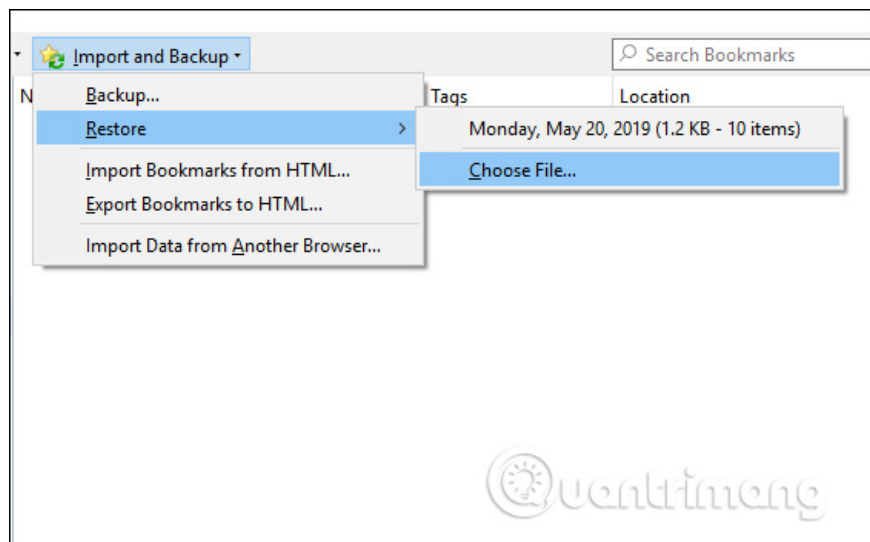


Step 2:

Display the folder on your computer to find where the HTML bookmark file is saved and click Open to import the bookmark file.



In case the user **saves the JSON bookmark file, Firefox** immediately click Restore. Then display the list of bookmark files that have been exported, click the file you want to recover or click Choose File below .



Above is how to backup and restore Firefox browser bookmarks with a very simple and easy way. The above procedure applies to different versions of Firefox.
